Gamecocks Set For Palmetto Intercollegiate

The South Carolina men's golf team returns to action for the third straight week as it travels to Aiken, S.C., for the 16th annual Palmetto Intercollegiate. The teams will play 36 holes on Monday and 18 on Tuesday at the historic Palmetto Golf Club.

The Lineup

Coming off a second-place finish at the USF Invitational, the Gamecocks will stick with the same lineup from a week ago. Senior Dykes Harbin, junior Caulder Moore, sophomores Caleb Sturgeon and Will Murphy and freshman Matt NeSmith will tee off on Monday the Palmetto Golf Club.

History At The Palmetto Intercollegiate

South Carolina is making its second straight appearance and fourth overall at the Palmetto Intercollegiate. The Gamecocks have had plenty of success at the event, finishing no worse than third in any of their previous appearances. Carolina placed third last season, third in 2003 and first in 2004. The Gamecocks have also had a top-five finisher each year, including medalist Erik Johansen in 2004.

Recapping The 2012 Palmetto Intercollegiate

South Carolina was tied for the lead after 36 holes but fell short in the final round, finishing in third place with a total of 863 (+23). Caleb Sturgeon recorded his first career top-five finish as he placed fourth with a total of 213 (+3). Wesley Bryan and Will Murphy also finished in the top 20, tying for seventh and 11th, respectively. Rival Clemson won the team title with a total of 854 (+14).

Breaking Down the Field

This year's field is made up of 18 teams, including four teams ranked in the Golfstat Top 50. No. 22 Clemson, No. 34 Liberty and No. 50 North Carolina State join the 35th-ranked Gamecocks to highlight the field. Tournament host USC Aiken enters the week as the seventh-ranked team in Division II. Akron, Augusta State, Elon, Francis Marion, Furman, Georgia State, Maryland, Nebraska, Penn, Presbyterian, Virginia, Western Carolina and Wofford round out the field. South Carolina has competed against eight teams in the field this season and has a 6-4 head-to-head record against those teams.

Aging Nicely

The Gamecocks will tee off on Monday at the Palmetto Golf Club, which features a par-70, 6,617-yard setup. The course has been taken very good care of over the years as it was founded in 1892, earning it the distinction as the fourth oldest course in the nation.

Sweeping The Awards

Senior Dykes Harbin and freshman Matt NeSmith made it a clean sweep of the weekly SEC Awards. Harbin was named SEC Golfer of the Week and NeSmith earned SEC Freshman Golf of the Week. Harbin and NeSmith received the awards after leading the Gamecocks to a second-place finish at the USF Invitational, finishing tied for second and 10th, respectively.

Movin' On Up

South Carolina is ranked No. 35 in the latest Golfstat Head-To-Head rankings after going on one of the program's most successful stretches in recent history. The Gamecocks have finished first, third and second in their last three tournaments. Carolina was close to making it two first-place finishes but it came up one stroke shy of first last week at the USF Invitational. The Gamecocks have four top-five finishes in six tournaments this season.

Going Out With A Bang

Senior Dykes Harbin is leaving it all on the course during his final season in Columbia. A native of Augusta, Ga., Harbin has a team-high five top-20 finishes this season, including his first career win at the Wendy's Kiawah Classic. Harbin's season average of 72.17 ranks seventh in the conference and is currently eighth all-time on the South Carolina single-season scoring list.

USF Invitational Recap

The South Carolina men's golf team erased a three-shot third-round deficit to tie North Carolina State in the final few holes at the USF Invitational, but it wasn't enough as a late birdie pushed the Wolfpack past the Gamecocks to claim the title at Lake Jovita Golf and Country Club.

South Carolina was tied with North Carolina State at 3-under par with just one player each left on the golf course. Gamecock senior Dykes Harbin, who was 2-under on the back nine through six holes, recorded par on his final three holes to finish the day with a solid 1-under 71. The Wolfpack's Albin Choi made par on the 16th and 18th holes, but it was his birdie at the par-4 17th that lifted North Carolina State to victory.

The Gamecocks closed out the tournament in second place with a three-round total of 861 (-3), while the Wolfpack finished with a total of 860 (-4).

Four Gamecocks wrapped up the week in the top 20 led by Harbin, who finished tied for second with a total of 211 (-5). Matt NeSmith earned his third top-10 finish of the season with a final-round 71 (-1). NeSmith closed out the week with a career-best total of 216 (E). Sophomore Caleb Sturgeon posted a 1-over 73 on Tuesday to finish the event in a tie for 14th with a total of 217. Sophomore Will Murphy earned his second straight top-20 finish in a team event by tying for 19th with a total of 219 (+3) after shooting a final-round 76 (+4).

Bayou City Collegiate Championships Recap

The South Carolina men's golf team made one last charge up the leaderboard, posting a final-round 291 (+3) on its way to claiming third place at the Bayou City Collegiate Championships at Redstone Golf Club. The Gamecocks, who moved three spots up the standings with the third lowest round of the day, wrapped up the weekend with a total of 871 (+7).

Sophomore Caleb Sturgeon fired a 3-under 69 to lead the Gamecocks' move up the leaderboard. Sturgeon, who won

medalist honors at the Wendy's Kiawah Classic to close out the fall, earned his second straight top-10 finish as he moved 19 spots up the standings to tie for eighth with a total of 214 (-2).

Sophomore Will Murphy came close to carding his third straight round of par or better on the weekend but he fell one stroke short, turning in a 1-over 73 to conclude one of the best tournaments of his collegiate career. Murphy finished the weekend in a tie for eighth along with Sturgeon with a total of 214 (-2), which is his best collegiate finish when competing at a team event. Senior Dykes Harbin and freshman Matt NeSmith tied for 31st and 39th, respectively. Harbin turned in a 4-over 76 in the final round to close out the weekend with a total of 221 (+5), while NeSmith shot a 1-over 73 to take his final total to 222 (+6).

Rounding out the lineup, freshman Will Starke carded a 77 (+5) to finished tied for 71st with a total of 232 (+16).

Wendy's Kiawah Classic Recap

With its first tournament title in three years on the line, the South Carolina men's golf team left no doubt about which team was going to come out on top as it posted a final-round 284 (E) to cruise to a 20-stroke victory in the Wendy's Kiawah Classic at Turtle Point Golf Club.

The Gamecocks, who had four golfers finish in the top 20, wrapped up the tournament with a three-round total of 859 (+7) to capture their first title since winning the Rees Jones Invitational on Oct. 6, 2009. South Carolina was also represented in the medalist trophy presentation, as sophomore Caleb Sturgeon claimed his first career tournament title following his second round of 68 (-3) of the week.

A native of Laurens, S.C., Sturgeon finished the tournament with a career-low 54-hole total of 210 (-3). His closest competitor happened to be wearing garnet and black as well, with freshman Will Starke finishing two strokes back in second place after carding a career-low 69 (-2). With senior Dykes Harbin winning the AutoTrader.com Collegiate Classic two weeks ago, Sturgeon's win marks the first time the Gamecocks have had medalists in back-to-back tournaments since Carl Paulson won the PING Intercollegiate and the Billy Hitchcock Intercollegiate consecutively in October of 1993.

Freshman Matt NeSmith and Harbin joined Sturgeon and Starke in the top 20. NeSmith turned in a 4-over 75 to finish tied for sixth with a total of 217 (+4), while Harbin placed 17th with a total of 220 (+7) after shooting a 1-over 72 in the final round. The top-20 finish is the third for NeSmith this season and the fourth for Harbin.

Junior Caulder Moore also had a solid week as he turned in a 76 (+5) to finish in a tie for 49th with a total of 229 (+16).

AutoTrader.com Collegiate Classic Recap

South Carolina senior Dykes Harbin continued to play the best golf of his career as he shot a final-round 72 (+1) to win the AutoTrader.com Collegiate Classic at Berkeley Hills Country Club. Harbin claimed a two-stroke victory over

Chattanooga's Steven Fox, Winthrop's Kamito Hirai and Georgia Southern's Scott Wolfes with a three-round total of 210 (-3), which ties a career low. As a team, the Gamecocks posted the sixth best score of the day with a 10-over 294 on their way to finishing in a tie for seventh place with a total of 889 (+37).

Through three tournaments this season, Harbin has now finished first, sixth and tied for 14th and leads the team with a 71.89 stroke average. Sophomore Caleb Sturgeon was the next highest finisher for the Gamecocks as he tied for 31st with a total of 225 (+12). Sturgeon carded a final-round 74 (+3), which included two birdies, five bogeys and 11 pars.

Sophomore Will Murphy posted the second lowest score of the day for South Carolina with a 2-over 73. His round consisted of three birdies, five bogeys and 10 pars. Murphy finished the tournament in a tie for 35th with a score of 226 (+13). Senior Dean Hester tied for 50th with a total of 229 (+16) after shooting a final-round 75 (+4), while freshman Matt NeSmith shot a 78 (+7) to finished tied for 67th with a score of 233 (+20).

Rees Jones Invitational Recap

The South Carolina men's golf team carded a final-round 305 (+17) on Tuesday to finish in third place at the Rees Jones Invitational at Haig Point Club. The Gamecocks wrapped up the event with a three-round total of 896 (+32), finishing two strokes behind second-place East Carolina (894). Liberty won the tournament with a total of 870 (+6), which is one stroke off the tournament record.

The Gamecocks toughed out the conditions and had a strong presence at the top of the leaderboard with five golfers finishing in the top 15. Senior Dykes Harbin led the way for South Carolina as he recorded a final-round 77 (+5) to finish sixth with a total of 221 (+5). The finish is the best of his career and his second career top-10 showing.

Freshman Matt NeSmith bounced back from his second-round 78 to post a solid round of even-par 72 on Tuesday. A native of North Augusta, S.C., NeSmith earned his first career top-10 finish as he tied for seventh place with a total of 223 (+7). Senior Dean Hester, who played as an individual, finished in a tie for 13th with a score of 226 (+10) after shooting a final-round 73 (+1). Sophomores Will Murphy and Caleb Sturgeon tied for 15th with totals of 227 (+11). Murphy closed out the tournament with a 76 (+4), and Sturgeon carded an 80 (+8). Sophomore Sean Kelly shot an 82 (+10) on the afternoon to finish 42nd with a score of 235 (+19).

Carpet Capital Collegiate Recap

The South Carolina men's golf team carded a final-round 294 (+6) to wrap up the Carpet Capital Collegiate in a tie for 11th place on Sunday at The Farm Golf Club.

The Gamecocks finished the weekend with a three-round total of 886 (+22). Senior Dykes Harbin and freshman Matt NeSmith both finished in the top 20 to lead Carolina, tying for 14th and 19th place, respectively.

Harbin posted the low round of the Gamecocks on Sunday, shooting an even-par 72 to take his three-round total to 216 (E). The top-20 finish is the fifth of his career.

One of three newcomers on the South Carolina roster this season, NeSmith made a stellar debut as he closed out the weekend with a 3-over 75. The North Augusta, S.C., native tallied two birdies, five bogeys and 11 pars to finish with a three-round score of 219 (+3).

Sophomore Sean Kelly produced his best round of the tournament, shooting a 1-over 73 as he finished in a tie for 68th with a score of 230 (+14). Junior Caulder Moore turned in a 3-over 75 on Sunday to tie for 45th with a total of 224 (+8), while sophomore Caleb Sturgeon posted a 2-over 74 to tie for 66th with a total of 229 (+13).

Be on the Lookout

Freshman Matt NeSmith is player to watch in 2012-13, according to Golf Digest. NeSmith is one of 50 golfers on Golf Digest's preseason watch list. A native of Augusta, Ga., NeSmith was ranked No. 1 in the Polo Golf Rankings. He won three AJGA "majors" last season and was one of four golfers to receive the prestigious Byron Nelson International Junior Golf Award. NeSmith also played at the PGA Wyndham Championship, missing the cut by just two strokes.
