TODAY'S GAME

South Carolina hosts Louisiana Tech on Friday in the season opener for both schools at Colonial Life Arena. The meeting is the second all-time between the two programs and the first since the 1960-61 campaign. Friday's matchup will be broadcast on SEC Network + with Burch Antley (pxp) and former Gamecock Carey Rich (analyst) on the call. The matchup vs. the Bulldogs marks the first in a stretch of three games in five days for Carolina to open up the 2016-17 season.

GAME STORYLINES

- South Carolina is in its 109th season of varsity basketball in 2016-17.
- On the sidelines, Frank Martin is joined by associate head coach Matt Figger, assistant coaches Perry Clark and Bruce Shingler, and director of operations Andy Assaley.
- The contest vs. Louisiana Tech marks Carolina's first official matchup on its new court, which features a Block C logo at center court, a lighter wood grain and South Carolina Palmetto Trees in the corners.
- South Carolina returns two starters and eight letterwinners from last season's squad that posted a 25-9 overall record, matching the Carolina record for total wins.
- Carolina owns an 79-29 (.731) all-time record in season openers, including a perfect 10-0 record in the last 10 seasons. The last season-opening loss for the Gamecocks came against the Ohio Valley's Tennessee Tech during the 2000-01 season, as the Golden Eagles edged the Gamecocks, 73-67. The Gamecocks earned an 84-69 victory over Norfolk State in last season's lidlifter.

BY THE NUMBERS

Senior guard Sindarius Thornwell is the SEC's active leader for points scored in his career with 1,278, which ranks 22nd in Carolina history.

South Carolina set a record for regular-season wins in 2015-16, notching its 24th win of the season in the regular-season finale at Arkansas.

A SOUTH CAROLINA WIN WOULD ...

- Be Carolina's 16th-straight win in a season opener, dating back to the 2001-02 season.
- Improve Frank Martin's record to 10-0 in season lidlifters.
- Be Carolina's first over a C-USA opponent since a 77-59 road win at Marshall on Dec. 1, 2014.
- Be Carolina's 17th win in the last 20 games played in Colonial Life Arena dating back to last season.

- Those returning starters feature the only back-court in the SEC with two 1,000-point scorers, in senior guards Sindarius Thornwell and Duane Notice. The duo accounted for 24.2 points and 6.1 assists per game last season.

- Thornwell was named to the SEC All-Defensive Team last March, while Notice was named the league's Sixth Man Of the Year.

- The Gamecocks return just 49.4 percent of their scoring from a year ago, with the departure of three senior starters in Michael Carrera (14.5 ppg), Laimonas Chatkevicius (10.2 ppg) and Mindaugas Kacinas (9.9 ppg).

- The Gamecocks began the 2015-16 season 15-0, their best start since the 1933-34 campaign.

- Carolina welcomes nine newcomers to the squad this season in Tommy Corchiani, Rakym Felder, Hassani Gravett, Khadim Gueye, Evan Hinson, Kory Holden, Sedee Keita, Maik Kotsar and Ran Tut.

- The Gamecocks are undefeated in exhibition contests under the direction of Frank Martin with wins over Kentucky Wesleyan (2012-13), USC Aiken (2013-14), Benedict (2014-15), Allen (2015-16) and Newberry (107-89).

SCOUTING LA TECH

- The Bulldogs are led by second-year head coach Eric Konkol.

- La Tech posted a 23-10 record last season, including a 7-7 mark in road games.

- La Tech's top returner is fifth-year senior big man Eric McCree who averaged 16.2 points and 7.4 rebounds per game last season to earn All-Conference honors.

- McCree was named to the Preseason All-Conference USA team last month.

- La Tech was picked seventh in the Preseason Conference USA poll by the league's coaches.

- The Bulldogs defeated Southern Arkansas 86-69 in their lone exhibition of the season on Nov. 3.

- Returning to the hardwood for the Bulldogs this season are senior forward Qiydar Davis and sophomore center Joniah White, who missed the majority of last season due to injuries.

EXHIBITION RECAP

South Carolina opened its 2016-17 season with a 107-89 exhibition win over Newberry College on Nov. 6 at Colonial Life Arena. Carolina shot 50.0 percent from the field in the game en route to its offensive outburst. Senior guard Sindarius Thornwell led all players with 34 points on 13-of-24 shooting. Thornwell recorded a double-double with 11 rebounds, which led the team. He also led the team with five assists and five blocks.

THORNWELL NAMED TO PRESEASON SQUAD

Senior guard Sindarius Thornwell was named to the Preseason All-SEC First Team on Thursday by the league's coaches. Thornwell enters the season as the league's high scorer for active players with 1,278 career points. This marks the third-straight season that Thornwell has garnered pre-season honors from the coaches, as he was named to the Preseason All-SEC Second Team prior to his sophomore and junior campaigns.

KEY STAT

In home games last season South Carolina held a +10.6 scoring margin, shot 43.3 percent from the field and out-rebounded its opponents by a +6.8 margin.

South Carolina continues its stretch of three games in five days to open the 2016-17 campaign when it hosts Holy Cross on Sunday. Game time vs. the Crusaders is set for 6 p.m. ET on the SEC Network with Kevin Fitzpatrick (pxp) and Dane Bradshaw (analyst) on the call.

GAMECOCKS CONCLUDE HISTORIC 2015-16 REGULAR SEASON

South Carolina concluded an historic regular season on March 5, 2015, with a 76-61 win on the road at Arkansas. That victory set the school record for regular-season wins at 24. The Gamecocks began the season 15-0, their best start since the 1933-34 campaign, and the 24 wins marked the most since the 1996-97 squad also posted 24 victories. In addition, South Carolina's 11 SEC wins marked the most since 1998, match the second-most ever by a Carolina team and marked just the fourth time that the Gamecocks had double-digit SEC wins in their 25 years in the league.

Frank Martin was named the head men's basketball coach at the University of South Carolina on March 27, 2012, becoming the 32nd head coach in the history of the South Carolina program, which enters its 109th season as a varsity sport in 2016-17. Martin owns a 187-117 (.600) overall record as a head coach, entering his 10th season overall, and a 70-63 (.526) record entering his fifth season at South Carolina.

In Martin's fourth season leading the Garnet and Black (2015-16), Carolina put together one of the top seasons in its history, matching a school record for wins with a 25-9 overall record on the year, while the Gamecocks reached double-digit SEC wins for just the fourth time since joining the league, posting an 11-7 mark in conference contests. The SEC finish was Carolina's highest since the league combined its East and West Divisions prior to the 2012 season. South Carolina began the season 15-0, its best start since the 1933-34 campaign and went on to post a school-record 24 regular-season wins.

The Gamecocks received votes or were ranked for 15 weeks in the USA Today Coaches Poll, rising to as high as 15th, and for a total of 14 weeks in the AP poll, rising to as high as 19th, during the season. Carolina advanced to postseason play for the first time since 2009, making their 12th appearance in the Postseason NIT as one of the top four seeds in the event. The Gamecocks posted a win over High Point in the opening round, before suffering a season-ending loss to visiting Georgia Tech on March 21.

Three Gamecocks were honored with postseason awards by the SEC coaches, with senior forward Michael Carrera earning First Team All-SEC accolades, junior guard Sindarius Thornwell was named to the All-Defensive Team and junior guard Duane Notice was named the league's Sixth Man of the Year. Carrera went on to earn honors from several organizations following the best season of his career. Carrera, Notice and Thornwell each reached the 1,000 career-point plateau during the season as well.

Prior to his appointment in Columbia, Martin spent the previous five seasons as the head coach at Kansas State University, leading the Wildcats to the NCAA Tournament four times, including a trip to the "Elite 8," during the 2009-10 campaign when the squad won a school record 29 contests. Martin's Wildcats won at least 21 games in each of his five seasons at the helm, as the program compiled a record of 117-54 (.684) under his direction. During that time, Kansas State posted a 50-32 (.609) record in Big 12 Conference games, finishing fifth or higher in each season, with three season finishes of third or better.

A native of Miami, Fla., Martin earned his bachelor's degree in physical education from Florida International in 1993. He and his wife, Anya, have three children, Brandon, Amalia and Christian.
