GAMECOCKS SET TO FACE RIVAL CLEMSON

The South Carolina swimming and diving teams will face rival Clemson this weekend for the final time. The diving portion of the meet will be held on Friday at the Blatt P.E. Center/Carolina Natatorium at 6:30 p.m. The swimming events will be held on Saturday at 12 p.m. at Westside Aquatic Center in Greenville, S.C.

ONE LAST TIME

The Gamecocks and Tigers are meeting this weekend for the final time, as Clemson is phasing out its swimming and diving program at the end of the season. Carolina holds the upper hand on both the men and women's sides in the series history. The Gamecock men boast a 38-31-1 record against the Tigers, while the Carolina women are 20-16 all-time against Clemson. The series dates back to 1923.

LAST TIME VS. CLEMSON

The Gamecocks swept the Tigers in last year's meet on Oct. 29, 2010. The Carolina men claimed a 169.5-125.5 victory, while the Gamecock women defeated the Tigers 167-133. Rachael Schaffer and Michael Flach each recorded three wins apiece to lead Carolina on the day. The Gamecocks got off to a strong start with the help of their diving corps, as Rylan Ridenour won both the one and three-meter springboards. Taryn Zack grabbed first in the one-meter springboard on the women's side, while Courtney Forcucci edged out Zack for first place on the three-meter springboard.

SCOUTING CLEMSON

Both the Clemson men and women's teams enter Saturday's showdown undefeated at 3-0. The Tigers have defeated Davidson, Limestone and Savannah College of Art and Design to open the season.

The Tiger men had one of the most successful seasons in program history a year ago, posting a 6-3 dual meet record and finishing sixth at the ACC Championships. Clemson brings back a bulk of that roster led by senior Chris Dart, who won an ACC title last season in the 200 backstroke with a time of 1:43.77.

On the women's side, Clemson went 4-5 in 2010-11 and finished 10th at the ACC Championships. The Tigers return the most experience in the backstroke with seniors Kelly Fowler, Kerry McLaughlin and Deanna Piper and sophomore Ali Polhill leading the way. Polhill and Fowler have the sixth and seventh best 100 backstroke times in school history, respectively.

GAMECOCKS SWEEP GEORGIA TECH IN HOME OPENER

The South Carolina swimming and diving teams turned in a dominating performance en route to a sweep of Georgia Tech in their home opener at the Blatt P.E. Center/Carolina Natatorium.

The Gamecock women (2-1) defeated the Yellow Jackets, 176-122, while the Carolina men (1-2) cruised to a 179.5-116.5 victory. On the day, the Gamecocks recorded an impressive 25 wins out of the 32 events.

The Carolina diving corps gave the Gamecocks plenty of momentum heading into the swimming events by sweeping the boards. Senior Courtney Forcucci won both the one and three-meter springboards with NCAA Zone

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qualifying scores of 295.35 and 343.20. Freshman Patricia Kranz finished second on the three-meter board with a Zone qualifying score of 325.88. On the men's boards, junior Rylan Ridenour posted a Zone qualifying score of 387.75 to win the one-meter springboard, while freshman Cole Miller placed second with a Zone score of 348.82. Miller also won the three-meter event with a Zone score of 380.77, and Ridenour finished second with a qualifying score of 372.60.

On the women's side, junior Matea Peteh was a part of three wins. She claimed first in the 100 and 200 backstroke with career best times of 57.22 and 2:02.73, respectively. She also helped lead the Gamecock 200 medley relay team with Amanda Rutqvist, Meghan Brockington and Rachel Elliott to a first-place showing with a time of 1:46.81.

Sophomore Matt Navata had a strong showing for the Gamecock men with a win in the 200 butterfly with a time of 1:53.38 and a second-place finish in the 200 backstroke with a time of 1:52.81.

The Gamecocks also had a stellar day in the distance events as they claimed the top two spots in the men and women's 500 freestyle and the men's 1,000 freestyle and the top three spots in the women's 1,000 freestyle.

The Gamecocks took the top three spots in the men's 100 backstroke, as Heinze led the way with a time of 50.75. Freshman Michael Covert claimed second with a time of 51.48, and sophomore Jay Warner placed third in a time of 51.58.

Carolina swept the breaststroke events, as Rutqvist claimed both the women's 100 and 200 breaststroke races with times of 1:05.03 and 2:17.81, respectively. Cave won both events on the men's side with times of 57.73 and 2:05.91. Also collecting wins for the Gamecocks were Badillo in the 100 butterfly (49.56), Schaffer in the women's 200 IM (2:04.85) and Collin Kaden in the men's 200 IM (1:53.39).

GAMECOCK WOMEN SPLIT, MEN FALL IN TRI-MEET WITH FSU, ALABAMA

The South Carolina swimming and diving teams opened the 2011-12 season in a challenging tri-meet at Florida State against the Seminoles and Alabama at the Morcom Aquatics Center last Saturday.

The Gamecock women pulled out a thrilling 151-149 victory over the Crimson Tide but fell to Florida State, 201.50-93.50. The Carolina men lost to the Seminoles, 199-101, and dropped a 171-129 decision to Alabama.

Sophomore Rachael Schaffer helped the Gamecocks clinch the win over Alabama as she claimed first in the 200 IM with a time of 2:04.58, while freshman Annika Jonsson placed third in the event with a time of 2:08.67.

Jonsson also finished third in the 500 freestyle (5:01.93) and the 1,000-yard freestyle (10:18.81).

The Carolina women had two runner-up finishes on the day. Sophomore Amanda Rutqvist placed second in the 200 breaststroke with a time of 2:17.35. On the boards, senior Courtney Forcucci finished second on the three-meter springboard (281.15) and third on the one-meter springboard (264.45).

On the men's side, the Gamecocks had several strong performances despite the losses. Freshman Alex Vance had a memorable start to his Gamecock career, winning the 200 breaststroke and claiming third in the 100 breaststroke with times of 2:04.29 and 58.15, respectively.

Junior Matt Columbus finished second in the 1,000-yard freestyle with a time of 9:33.34, while sophomore Gerard Rodriguez swam to a second-place finish in the 200 freestyle with a time of 1:39.94. Junior Max Heinze finished second in the 100-yard backstroke in a time of 50.76, and junior Brooks Ross claimed second in the 500 freestyle in a time of 4:37.27.

Freshman Cole Miller had the best performance on the boards for the men with a third-place showing in the 3-meter springboard with a score of 332.00.

BACK-TO-BACK

For the second straight week, a South Carolina diver earned SEC Diver of the Week honors. Junior Rylan Ridenour received the honor this week as he helped lead the Gamecocks to a convincing 179.5-116.5 win over Georgia Tech on Saturday in their home opener at the Blatt P.E. Center/Carolina Natatorium. The Lebanon, Ind., native cruised to a win on the one-meter springboard with a NCAA Zone qualifying score of 387.75, the highest score in the SEC this season. Ridenour finished second on the three-meter springboard with a Zone score of 372.60, which is the fourth highest score in the conference.

Senior Courtney Forcucci received the honor last week.

FOCUSING ON LONDON

Junior All-American Michael Flach, who finished 15th in the 500 freestyle at the 2011 NCAA Championships, is the team's unquestioned leader. But with the 2012 Summer Olympics approaching, Flach is taking an Olympic redshirt to train for an opportunity to compete at the games in London. Flach is the school record holder in the 500 freestyle with a time of 4:16.03.

With Flach focusing on the Olympics, the Gamecocks will turn to juniors Bobby Cave and Max Heinze to help carry the load. Cave is one of the most talented breaststrokers in the SEC as he broke his own school record in the 200 breaststroke at the SEC Championships a year ago with a time of 1:58.27. Heinze returns as one of the Gamecocks' top sprint specialists. The Berlin, Germany, native won five consecutive times in the 100 backstroke last spring.

To convert a metric time achieved in a 25-meter racing course to an equivalent time for a 25-yard racing course: (a) transform the achieved metric time into seconds; (b) carrying the calculation out to five decimal places, multiply the transformed time in seconds by the appropriate following conversion factor; (c) drop, without rounding, all units smaller than a hundredth of a second; and (d) finally, transform the resultant value in seconds back into minutes and seconds to obtain the converted time.
