- South Carolina is in its 35th season of varsity soccer in 2012.
- South Carolina head coach Mark Berson is in his 36th season overall and his 35th season as head coach of the Gamecocks. He is assisted by former players Spencer Lewis and Joey Worthen, both in their first season. Another former player for the Gamecocks, Clark Brisson, is the volunteer assistant coach.
- Following two consecutive Conference USA road contests, South Carolina returns to the friendly confines of Stone Stadium for three straight matches over the next two weeks, beginning with Saturday's contest vs. FIU.
- South Carolina looks to rebound after a 4-0 loss at Tulsa and a 2-1 defeat at SMU last weekend to begin league play.
- The Gamecocks hold an 11-0-2 upperhand in the all-time series with FIU. South Carolina has won two-straight in the series between the two schools, including a 4-3 victory last season in Miami.
- Sophomore midfielder Asa Kryst tallied the first goal of his career in last week's contest vs. SMU. Kryst has nine shots this season.
- Freshman midfielder Jeffrey Torda collected the first assist of his career on Kryst's tally at SMU. Torda has seen action in all nine contests thus far in 2012.
- Junior defender Eric Martinez was the hero in Carolina's 1-0 victory vs. intrastate rival Clemson on Sept. 18. Martinez scored in the 65th minute on a header to secure the Gamecock victory.
- Freshman midfielder Ryan Arambula collected the first assist of his career on Martinez's game winner vs. Clemson on a corner kick opportunity. Arambula has seen action in seven contests this season.
- Junior goalkeeper Alex Long collected his fourth shutout of the season vs. Clemson on Sept. 18. He collected three saves in the victory.
- Junior striker Bradlee Baladez scored both Carolina goals vs. Charlotte On Sept. 12, marking the first two goals of the season for the Dallas, Texas, native. Baladez was a Preseason All-Conference USA selection earlier this fall. He leads the Gamecocks with 20 shots on the year.
- Junior goalkeeper Alex Long collected a career high seven saves vs. Charlotte.
- Sophomore midfielder Niklas Kivinen scored the first goal of his career in the impressive 1-0 victory at No. 2 USF on Sept. 6. The Mikkeli, Finland, native posted the score on a free kick opportunity in the first half.
- Former South Carolina goalkeeper Warren Lipka was honored with selection to the South Carolina Athletic Hall of Fame for the 2012 class. Lipka was inducted on Thursday, Sept. 13, in a ceremony at Williams-Brice Stadium.
- South Carolina is the reigning Conference USA Co-Regular Season champions, as both the Gamecocks and UAB finished the 2011 league campaign with a 6-1-1 record.
- Carolina made its 20th appearance all-time in the NCAA Tournament in 2011, earning hosting duties for the first round.
- Baladez and sophomore midfielder Braeden Troyer were both named to the Preseason All Conference USA squad earlier this month published by College Sports Madness, while Baladez was tabbed a Third-Team Preseason All-American by CollegeSoccerNews.com.

SCOUTING FIU

FIU's contest at South Carolina marks the first since a 2-1 overtime victory at intrastate rival Stetson on Sept. 22. The Panthers hold a 6-1-1 record on the year, with their only loss coming against Furman on Sept. 14. Saturday's match marks the first Conference USA contest of the year for FIU. Through eight games in 2012, FIU has already eclipsed its win total from the 2011 season. The squad is led by first-year head coach Kenny Arena, son of legendary U.S. Soccer head coach Bruce Arena. FIU enters the contest ranked sixth in the most recent NCAA statistics in assists, as the Panthers have 22 helpers on the year. Freshman Lyle Lindquist leads the squad with four and is ranked tied for 18th nationally in the category. Sophomore forward Quentin Albrecht leads the team and ranks tied for second in the league with six goals on the year. His 37 shots are also a team best.

ALUMNI WEEKEND FOR GEORGIA FOOTBALL GAME AND UCF SOCCER MATCH

South Carolina men's soccer will hold its annual Alumni Weekend, Oct. 5-7, in Columbia. Festivities will surround the Gamecock football game vs. Georgia on Saturday, before a men's and women's soccer doubleheader on Sunday, with the women hosting Georgia at 1 p.m., before the men's contest vs. UCF at 3:30 p.m. at Stone Stadium.

WARREN LIPKA HONORED WITH SELECTION TO HALL OF FAME

Former South Carolina goalkeeper Warren Lipka (1982-85) was honored with selection to the South Carolina Athletic Hall of Fame as part of the 2012 class. Along with the other honorees, Lipka was inducted into the Hall of Fame on Thursday, Sept. 13, in a ceremony at Williams-Brice Stadium. Lipka, the 1985 National Goalkeeper of the Year, was also an All-American during his time at Carolina. He was the team captain of the 1985 squad that compiled the most wins in school history (20) and advanced to the NCAA Tournament Quarterfinals.

35TH SEASON NOTABLE

Former South Carolina great Clint Mathis showed signs of brilliance in a thrilling 7-5 victory over No. 2 North Carolina on Oct. 14, 1994, at Stone Stadium in front of an overflow crowd and driving rains. The freshman midfielder scored two goals in that match, marking the first two goals of his celebrated career where he would go on to score 53 goals and 15 assists. The victory propelled the Gamecocks to the MetLife Classic tournament title. The listed attendance for that contest was 2.994.

USF MATCH STARTS LATE DUE TO WEATHER DELAY

The Sept. 6, South Carolina vs. No. 2 USF match started at 10:55 p.m., due to a lightening delay. The match started three hours and 25 minutes past its scheduled start time of 7:30 p.m. The team waited out the delay in a building on USF's campus.

MARTINEZ, STAM NAMED TO GAMECOCK CLASSIC ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

South Carolina defenders, and team co-captains, junior Eric Martinez and senior Kevin Stam put forth stellar play in two matches at the Gamecock Classic vs. No. 15 St. John's and No. 25 Northwestern. With hot and humid temperatures during both matches, the duo played all 90 minutes vs. the Red Storm and all 110 minutes against the Wildcats. The Gamecock defense earned its second shutout of the season against Northwestern.

Out of all active Division I men's soccer coaches, Mark Berson has been to the D-I NCAA Tournament more times (20) than any other coach, including in 19 of the last 27 seasons.

CONFERENCE USA PRESEASON POLL

The South Carolina men's soccer team was picked to finish first in the 2012 Conference USA Preseason Poll, while junior forward Bradlee Baladez was selected to the 13-member Men's Soccer Preseason All-Conference Team for the second-consecutive season, as announced by the league office in mid-August. 2012 marks the first time the Gamecocks have been selected as the preseason favorite in the league. Their previous high mark was when the team was projected to finish second in 2006. The Gamecocks were the 2011 regular season co-champs of the league last year. SMU was picked to finish second, followed by UCF, UAB, Memphis, Tulsa, Kentucky, Marshall and FIU.



MARK BERSON 35TH SEASON AT SOUTH CAROLINA (442-187-62) 36TH OVERALL (453-192-62)

Mark Berson, the reigning Conference USA Coach of the Year, and one of three coaches all-time to post 450 Division I victories, begins his 35th season at the helm of the South Carolina soccer program in 2012. Below are some of Berson and the team's accomplishments:

Berson has been at South Carolina from the beginning. He was hired to move the program to varsity status in 1978, and he quickly put Carolina on the map. He has gone on to mold the Gamecocks into consistent winners that compete for championships.

Before coming to Carolina in 1978, Berson went 11-5-0 in one season at The Citadel, making his overall record 450-187-61, a winning percentage of 68.8 percent. In 2006, Berson became one of five active (at that time) Division I coaches and the 10th all-time to reach the 400-victory milestone when his Gamecocks defeated UAB, 2-0, in a televised contest at Stone Stadium. Berson now has a 439-182-61 record at South Carolina.

Berson has made his mark on the college soccer world by taking the Gamecocks to 20 NCAA Tournaments. The Gamecocks have advanced to at least the second round 11 times and have four quarterfinal and two Final Four appearances. In 1993, the Gamecocks advanced to the NCAA Championship game.

Though Carolina has been independent during the majority of the program's tenure, the Gamecocks have captured four conference titles under Berson's leadership. Carolina won the 1993 Metro Conference Championship in one of its two years competing in the conference. The Gamecocks joined Conference USA in 2005 and promptly claimed the league's tournament championship and automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament, while Carolina also won the C-USA Championship Tournament in 2010 and collected the regular season championship in 2011.

South Carolina saw continued success during the 2011 campaign, earning the Conference USA regular season crown with a stellar 6-1-1 mark in league contests. The Gamecocks earned an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament and held hosting duties in the event's first round. Several Gamecocks earned postseason accolades from the league and NSCAA, including C-USA First Team member Bradlee Baladez and All-Freshman honoree Braeden Trover.

South Carolina won the 2010 Conference USA Tournament Championship, earning the No. 7 national seed in the NCAA Tournament en route to a first-round bye. The home field advantage propelled the Gamecocks to a 1-0 win over Duke during the second round, advancing the squad to the Round of 16. South Carolina concluded the season ranked No. 12 in the final NSCAA Top 25 Poll, while the team also earned the NSCAA's top team academic award.

South Carolina is very successful in its recruiting, bringing in a top-20 recruiting class in 2006, while in 2007 the South Carolina recruiting class ranked No. 10, the 2008 class ranked No. 14, the 2009 class No. 23, the 2010 class ranked No. 16 and the most recent 2011 class ranked No. 11 in the nation according to CollegeSoccerNews.com.

A 1971 graduate of Summit (N.J.) High School, Berson attended the University of North Carolina and received his bachelor of arts degree in journalism in 1975. Berson played on the Tar Heel soccer squad for four years, one as a midfielder and the other three in goal. As a senior, Berson received the UNC Educational Foundation Award and was a member of the Academic ACC Honor Roll. Berson earned his master's of education degree in sport administration from Ohio University in 1977.

Born March 16, 1953, in Hartford, Conn., Berson is married to the former Shauna Hopkins, a South Carolina alum, of Columbia. They have two children, Erin Rhea, and Luke William. Erin graduated from South Carolina in 2009, and Luke is currently enrolled at the University of South Carolina in the Moore School of Business.
