Opening Statement

"Coming off the season we had and our performance at the SEC Tournament, I felt good about coming back home. We've had great success here this season, and I know our team was excited about playing in the postseason, so we felt good coming into the match. We had time to rest and recover from the SEC Tournament, so we were ready and prepared, and showed that throughout the game, and we put the ball in the net."

One reaching 200th win at South Carolina

"It's exciting. I'm thrilled to be here and be able to win games with this staff and team. I'm glad we're not done for right now. I don't keep track of the wins, but it's pretty neat when those milestones come along. We had some alumni here, and some of our players even said, "I was here for your 150th win."
