Tournament Host:

Gamecocks Travel to Bridgestone Golf Collegiate

After nearly a month off, the South Carolina men's golf team returns to action in the Bridgestone Golf Collegiate hosted by UNC Greensboro. The 54-hole tournament runs Saturday through Sunday at Forest Oaks Country Club in Greensboro, N.C. The course features a par-72, 7,212-yard layout. The teams will play 36 holes on Saturday and 18 on Sunday.

This Week's Lineup

The Gamecocks' lineup will be different for the fourth time this fall. Senior Wesley Bryan, junior Dykes Harbin, sophomore Blaine Woodruff and freshmen Sean Kelly and Will Murphy will tee it up for Carolina this weekend. Murphy is making his first career appearance.

First Time Visitors

The Gamecocks are making their first appearance in the Bridgestone Golf Collegiate. The tournament is in its seventh season. Last season, North Carolina claimed the title with a score of 833 (-31). Forest Oaks Country Club will provide a stiff challenge for the Gamecocks as it is PGA Tour tested. The course hosted a PGA event from 1977-2007.

Breaking Down the Field

South Carolina will compete against 14 teams at the 2011 Bridgestone Golf Collegiate. Defending tournament champion North Carolina returns,

as well as ACC programs from NC State and Virginia Tech. Kentucky, Mississippi and Mississippi State will represent the SEC, while Iowa State, Michigan and Purdue make up the Big 10 contingent. Also competing are Georgia State, Pepperdine, Toledo, UNC Greensboro and VCU.

Young Gun

South Carolina freshman Sean Kelly has made a huge impact in just two tournaments this season. Kelly, who has been the Gamecocks' top finisher in both events, currently leads the team with a scoring average of 73. He is also tied for the team lead in rounds under par (three), lowest 18-hole score (69) and lowest 54-hole score (218).

Gamecocks Finish Second, Kelly Third at Rees Jones Invitational

The South Carolina men's golf team posted a final-round 300 (+12) at the Rees Jones Signature Course at Haig Point Club to finish in second at the Rees Jones Invitational. The Gamecocks wrapped up the event with a three-round score of 898 (+34). South Carolina came up just short of winning their third title in four years at the event, finishing four strokes behind

champion Kennesaw State. The Owls shot 289 (+1) on Tuesday to win their second straight Rees Jones Invitational with a score of 894 (+30).

Freshman Sean Kelly produced the best round of the day for the Gamecocks as he fired a final-round 70 (-2) to claim third place with a score of 220 (+4).

Junior Dykes Harbin turnéd in a 77 (+5) to give the Gamecocks a second top-10 finisher as he closed out the event with a three-round score of 222 (+6) to tie for seventh. Sophomore Blaine Woodruff carded a 76 (+4) to tie for 26th with a score of 229 (+13).

After two stellar rounds to open his Gamecock career, freshman Caleb Sturgeon struggled on Tuesday, turning in an 81(+9)





to fall back to a tie for 33rd. Junior Dean Hester recorded his lowest round of the tournament with a 77 (+5) to tie for 57th with a 241 (+25).

Junior Clint Tolleson, who played the event as an individual, posted a final-round 81 (+9) and finished tied for 53rd with a score of 239 (+23).

South Carolina Finishes 11th at Mason Rudolph Championship

South Carolina freshman Sean Kelly posted a 1-under 70 to lead the Gamecocks in the final round of the Mason Rudolph Championship at the Vanderbilt Legends Club South Course. South Carolina shot a final-round 288 (+4) to finish the tournament in 11th place with a three-round score of 877 (+25).

Kelly got off to a strong start as he started the day at the 10th hole and carded a birdie. The Staten Island, N.Y., native recorded his second birdie of the day on the 14th and he went on to make the turn at 34 (-2). Kelly fell back to even with back-to-back bogeys on the first and second holes but he birdied the sixth and made par the rest of the way to wrap up the round at 1-under to finish in a tie for 31st.

Sophomores Blaine Woodruff and Caulder Moore also had solid rounds for the Gamecocks with a pair of 1-over 72s. Woodruff finished in a tie for 55th, while Moore tied for 51st

Junior Dykes Harbin was the second-highest finisher for the Gamecocks, claiming a tie for 34th after a final-round 75 (+4). Senior Wesley Bryan wrapped up the event in a tie for 39th after carding a 74 (+3).

Gamecocks Tie for 11th to Open Season

South Carolina recorded a final-round 300 (+12) and tied for 11th place to wrap up play at the Carpet Capital Collegiate at The Farm Golf Club to open the 2011-12 season. The Gamecocks finished the week with a team total of 890 (+26).

Junior Dykes Harbin proved to be the most consistent Gamecock during the weekend as he posted a final-round 72 (E) to finish the tournament in a tie for 21st with rounds of 73-73-72=218 (+2).

Sophomore Blaine Woodruff improved his score for the third straight day with a 1-over 73 as he finished in a tie for 35th with rounds of 76-74-73=223 (+7).

After posting the Gamecocks' tournament low with a 3-under 69 in the second round, senior Wesley Bryan was unable to carry that momentum into the final round with a 6-over 78 to wrap up the tournament in a tie for 42nd with rounds of 78-69-78=225 (+9).

Sophomore Caulder Moore made the turn at even par but fell back on the back nine with four bogeys and a double bogey as he turned in a 77 (+5) for the round, while sophomore Logan Harrell posted an 82 (+10) for the Gamecocks
