TODAY'S GAME

South Carolina is set to face two ranked opponents this week, beginning with a mid-week matchup with No. 25/24 Michigan. The Wolverines come to Colonial Life Arena with a flawless 4-0 record after most recently posting a 76-54 win over SMU to clinch the 2K Classic title at Madison Square Garden last Friday. The meeting between the Gamecocks and Wolverines marks the fifth all-time between the two schools, and the first since Carolina posted a 76-64 win over Michigan on March 30, 2006, to clinch its second-straight Postseason NIT championship.

GAME STORYLINES

- South Carolina is in its 109th season of varsity basketball in 2016-17.
- On the sidelines, Frank Martin is joined by associate head coach Matt Figger, assistant coaches Perry Clark and Bruce Shingler, and director of operations Andy Assaley.
- South Carolina will face two ranked opponents this week in No. 25/24 Michigan in Columbia, before traveling to Brooklyn, N.Y., to face No. 18/16 Syracuse in the Brooklyn Hoops Holiday Invitational at the Barclays Center on Saturday.
- South Carolina looks for its fifth-straight victory to open the 2016-17 campaign, which would mark Carolina's 21st win in its last 24 games at Colonial Life Arena.
- The Gamecocks posted a 90-52 victory over visiting SC State last Friday. Senior guard Sindarius Thornwell led Carolina for the fourth-straight game with a game best 22 points. Freshman forward Maik Kotsar was a perfect 7-of-7 from the field and tallied 15 points, and sophomore big Chris Silva added 11. Carolina shot 50.8% (33-65) from the field, marking its third game shooting 50% or better this season.
- The Gamecocks held SC State to just 30.8% (16-52) from the field last Friday. It marked the third-consecutive opponent the Gamecocks have held under 40% from the field (Holy Cross: 37.8%; Monmouth: 30.8%; SC State: 30.8%).

Senior guard Sindarius Thornwell enters Wednesday's contest coming off threestraight 20-point games after scoring a team high 22 vs. SC State. He ranks t-2nd in the SEC with 20.8 points per game this season.

After not scoring in regulation, sophomore guard PJ Dozier scored six of Carolina's 10 points in OT, including the buzzer beater game-winner, in the victory vs. Monmouth on Nov. 15.

The Gamecocks sit atop the SEC in rebound margin with a mark of +12.5 after holding a +23 margin over SC State last Friday.

A SOUTH CAROLINA WIN WOULD ...

- Improve the Gamecocks' record to 3-2 all-time vs. Michigan
- Be Carolina's first home win vs. the Wolverines
- Be the first Gamecock win over a current member of the Big Ten since a 74-67 win over Penn State on Nov. 22, 2007, at the Old Spice Classic in Orlando
- Be the first Carolina home win over a current member of the Big Ten since a 74-68 win at Frank McGuire Arena vs. Ohio State on Dec. 20, 1988.
- The Gamecocks claimed a hard-fought overtime victory over visiting Monmouth on Nov. 15, fueled by a buzzer beater jumper from sophomore guard PJ Dozier in overtime for the 70-69 win. South Carolina held Monmouth to just 23.3 percent (7-30) from the field in the opening half with stifling defense, but the Gamecock offense was unable to find its rhythm as well, hitting a slightly better 26.7 percent (8-30) in the set. The game had several scoring runs, with the team's trading the lead late in the second half which resulted in the extra time. Senior guard Sindarius Thornwell led Carolina for the third-straight game, scoring 23 points, with nine rebounds, five assists, three blocks and two steals.
- Sophomore forward Chris Silva posted the first double-double of his career in the win vs. the Hawks with 10 points and a team high 10
- South Carolina hit 27 baskets, including 12 3s, in an 81-49 win over Holy Cross on Nov. 13 at Colonial Life Arena in the first of three home contests as part of the Brooklyn Hoops Holiday Invitational. Senior guard Sindarius Thornwell once again paced the Gamecocks with 20 points, marking the 16th 20-point game of his career.
- South Carolina won its 16th-straight season opener on Nov. 11, posting an 85-76 victory over Louisiana Tech at Colonial Life Arena. It would be a game that would go down to the wire, as a late surge fuled by back-to-back transition dunks from South Carolina's Chris Silva and Sindarius Thornwell would secure the win. Carolina hit 52.6 percent from the field, and was led by Thornwell's 18 points and seven rebounds.
- Several Gamecocks made their college debuts on Nov. 11, including freshman forward Maik Kotsar, r-sophomore guard Hassani Gravett, junior forward Ran Tut and freshman forward Khadim Gueye. Rookie guard Rakym Felder made his college debut vs. Holy Cross (Nov. 13).
- South Carolina returns two starters and eight letterwinners from last season's squad that posted a 25-9 overall record, matching the Carolina record for total wins.
- Those returning starters feature the only backcourt in the SEC with two 1,000-point scorers, in senior guards Sindarius Thornwell and Duane Notice. The duo accounted for 24.2 points and

- 6.1 assists per game last season.
- Thornwell was named to the SEC All-Defensive Team last March, while Notice was named the league's Sixth Man Of the Year.
- The Gamecocks return just 49.4 percent of their scoring from a year ago, with the departure of three senior starters in Michael Carrera (14.5 ppg), Laimonas Chatkevicius (10.2 ppg) and Mindaugas Kacinas (9.9 ppg).
- The Gamecocks began the 2015-16 season 15-0, their best start since the 1933-34 campaign.
- Carolina welcomes 10 newcomers to the squad this season in Tommy Corchiani, Rakym Felder, Hassani Gravett, Khadim Gueye, Evan Hinson, Kory Holden, Sedee Keita, Maik Kotsar, Christian Schmitt and Ran Tut.
- The Gamecocks are undefeated in exhibition contests under the direction of Frank Martin with wins over Kentucky Wesleyan (2012-13), USC Aiken (2013-14), Benedict (2014-15), Allen (2015-16) and Newberry (107-89).

SCOUTING MICHIGAN

- Michigan is led by head coach John Beilein in his 10th season with the Wolverines. He is in his 39th season overall on the sidelines.
- Michigan finished the 2015-16 campaign 23-13 overall with a 10-8 mark in Big Ten play. The Wolverines earned the No. 8 seed in the Big Ten Tournament advancing to the semifinal and moved on to the NCAA Tournament playing in the First Four and First Round.
- The Wolverines return all five starters for the majority of games last season to this year's squad, including leading scorer Zak Irvin (14.5 ppg entering Wednesday's contest).

KEY STAT

The Gamecocks are really sharing the basketball through the early portion of the season, collecting an assist on 57.5 percent of made baskets. Notice's 4.3 assists per game lead the group, but Dozier (3.8) and Thornwell (3.0) have led the Gamecocks in the category as well.

- Senior guard Derrick Walton Jr. was named to the Preseason All-Big Ten Team prior to the start of the 2016-17 campaign. Thus far he averages 14.0 points and 3.3 rebounds per game. His 4.0 assists per game tie Irvin for a team best.
- Walton Jr. posted a game-high 23 points, including a career-high seven three pointers, in Michigan's most recent win over SMU in the 2K Classic Championship.
- Irvin was named the 2K Classic Championship Round MVP after scoring 16 points in both the semifinal and championship games, while Walton Jr. and Muhammad-Ali Abdur-Rahkman also joined him on the all-tournament team.
- Michigan ranks first in the country in free throw percentage (NCAA stats games through Nov. 20) with a mark of 85.3 percent.

MARTIN - BEILEIN CONNECTION

South Carolina head coach Frank Martin mentioned in his weekly press conference on Monday that he has known Michigan head coach John Beilein for several years, however, their time coaching together with USA Basketball during the summer of 2013, and their 18 days sharing a dorm room in Kazan, Russia, for the World University Games, strengthened their relationship.

QUOTABLE

Gamecock head coach Frank Martin on the week ahead (vs. Michigan, vs. Syracuse), and looking back at the start of the season:

"Excited for the week ahead. Excited for the progress our team has made after the first four games. I thought we've gotten better every game - offensively and defensively. I knew Sindarius [Thornwell] and Duane [Notice] for the most part, how they would react playing such drastic differences in the teams on such short turns, but everything else was kind of an unkown. After going back and reviewing, the young guys, and even PJ [Dozier] and Chris [Silva], because they are still young, we tend to forget that even though they played last year they are just starting their sophomore years, I thought our team handled all that pretty well. Turnovers, I think Monmouth is the one game we had too many - I think we had 20 that game. What concerns me is not the amount of turnovers but the kind of turnovers. We have to be better there."

EXHIBITION RECAP

Carolina shot 50.0 percent from the field in the game en route to its offensive outburst. Senior guard Sindarius Thornwell led all players with 34 points on 13-of-24 shooting. Thornwell recorded a double-double with 11 rebounds, which led the team. He also led the team with five assists and five blocks.

THORNWELL NAMED TO PRESEASON SQUAD

Senior guard Sindarius Thornwell was named to the Preseason All-SEC First Team on Thursday by the league's coaches. Thornwell enters the season as the league's high scorer for active players with 1,278 career points. This marks the third-straight season that Thornwell has garnered preseason honors from the coaches, as he was named to the Preseason All-SEC Second Team prior to his sophomore and junior campaigns.

2016-17 SCHEDULE

South Carolina has an exciting schedule set for the 2016-17 campaign. The slate features 14 games, with 10 home contests, including one exhibition. Highlighting the non-conference portion of the schedule is the Gamecocks' participation in the Brooklyn Hoops Holiday Invitational, as well as a matchup versus Seton Hall in the Under Armour "Reunion" doubleheader at Madison Square Garden in mid-December. The Gamecocks will face eight teams that advanced to the postseason a year ago, with four of those NCAA Tournament participants, including Syracuse, which advanced to the Final Four

GAMECOCKS CONCLUDE HISTORIC 2015-16 REGULAR SEASON

South Carolina concluded an historic regular season on March 5, 2015, with a 76-61 win on the road at Arkansas. That victory set the school record for regular-season wins at 24. The Gamecocks began the season 15-0, their best start since the 1933-34 campaign, and the 24 wins marked the most since the 1996-97 squad also posted 24 victories. In addition, South Carolina's 11 SEC wins marked the most since 1998, match the second-most ever by a Carolina team and marked just the fourth time that the Gamecocks had double-digit SEC wins in their 25 years in the league.

Martin owns a 187-117 (.600) overall record as a head coach, entering his 10th season overall, and a 70-63 (.526) record entering his fifth season at South Carolina.

In Martin's fourth season leading the Garnet and Black (2015-16), Carolina put together one of the top seasons in its history, matching a school record for wins with a 25-9 overall record on the year, while the Gamecocks reached double-digit SEC wins for just the fourth time since joining the league, posting an 11-7 mark in conference contests. The SEC finish was Carolina's highest since the league combined its East and West Divisions prior to the 2012 season. South Carolina began the season 15-0, its best start since the 1933-34 campaign and went on to post a school-record 24 regular-season wins.

The Gamecocks received votes or were ranked for 15 weeks in the USA Today Coaches Poll, rising to as high as 15th, and for a total of 14 weeks in the AP poll, rising to as high as 19th, during the season. Carolina advanced to postseason play for the first time since 2009, making their 12th appearance in the Postseason NIT as one of the top four seeds in the event. The Gamecocks posted a win over High Point in the opening round, before suffering a season-ending loss to visiting Georgia Tech on March 21.

Three Gamecocks were honored with postseason awards by the SEC coaches, with senior forward Michael Carrera earning First Team All-SEC accolades, junior guard Sindarius Thornwell was named to the All-Defensive Team and junior guard Duane Notice was named the league's Sixth Man of the Year. Carrera went on to earn honors from several organizations following the best season of his career. Carrera, Notice and Thornwell each reached the 1,000 career-point plateau during the season as well.

Prior to his appointment in Columbia, Martin spent the previous five season as the head coach at Kansas State University, leading the Wildcats to the NCAA Tournament four times, including a trip to the "Elite 8," during the 2009-10 campaign when the squad won a school record 29 contests. Martin's Wildcats won at least 21 games in each of his five seasons at the helm, as the program compiled a record of 117-54 (.684) under his direction. During that time, Kansas State posted a 50-32 (.609) record in Big 12 Conference games, finishing fifth or higher in each season, with three season finishes of third or better.

A native of Miami, Fla., Martin earned his bachelor's degree in physical education from Florida International in 1993. He and his wife, Anya, have three children, Brandon, Amalia and Christian

EXB - SOUTH CAROLINA 107, NEWBERRY 89 NOV. 6, 2016/COLONIAL LIFE ARENA

COLUMBIA, S.C. - South Carolina opened its 2016-17 season with a 107-89 exhibition win over Newberry College on Sunday afternoon at Colonial Life Arena. Carolina shot 50.0 percent from the field in the game en route to its offensive outburst. Senior guard Sindarius Thornwell led all players with 34 points on 13-of-24 shooting. The Lancaster, S.C., native, recorded a double-double with 11 rebounds, which led the team. He also led the team with five assists and five blocks.

South Carolina jumped out to a 12-point lead in the first half with 11:23 left, but Newberry would keep the game competitive forcing 12 turnovers and knocking down 10 shots from deep. Thornwell led all scorers at the break with 16 points on 6-of-10 shooting. He also led the team with five rebounds. Carolina shot 51.5 percent from the field as they headed to halftime with a 53-46 lead.

The Gamecocks opened the second half on a 29-11 run, building their lead to 81-57. Thornwell (10 points) and sophomore guard PJ Dozier (nine points) helped fuel the scoring outburst with 26 of those points. Dozier finished tied for second on the team with 17 points. Senior guard Duane Notice, last season's SEC Sixth Man of the Year, also poured in 17 points. Notice was 4-for-9 from behind the arc.

Carolina's defense ramped up in the second half holding Newberry to a 42.1 field goal percentage. The Gamecocks forced 21 turnovers in the game and out-rebounded the Wolves 52-33. Newberry, who looked to run all game with a smaller lineup, would finish the game with 39 attempts from three-point range.

With the win, South Carolina remains unbeaten in five career exhibition contests under the direction of Head Coach Frank Martin

GAME 1 - SOUTH CAROLINA 85, LA TECH 76 NOV. 11, 2016/COLONIAL LIFE ARENA

COLUMBIA, S.C. - The South Carolina men's basketball team (1-0) opened the 2016-17 regular season with an 85-76 victory over Louisiana Tech (0-1) Friday night. Four Gamecock starters were in double-figures, led by senior guard Sindarius Thornwell, who poured in 18 points. The Lancaster, S.C., native filled up the stat sheet leading the team in rebounds (7) and assists (6).

Senior guard Duane Notice (17), sophomore guard PJ Dozier (17) and sophomore forward Chris Silva (11) were the other South Carolina starters in double figures. Dozier's 17 points were a new career-high.

The Gamecocks jumped out to a 7-2 lead to start the game behind five points from Dozier. The Gamecocks extended their lead to 16-6 after Thornwell hit a 3-pointer with 12:49 left in the first half.

South Carolina's half court defense was suffocating in the first 10 minutes, as they held the Bulldogs to 29 percent shooting from the field. Louisiana Tech finished half one 11-of-29 from the field (37.9 percent).

The Bulldogs closed the gap to 18-16 with 10:24 left, but Carolina pushed the lead back to nine at 36-27 with 2:36 to play in the half after back-to-back 3s from senior guard Justin McKie and sophomore guard Hassani Gravett.

Gravett ended the first half with an exclamation point as he tipped in a Notice 3-point miss at the buzzer. Carolina led 42-31 at the break as the, Villa Rica, Ga. native's, tip-in gave the team its biggest lead of the first half at 11.

Thornwell led all scorers at halftime with nine points on 4-of-8 shooting. He also had five rebounds and three assists. Junior forward Ran Tut had a nice first half off the bench, dropping four points and tying for the team lead in rebounds with five. Notice had eight points, Dozier seven and Gravett seven to round our Carolina's scoring in the opening period. Carolina out-rebounded La Tech 22-18 in half one.

In the second half, the Bulldogs cut the deficit to seven with 14:13 left after a 3-pointer by sophomore guard Derric Jean from the right wing. La Tech's Jacobi Boykins stole the ball at half court finishing with an emphatic dunk at the other end to cut the lead to 59-54. He was whistled for a technical foul after the play. Notice missed both free throws but Silvia put the Gamecocks back up by seven after a dunk on the ensuing possession off a great dish from Gravett.

La Tech's Daquan Bracy would cut the lead to four at 65-61, knocking down a 3-pointer with 7:58 left. Thornwell would answer the basket with a fast break 3 of his own from the left corner to put Carolina back up seven with 5:56 on the clock. The Bulldogs answered, but Silva increased the lead to nine with a 3-point play with 4:31 left after beating Jean to the hole for the and-one bucket.

Thornwell and Silva again halted La Tech's momentum after bringing Colonial Life Arena to its feet with two straight transition dunks, pushing the lead to 80-70 with 2:37 left, and the Gamecocks would close the nine-point win.

GAME 2 - SOUTH CAROLINA 81, HOLY CROSS 49 NOV. 13. 2016/COLONIAL LIFE ARENA

COLUMBIA, S.C. - South Carolina (2-0) picked up its second win of the season Sunday night at Colonial Life Arena after an 81-49 victory versus Holy Cross (0-1). The Gamecock defense limited the Crusaders to just 17 second half points and 30 percent shooting (6-20) from the field in the half. Carolina senior guard Sindarius Thornwell had 20 points to lead all scorers.

After trailing 4-3 early in the game, Carolina went on a 9-0 run after a put-back dunk by sophomore Chris Silva that put the Gamecocks up 12-4. Senior guard Justin McKie extended the early lead to 10 after a transition layup put Carolina ahead 18-8 with 11:56 to go in the first half. McKie's layup forced Crusader Head Coach Bill Carmody to take a timeout after his team started the game 2-for-11 from the field (18.1 percent).

After the timeout, freshman guard Rakym Felder hit a 3-pointer from the top of the key to put the Gamecocks up 24-13. Carolina started the game on fire from the field, hitting 10-of-14 shots, good for 71.4 percent.

Holy Cross cut the lead to five at the 7:08 mark, but Thornwell answered with a post up bucket from the left block to put the Gamecocks up 33-26. Senior guard Duane Notice then hit a 3 on the team's next possession, putting Carolina up 10, 36-26, with 3:03 left in the opening half.

Senior guard PJ Dozier hit his third 3 of the first half from the left wing with 1:29 left to put the Gamecocks up 15. Holy Cross answered with a 3-point bucket of its own. The teams exchanged 3s again on their next possessions, as Thornwell hit from deep for Carolina and Robert Champion, the Crusaders' leading scorer from a year ago, hit one for Holy Cross. Champion's 3 cut the deficit to 12 just before the half with Carolina leading 44-32.

Thornwell led all scorers at the break with 14. Dozier was the second-leading scorer on the stat sheet with 13 first-half points for the Gamecocks. Notice had four assists to lead all players. Carolina shot 58.3 percent in the opening period, including going 8-of-13 from deep. Champion, and forward Malachi Alexander, each scored 12 points for the Crusaders to account for 24 of the team's 32 first-half points.

Carolina picked up right where it left off in the second half as Thornwell hit a 3 at the 15:03 mark to give the Gamecocks a 16-point lead, 53-37. McKie tallied his eighth point with just under 12 minutes to play with a high floater in the lane, which put Carolina up by 20, 59-39.

The Gamecocks defense remained locked in during half two. Holy Cross started the second half 4-for-13, just 30.8 percent from the field. Carolina's hot shooting continued on the offensive end, as it started the second half 8-of-16 (50 percent).

Thornwell hit his fourth 3 of the game with 8:34 left to put the Gamecocks up 66-42. He finshed the night 4-for-6 from behind the arc. McKie joined Thornwell in double figures, scoring his 10th point of the night with 3:08 left after stealing the ball and taking it coast-to-coast for the lay in to give Carolina a 74-47 lead late in the game.

COLUMBIA, S.C. - PJ Dozier scored the game-winning jumper on a lob from Duane Notice as time expired in overtime Tuesday night at Colonial Life Arena to power South Carolina (3-0) to a 70-69 non-conference win over Monmouth (1-1). Senior guard Sindarius Thornwell led all scorers for the third-straight game with 23 points. He also had nine rebounds and five assists.

Tonight's game marks Carolina's third game in five days to open the 2016-17 season. Carolina got off to a fast start, opening the game on a 13-0 run. Thornwell and Notice each hit 3s as the Gamecocks opened the game 4-of-7 from the field. Monmouth started the game 0-for-9 and didn't get its first bucket until 13:12 left in the first half.

South Carolina pushed its run to 17-2 just before the second media timeout on a Chris Silvia made free throw. The Gamecocks went 9-for-13 from the charity stripe in the first 10 minutes, after a pair of Notice free throws made the score 19-2.

The Hawks would bartle back into the game, cutting the lead to 19-7 with 7:35 left in the opening period, after taking advantage of an 0-for-11 field-goal drought for Carolina that lasted over 10 minutes. Redshirt-sophomore guard TeMarcus Blanton ended the drought after knocking down a 3 to push the Carolina lead to 22-7 with 6:59 left in the half.

Monmouth went on a 6-0 run to cut the lead to nine at 22-13, but the Gamecocks remained ahead 26-13 after back-to-back buckets by senior guard Justin McKie. The Hawks scored the final two baskets of the half to make it 29-22 as the teams headed to the locker room.

Both teams struggled shooting the ball for long stretches in the first half. Monmouth finished the first half 7-for-30 (23.3 percent), while South Carolina shot 8-of-30, good for 26.7 percent.

The Gamecocks started the second half much like half one, going on an 11-0 run after knocking down 4-of-7 shots from the field (57.1 percent). They led 38-22 at the first media timeout. Thornwell (4) and Notice (5) tallied nine of the 11 points on the run.

The Hawks started half two 2-of-9 (22.2 percent) from the field, but then went on a 16-2 run, holding Carolina scoreless for nearly five minutes before a Silva reverse lay-in. McKie and Notice each hit 3s in the street ho make it 50-46, but the Hawks got back within two at the under-eight media timeout. Monmouth took its first lead at 52-50 with 6:52 left after a put-back lay-in by big man Diago Quinn.

Thornwell scored five-straight points to put the Gamecocks back ahead, 55-52,

Thornwell scored five-straight points to put the Gamecocks back ahead, 55-52, forcing a timeout by head coach King Rice with 5:45 remaining in the second half. Monmouth then had a four-minute field goal draught before scoring four-straight to tie it up at 58-58 with 1:23 remaining. A pair of Thornwell free throws put Carolina ahead by two with 31.7 seconds left, but Micah Seaborn answered for the Hawks with two free throws of his own to tie the score again.

The Camecocks runned it over off an inbounds play with eight seconds left. Monmouth got a shot off from the right wing, but Thornwell skied high to block it. Carolina got the ball back with .07 seconds left. Dozier launched a half-court heave from the left side that rimmed in sundout and the carne beaded to overtime tied at 600.

the left side that rimmed in-and-out and the game headed to overtime tied at 60. Dozier, who did not score in regulation, scored six of the team's 10 points in overtime, to propel Carolina to victory. Hornwell scored the other four points from the free throw line. Nine of his 23 points came from the charity stripe Tuesday night. Notice (15) and Silva (10) joined Thornwell in double-figures. Silva tallied his first career double-double after leading the team with 10 rebounds.

The Hawks finished the game with four players in double-figures. Chris Brady led the way with 17 points and 10 rebounds. Je'Lon Hornbeak (14), Micah Seaborn (11) and Justin Robinson (11) were also in double-figures for Monmouth. COLUMBIA, S.C. - South Carolina (4-0) picked up a non-conference home win Friday night after downing South Carolina State (1-2) 92-50. Senior guard Sindarius Thornwell led all scorers for the fourth-straight game with 22 points (8-of-15 from the field). It was Thornwell's third 20-point game of the season.

Carolina went to the first media timeout up 11-3, after starting the game 5-of-7 from the field. The Bulldogs cut the lead to 13-8 after an Edward Stephens 3. The Gamecocks then held the Bulldogs scoreless for the next 3:25 (14:44 to 11:19). Two Khadim Gueye free throws and a jumper by Maik Kotsar pushed the lead back to nine at 17-8 at the 13:44 mark in the opening period.

In the first 10 minutes, Carolina held SC State to just 29 percent shooting (4-of-14). The Gamecocks were the exact opposite, starting the game shooting 59 percent from the field (10-for-17).

Kotsar put Carolina up 25-11 after a nifty reverse layup with 8:56 left in the opening half to force Bulldogs head coach Murray Garvin to take his first timeout of the game. The Lancaster, S.C. native, then hit another 3 with 1:46 left to push Carolina's lead to 45-23. The 3 gave him 16 first-half points, which led all scorers. The Gamecocks ended the half on a 5-0 run to take a 50-25 lead at the break. Kotsar had eight points at the break and led the team with seven rebounds. The Bulldogs did not connect for a field goal the final 2:41 of the first half and finished 9-for-28 (32 percent) from the field.




