OUTLOOK – Coming off injury that sidelined him in 2011 ... Left-hander that could help out of bullpen, possibly a spot starter as well ... An older member of the program that should contribute.

2011 – Medical redshirt after undergoing Tommy John surgery ... **Named to SEC Academic Honor Roll.**

2010 – Appeared in 11 games with six starts, compiled a 3-1 record with a 2.43 ERA in 29.2 innings with 32 strikeouts and 18 walks ... Two scoreless innings of relief in 11-6 win over Furman (5/18) ... Picked up a win with five no-hit innings in 17-4 win over Wofford (5/11) ... No-decision at Georgia Southern, went 3.2 innings and allowed two runs on six hits with two strikeouts and two walks in 8-5 win (3/23) ... Pitched six scoreless innings and won second game of the season allowing just four hits and striking out six batters in 15-0 win at Furman (3/16) ... Earned first win of the season hurling five scoreless innings of work allowing just one infield hit while striking out seven in 15-0 win vs. Presbyterian (3/3) ... 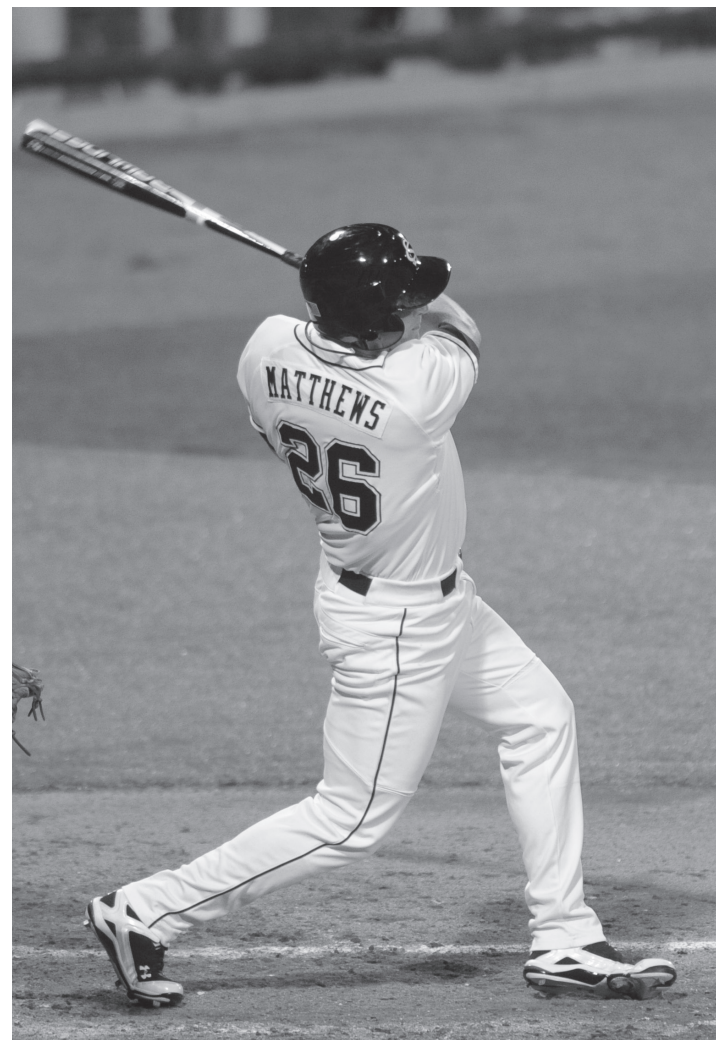

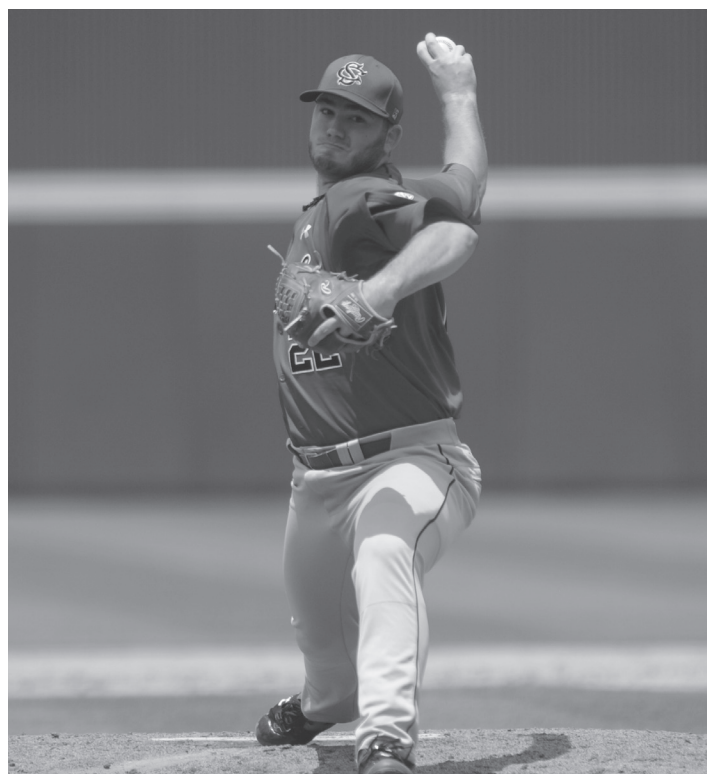

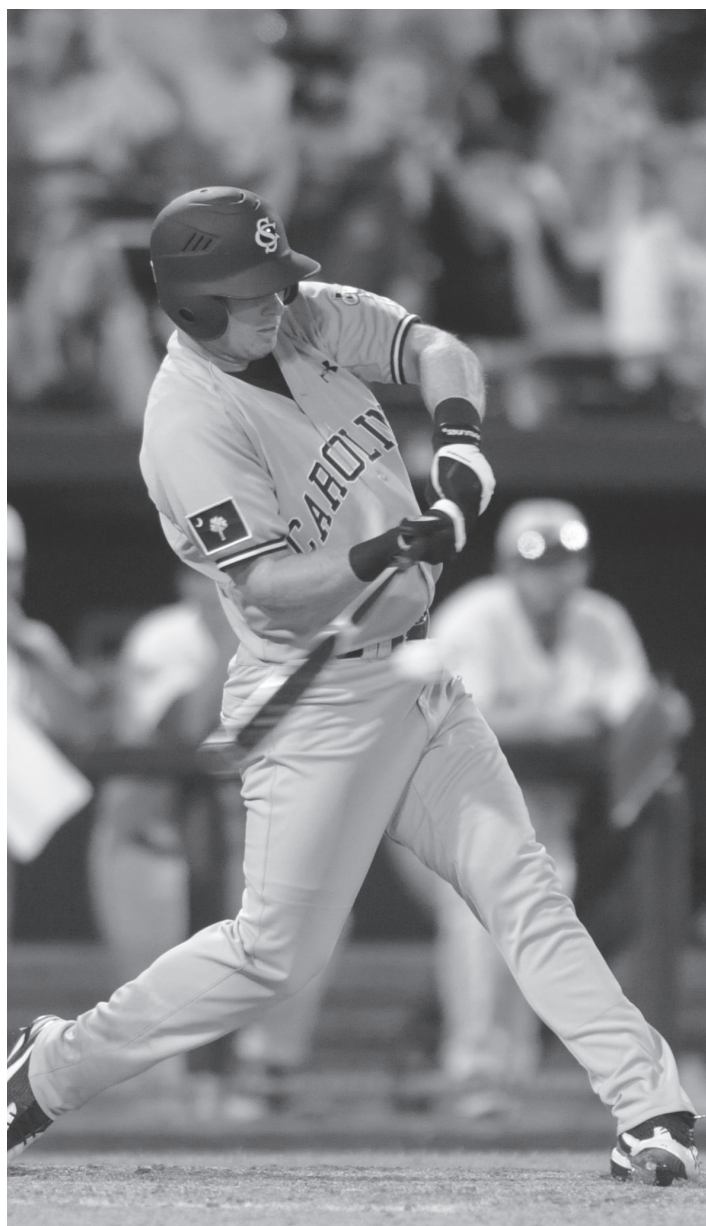
