Gamecocks Begin Fall Slate at Cougar Classic

Coming off another stellar season, the South Carolina women's golf team will attempt to keep the momentum going as it opens the 2013-14 season on Sunday at the Cougar Classic in Hanahan, S.C. The 54-hole event runs through Tuesday at Yeamans Hall Club, which features a par-72, 6,204-yard layout.

Back in Action

South Carolina returns six letterwinners from last year's squad including two seniors, Suzie Lee and Samantha Swinehart.

Swinehart competed in eight events last year and had a scoring average of 76.71. Her season best finish was tied for twelfth at the Tar Heel Invitational in Chapel Hill, N.C.

Lee competed in all 11 tournaments in 2012-13 and had a scoring average of 75.42. Her best finish was tied for fourteenth at the NCAA West Regional in Stanford, Calif., which helped lead the Gamecocks to a fourth-place team finish, advancing them to the NCAA Championship.

Also returning this season are sophomores Chelsey Couch, Sarah Schmelzel and Mary Fran Hillow, and junior Justin Dreher. Couch participated in five events a year ago and had a scoring average of 76.92. Hillow played in seven events and had a scoring average of 77.59. Dreher and Schmelzel both competed in all 11 tournaments, their respective scoring averages were 75.47 and a team best 74.78. Dreher finished tied for third at the SEC Championship and placed in the top 15 at The Landfall Tradition in Wilmington, N.C., and the UCF Challenge in Sorrento, Fla. Schmelzel finished third at the Bryan National Collegiate in Greensboro, N.C., and tied for eighth at the SEC Championship.

The Lineup

Freshman Katelyn Dambaugh will hold the top spot in this week's lineup. Hillow, Swinehart, Schmelzel and Lee will fill the two through five spots respectively. Dreher will also take part in the Cougar Classic as an individual.

History at the Cougar Classic

The Gamecocks are making their sixth trip to the Cougar Classic, including their fourth straight to open the season. Carolina's best finish at the event was a fourth-place showing in 2010.

Breaking Down the Field

Out of the 20 teams participating in this year's Cougar Classic, 15 competed in the 2013 NCAA Regionals and four boast national rankings in the Golf World/WGCA Coaches' Preseason Division I Poll. No. 10 Florida highlights the field and will look to defend it's 2012 title. Joining Florida in the rankings are No. 20 NC State, No. 22 LSU and No. 24 Baylor.

Recapping the 2012 Cougar Classic

The Gamecocks finished 16th at last year's Cougar Classic with a three-round total of 899 (+35). Schmelzel posted the lowest score of the tournament, shooting rounds of 75-72-72=219 (+3), and finished T30th. For three straight days, Schmelzel did not make worse than a bogey as she produced four birdies, four bogeys and 10 pars.

Swinehart shot the Gamecocks' only other round of par on the last day, finishing with rounds of 77-77-72=226 and T65th. After recording just one birdie in the first two rounds, she tallied five in the final round (+10) to go along with five bogeys and eight pars.

Dreher finished in a tie for 78th with a score of 228 (+12), recording three birdies, four bogeys and 11 pars for her round.

Junior Suzie Lee and senior Meredith Swanson each carded a 5-over 77. Lee tied for 71st with a total of 227 (+11), and Swanson concluded the tournament in a tie for 100th with a score of 232 (+16).

Among the Elite

South Carolina head coach Kalen Harris has built a force to be reckoned with in both the SEC and on a national level. Under her guidance, the Gamecocks have won two NCAA East Regional titles and advanced to five NCAA Championships including a program best fifth place finish in 2012.

In the Polls

South Carolina earned a preseason ranking of 20th by Golfweek but was left out of the Golfworld/WGCA Coaches Preseason Poll. Five SEC schools made the cut including Eastern Division rivals No. 8 Vanderbilt, No. 10 Florida and No. 17 Georgia.

Taking on the Tigers

The 2013-14 season will be the first year South Carolina and Clemson compete in women's golf, as the Cougar Classic marks the Tigers' first ever tournament for their program.

Busy Summer

The Gamecocks had yet another productive summer in 2013 with several golfers competing in a variety of events. Justine Dreher advanced to the Final 16 at the Ladies' British Amateur, finished tied for third at the Swiss Am and made it to match play as a member of Team France at the European Ladies' Amateur Team Championship. Sarah Schmelzel finished tied for fifth at Trans National Amateur Championship and Katelyn Dambaugh advanced to the round of 32 at the US Amateur Championship.
