Prior to each season, head coach Dawn Staley chooses a theme for her team to play under. This season's is "one."

With expectations surrounding this season, Staley believed it was important for her team to focus on the collective instead of any individual, knowing that to thrive in pressure situations, each student-athlete may have to sacrifice a piece of herself to become one team.

South Carolina Notables

- The Gamecocks are in their 41st season of women's basketball. It is the program's 24th season in the SEC and the seventh under head coach Dawn Staley. South Carolina has played in the last three NCAA Tournaments, including two trips to the Sweet 16 (2012, 2014).
- South Carolina is one of two teams in the nation ranked among the top 15 in both scoring offense (12th, 80.1 ppg) and scoring defense (2nd, 49.9 ppg). The other is UConn at second in scoring offense (88.8 ppg) and seventh in defense (51.3 ppg).
- The Gamecocks' 16-0 start is the best in program history and also is the new school record for longest win streak. The previous win streak record was held by the 1985-86 team, which put together 13 wins from Jan. 25 through March 3.
- Ten of the 14 Gamecocks on the active roster have scored in double figures at least once this season. Freshman A'ja Wilson leads the way with 14 games with 10 or more points, while veterans Tiffany Mitchell (12), Alaina Coates (10) and Aleighsa Welch (10) follow close behind.
- South Carolina has trailed at halftime just three times this season – all three against nationally ranked opponents and all eventual Gamecock victories. Last season, South Carolina lost all five games in which it was behind at halftime.
- In the last two seasons (50 games), senior Aleighsa Welch has shot 50.0 percent or better in all but 11 games, including three perfect shooting games. This season, SEC play has brought out the best in Welch, who is currently shooting 72.0 percent (18-of-25) in league games.
- Freshman A'ja Wilson is making an early case for SEC Freshman of the Year, averaging nearly a double-double in league play so far – 13.0 ppg, 9.3 rpg. Overall on the season, she has scored in double figures in all but two games and has four double-doubles to her credit.
- Four Gamecocks were named to the Naismith Trophy Top 50 Watch List this week with Alaina Coates and A'ja Wilson joining junior Tiffany Mitchell and Aleighsa Welch, who are also on the Wooden Award and Wade Trophy Watch Lists. No other school had four entries on the Naismith list, and South Carolina is one of four teams with two entries on the other two watch lists.

- Extend the school record for longest win streak to 17.
- Make the Gamecocks 5-0 in SEC play, which would top the 2002 team's 4-0 start as the best SEC open in program history.
- Be the Gamecocks' first in Mizzou Arena.

- Block needed by senior Elem Ibiam to tie Michelle Murray (1990-93) for second on the program's career list

- South Carolina 1,000-point scorers who have also grabbed at least 800 career rebounders, with senior Aleighsa Welch joining the group on Jan. 11 (vs. #10/11 Kentucky)
- Games this season in which at least one Gamecock has posted a double-double
- 3-pointers made by the Gamecocks at Alabama, the most in a road game since hitting the same number at Auburn on Feb. 15, 2004
- Free throws made by junior Tiffany Mitchell in the last five minutes of the Gamecocks' four games decided by single digits

- Free throw attempts per game by South Carolina this season, compared to 13.4 by its opponents
- Points per game scored by the Gamecocks in the paint this season, compared to just 21.1 by their opponents.
- Percent of the Gamecocks' field goals that have been assisted this season, helping them rank fifth in the nation with 19.3 apg
- Career rebounds by senior Aleighsa Welch, more than any other current SEC player and 10th in school history

Missouri Series History

As one of the newest members of the SEC, Missouri has played South Carolina just three times prior to tonight. The Gamecocks won the first and most recent meetings, while the Tigers claimed the lone previous matchup at Mizzou Arena.

In the most recent meeting – a 78-62 win by South Carolina on Feb. 2, 2014, at Colonial Life Arena – all five Gamecock starters scored in double figures, as did Alaina Coates off the bench. Then No. 7/8 South Carolina shot a sterling 49.0 percent and led 48-25 at the half. The Tigers shook off the slow start to hit six 3s in the second half to out-score the Gamecocks 37-30 in the final 20 minutes as South Carolina struggled to capitalize on 27 trips to the free throw line in the period.

In the last meeting at Mizzou Arena – the two teams' first as conference rivals – the Tigers spoiled the Gamecocks' bid for a top-four seed at the upcoming SEC Tournament with a 65-58 decision on Feb. 28, 2013, behind 26 points and 12 rebounds from Bri Kulas as the Tigers dominated then No. 14/13 South Carolina in the paint 34-14.

The first meeting of the series came on Nov. 24, 2001, at the Duke Classic and ended in a 72-60 South Carolina victory.

Road Warriors

The Gamecocks are 4-0 on the road this season, including two SEC outings in enemy territory.

Overall, South Carolina is 207-240 (.463) in road games, including a 38-31 (.551) record during the Dawn Staley era. After a difficult start as the Gamecocks' mentor, Staley has guided her team to two of the program's top five road records in program history, including last season's school-record winning percentage of .833 (10-2). Her 2012-13 team posted a 7-3 (.700) record on the road for the fourth-best in program history.

Poll Prominence

South Carolina is in its eighth week as the No. 1 team in the nation in the Associated Press Poll, the third-longest stretch by a team in the last five seasons (beginning 2010-11). Only four teams have held the top spot in the AP poll during that time – Baylor (39 weeks), Connecticut (35 weeks) and Stanford (6 weeks).

In the last 10 seasons (beginning 2005-06), eight teams have occupied the AP Poll's No. 1 position. South Carolina's eight weeks in the spot is the sixth-most among that group, which is led by UConn's 85 entries. Baylor is second at 39 followed by Tennessee (16), Duke (14) and Maryland (10).

The AP's No. 1 ranking on Nov. 24 was a South Carolina program first, besting the No. 2 spot the Gamecocks held for five times in their history – Nov. 17, 2014; Preseason 2014-15; Jan. 2, 1982; Dec. 27, 1981; and Dec. 20, 1981.

SEC Stories

Head coach Dawn Staley has steadily lifted the Gamecocks' national profile by building the Gamecocks into a consistent SEC contender, shirking decades of difficulty in the nation's best women's basketball conference.

In her seventh season at the helm, Staley boasts a 56-42 (.571) SEC regular-season record and has finished outside the league's top five just twice – an unprecedented achievement for a program that had finished INSIDE the top five just twice in the previous 17 seasons. Staley's 56 wins include three seasons of double-digit league victories – 10-6 in 2012, 11-5 in 2013 and an SEC-best 14-2 in 2014.

Staley's SEC regular-season record includes a 31-18 (.633) mark at home and a 25-24 (.510) slate on the road.

Win Any Way

As the Gamecocks' baseball coach a few years ago, South Carolina athletics director Ray Tanner frequently used the saying "Win Anyway," and the women's basketball team has put its own twist on the quote. The Gamecocks have not lost a game this season, but the end has not always come by the same means.

Dawn Staley's team has won with both a high-flying offense – posting records of 4-0 when scoring 90+ points, 4-0 when scoring 80-89 points – and a more methodical one, 4-0 when scoring 70-79

points, 5-0 with scoring fewer than 70.

The Gamecocks have won both inside – 7-0 when shooting less than 33.3 percent from 3-point range, 6-0 when at least half of points come in the paint – and outside – 9-0 when shooting 33.3 percent or better from 3-point range, 10-0 when less than half of points come in the paint.

South Carolina has seen its top scorer come from both the starting lineup (7-0) and the bench (8-0) – with one game a starter and reserve tied for the team high (vs. Auburn – Welch, Wilson).

Diehard Defenders

While the offense has fluctuated in source and volume, the one standard for the Gamecocks – both this season and throughout head coach Dawn Staley's career – has been their defense. South Carolina is second in the nation in scoring defense, allowing 49.9 points per game with no opponent scoring more than 63 points. In fact, South Carolina has held an opponent under 50 points eight times.

Controlled Caroms

The Gamecocks have also built their success on the glass – an area, like defense, that Staley preaches as a measure of effort as much as talent. South Carolina ranks eighth in the nation in rebounding margin, out-boarding its opponents by 11.4 per game. The Gamecocks have out-paced their opponent by double-digit rebounds eight times this season, including three games by at least 20 rebounds – Clemson (+22), Savannah State (+35) and at Hampton (+27).

Bench Marks

While every competitor wants to be a starter, the Gamecocks have shown that the bench can be just as productive a position. The South Carolina bench has tied or out-scored its starting teammates eight times this season, including three SEC contests, and has out-scored the entire opposing team four times – Clemson (Nov. 20), San Diego State (Nov. 23), NC Central (Dec. 1). In all, the bench has accounted for 48.4 percent of the Gamecocks' points this season.

Of the 64 double-figures games turned in so far this season, 31 of them have come from the bench – A'ja Wilson (14), Alaina Coates (8), Bianca Cuevas (4), Tina Roy (2), Jatarie White (2) and Asia Dozier (1).

Diversified Assets

South Carolina ranks second in the nation in field goal shooting with an SEC-best .489 percentage. The Gamecocks' top five scorers all shoot over 50.0 percent from the field, but only one ranks among the SEC's best in the category – A'ja Wilson's .503 percentage is fifth in the SEC, 76th in the nation and sixth among freshmen

nationally. The anomaly comes from the league and the NCAA required minimum of five made field goals per game to qualify.

Zone Buster

Since the emergence of Elem Ibiam and the arrival of Alaina Coates in 2013-14, South Carolina has been a team feared for its inside presence. That perception got a boost with the addition of Jatarie White and A'ja Wilson this season, and teams have packed into a zone early and often against the Gamecocks.

This season, South Carolina's guards have been effective at capitalizing on what opposing teams are willing to cede in that defensive alignment – the 3-point shot. The Gamecocks lead the SEC and rank 30th in the nation in 3-point field goal percentage, hitting 36.1 percent from outside the arc. The percentage is not far above last season's (.347), but after closing 2013-14 averaging 3.9 made 3s per game, South Carolina is third in the SEC with a 5.6 average this season – a number that goes up to 6.5 per game in SEC play. The most 3s made per game of the Staley era is 9.2 in 2009-10.

Junior Tiffany Mitchell has been the primary long-range shooter, ranking fourth in the SEC with 2.2 made 3s per game and seventh in the country with an SEC-best .479 3-point field goal percentage. But juniors Asia Dozier and Tina Roy have lifted their long-range production in SEC action, shooting .400 (6-of-15) and .545 (6-of-11),

respectively, in league play and the pair are tied for 10th in the league with 1.5 made 3s per SEC game. Each was hitting around one-third of her attempts prior to the start of conference games.

SWAT Team

South Carolina leads the SEC and ranks ninth in the nation with 6.4 blocked shots per game. The effort is a continuation of last season, during which the Gamecocks shattered the school record for blocks in a season by 41, recording 240 over 34 games for a 7.1 average.

Four Gamecocks rank among the SEC's top 12 blockers, led by freshman A'ja Wilson in third at 1.8 per game – a number that jumps to 2.8 per SEC game. Sophomore Alaina Coates is just behind in sixth with 1.65 per game this season. Seniors Aleighsa Welch and Elem Ibiam are next in line with Welch swatting 1.3 per game for seventh and Ibiam rejecting 1.1 per game for 12th place.

Handled with Care

Head coach Dawn Staley refers to the point guard position as one of "service" to teammates, a job designed to create stars out of teammates. More than just her point guards have embraced that theory as the Gamecocks rank fifth in the

nation in assists per game with an SEC-best 19.3 per game and seventh in the country with a 1.4 assist-to-turnover ratio. Living up to the legend of their head coach, the Gamecocks have handed out 20 or more assists nine times this season, including a Staley-era high of 26 against NC Central. In all, South Carolina has assisted on 309 of its 478 made field goals this season (.646). The 2013-14 team set the mark for best percentage of the Staley era at .577.

Three Gamecocks rank among the SEC's top 15 in assists, led by junior Khadijah Sessions in 10th at 3.3 per game. The sure-handed Sessions is 27th in the nation in assist-to-turnover ratio with an SEC-best 2.5 mark. Last season's assist leader, junior Tiffany Mitchell is 11th with a 3.1 average, which rises to a team-best 3.3 mark in SEC play. Junior Tina Roy has been the unexpected distributor this season, ranking 15th in the conference with 3.0 assists per game and a 2.3 assist-to-turnover ratio that has her third in the SEC and among the nation's top 35.

SEC Title Talk

In 2013-14, South Carolina became the seventh program to win the SEC regular-season title, and the Gamecocks were predicted by the league's coaches and media to the repeat the feat this season. If Staley's group brings that forecast to fruition, it would be just the fourth team to repeat as the regular-season champion, joining Tennessee (multiple times), Georgia (1996, 1997) and LSU (2005, 2006).

Two Grand

Junior guard Tiffany Mitchell joined senior Aleighsa Welch in the 1,000-point club against Liberty (Dec. 21), making it the first time a Gamecock team has had multiple 1,000-point scorers since 2001-02 when Shaunzinski Gortman and Jocelyn Penn both reached that plateau. In program history, there have been nine seasons that featured multiple 1,000-point scorers, including three seasons that saw three Gamecocks who surpassed the benchmark.

More on Muffin

Senior forward Aleighsa Welch – nicknamed Muffin at birth by her mother – continues to be at the foundation of the Gamecocks' success. The South Carolina high school standout who first took a chance on head coach Dawn Staley's vision has done everything asked to power the Gamecocks to the lofty heights achieved during her career. Always willing to do the "dirty work" that doesn't show up in the box score, Welch's energy is what drives the Gamecocks and what has prompted her teammates to vote her a team captain each of the last three seasons.

Welch's consistent effort has her ranked among the program's career top 10 in six different categories, including three rebounding totals, while also among the top-20 scorers. Among the Gamecocks' 30 1,000-point scorers, she is one of just nine to amass at least 800 career rebounds as well. Her current career .589 field goal percentage (478-of-812) is second in school history behind only Jocelyn Penn's school-record .593 (757-of-1277).

The expansion of the Gamecocks' frontline have brought her rebounding numbers down slightly (5.4 rpg this season vs. 7.2 average previous three seasons), but Welch continues to provide consistency on the offensive end, shooting 61.2 percent from the field and handing out 1.9 assists per game.

Trademark TM

Last season, junior guard Tiffany Mitchell established her presence on a national level based on her offensive versatility. But the All-American frequently kept one weapon in check, taking just 2.2 3-pointers per game to account for just 22.1 percent of her field goal attempts on the season.

This season, the usually attacking guard has shown that opponents better be prepared to play her a little tighter around the arc. Mitchell is seventh in the nation in 3-point accuracy, hitting 47.9 percent from long range and has made 2.2 3s per game to rank fourth in the SEC. The outside shot has accounted for nearly half of her field goal attempts (73 3FGA, 152 FGA). In fact, she has taken at least half her shots from outside the arc in eight games this season.

Mitchell's heightened accuracy was on full display against San Diego State (Nov. 23) when her 6-of-6 effort from 3 was the best perfect game in program history. She went on to match her career high with six 3s at Hampton as well, those

coming on eight attempts.

Double Trouble

One of sophomore Alaina Coates' goals this season focuses around posting double-doubles, taking to heart her head coach's quip that the 6-foot-4 center is a "walking double-double." Ranking 30th in the nation with an SEC-best seven this season, the Irmo, S.C., native has already passed the halfway mark of her freshman year, during which she posted 10 double-doubles, but just three in non-conference action. With 17 career double-doubles through 50 games, Coates is just three shy of making the Gamecocks' career top 10 in the category.

Bang off the Bench

The Class of 2014's No. 1 recruit, A'ja Wilson drew the start in her collegiate debut, but the 6-foot-5 Heathwood Hall product has thrived off the bench ever since, averaging 14.5 points and 7.3 rebounds during the stretch. Overall on the season, Wilson is second on the team in scoring, ranking ninth in the SEC in at 13.9 ppg, and has been the Gamecocks' top scorer a team-high eight times. She is the only freshman to rank among the SEC's top 20 scorers and rebounders – standing

It's Elem-entary

Senior center Elema Ibiam is making a charge at the school record for career blocks this season after setting the single-season mark with 83 in 2013-14. The Fayetteville, Ga., native is currently third with 147 in her career, trailing Michelle Murray (1990-93) in second place at 148. The Gamecocks' career record of 177 of set by Lakesha Toller (2004-07) is also well within reach.

Home Grown, Nationally Known

Since her arrival for the 2008-09 season, South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley has been working to protect her new home state's best prospects while fielding a team that competes at a national level. Her efforts have paid huge dividends as eight of the 15 members of this year's team hail from South Carolina. Beginning with Aleighsa Welch, the first South Carolina player to sign a National Letter of Intent for Staley, the Palmetto State has frequently sent its players of the year to Columbia as Welch (2011), Asia Dozier (2012), Alaina Coates (2013), A'ja Wilson (2014) and Kaydra Duckett (2014) have each earned the title during their high school careers.

Class of 2015 Signee

Head coach Dawn Staley added one future Gamecock during the early signing period. Canada's Shay Colley signed her NLI with South Carolina on Nov. 18 and will have four years of eligibility upon enrollment.

Colley is a three-year standout for Team Canada in junior international play, representing

her country in the 2014 FIBA U18 Americas Championship (silver), the 2013 FIBA U19 World Championship (7th) and the 2012 FIBA U17 World Championship (bronze).

Cliney to Miss 2014-15 Season

South Carolina announced in September that the NCAA approved an initial eligibility waiver for freshman Doniyah Cliney, which allowed her to enroll in school but not compete for the Gamecocks in the 2014-15 season. The guard focused on academics in the fall semester and was cleared to practice with the team beginning Dec. 15.

DAWN STALEY

7th Season at South Carolina Virginia, 1992

When three-time Olympic gold medalist Dawn Staley took the reins of the University of South Carolina women's basketball program on May 10, 2008, the Gamecocks' stature immediately rose not just in the Southeastern Conference but on the national stage as well. Building on a foundation of hard work, defensive effort and a "team first" mentality, South Carolina began to realize those expectations in 2011-12. Three consecutive 25-win seasons were capped with the 2013-14 squad's 29-win effort that included the program's first SEC regular-season championship and No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament as well as the Gamecocks' second NCAA Sweet 16 appearance in three seasons.

In her 14 seasons as a head coach, Staley has amassed a 309-151 record, including her 137-71 slate in six seasons at South Carolina. She has led her teams to nine 20-win seasons, a total of 11 postseason appearances (two WNIT), highlighted by the Gamecocks' pair of Sweet 16 appearances and 14 weeks in the Associated Press top 10, including four in the top five. The future continues to brighten as the nation's top recruits make Columbia, S.C., a highly coveted destination. Consistently signing the top players in the state, Staley's 2014 group illustrated the seeds her staff had been sowing since its arrival as the No. 1 recruit in the class joined two other top-35 entries among the five-member class that was ranked No. 2 in the nation.

While her coaching career is blossoming, Staley is still recognized for her body of work as a one of the most decorated participants in United States women's basketball history. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame solidified her legacy with her enshrinement into the Hall as part of the Class of 2013. The Phoenix Club of Philadelphia established the Dawn Staley Award recognizing the nation's top guard in women's Division I basketball in 2013 as well. Staley was inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2012 and was one of the final nominees for induction to the U.S. Olympic Hall of Fame the same year. In the summer of 2011, the WNBA recognized her as one of the league's "Top 15," honoring the most influential players in the league's history.

At the helm of the Gamecocks over the last six seasons, Staley has been named National Coach of the Year (2014, Basketball Times), Naismith National Coach of the Year Finalist (2014), SEC Coach of the Year (2014, Coaches and AP) and BCA Female Coach of the Year (2012). She has coached an All-American, 12 All-SEC selections, five SEC All-Freshman team selections, an SEC Player of the Year, an SEC Sixth Player of the Year, an SEC Defensive Player of the Year and two SEC Freshmen of the Year. South Carolina's 29 wins in 2013-14 were one shy of the overall school record, breaking the best mark since joining the SEC of 25 set in 2011-12 and tied in 2012-13. The Gamecocks have won more SEC games than the season before in each of Staley's last five seasons, and her 52 SEC victories are more than any other Gamecock coach and account for 44.8 percent of the program's total 116 league wins. She has helped the Gamecocks to three of the program's four top-four finishes in the SEC, including the first regular-season championship in 2013-14. Her 97 overall wins in the last four seasons marks the most successful four-year stretch in program history.
