## South Carolina Notables

- This is the 38th season of women's basketball at South Carolina and the Gamecocks' 21st season in the SEC.
- South Carolina's defense, rated second in the nation in points allowed (47.8), has held an opponent to 48 or fewer points 10 times this season, including three SEC foes – Alabama (42), Florida (44) and Ole Miss (43). The 2005-06 team held opponents to 48 or fewer points a school-record 11 times.
- Senior guard La'Keisha Sutton set her career-high for 3-pointers made twice in the last two games, amassing half of her season total over the stretch. With four at Vanderbilt and five against Ole Miss, Sutton made 75.0 percent of her long-range attempts in the last two games after entering the contests hitting just 9-of-50 (.180).
- While turning the high-scoring duties over to her hot-shooting backcourt mates the last two games, junior leasia Walker has averaged 5.0 assists and 5.0 rebounds over the stretch. That rebound average is second-best on the team, and her career-high seven assists against Ole Miss moved her into the team league in assists per SEC outing (3.0).
- South Carolina is second in the SEC in rebounding margin in conference games (+6.4) and has two players ranked among the league's top 20 rebounders in league games – Aleighsa Welch (11th) and Charenee Stephens (20th), despite being one of just two teams in the league (Vanderbilt) with fewer than three players who stand 6-foot-1 or taller.

### Mississippi State Series Notes

The Lady Bulldogs lead the series 16-10, although the Gamecocks ended a four-game skid with a 60-53 victory in Starkville last season behind 16 points from guard Ieasia Walker. South Carolina holds a 7-5 edge over Mississippi State in Columbia but have not won a home game against the Lady Bulldogs since a 72-66 overtime decision on Feb. 25, 2007.

Walker has the best career scoring average against the Lady Bulldogs at 13.0 points and has shot 45.8 percent from the field in her two games against them. Senior forward Charenee Stephens averages 7.0 rebounds in her four career games against MSU, including a total of 17 boards over the last two meetings.

### Home Sweet Home

South Carolina has won 69.6 percent of its home games since the 1976-77 season (records did not include the site of games for the first two seasons of women's basketball). That 346-151 mark includes a 102-54 mark in Colonial Life Arena.

The Gamecocks turned in their most productive home season in 2001-02, winning 17 of their 18 contests in their final season playing at Carolina Coliseum. The team's best home record at Colonial Life Arena came in 2006-07 when South Carolina went 15-5. Last season, South Carolina was 14-5 at home, the fourth-most home wins in school history. So far this season, the Gamecocks are 9-2 at Colonial Life Arena.

### Life in the League

South Carolina is 86-189 all-time in its 21st season SEC regular-season play. The Gamecocks are 56-82 in SEC games played in Columbia with a 30-107 record on the road. The Gamecocks are 20-20 in conference play since head coach Dawn Staley's first season in the league yielded a 2-12 mark. This season's 3-2 start to league action matched that of the 2009-10 squad as the best five-game open since the 2001-02 squad went 4-1. Overall, Staley boasts a 121-57 record in league play, including eight seasons leading her Temple teams to a 99-25 Atlantic 10 mark.

### Judging January

The Gamecocks are 177-177 (.500) all-time in the month of January, including a 103-74 (.582) record at home. Under head coach Dawn Staley, South Carolina is 15-19 in the first month of the year. The Gamecocks went 2-6 in Staley's first year at the helm (2008-09) and were 4-5 in each of the last two seasons. The Gamecocks are 5-3 so far this month.

### Yin-Yang of 3-Point Land

Head coach Dawn Staley is fond of theorizing that the thing a team does best is also the thing it does not handle well. The inverse seems to be true for the Gamecocks when it comes to 3-point shooting this season. The Gamecocks are currently second in the nation in 3-point field goal percentage defense, allowing opponents to hit just 21.1 percent from the arc, but they are last in the SEC in 3-point shooting, hitting just 26.2 percent from long range.

The dichotomous relationship with the arc has not hindered South Carolina's success as its strength has overcome its weakness. The Gamecocks are 12-3 this season when making more 3-pointers than their opponent. They have shot more accurately than their opponent 13 times in 21 games this season, coming out with a 10-3 record in those outings.

### Bringing the Defense

The South Carolina defense ranks second in the nation in points allowed per game (47.8) behind just Connecticut (44.3). The Gamecocks have allowed more than 55 points just five times in 21 games this season – at Vanderbilt 60 in overtime (Jan. 22), Kentucky 66 (Jan. 15), LSU 58 (Jan. 12), Drexel 58 (Dec. 28), Xavier 56 (Nov. 30) and have held nine opponents to 48 or fewer points.

Under head coach Dawn Staley, stingy defense has been a staple of the Gamecock game plan. South Carolina has allowed just 59.5 points per game on Staley's watch, including a 44.8 average this season and a 59.6 mark in 2010-11. In the last two seasons, the Gamecocks held their opponent to 55 or fewer points in a game 30 times, including 16 of 21 games this season. In the 111 games with Staley at the helm, South Carolina has held an opponent to 55 points or fewer 38 times. In that same period, an opponent has netted 70 or more points in a game just 26 times.

### How Do They Go So Low?

One of the more interesting facets of the Gamecocks' stifling defense is that they have not necessarily held opponents to a sub-par shooting percentage. Through Staley's tenure, opponents have shot 40.9 percent from the field. South Carolina has shot 39.2 percent during that time with the Gamecocks' season field goal percentage exceeding that of its opponents just once (2009-10).

The defensive success comes from limiting opponent shot attempts entirely as South Carolina has put up more shots than its opponents every season except Staley's first (2008-09). This season alone, the Gamecocks have taken 10.4 more shots per game than their opponents. South Carolina has had fewer shot attempts than its opponent just once this season – Kentucky (Jan. 15).

### Good Hands

South Carolina is ranked 20th in the country and third in the SEC with a +5.3 turnover margin. The trio of experienced guards have helped the Gamecocks on both sides of the turnover margin. The Gamecocks have forced 20 or more turnovers in 11 of their 21 games this season while committing 20 or more turnovers only three times (29 vs. Kentucky, Jan. 15; 25 at LSU, Jan. 12; 22 vs. College of Charleston, Nov. 23). The Gamecocks are 34th in the country in fewest turnovers per game with 14.8, the lowest average for the program since the 1983-84 team set the school record of 8.2.

### Tough to Scout

Throughout the preseason, head coach Dawn Staley talked about the versatility of her team as a key to the season's success. While she may have been speaking more about the various ways individual players could score, it has been the Gamecocks' ability to get points from various locations that has delivered the program's best opening record since Staley arrived in Columbia. So far this season, seven different players have led the team in scoring – Markeshia Grant, Ieasia Walker, Aleighsa Welch, Ashley Bruner, Tina Roy, La'Keisha Sutton and Charenee Stephens. In all, eight different Gamecocks have scored in double figures at least once this season.

## Triple Play

Coming into the season, many observers felt the fate of the Gamecocks' season rested largely in the hands of its experienced backcourt – seniors Markeshia Grant and La'Keisha Sutton and junior Ieasia Walker. That has certainly been the case as between its points and assists, the trio has contributed to 61.1 percent of the team's 61.1 points per game.

Grant is leading the trio in scoring with her team-high 10.1 points per game, which ranks 25th in the SEC. Sutton is atop the assist category as her 3.0 per game are 13th in the league standings. Walker leads the defensive effort, ranking sixth in the SEC with 2.3 steals per game.

## Not So Fast

While the backcourt got all the attention leading into the season, the frontcourt has made significant contributions to the team's success as well.

The unanticipated spark of the season as been freshman forward Aleighsa Welch. Surprising head coach Dawn Staley with her consistent play and ability to absorb and apply every teaching point, the six-foot Goose Creek, S.C., product is third on the team with 8.9 points per game and leads the club in rebounding at 6.1 per contest, which also ranks her 12th in the SEC. Her 59.0 percent field goal accuracy is second in the league as well. Welch's point (10.1 ppg) and rebound (6.5 rpg) numbers are even higher in SEC action.

While Welch has been the more recent catalyst in the frontcourt, junior Ashley Bruner had a significant hand in much of the season's early success as she spent most of the season's first

month as the team's top scorer and rebounder and continues to provide solid support numbers. She accounts for 5.6 points and 3.9 rebounds per game.

## On the Horizon

Head coach Dawn Staley inked four players in the early signing period. Below is a brief look at each of the future Gamecocks.

- **Tiffany Davis** (Houston, Texas/Westbury Christian) is a 5-foot-8 point guard rated the 29th in the 2012 class at that position. Before transferring to Westbury Christian, she helped Westside High to the 2011 District 20-5A championship game. Davis earned all-region and first-team all-district honors as a junior, netting 16.0 points per game.
- **Asia Dozier** (Columbia, S.C./Spring Valley) is a 5-foot-11 guard who helped Spring Valley to state championships in 2009 and 2011. Rated the 34th-best guard in the 2012 class and a four-star player by *ESPN Hoop/Gurlz*, Dozier averaged 17.1 ppg and 3.8 apg as a junior as the Lady Vikings went 29-0. As a freshman, her 18.3 ppg and 3.8 apg earned her Class 4A Area Player of the Year honors from *The State* newspaper. Her father, Perry, and uncle Terry Dozier also played basketball for the Gamecocks.
- **Tiffany Mitchell** (Charlotte, N.C./Providence Day) is a 5-foot-10 guard who is rated among the top 50 players in the 2012 class by *ESPN Hoop/Gurlz*. She earned South Charlotte player of the year honors and was an *Associated Press* All-State selection after averaging 18.4 points, 6.9 rebounds, 4.2 steals and 3.9 assists as a junior. She guided the Chargers to 21 straight wins in 2010-11, including the program's second-straight NCISAA state title.
- **Khadijah Sessions** (Myrtle Beach, S.C./Myrtle Beach) is a 5-foot-6 point guard rated the seventh-best in the class at her position by *ESPN Hoop/Gurlz*. The 40th-ranked player overall, she averaged 17.9 points and 5.7 assists as a junior while leading the Seahawks to their second-straight AAA state championship. A member of the all-state team, Sessions also captured all-region honors last season.

## Helping Hand

With arguably the best point guard in international women's basketball history at the helm, South Carolina has been at its best when its assist numbers are highest. In the Dawn Staley era (2008-09 through present), the Gamecocks are 44-16 when handing out 10 or more assists, including a 12-1 mark this season. When missing the 10-assist plateau, South Carolina is just 15-38 overall with Staley, including a 5-23 mark in SEC action. That overall record includes this season's 4-4 ledger.

## Defense Is the Difference

How solid is the South Carolina defense this season? Just look at its performances against four of the nation's top 25 offenses.

Most recently, the Gamecocks took on the fifth-highest scoring team in the nation in then-#9/8 Kentucky (Jan. 15). South Carolina limited the high-flying Wildcat offense 15 points below its season average, allowing just 66 points when UK came in averaging 81.1 per game.

The Gamecocks limited Vanderbilt (Jan. 5) to just 55 points after the Commodores entered the game ranked ninth in the country with 80.0 points per game. South Carolina crippled the nation's top 3-point shooting team, which entered the game shooting 43.8 percent from the arc and making 6.5 3-pointers per game, allowing Vanderbilt to take just six 3-pointers in the game, making one of them. In the second meeting between the two teams, the Gamecocks were just as effective, yielding just 60 points in their overtime victory and allowing the Commodores to shoot just 17.6 percent (3-of-17) from 3-point range.

Entering its Dec. 18 game against the Gamecocks, North Carolina led the nation in scoring, pouring in 87.5 points per game. South Carolina allowed the Tar Heels just 54.9 percent of that average – 48 points – the lowest scoring output for the Tar Heels since Connecticut held them to 47 points on Jan. 9, 2010. Even with that limited offense against the Gamecocks, North Carolina still ranks among the nation's top 10 in scoring offense.

The first evidence of the stingy South Carolina defense came early in the season when the Gamecocks allowed Penn State, which is currently ranked 14th in the nation in scoring offense, just 55 points on Nov. 20. The Lady Lions have not scored lower than 65 points in any other game this season and have topped out at 103 in three games.

## Locking It Down

South Carolina has held an opponent to 48 or fewer points 10 times this season, the most since the 2005-06 squad limited its foes to that number a school-record 11 times. South Carolina has never lost a game when holding an opponent to 48 or fewer points, which it has done in a total of 109 games (two games in the 1980-81 season were later forfeited).

## Making a Name for Herself

In December, senior guard La'Keisha Sutton etched her names among the top guards in South Carolina women's basketball history. Handing out her 300th career assist against Drexel (Dec. 28) and scoring her 1,000th career point against South Carolina State (Dec. 14), making her just the 11th Gamecock to achieve both milestones in her career. The last to hit both marks was Cristina Ciocan in 2003-04.

Sutton's 1,000th career point game just 8:40 into the 100th game of her career on a trademark drive through the lane. Her effort against South Carolina State, which ended with 12 points, made her just the 27th player in school history to score at least 1,000 points. She also became the 48th player to play in 100 career games in that outing. Her 300th assist came just in time for the Gamecocks to hold off a late rally by Drexel. After driving the lane, Sutton found Ashley Bruner on the right block for a bucket that ended a four-minute scoring drought for the Gamecocks.

## Record Book Rewrite

The South Carolina defense made its mark on the program's record book just 10 games into the 2011-12 season. The Gamecocks both tied and broken the previous record for fewest points allowed in a game – holding Presbyterian to 24 to tie the mark on Nov. 27 then limiting SC State to just 21 to reset the record on Dec. 14. Presbyterian's 11 second-half points lowered that record by two, while SC State's 13 in the second stanza tied the previous low. The Lady Bulldogs became just the fifth opponent in Gamecock history to fail to reach double figures in the first half, and they now hold the Gamecocks' record for lowest opponent field goal percentage at 12.5 (6-of-48).
