FOR STARTERS

South Carolina (11-5) begins a four-game road swing on Tuesday night against Furman (8-7) at Fluor Field. First pitch is 7 p.m. with the game available on the Gamecock IMG Network including flagship station, 107.5 FM, "The Game."

RANKINGS

South Carolina is ranked in all six major collegiate rankings. The Gamecocks are ranked No. 7 by Perfect Game, No. 8 by D1Baseball and the NCBWA, No. 10 by Baseball America, No. 12 in the USA Today coaches poll and No. 16 by Collegiate Baseball.

RECAP

South Carolina went 4-0 last week with wins over The Citadel and Winthrop and a pair of victories vs. Michigan State. The Gamecocks are 11-5 on the year after four weeks of action.

AT THE PLATE & ON THE FIELD

The Gamecocks are hitting .275 (147-for-535) as a team for the year with a .354 on-base percentage and a .424 slugging mark. The Gamecocks are fielding .977 for the season, fourth-best in the SEC. South Carolina has equaled or out-hit its opponent in 14 of 16 games this year.

TO ARMS

The South Carolina pitching staff had another strong week as the group struck out 52 batters in 36.0 innings pitched and combined for a team ERA of 3.50 in the four victories. For the season, the Gamecocks own a team ERA of 3.02 with 176 strikeouts in 146.0 innings. The Gamecocks have allowed 58 runs, 49 earned, on 112 hits with 176 strikeouts to 61 walks. Opponents are hitting .209 against Carolina for the season. The Gamecocks lead the SEC in strikeouts, rank fifth in opposing batting average and eighth in earned run average.

SUPERLATIVES

South Carolina is 9-2 on the year when scoring first in a game and 9-2 when entering the seventh inning with a lead and 11-1 when entering the ninth inning with the lead. The Gamecocks are 5-1 when scoring six or more runs and 10-3 when allowing five runs or less. South Carolina is 6-4 in games decided by three runs or less.

START WITH CLARKE

Junior right-hander Clarke Schmidt is now 3-0 on the year after earning the win in Friday's 3-2 victory over Michigan State. Schmidt allowed just two runs on eight hits in 7.1 innings of work with no walks and a career-high 12 strikeouts. Schmidt owns a 1.04 ERA for the season having allowed just six runs, three earned, on 19 hits in 26.0 innings with 31 strikeouts. Opponents are batting .198 against him. Schmidt is tied for fifth in both strikeouts and innings pitched and eighth in the SEC in earned run average.

WILLIAMS IS A HIT

Junior first baseman Matt Williams is South Carolina's leading hitter after 16 games with a .413 batting average (19-for-46) with seven runs scored and eight RBI. He owns a .500 on-base percentage and a .522 slugging mark. Williams ranks sixth in the SEC in both hitting and on-base percentage. Williams was 3-for-5 with his first homer of the year and two runs scored in the 5-2 win over Michigan State. He has reached base safely in 14 straight games and is tied for second on the team with four multi-hit games and three multi-RBI games.

Williams tied with Jonah Bride as South Carolina's top hitter last week in four games with a .462 (6-for-13) average in the four victories.

WELCOME BACK WIL

Junior right-hander Wil Crowe is also 3-0 after earning the win in Saturday's 5-2 victory over Michigan State. Crowe limited the Spartans to one run on three hits in 6.2 innings with three walks and tied his season-high with nine strikeouts.

Crowe owns a 2.25 ERA and has allowed just six runs, all earned, on 14 hits in 24.0 innings with seven walks and 31 strikeouts. Opponents are batting .163 against him. Crowe is tied for fifth in the SEC in strikeouts and is ninth in the league in opposing batting average.

TJ LEADS IT OFF

Sophomore outfielder TJ Hopkins is second on the Gamecocks in hitting with a .300 batting average (15-for-50) to go along with a team-high 17 runs scored and a .390 on-base percentage. He is tied for eighth in the SEC in runs scored. Hopkins homered twice, his first multi-homer game of his career, in a 3-for-5 day at the plate with three runs scored and four RBI in the 12-5 win over The Citadel.

Hopkins won the Tom Price Award as MVP for the Gamecocks in the Clemson series. His top game of the series was game three when he went 3-for-5 with his second triple of the season and a pair of runs scored. He also had a key diving catch to record the final out in a 2-0 win at Clemson.

HILL ON THE MOUND

Sophomore right-hander Adam Hill gave the Gamecocks a quality start in Sunday's contest vs. Clemson. Hill allowed just one run, a solo homer, on five hits in 5.1 innings with three walks and seven strikeouts.

Hill owns a 1.56 ERA in three starts having allowed five runs, three earned, on nine hits in 17.1 innings with seven walks and 20 strikeouts. Opponents are hitting a miniscule .153 against him. Hill is seventh in the SEC in opposing batting average.

OLSON PROVIDES A SPARK

Sophomore utility player Jacob Olson tallied the Gamecocks' first multi-homer game of the season in the 8-4 win over Appalachian State. Olson went 2-for-4 with a double, a triple, a RBI and a run scored in the 8-7 loss to Clemson.

Olson is hitting .276 (16-for-58) on the year including three homers, a triple and three doubles to go along with eight RBI and 10 runs scored. He has a .517 slugging percentage. Olson owns a team-high five multi-hit games.

JOHNSON BRINGS THE HEAT

Junior right-hander Tyler Johnson pitched a scoreless inning of relief for his fourth save of the season in Friday's 2-0 win at Clemson. Johnson has four saves in five relief appearances. He has struck out 12 in 6.2 innings of work out of the bullpen. He is tied for the lead in the SEC in saves.

Johnson struck out five of six batters he faced for his third save of the year in the 8-4 win over Appalachian State last Tuesday. He earned two saves the previous week with 1.1 innings of work in the 5-4 win over Charlotte followed by a scoreless ninth inning in which he struck out the side in the 4-3 victory over Wright State on Friday night.

CATCHING UP WITH CULLEN

Sophomore catcher Chris Cullen homered in two straight games with a homer in the 12-5 win vs. The Citadel as well as the 8-6 win over Winthrop.

Cullen is hitting .231 (9-for-39) for the season with three homers and 11 RBI. He owns a .375 on-base percentage as well.

BOWERS BRINGS IT

Senior right-hander Colie Bowers earned his first career save in Friday's 3-2 win over Michigan State with 1.2 scoreless innings of work and a pair of strikeouts.

Bowers is 2-0 with a save in seven relief appearances and owns a 0.00 ERA. He has allowed just one unearned run on four this in 11.0 innings with two walks to 12 strikeouts and opponents hitting .111 against him.

DYNAMIC DESTINO

Junior outfielder/designated hitter Alex Destino was 2-for-3 with a key two-run single in Saturday's 5-2 win over Michigan State. He also had a big home run in the eighth inning of South Carolina's rally in the 8-6 win over Winthrop. Destino is hitting .298 (17-for-57) with three homers, three doubles, 10 runs scored and 14 RBI. He is at .379 in on-base percentage and .509 in slugging. Destino has a team-high five multi-RBI games.

REAGAN FROM THE LEFT

Senior left-hander Josh Reagan earned his first save of the year in the 5-2 win over Michigan State. Reagan allowed just one unearned run on two hits in 2.1 innings with no walks and two strikeouts.

Reagan has pitched in a team-high eight appearances, tied for second-highest in the SEC. He is 1-0 with a 1.29 ERA. Reagan has struck out 16 in 14.0 innings with a .146 opponents batting average.

THERE'S HUNTER TAYLOR

Junior catcher Hunter Taylor went 2-for-3 with a walk in the 5-2 win over Michigan State. Taylor is hitting .400 (6-for-15) in seven games with four starts. Three of his six hits are doubles and he has also scored a pair of runs.

THAT'S TOLBERT

JONAH WITH A JOLT

Junior infielder Jonah Bride hit .462 (6-for-13) in last week's four wins and scored a team-high six runs and had a double and a triple as well. For the season, he is hitting .278 (15-for-54) with six RBI and nine runs scored and a .350 on-base percentage. Bride ranks second in the SEC also with five sacrifice hits. Bride owns the team's longest current hitting streak at four games as well.

GREAT SCOTT

Senior right-hander Reed Scott struck out a career-high eight batters in five innings of relief and earned the win in the 8-6 victory over Winthrop. Scott is 1-1 with a 3.50 ERA in six relief appearances. Opponents are hitting .246 against him. He has 17 strikeouts in 18 innings.

BLAIR ON BASE

Sophomore outfielder Danny Blair leads the Gamecocks with four stolen bases.

Blair had his best series at the plate in a Gamecock uniform in his career as he went 6-for-11 (.545) to lead the Gamecocks at the plate in the UNCG series. Blair also scored a pair of runs, drove in two and stole two bags. He finished with a .545 on-base and slugging percentage as well.

ROW WITH IT

Junior infielder Justin Row went 2-for-4 with his first career triple in Saturday's 8-7 loss to Clemson. Row is hitting .263 (5-for-19) with three RBI and three runs scored.

LAWSON'S FIRST WIN

Sophomore right-hander Graham Lawson earned his first career win in the 12-5 victory over The Citadel. Lawson allowed four runs on four hits in three innings of relief with a walk and three strikeouts. Lawson has struck out seven in 9.1 innings of work in three games.

PARKE'S FIRST SAVE

Junior left-hander John Parke earned his first career save in the 12-5 win over The Citadel. Parke allowed just one run on three hits in three innings and struck out a career-high five batters.

SCOUTING FURMAN

Furman is 8-7 on the year heading into Tuesday night's game. Head Coach Brett Harker is in his first year at the helm of the Paladins.

Junior outfielder Landon Kay leads Furman at the plate with a .388 average (19-for-49) with three doubles, a triple, two homers and a team-high 14 RBI. Junior first baseman Brandon Elmy is second on the team with a .339 average (20-for-59) with nine runs scored, four doubles, 10 RBI and a team-high three homers. Senior catcher Cameron Whitehead also has three homers.

The Paladins will start junior right-hander Hunter Baker on Tuesday night. He is 1-0 with a 4.11 ERA in three starts. Baker has allowed eight runs, seven earned, on 20 hits in 15.1 innings with nine strikeouts and seven walks.

WELCOME TO GAMECOCK NATION

Four Gamecocks made their debut in the weekend series vs. UNCG. Olson, junior infielder Justin Row, freshman infielder/outfielder Carlos Cortes and freshman first baseman Riley Hogan all made appearances. Also making their debut last week were right-handers Sawyer Bridges and Graham Lawson.

LOOK AT THE CROWD

South Carolina had pair of sellouts over the weekend and totaled 24,501 in attendance the first weekend for an average of 8,167 per contest at Founders Park. That is the fifth-highest series total in Founders Park history and the highest series total since the 2014 season.

WEEKEND ROTATION

Junior right-hander Clarke Schmidt, junior right-hander Wil Crowe and sophomore right-hander Adam Hill will headline the Opening Weekend rotation for the Gamecocks as announced by head coach Chad Holbrook Monday afternoon. Schmidt will start Opening Day vs. UNCG with Crowe taking the mound in Saturday's contest for the Gamecocks and Hill getting the ball for the series finale on Sunday.

This will be the second straight year that Schmidt gets the ball on Opening Day. Schmidt has been named Preseason All-America by D1Baseball, the NCBWA and Perfect Game and earned third-team All-America honors from Collegiate Baseball and the NCBWA last year after going 9-5 with a 3.40 ERA. He struck out 129 batters to 27 walks in 111.1 innings pitched with opponents hitting .248 against him. Schmidt's 129 strikeouts are the second-highest among returning pitchers from last season in Division I baseball.

Crowe is a Preseason All-America selection by Baseball America and returns to the mound this season after sitting out the 2016 campaign recovering from Tommy John surgery. Crowe went 8-3 and earned Freshman All-America honors in 2014 with a 2.75 ERA in 91.2 innings pitched. Opponents hit .228 against him. He also won three games in 2015 before suffering the injury that sidelined him the rest of the season.

Hill earned Freshman All-America last year after going 7-0 with a 3.53 ERA. He allowed 26 runs, all earned, on 49 hits in 66.1 innings. He had 72 strikeouts to 28 walks; opponents are batting .208 against him. That opposing batting average was fourth-best in the SEC. He was also named to the SEC All-Freshman team.

PRESEASON ALL-AMERICANS

Five Gamecocks have received Preseason All-America honors this year.

Junior right-hander Tyler Johnson is a first-team selection by D1Baseball, the NCBWA and Perfect Game. Last season, Johnson went 3-2 with a 2.42 ERA and had nine saves. Johnson struck out 59 to just eight walks in 52.0 innings in 29 relief appearances. Eight of Johnson's nine saves were in league play, the most by any SEC pitcher. Johnson pitched on USA Baseball's Collegiate National Team over the summer.

Schmidt has been named Preseason All-America by D1Baseball, the NCBWA and Perfect Game and earned third-team All-America honors from Collegiate Baseball and the NCBWA last year after going 9-5 with a 3.40 ERA.

Crowe is a third-team Preseason All-America selection by Baseball America and returns to the mound this season after sitting out the 2016 campaign recovering from Tommy John surgery.

Junior Alex Destino earned second-team honors from the NCBWA. Destino is South Carolina's leading returning hitter as he hit .321 last season with 10 homers and 59 RBI in 60 games with 59 starts.

Senior left-hander Josh Reagan received third-team accolades from Collegiate Baseball. Reagan returns for his senior year after going 3-2 with 11 saves in 29 relief appearances. He posted a 2.08 ERA last year and struck out 50 batters in 56.1 innings. Opponents hit .172 against him.

BRAG FACTS

South Carolina won the NCAA Division I Baseball Championship in 2010 and 2011 at the College World Series. South Carolina has made 11 College World Series appearances including six times in the last 15 years. In those 11 appearances, the Gamecocks are 32-20 for a .615 winning percentage, that is sixth-best among winning percentage leaders in CWS history. South Carolina is one of three schools in the nation to have reached at least 12 NCAA Super Regionals since 2000 and has the most NCAA Super Regional appearances of the 14 SEC schools since 2000. In addition, the Gamecocks own the second-highest win total in Division I baseball since 2000 (791-332 record) and more conference wins than any SEC team since 2000 (308-198 record).

Recently, South Carolina is one of only four schools in the nation to host a NCAA Regional in six of the last seven years. South Carolina has ranked among the top three in the nation in total attendance for six consecutive years including a mark of 293,677 last year. South Carolina averaged a total of 7,162 fans at Founders Park in the 2016 season.

GAMECOCKS PREDICTED TO FINISH SECOND IN THE SEC EAST

South Carolina has been predicted to finish second in the SEC Eastern Division as voted by the league's 14 head coaches in the annual preseason poll announced on Thursday. Junior right-hander Tyler Johnson was a first-team Preseason All-SEC selection with junior Alex Destino garnering second-team honors.

South Carolina received four first place votes for the Eastern Division as well as two first place votes as SEC champion. South Carolina won its seventh SEC Eastern Division title last year with a 20-9 conference record.

Florida and LSU each garnered six votes for SEC Champion in the preseason poll. The Gators were predicted to win the SEC Eastern Division, while the Tigers were the favorite to win the SEC West.

Since 1996, the SEC has named a regular season champion as well as a tournament champion. Prior to 1996, the tournament champion was considered the SEC champion.

Points were compiled on a descending basis for each division. Coaches were not allowed to vote for their own team, and each coach also voted for one team as an overall conference champion.

Conference play is set to begin March 17. A total of seven SEC teams qualified for NCAA Regionals in 2016, and a record four teams were selected as national seeds.

Head Coach Chad Holbrook

Chad Holbrook is in his fifth season as head coach of the South Carolina program and has spent over 20 seasons coaching college baseball including two national championship staffs with five national championship series appearances, six College World Series trips and 17 NCAA Regionals.

As head coach of the Gamecock program, South Carolina has made three NCAA Regional appearances in the last four years with two NCAA Super Regional appearances in 2013 and 2016. Under Holbrook's direction, South Carolina is one of only nine schools in the nation to host a NCAA Regional in three of the last four seasons (2013, 2014, 2016). In addition, South Carolina is one of just three schools in the SEC to finish among the top four teams in three of the last four seasons and one of four schools in the league to win at least 40 games in a single season in three of four years as well.

Holbrook's 2016 team won 46 games, the most in Holbrook's four seasons as head coach of the Garnet & Black and won the 2016 SEC Eastern Division title as Carolina made its 31st trip to the NCAA Division I Baseball Tournament and its 12th appearance in the NCAA Super Regional. The Gamecocks went 20-9 in the SEC with five sweeps in the 30-game conference slate. It marked just the fifth time Carolina reached 20 or more wins in the conference. The Gamecocks fought back from an opening round loss in the NCAA Columbia Regional to win four straight games and advance to the NCAA Super Regional. Attendance at Founders Park totaled 293,677, the third-highest mark in the country.

Right-handers Clarke Schmidt and Braden Webb earned All-America honors in 2016 with Webb also the Freshman Pitcher of the Year by the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association. Schmidt won nine games and struck out 129 batters, the seventh-highest total by a pitcher in school history. Webb pitched his way to unanimous Freshman All-America accolades with 10 wins, the most victories by a Gamecock in five seasons and he struck out a freshman record 128 batters in 102.0 innings pitched. Junior outfielder Gene Cone was named first-team All-SEC after leading the team with a .363 average (78-for-215) and an on-base percentage of .474, the best mark in the SEC. Schmidt was a second-team All-SEC choice. Freshman right-hander Adam Hill also picked up Freshman All-America recognition with Hill, Webb, catcher Chris Cullen and infielder LT Tolbert named to the SEC All-Freshman team, the first time in school history that the Gamecocks had four players in a single season earn that distinction.

The 2016 South Carolina pitching staff was among the best in the nation averaging 9.7 strikeouts per nine innings, second-most in the country with a WHIP of 1.21, 14th best in the nation. Carolina showcased itself on the diamond with a .978 fielding percentage, second-highest in the SEC and 12th in the country. Carolina also improved at the plate with a .291 batting average, up 34 points from the previous year to go along with a .381 on-base percentage and a .412 slugging mark.

Seven Gamecocks heard their names called in the 2016 MLB Draft including four selections in the top 10 rounds. Webb was a third round selection by the Milwaukee Brewers, junior outfielder Dom Thompson-Williams a fifth round selection by the New York Yankees, senior infielder Marcus Mooney a 10th round selection by the Atlanta Braves, Cone a 10th round selection by the New York Mets, right-handed pitcher Taylor Widener a 12th round selection by the New York Yankees, right-handed pitcher Wil Crowe a 21st round selection by the Cleveland Indians and right-handed pitcher Matt Vogel a 25th round selection by the Tampa Bay Rays.

The Gamecocks succeeded in the classroom in the 2015-16 academic year as well with South Carolina's 3.186 GPA in the spring of 2016 the highest team GPA in season in the history of the baseball program.

Holbrook is 165-81 for a winning percentage of .671 in four seasons at the helm of the Gamecock program.

He was named head baseball coach for the University of South Carolina on July 16, 2012, promoted to the top spot by athletics director Ray Tanner after four seasons as associate head coach and recruiting coordinator for the Gamecocks. Holbrook came to South Carolina in July 2008 as associate head coach. Along with his recruiting coordinator duties, he served as hitting instructor, oversaw the Gamecock offense, including base running and the short game and was the third base coach. He also worked with the outfielders. Holbrook came to the Gamecock program after serving 15 seasons as a member of the University of North Carolina coaching staff. Holbrook was the 2011 ABCA/Baseball America Assistant Coach of the Year after the Gamecocks won a second consecutive national championship.

A tremendous evaluator of talent, Holbrook was named the No. 10 best recruiter in all of college sports by ESPNU & ESPN The Magazine in the publication's 2011 January edition. The list was put together in conjunction with three-dozen experts who were asked the question: Who are the top 20 recruiters in college sports? Holbrook was the only baseball coach on the list.
