South Carolina Notes

- South Carolina's 7-3 win gave the Gamecocks their 14th-straight season with 40 or more wins (40-18).
- The Gamecocks now have 25-straight home wins in postseason play, including an undefeated 14-0 record in Carolina Stadium. They are 56-8 at home in postseason play overall.
- South Carolina has now won 21 straight openers in NCAA regional play
- Tonight was senior Tyler Webb's first appearance of more than an inning since April 28th, a save at LSU. It's his first win since tossing three innings on April 20th against Kentucky.
- Freshman Max Schrock has now reached base 15-straight games and is riding a five-game hitting streak.
- Junior Graham Saiko's homer was his second home run as a Gamecock and his first since April 16th against the College of Charleston.
- Sophomore Tanner English picked up his first stolen base since the April 7th contest against Tennessee.
- The Gamecocks move to the winner's bracket game on Saturday at 8 p.m. EDT against third-seeded Liberty.



Saint Louis Notes

- The loss broke the Billikens' five-game winning streak, those five coming in the Atlantic 10 Tournament to earn the postseason berth.
- Saint Louis is now 12-14 when making two or more errors in a game.
- The three runs are the least scored by SLU since March 17 and 18, consecutive 2-1 wins over Charlotte in the final weekend of regular-season play
- Saint Louis faces Clemson, the Columbia Regional's No. 2 seed, at 2 p.m. EDT on Saturday.
