# **South Carolina Notables**

- This is the Gamecocks' 40th season as a varsity sport, the sixth with head coach Dawn Staley at the helm. It is South Carolina's 23rd season in the SEC.
- Ranked in the top 10 in both national polls, South Carolina is enjoying its highest rankings since February 2012.
- Today's matchup pits head coach Dawn Staley against one of her former WNBA assistant coaches as Winthrop
  head coach Kevin Cook was on the Houston Comets' bench during Staley's time with the team. Staley also
  coached Winthrop assistant coach Christena Hamilton while at Temple.
- South Carolina leads the SEC in field goal percentage (.494), blocks per game (6.2) and assist-to-turnover ratio (1.4). The Gamecocks are among the top 10 in the nation in each category as well.
- While guard Tiffany Mitchell is the Gamecocks' leading scorer, South Carolina's offense is driven by what happens
  in the paint. The Gamecocks have scored 40.2 points per game in the paint more than half of their 78.3 scoring
  average.
- With 32 offensive rebounds so far this season, junior Aleighsa Welch has moved into sixth place in school history with 267 career offensive boards, just seven away from tying Demetress Adams (2006-09) for fifth.
- Sophomore guard Tiffany Mitchell is the only Gamecock to score in double figures every game this season, but she has really excelled in the last five games. Starting with the two-game trip to California, the Charlotte native averaged 18.2 points, 3.8 assists and 3.2 steals. In the first four games, Mitchell contributed 12.0 ppg on 50.0 percent shooting, 4.0 rpg, 2.3 apg and 1.8 spg. She has been more aggressive and earned trips to the free throw line as a result, averaging 7.8 free throw attempts per game over the last five games compared to 4.0 over the first four
- Junior center Elem Ibiam has re-asserted herself over the last two games, answering her head coach's challenge to be more of an impact on every game. Ibiam is averaging 16.5 points, 7.0 rebounds and 3.5 blocks in a win at Charlotte and Wednesday night's loss to North Carolina.
- Sophomore guard Khadijah Sessions suffered an ankle sprain against North Carolina on Wednesday and will not play today or Sunday, according to head coach Dawn Staley. Her status will be re-evaluated when the team returns from the holiday next week.

# Staley in the Hall of Fame

Head coach Dawn Staley was enshrined in the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame this fall, becoming just the 15th female player to earn the honor based on her individual merits (not as part of a team enshrinement). Staley's career shone in an era that spawned two professional women's basketball leagues in the United States and forever changed the dreams of the nation's top female players. On the international stage, she collected three Olympic gold medals (1996, 2000, 2004) and was twice named the USA Basketball Female Athlete of the Year (1994, 2004). In the U.S. she turned national high school player of the year honors into a career at Virginia that yielded three All-America seasons, including a 1991 campaign that ended with being named national player of the year. On the professional level, Staley was a five-time WNBA All-Star who was named to the All-Decade Team and one of the 15 most influential players in league history.

# **Welch Watch on Record Book**

South Carolina junior forward Aleighsa Welch has proven to be one of the best offensive rebounders in Gamecock history. She is one of just four Gamecocks all-time to record multiple seasons with at least 100 offensive rebounds, including her 131 O-board mark last season, which ranks second in school history.

In just her third season, Welch already ranks among the program's top 10 in career offensive rebounds.

Staley's 2013-14 success is predicated on getting the ball inside – three primary post players combine to score 47.1 percent of the team's points – and on ball movement creating the best shots – 60.1 percent of made field goals have been assisted, ranking the Gamecocks sixth in the SEC and top 30 in the nation with 16.6 assists per game.

Defense is still a staple of the program with the Gamecocks ranking among the nation's elite in scoring defense, allowing just 50.1 points per game. Only three opponents this season have scored 55 or more points against South Carolina

### **December Decisions**

In its 40th season of women's basketball, South Carolina is 157-79 (.665) all-time in the month of December, including a 25-7 record (.781) in the sixth season of the Dawn Staley era. The Gamecocks hold at least a .500 record in all three site possibilities during the month – 94-23 (.803) at home, 34-30 (.531) on the road and 24-24 (.500) at neutral sites.

## **Home Sweet Home**

With comprehensive records beginning in the 1976-77 season (the third for women's basketball at South Carolina), the Gamecocks are 367-155 (.703) all-time in games played at home, including a 122-58 mark (.678) in Colonial Life Arena. In the sixth season with head coach Dawn Staley at the helm, South Carolina is 57-25 (.695) at home, including one game at Carolina Coliseum in the 2012-13 season. The Gamecocks have won 43 of their last 54 games played in Colonial Life Arena.

# Century Mark for Staley

Head coach Dawn Staley captured her 100th victory at South Carolina on Dec. 2 against NC Central. She is the fourth of the program's seven all-time head coaches to reach the mark and the fastest to the total (164 games) of the

three coaches to lead the team in the SEC era by nearly a full season.

South Carolina's third head coach, Pam Parsons, was the first and the fastest to reach 100 victories, hitting the plateau in her 143rd game at the helm just six games into her fifth season (1981-82). Nancy Wilson was next up, winning her 100th game in her 150th outing late in the 1988-89 season, en route to her school-record 231 Gamecock victories.

Susan Walvius was the first head coach to have her entire South Carolina career in the SEC, hitting 100 wins in her 179th game on the sideline five games into her seventh season.

### 20/20 Vision

The Gamecocks won their first eight games this season by at least 20 points for the first time in the Dawn Staley era, a streak ended with a 15-point victory at Charlotte (Dec. 8). South Carolina opened the 2012-13 campaign with four straight 20-point wins en route to nine games with that minimum margin – a Staley era record. The Gamecocks posted eight 20-point wins in 2011-12 after just two in 2010-11, one in 2009-10 and two in Staley's first season 2008-09.

# Finding the Right Octave

South Carolina has scored at least 80 points in four games so far this season after reaching the mark just four times in the first five seasons of the Dawn Staley era combined. Three of this season's games are the first of the group to be played in Colonial Life Arena.

Under Staley, the Gamecocks are 7-1 in games in which they score 80 points with the lone loss coming in a double-overtime affair (94-92) at Clemson on Nov. 19, 2009. That is the only previous season in which the

Gamecocks hit the 80-point plateau multiple times, adding an 80-68 victory at Alabama on Jan. 10, 2010.

South Carolina is exhibiting its most efficient offense of the Dawn Staley era so far this season, leading the SEC and ranking fourth in the nation with 49.4 percent accuracy from the field. The Gamecocks have shot 50.0 percent or higher five times already this season - the most in a season under Staley. In fact, in the previous five seasons, South Carolina hit at least 50.0 percent of its field goal attempts just 12 times.

This year's top effort was 60.9 percent against Charleston Southern (Nov. 8) - program best under Staley followed by a 58.5 percent showing against NC Central (Dec. 2). The Gamecocks made at least 65.0 percent of their attempts in a half five times this season, including a remarkable 73.9 percent (17-of-23) in the second half against Seton Hall (Nov. 17).

### Post Presence

South Carolina's trio of primary post players - Alaina Coates, Elem Ibiam and Aleighsa Welch - has been the key to the Gamecocks' offensive production so far this season. The trio has accounted for 369 of the team's 783 points this season - 47.1 percent - and is shooting a combined 64.8 percent from the field (138-of-213). Welch is second in the nation in field goal percentage at .705 for 14.9 points per game (10th in SEC). Ibiam's strong last two games lifted her scoring average to 11.2 on 61.4 percent shooting, and Coates adds 10.8 ppg on 61.5 percent shooting. In all, the Gamecocks have scored 402 points in the paint this season – 51.3 percent of their total scoring.

# The Gift of Glass

The Gamecocks have been a solid rebounding team throughout head coach Dawn Staley's tenure, but it was a team effort by an undersized roster in the past. This season, South Carolina is out-rebounding its opponents by 10.4 boards per game to rank fourth in the SEC and among the nation's top 15, behind the strength of the trio of Alaina Coates, Elem Ibiam and Aleighsa Welch, who leads the group and ranks 10th in the SEC with 7.9 boards per game. Coates is bringing down 7.4 rebounds per game, and Ibiam

As a team, South Carolina has turned its 142 offensive rebounds into 157 second-chance points. Welch and paces the group on the offensive glass with 3.2 per game to rank

eighth in the league in the category.

# **Block Party!**

With a pair of 6-foot-4 centers, the Gamecocks are a constant shot-blocking threat in the post, leading the SEC and among the nation's top 10 with 6.2 per game. Junior Elem Ibiam's 2.6 blocks per game are tops in the league and 30th in the nation. She got the season off to a solid start with five in the opener against Charleston Southern (Nov. 8), which matched her career high and the fifth-most in Colonial Life Arena history. She has blocked at least three shots five times this season. Freshman Alaina Coates is among the SEC's top five as well, holding fourth place with 1.6 per game after swatting away four against Seton Hall (Nov. 17).

# A Little Help from My Friends

Under the tutelage of one of the premier point guards in U.S. women's basketball history in Dawn Staley, the Gamecocks are thriving in the assist category this season unlike any other, ranking sixth in the SEC and among the top 30 in the nation with 16.6 per game. By comparison, in Staley's first five seasons, the team never averaged more than 11.2 per game. This season's three games of 20 or more assists by the team matches the total of the previous five seasons.

The increase is not simply a product of more made field goals, either. This season, South Carolina has assisted on 60.1 percent of its made field goals, compared to the previous five seasons under Staley, which saw a high of 48.5 percent in 2011-12.

South Carolina's 25 assists against Charleston Southern (on 39 FGM) are a Staley-era high. The Gamecocks handed out 24 assists on 29 made baskets at San Diego State – 82.8 percent. The percentage of assisted field goals has been over 60.0 percent in all but four games this season.

# Home Grown, Nationally Known

Since her arrival for the 2008-09 season, South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley has been working to protect her new home state's best prospects while fielding a team that competes at a national level. Her efforts are paying dividends as this season's roster features seven Gamecocks who played high school basketball in the state of South Carolina, the highest percentage of the roster to be from the state since the 1990-91 squad featured eight South Carolinians on the 11-player roster. Beginning with Aleighsa Welch, the first South Carolina player to sign a National Letter of Intent for Staley, the Palmetto State has sent its players of the year to Columbia as Welch (2011), Asia Dozier (2012) and Alaina Coates (2013) have each earned the title during their high school careers.

# Be the Change

South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley has provided an extra challenge for her program with the "Be the Change" theme for this season. Reflecting on her career as she prepared for enshrinement into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame and traveling in Africa this summer, she discovered she wanted her team to embrace the

### Intro Video Vibe

South Carolina's intro video features voices familiar to the Gamecock faithful as redshirt sophomore Tina Roy and sophomore Khadijah Sessions collaborated for the second-straight year on the song that sets up the Gamecocks' starting lineup. It is the third season that Roy has written a song that reflects the team, the program and its goals. After the first year's song was more just for the team, South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley encouraged Roy to create one to share center stage at home games in 2012-13, which she did with support and "beats" from her first-year teammate Sessions. It was such a hit with fans and spark for the team that the duo did it again this season.

# Drive for 5

The Gamecocks launched their "Drive for 5" women's basketball ticket campaign this season. Inspired by head coach Dawn Staley's jersey number during her Naismith Hall of Fame playing career, the campaign looks to bring at least 5,000 fans to every Gamecock women's basketball game. At the end of October, the Gamecocks were well on their way, surpassing 3,000 season tickets issued for the season for the first time in the Staley era.

## Watching the Gamecocks

South Carolina will play a total of 13 regular-season games on television in 2013-14. Four non-conference home games – College of Charleston (Nov. 14), NC Central (Dec. 2), SC State (Dec. 22) and Savannah State (Dec. 29) – will air on Fox Sports South and Fox Sports Carolinas in addition to the Gamecocks' game at Southern Cal airing on the Pac-12 Networks and their outing at Kentucky showing on Fox Sports South. The SEC package includes four national and three regional broadcasts during league play. The Gamecocks will play twice on ESPN2 – at Vanderbilt (Jan. 26) and at LSU (Feb. 16) – and twice on ESPNU – vs. Vanderbilt (Jan. 5) and at Tennessee (Mar. 2). Other televised games are at Auburn (Jan. 12, SportSouth), vs. Arkansas (Feb. 9, SECTV) and vs. Florida (Feb. 23, SportSouth).


