The spring of 2012 marks a new era for South Carolina tennis as the Gamecocks open a \$4.6 million facility that will accommodate both men's and women's programs. Located in the heart of the Athletics Village at the Roost, the stadium features 12 courts with lights and scoreboards on each one. Each side of six courts also has a master scoreboard so fans always know what's happening on each court. Video cameras are mounted behind each court as well to record matches and stream them live over the internet. Seating is available for 670 fans with plenty of standing room available for more. The stadium has 400 square feet of court-side storage and 900 square feet of dedicated restroom facilities.
