## SEC TOP 10 ATHLETES

**Radiance Basden** Senior // Greensboro, N.C.  
**Event:** Triple Jump  
**Mark:** 12.88m // 42-03.25 (February 11 // Tyson Invitational)  
**Notes:** Basden took the SEC lead in the triple jump and was named the SEC Field Athlete of the Week after her winning performance at the Tyson Invitational. She ranks seventh in the NCAA and is on track to earn her first NCAA bid.

**Kierre Beckles** Senior // Pinelands, Saint Michael, Barbados  
**Event:** 60m Hurdles  
**Time:** 8.18 (February 11 // Tyson Invitational)  
**Notes:** Beckles will look to medal at the SEC Championships after taking fourth overall in the 60m hurdles last season, her first as a Gamecock. The Barbados national record holder in the 100m hurdles currently has the sixth-best 60m hurdle time in the nation.

**Damiere Byrd** Freshman // Sicklerville, N.J.  
**Event:** 60m Dash  
**Time:** 6.72 (February 10 // Tyson Invitational)  
**Notes:** Two-sport athlete Damiere Byrd has the third-fastest time in the nation for a freshman in the 60-meter dash, and the football wide receiver will look to make his mark in the short sprint on the track.

**Louis Day** Redshirt Junior // Hempstead, N.Y.  
**Event:** Shot Put  
**Mark:** 16.96m // 55-07.75 (February 18 // Gamecock Invitational)  
**Notes:** Day will most likely be remembered for his performance at the 2011 SEC Indoor Championships when he alerted the officials of a scoring error that would have benefited him in the weight throw competition. His act earned him SEC and NCAA Sportsmanship of the Year honors. This season, Day will look to make waves in a new way -- by scoring at the indoor championships for the first time in his career.

**Jarrod Hutchen** Junior // Douglasville, Ga.  
**Event:** Long Jump  
**Mark:** 7.55m // 24-09.25 (February 10 // Tyson Invitational)  
**Notes:** Hutchen has made his mark in his first season in a Gamecock uniform. His path to Columbia took longer than expected, but the junior college transfer will look to become the first Gamecock man to score at the SEC meet since Greg Cryer earned silver in 2006.

**Petra Olsen** Sophomore // Malmö, Sweden  
**Event:** Pole Vault  
**Mark:** 4.00m // 13-01.50 (February 3 // New Balance Invitational)  
**Notes:** Olsen was named to the 2011 SEC All-Freshman team after placing fourth in the pole vault at the indoor championships last season. The Swedish international holds the No. 3 mark in Gamecock history.

**Breanna Radford** Junior // Alpharetta, Ga.  
**Event:** Shot Put  
**Mark:** 14.62m // 47-11.75 (February 10 // Tiger Paw Invitational)  
**Notes:** Radford placed fifth in the shot put at SEC's as a sophomore. She has steadily improved her mark throughout the indoor season.

**Marvin Reitze** Redshirt Junior // Bergisch Gladbach, Germany  
**Event:** Pole Vault  
**Mark:** 5.42m // 17-09.25 (January 27 // Rod McCravy Memorial)  
**Notes:** Reitze is back on All-American track after missing the 2011 indoor season due to injury. He currently ranks second in the SEC and fourth in the NCAA in the pole vault in a season where he has finished first or second at every meet that he has competed in. The redshirt junior has earned bronze medal honors at both the 2009 and 2010 SEC Indoor Championships, and also has a bronze medal from the 2011 SEC Outdoor Championships. The Gamecocks have had a medalist at each of the last three SEC indoors, and Reitze will look to return the gold to South Carolina.

**Jeannelle Scheper** Sophomore // Gros-Islet, Saint Lucia  
**Event:** High Jump  
**Mark:** 1.83m // 6-0 (February 14 // New Balance Invitational)  
**Notes:** Scheper is the school record holder and on track for an All-American season as a 17-year old sophomore in the high jump. She is looking to become just the second Gamecock woman to medal in the high jump at an SEC Championship (indoor or outdoor), following the footsteps of Monica Bozinski's bronze medal finish at the 2005 Indoor Championships. Scheper's mark of 6'0 (1.83m) ranks fourth in the NCAA.

**Katie Vuckovich** Senior // Naperville, Ill.  
**Event:** Shot Put  
**Mark:** 14.71m // 48-03.25 (February 4 // New Balance Invitational)  
**Notes:** Vuckovich leads the trio of Gamecock throwers that all have the ability to score at the SEC meet. She placed 11th as a sophomore and 9th as a junior in the shot put.

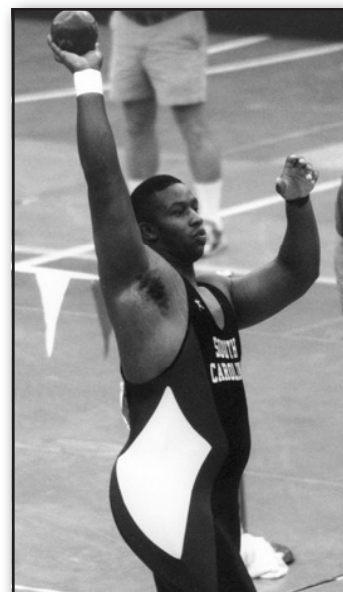

# Curtis Frye

## South Carolina Head Coach

### 16th Season // East Carolina '74

Entering the 2012 track season in his 16th year as head track & field and cross country coach at South Carolina, Curtis Frye has established a program that is regarded as one of the nation's elite. Frye has coached or overseen over 60 NCAA champions, 115 SEC champions and more than 435 NCAA All Americans.

In October 2008, Frye was bestowed the Order of Ikko Medallion, presented by the United States Olympic Committee. A special order reserved for the coach of an Olympic or Paralympic medalist, Frye received the honor after coaching Jerome Singleton Jr. to a silver medal in the men's 100-meter dash at the 2008 Paralympic Games in Beijing. He also currently serves as President of the United States Track & Field and Cross Country Coaches Association.

Frye has coached an NCAA champion in all but one year since taking over the program in 1996, including coaching LaKya Brookins to the 60-meter dash indoor title last season en route to being named USTFCCA Southeast Region Athlete of the Year for both the indoor and outdoor seasons. In addition, Frye has coached an SEC champion every year he has been at South Carolina.

One of the most well-respected coaches in the country, Frye brought South Carolina its first team NCAA championship in any sport when his women's team captured the 2002 NCAA Outdoor Championship crown. Frye is a three-time United States Track Coaches Association (USTCA) National Coach of the Year, taking home the 1999 and 2002 women's outdoor honors and the 1999 men's indoor honors. In taking home the men's indoor and women's outdoor coach of the year honors in 1999, he became the first person in the history of the USTCA to win the award indoors and outdoors in the same year. In 2001, he earned the prestigious Nike Coach of the Year award and was also named the 1997 USOC Track & Field Coach of the Year. Frye is also a three-time SEC Coach of the Year with the honor coinciding with his three women's outdoor conference championships in 1999, 2002 and 2005.

During his tenure at South Carolina, Frye has coached 11 SEC Athletes of the Year, the most recent being Nadonna Rodrigues, who was named the 2009 SEC Freshman Runner of the Year (indoor). He has also coached five national athletes of the year in Hastings (2007-overall), Demetria Washington (2002-indoor), Lashinda Demus (2002-overall), Terrence Trammell (2000-outdoor) and Miki Barber (2000-outdoor). Demus was acknowledged by Track & Field News while the United States Track & Field & Cross Country Coaches Association (USTFCCA) honored the other four recipients.

On the women's side, Frye's teams have placed in the top 10 nationally outdoors in all but four of his seasons at Carolina. In addition to the team title in 2002, his teams earned the silver medal in 2005 and took home the bronze in 2003 and 2006. On the men's side, Frye's team placed in the top 25 nationally indoors in all but four of his seasons.

Along with continued success on the track, Frye has produced winners in the classroom on a consistent basis. Frye's athletes have earned four USTFCCA National Scholar-Athlete of the Year honors in addition to an SEC Scholar-Athlete of the Year award. Richardson swept the indoor and outdoor national honors in 2008, following awards earned by 2006 National Indoor Scholar Athlete of the Year Shalonda Solomon and 2002 National Scholar Athlete of the Year Otukile Lekote. In 2009, the men's team was named Scholar Team of the Year.

In his career, Frye has coached 25 Olympians who have won 11 medals at the Olympic Games. Nine of his former student-athletes competed at the 2008 Olympic Games in Beijing, six of them as first-time Olympians. At the Games, Natasha Hastings earned a gold medal as a member of the USA 4x400m relay team. Frye served as an assistant coach for the 2004 USA Olympic women's track team with responsibilities that included working with the sprinters and the relays. He also accompanied his former athletes to the 2000 Sydney Olympics. Frye's athletes won three gold medals in 2004 by Tonique Williams-Darling (Bahamas-400m), Otis Harris (USA-4x400m relay) and Aleen Bailey (Jamaica-4x100m relay).

Hired at South Carolina on July 29, 1996, Frye came to Columbia after serving as assistant head coach at North Carolina for four years. During his tenure at UNC, he was a part of 13 ACC championship teams.

Prior to his stint with the Tar Heels, Frye was an assistant coach at Florida from 1988 to 1992. While with the Gator program, he coached three NCAA individual champions and one relay champion team. In total, 29 All-America certificates were earned while Frye was in Gainesville.

From 1984 to 1988, Frye was an assistant coach for N.C. State, aiding the Wolfpack to four conference championships. He was instrumental in leading State to 27 All-America honors, four individual NCAA second-place finishes and 37 conference champions.

Frye began his coaching career as an assistant at his alma mater, East Carolina, in 1974. He also served as head coach for the men's soccer team and was director of facilities. Frye took a break from the collegiate ranks from 1979 to 1984 when he was head track and field coach for Douglas Byrd High School in Fayetteville, N.C.

Frye and his wife, Wilma, have three children: Crystal, C.J. and Curtrell.
