South Carolina Notables

- This is the Gamecocks' 40th season as a varsity sport, the sixth with head coach Dawn Staley at the helm. It is South Carolina's 23rd season in the SEC.
- South Carolina leads the SEC in field goal percentage (.507), rebounding margin (+13.4), scoring margin (+34.4), blocks per game (6.1) and assist-to-turnover ratio (1.6). The Gamecocks are among the top 15 in the nation in each category as well.
- South Carolina has scored 40.3 points per game in the paint just over half of its 80.1 scoring average, which ranks among the top 40 in the nation.
- The top three individual field goal percentages in the SEC all belong to Gamecocks Aleighsa Welch (.714), Alaina Coates (.656) and Tiffany Mitchell (.581).
- With 25 offensive rebounds so far this season, junior Aleighsa Welch has moved into sixth place in school history with 260 career offensive boards, just 14 away from a spot in the top five.
- Sophomore guard Tiffany Mitchell is the only Gamecock to score in double figures every game this season, but it is
 the last four games that have catapulted her up the SEC standings. In the last four games, as opponents have sagged to

contain the Gamecock post players, Mitchell averaged 18.0 points on 65.8 percent shooting, including 50.0 percent from 3-point range, and 77.3 percent from the free throw line, while pulling down 4.5 rebounds, handing out 4.8 assists and swiping 3.3 steals per game during the stretch. In the first four games, Mitchell contributed 12.0 ppg on 50.0 percent shooting and 43.8 free-throw shooting, 4.0 rpg, 2.3 apg and 1.8 spg.

- Center Alaina Coates is the third-highest scoring freshman in the SEC (18th overall), while getting fewer minutes than the two first-year players ahead of her. Coates scores one point every 1.4 minutes she is on the floor. LSU's Raigyne Moncrief comes in at one point every 1.6 minutes (14.5 ppg), and Arkansas' Jessica Jackson is adding one point every 2.0 minutes of court time.
- Sophomore guard Khadijah Sessions is third in the SEC in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.6). She has handed out five or more assists four times this season, including a career-high six in just 20 minutes against NC Central (Dec. 2). On the other side, Sessions has turned the ball over two more times in just two games this season.

Charlotte Series Notes

The Gamecocks lead the series 16-6, although the 49ers won the last meeting 69-57 to end South Carolina's run in the 2011 WNIT. It was just the second Charlotte win in the last 12 meetings between the two

In a series that begin in the 1982-83 season, the Gamecocks are 7-3 in games played in Charlotte with the last meeting coming on Nov. 16, 2009, and ending in a 70-66 overtime win for South Carolina. The 49ers' last win over the Gamecocks in Charlotte was a 73-60 decision on Feb. 15, 1995.

Five-Second Count

For the first time in her tenure at South Carolina, head coach Dawn's Staley's Gamecocks look different on the court and in the stat sheet. Coming off back-toback 25-win seasons, Staley was not afraid to change her strategy to fit her personnel.

After seasons of building around defense, Staley finally as a group that is designed for offensive efficiency. The Gamecocks are scoring more (80.1 ppg - 4th in

Staley in the Hall of Fame

Head coach Dawn Staley was enshrined in the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame this fall, becoming just the 15th female player to earn the honor based on her individual merits (not as part of a team enshrinement). Staley's career shone in an era that spawned two professional women's basketball leagues in the United States

and forever changed the dreams of the nation's top female players. On the international stage, she collected three Olympic gold medals (1996, 2000, 2004) and was twice named the USA Basketball Female Athlete of the Year (1994, 2004). In the U.S. she turned national high school player of the year honors into a career at Virginia that yielded three All-America seasons, including a 1991 campaign that ended with being named national player of the year. On the professional level, Staley was a five-time WNBA All-Star who was named to the All-Decade Team and one of the 15 most influential players in league history.

Welch Watch on Record Book

South Carolina junior forward Aleighsa Welch has proven to be one of the best offensive rebounders in Gamecock history. She is one of just four Gamecocks all-time to record multiple seasons with at least 100 offensive rebounds, including her 131 O-board mark last season, which ranks second in school history.

In just her third season, Welch already ranks among the program's top 10 in career offensive rebounds.

SEC, top-40 in nation) and more efficiently (.507 FG %age – 1st in SEC, top-40 in country) than at any time in the Staley era. And, after seasons of talented guards generating their own offense, Staley's 2013-14 success is predicated on getting the ball inside – three primary post players combine to score 45.7 percent of the team's points – and on ball movement creating the best shots – 64.9 percent of made field goals have been assisted, ranking the Gamecocks second in the SEC and top-25 in the nation with 18.5 assists per game.

Defense is still a staple of the program with the Gamecocks ranking among the nation's top five in scoring defense, allowing just 45.8 points per game. Only one opponent this season has scored 55 or more points against South Carolina.

December Decisions

In its 40th season of women's basketball, South Carolina is 156-78 (.667) all-time in the month of December, including a 24-6 record (.800) in the sixth season of the Dawn Staley era. The Gamecocks hold a winning record in all three site possibilities during the month – 94-23 (.803) at home, 33-30 (.524) on the road and 24-23 (.511) at neutral sites.

Road Warriors

With comprehensive records beginning in the 1976-77 season (the third for women's basketball at South Carolina), the Gamecocks are 198-234 (.458) all-time in games played on the road, including a 29-29 mark (.500) in the Dawn Staley era. The Gamecocks have had winning road records in each of the previous two seasons, combining for a 16-8 record (.667) in 2011-12 and 2012-13.

Century Mark for Staley

Head coach Dawn Staley captured her 100th victory at South Carolina on Dec. 2 against NC Central. She is the fourth of the program's seven all-time head coaches to reach the mark and the fastest to the total (164 games) of the

three coaches to lead the team in the SEC era by nearly a full season.

South Carolina's third head coach, Pam Parsons, was the first and the fastest to reach 100 victories, hitting the plateau in her 143rd game at the helm just six games into her fifth season (1981-82). Nancy Wilson was next up, winning her 100th game in her 150th outing late in the 1988-89 season, en route to her school-record 231 Gamecock

Susan Walvius was the first head coach to have her entire South Carolina career in the SEC, hitting 100 wins in her 179th game on the sideline five games into her seventh season.

20/20 Vision

The Gamecocks have won each of their games this season by at least 20 points for the first time in the Dawn Staley era. South Carolina opened the 2012-13 campaign with four straight 20-point wins en route to nine games with that minimum margin – a Staley era record. The Gamecocks posted eight 20-point wins in 2011-12 after just two in 2010-11, one in 2009-10 and two in Staley's first season 2008-09.

Finding the Right Octave

South Carolina has scored at least 80 points in four games so far this season after reaching the mark just four times in the first five seasons of the Dawn Staley era combined. Three of this season's games are the first of the group to be played in Colonial Life Arena.

Under Staley, the Gamecocks are 7-1 in games in which they score 80 points with the lone loss coming in a double-overtime affair (94-92) at Clemson on Nov. 19, 2009. That is the only previous season in which the Gamecocks hit the 80-point plateau multiple times, adding an 80-68 victory at Alabama on Jan. 10, 2010.

Make It, Take It

South Carolina is exhibiting its more efficient offense of the Dawn Staley era so far this season, leading the SEC and ranking among the nation's top 10 with 50.7 percent accuracy from the field. The Gamecocks have shot 50.0 percent or higher five times already this season – the most in a season under Staley. In fact, in the previous five seasons, South Carolina hit at least 50.0 percent of its field goal attempts just 12 times.

This year's top effort was 60.9 percent against Charleston Southern (Nov. 8) – program best under Staley – followed by a 58.5 percent showing against NC Central (Dec. 2). The Gamecocks made at least 65.0 percent of their attempts in a half five times this season, including a remarkable 73.9 percent (17-of-23) in the second half against Seton Hall (Nov. 17).

Post Presence

South Carolina's trio of primary post players – Alaina Coates, Elem Ibiam and Aleighsa Welch – has been the key to the Gamecocks' offensive production so far this season. The trio has accounted for 293 of the team's 641 points this season – 45.7 percent – and is shooting a combined 66.9 percent from the field (109-of-163). Welch leads the way with an SEC-best 71.4 percent accuracy for 13.5 points per game (15th in SEC). Coates is close behind with 13.3 ppg (18th in SEC) on 65.6 percent shooting (2nd in SEC). Elem contributes 9.9 points per game on 63.0 percent shooting. In all, the Gamecocks have scored 322 points in the paint this season – 50.2 percent of their total scoring.

The Gift of Glass

The Gamecocks have been a solid rebounding team throughout head coach Dawn Staley's tenure, but it was a team effort by an undersized roster in the past. This season, South Carolina is out-rebounding its opponents by 13.4 boards per game to lead the SEC and rank among the nation's top 15, behind the strength of the trio of Alaina Coates, Elem Ibiam and Aleighsa Welch. Coates sixth in the SEC with 8.6 boards per game, tops among league freshmen, and Welch is eighth in with 8.4. Ibiam rounds out the group with 5.8 per contest.

As a team, South Carolina has turned its 115 offensive rebounds into 130 second-chance points. Welch and Coates pace the group on the offensive glass with 3.1 and 2.8 per game, respectively, to each rank among the league's top 15 in the category.

Block Party!

With a pair of 6-foot-4 centers, the Gamecocks are a constant shot-blocking threat in the post, ranking second in the SEC and among the nation's top 15 with 6.1 per game. Junior Elem Ibiam's 2.4 blocks per game are second in the SEC and top 30 in the nation. She got the season off to a solid start with five in the opener against Charleston Southern (Nov. 8), which matched her career high and the fifth-most in Colonial Life Arena history. She has blocked at least three shots four times this season. Freshman Alaina Coates is among the SEC's top five as well, holding fifth place with 1.6 per game after swatting away four against Seton Hall (Nov. 17).

A Little Help from My Friends

Under the tutelage of one of the premier point guards in U.S. women's basketball history in Dawn Staley, the Gamecocks are thriving in the assist category this season unlike any other, ranking second in the SEC and among the nation's top 25 with 18.5 per game. By comparison, in Staley's first five seasons, the team never averaged more than 11.2 per game. This season's three games of 20 or more assists by the team matches the total of the previous five seasons.

The increase is not simply a product of more made field goals, either. This season, South Carolina has assisted on 64.9 percent of its made field goals, compared to the previous five seasons under Staley, which saw a high of 48.5 percent in 2011-12.

South Carolina's 25 assists against Charleston Southern (on 39 FGM) are a Staley-era high. The Gamecocks handed out 24 assists on 29 made baskets at San Diego State – 82.8 percent. The percentage of assisted field goals has been over 60.0 percent in all but two games this season.

Home Grown, Nationally Known

Since her arrival for the 2008-09 season, South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley has been working to protect her new home state's best prospects while fielding a team that competes at a national level. Her efforts are paying dividends as this season's roster features seven Gamecocks who played high school basketball in the state of South Carolina, the highest percentage of the roster to be from the state since the 1990-91 squad featured eight South Carolinians on the 11-player roster. Beginning with Aleighsa Welch, the first South Carolina player to sign a National Letter of Intent for Staley, the Palmetto State has sent its players of the year to Columbia as Welch (2011), Asia Dozier (2012) and Alaina Coates (2013) have each earned the title during their high school careers.

Be the Change

South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley has provided an extra challenge for her program with the "Be the Change" theme for this season. Reflecting on her career as she prepared for enshrinement into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame and traveling in Africa this summer, she discovered she wanted her team to embrace the importance of focusing on others. In Africa especially, she noted the significant impact even small acts can have on the world around her.

To that end, Staley has challenged her program and everyone who supports it to commit 50,000 random acts of kindness this season. The program has set up Twitter (@

Future Faces of the Gamecocks

South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley is the process of reeling in what would be one of the most significant recruiting classes in program history. The class currently includes four future Gamecocks, including the No. 7, No. 32 and No. 44 rated players, according to ESPN. The group gives South Carolina the fourth-best signing class in the nation, according to ESPN, trailing just UCLA (five signees), Duke (4) and Connecticut (4).

Intro Video Vibe

South Carolina's intro video features voices familiar to the Gamecock faithful as redshirt sophomore Tina Roy and sophomore Khadijah Sessions collaborated for the second-straight year on the song that sets up the Gamecocks' starting lineup. It is the third season that Roy has written a song that reflects the team, the program and its goals. After the first year's song was more just for the team, South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley encouraged Roy to create one to share center stage at home games in 2012-13, which she did with support and "beats" from her first-year teammate Sessions. It was such a hit with fans and spark for the team that the duo did it again this season.

Drive for 5

The Gamecocks launched their "Drive for 5" women's basketball ticket campaign this season. Inspired by head coach Dawn Staley's jersey number during her Naismith Hall of Fame playing career, the campaign looks to bring at least 5,000 fans to every Gamecock women's basketball game. At the end of October, the Gamecocks were well on their way, surpassing 3,000 season tickets issued for the season for the first time in the Staley era.

Watching the Gamecocks

South Carolina will play a total of 13 regular-season games on television in 2013-14. Four non-conference home games – College of Charleston (Nov. 14), NC Central (Dec. 2), SC State (Dec. 22) and Savannah State (Dec. 29) – will air on Fox Sports South and Fox Sports Carolinas in addition to the Gamecocks' game at Southern Cal airing on the Pac-12 Networks and their outing at Kentucky showing on Fox Sports South. The SEC package includes four national and three regional broadcasts during league play. The Gamecocks will play twice on ESPN2 – at Vanderbilt (Jan. 26) and at LSU (Feb. 16) – and twice on ESPNU – vs. Vanderbilt (Jan. 5) and at Tennessee (Mar. 2). Other televised games are at Auburn (Jan. 12, SportSouth), vs. Arkansas (Feb. 9, SECTV) and vs. Florida (Feb. 23, SportSouth).
