South Carolina Notables

- The Gamecocks are in their 41st season of women's basketball. It is the program's 24th season in the SEC and the seventh under head coach Dawn Staley. South Carolina has played in the last three NCAA Tournaments, including two trips to the Sweet 16 (2012, 2014).
- South Carolina will recognize the winners of the second segment of its Read with the Gamecocks program at halftime today. The 105 elementary schools that participated in the segment included over 7,000 students who read more than 1.4 million pages over the two-week period.
- Today's meeting between the Gamecocks and Wildcats is the second top-10 showdown in as many seasons of the series. In the first meeting of the 2013-14 season, then-No. 10 South Carolina topped then-No. 9 Kentucky 68-58 here in Colonial Life Arena.
- The Gamecocks' 15-0 start is the best in program history and broke the school record for longest win streak. The previous record was held by the 1985-86 team, which put together 13 wins from Jan. 25 through March 3.
- South Carolina scored in triple digits for the first time in SEC regular-season play in its 102-59 victory at Alabama Thursday night, but it was the first time since Dec. 7 (at Duke) that no Gamecock posted a double-double.
- The Gamecocks shot 63.8 percent from the field at Alabama, the highest field goal percentage of the Dawn Staley era, the best since hitting 65.2 percent against East Tennessee State on Dec. 19, 2000, and the highest in a road game in program history.
- In the last two seasons (49 games), senior Aleighsa Welch has shot 50.0 percent or better in all but 10 games, including three perfect shooting games. This season, SEC play has brought out the best in Welch, who is currently shooting 87.5 percent (14-of-16) in league games.
- Four Gamecocks were named to the Naismith Trophy Top 50 Watch List this week with Alaina Coates and A'ja Wilson joining junior Tiffany Mitchell and Aleighsa Welch, who are also on the Wooden Award and Wade Trophy Watch Lists. No other school had four entries on the Naismith list, and South Carolina is one of four teams with two entries on the other two watch lists.

A South Carolina Win Would...

- Extend the school record for longest win streak to 16.
- Make the Gamecocks 4-0 in SEC play for just the second time in school history, matching the 2002 team for the program's best opening SEC record at 4-0.
- Be the Gamecocks' 26th straight at Colonial Life Arena to break the tie with UConn for the longest active home win streak in the nation.

Kentucky Series History

The Wildcats lead the overall series 32-12 with

an 8-5 advantage during South Carolina's Dawn Staley era. The Gamecocks hold a 3-2 edge over the last two seasons.

South Carolina and Kentucky squared off three times last season with the Gamecocks winning both regular-season contests and the Wildcats winning in the SEC Tournament semifinals. Over the three games, Aleighsa Welch led the offense with 16.3 points per game – posting a double-

double in each of the regular-season outings – while Alaina Coates controlled the glass at 10.7 rebounds per game. South Carolina shot 45.6 percent from the field against the Wildcats last season and out-rebounded them 45.3-32.0. The Wildcats' lone win in the three-game stretch came behind solid shooting from the 3-point line and the ability to get to the free throw line.

The Gamecocks are 15-9 against the Wildcats in games played in Columbia, including wins in the last two meetings at Colonial Life Arena for a 4-2 home record against Kentucky in the Staley era. The Wildcats' last win on South Carolina's home floor was a 66-58 decision on Jan. 15, 2012.

Ranked Readings

South Carolina is facing its third ranked opponent of the season today and its second top-10 match-up. The Gamecocks are 67-216 all-time against ranked teams with a 17-39 record in the Dawn Staley era. Under Staley, South Carolina is 5-16 against ranked opponents at Colonial Life Arena, 8-12 on the road and 4-11 at neutral sites.

Poll Presence

This week's rankings extended South Carolina's string of Associated Press top-10 appearances to 20, the longest in program history, and is the Gamecocks' seventh in the No. 1 spot. The only teams to hold the position more often in the last five seasons are Baylor (39 weeks) and UConn (33).

The AP's No. 1 ranking on Nov. 24 was the program's first, besting the No. 2 spot the Gamecocks held for five times in their history – Nov. 17, 2014; Preseason 2014-15; Jan. 2, 1982; Dec. 27, 1981; and Dec. 20, 1981.

The Gamecocks opened this season with their highest preseason ranking from the organization, coming in at No. 2 to best the previous high of No. 4 heading into the 1981-82 season.

Home Sweet Home

The Gamecocks are in the midst of unprecedented success at Colonial Life Arena, having won their last 25 games on their home court, including the facility's first perfect season in 2013-14. That 16-0 mark alone matched the previous record for win streak at the Arena, originally set Jan. 20, 2002-Jan. 9, 2003. South Carolina's last loss at Colonial Life Arena was a 50-48 decision to then-No. 14 Texas A&M on Feb. 10, 2013.

The longest home win streak in school history is 32 games, which spanned three seasons. That streak began with a win over Clemson on Dec. 10, 1977, and ended with a win over Tennessee Tech on March 4, 1980. The stretch included a perfect 11-0 record in 1978-79 at Carolina Coliseum (9-0) and the Sol Blatt P.E. Center (2-0).

Overall, South Carolina is 140-58 (.707) at Colonial Life Arena, including a 74-25 (.747) mark under head coach Dawn Staley. In the now 41-year history of the program, the Gamecocks are 385-155 (.713) in home games.

SEC Stories

Head coach Dawn Staley has steadily lifted the Gamecocks' national profile by building the Gamecocks into a consistent SEC contender, shirking decades of difficulty in the nation's best women's basketball conference.

In her seventh season at the helm, Staley boasts a 55-42 (.567) SEC regular-season record and has finished outside the league's top five just twice – an unprecedented achievement for a program that had finished INSIDE the top five just twice in the previous 17 seasons. Staley's 54 wins include three seasons of double-digit league victories – 10-6 in 2012, 11-5 in 2013 and an SEC-best 14-2 in 2014.

Staley's SEC regular-season record includes a 29-18 (.617) mark at home and a 25-24 (.510) slate on the road.

Win Any Way

As the Gamecocks' baseball coach a few years ago, South Carolina athletics director Ray Tanner frequently used the saying "Win Anyway," and the women's basketball team has put its own twist on the quote. The Gamecocks have not lost a game this season, but the end has not always come by the same means.

Dawn Staley's team has won with both a high-flying offense – posting records of 4-0 when scoring 90+ points, 4-0 when scoring 80-89 points – and a more methodical one, 4-0 when scoring 70-79 points, 4-0 with scoring fewer than 70.

The Gamecocks have won both inside – 6-0 when shooting less than 33.3 percent from 3-point range, 5-0 when at least half of points come in the paint – and outside – 9-0 when shooting 33.3 percent or better from 3-point range, 10-0 when less than half of points come in the paint.

South Carolina has seen its top scorer come from both the starting lineup (6-0) and the bench (8-0) – with one game a starter and reserve tied for the team high (vs. Auburn – Welch, Wilson).

Diehard Defenders

While the offense has fluctuated in source and volume, the one standard for the Gamecocks – both this season and throughout head coach Dawn Staley's career – has been their defense. South Carolina is third in the nation in scoring defense, allowing 49.3 points per game with no opponent scoring more than 63 points. In fact, South Carolina has held an opponent under 50 points eight times.

Controlled Caroms

The Gamecocks have also built their success on the glass – an area, like defense, that Staley preaches as a measure of effort as much as talent. South Carolina ranks ninth in the nation in rebounding margin, out-boarding its opponents by 11.0 per game. The Gamecocks have out-paced their opponent by double-digit rebounds seven times this season, including three games by at least 20 rebounds – Clemson (+22), Savannah State (+35) and at Hampton (+27).

Bench Marks

While every competitor wants to be a starter, the Gamecocks have shown that the bench can be just as productive a position. The South Carolina bench has tied or out-scored its starting teammates eight times this season, including all three SEC contests, and has out-scored the entire opposing team four times – Clemson (Nov. 20), San Diego State (Nov. 23), NC Central (Dec. 1). In all, the bench has accounted for 49.0 percent of the Gamecocks' points this season.

Of the 62 double-figures games turned in so far this season, 31 of them have come from the bench – A'ja Wilson (14), Alaina Coates (8), Bianca

Cuevas (4), Tina Roy (2), Jatarie White (2) and Asia Dozier (1).

Diversified Assets

South Carolina ranks second in the nation in field goal shooting with an SEC-best .501 percentage. The Gamecocks' top five scorers all shoot over 50.0 percent from the field, but just two rank among the SEC's best in the category. The anomaly comes from the league and the NCAA required minimum of five made field goals per game to qualify. Only freshman A'ja Wilson (5.4) and junior Tiffany Mitchell (5.0) reach that mark with field goal percentages that rank 49th and 54th in the nation, respectively.

Zone Buster

Since the emergence of Elem Ibiam and the arrival of Alaina Coates last season, South Carolina has been a team feared for its inside presence. That perception got a boost with the addition of Jatarie White and A'ja Wilson this season, and teams have packed into a zone early and often against the Gamecocks.

This season, South Carolina's guards have been effective at capitalizing on what opposing teams are willing to cede in that defensive alignment – the 3-point shot. The Gamecocks lead the SEC and rank 25th in the nation in 3-point field goal percentage, hitting 36.9 percent from outside the arc. The percentage is not far above last season's

(.347), but after closing 2013-14 averaging 3.9 made 3s per game, South Carolina is up to an SEC-best 5.7 average this season – a number that goes up to 7.2 per game in SEC play. The most 3s made per game of the Staley era is 9.2 in 2009-10.

Junior Tiffany Mitchell has been the primary long-range shooter, ranking second in the SEC with 2.3 made 3s per game and second in the country with an SEC-best .515 3-point field goal percentage. Juniors Asia Dozier and Tina Roy combining for another 2.3 made 3-pointers per game, and both have lifted their percentages in SEC action. Dozier is hitting 45.5 percent (5-of-11) from the arc after bringing a .367 percentage into the calendar year. Roy's transformation has been just as dramatic, shooting 60.0 percent (6-of-10) from long range since league play began, improving on her 36.1 percent accuracy.

SWAT Team

South Carolina leads the SEC and ranks ninth in the nation with 6.2 blocked shots per game. The effort is a continuation of last season, during with the Gamecocks shattered the school record

for blocks in a season by 41, recording 240 over 34 games for a 7.1 average.

Four Gamecocks rank among the SEC's top 11 blockers, led by freshman A'ja Wilson in fourth at 1.7 per game. Sophomore Alaina Coates is just behind in sixth with 1.5 per game. Seniors Elem Ibiam and Aleighsa Welch are next in line with 1.1 per game for a share of 11th place.

Handled with Care

Head coach Dawn Staley recently referred to the point guard position as one of "service" to teammates, a job designed to create stars out of her teammates. More than just her point guards have embraced the theory as the Gamecocks rank fourth in the nation in assists per game with an SEC-best 19.8 per game and third in the country with a 1.5 assist-to-turnover ratio. Living up to the legend of their head coach, the Gamecocks have handed out 20 or more assists nine times this season, including a Staley-era high of 26 against NC Central. In all, South Carolina has assisted on 297 of its 455 made field goals this season (.679). Last season's team set the mark for best percentage of the Staley era at .577.

Three Gamecocks rank among the SEC's top 15 in assists, led by junior Khadijah Sessions in ninth at 3.3 per game. The sure-handed Sessions is 12th in the nation in assist-to-turnover ratio with an SEC-best 2.9 mark. Junior Tina Roy has been the unexpected distributor this season, ranking 11th in the conference with 3.1 assists per game and a 2.4 assist-to-turnover ratio that has her second in the SEC and among the nation's top 30. Last season's assist leader, junior Tiffany Mitchell rounds out the trio with a 3.1 average that is 14th in the SEC.

SEC Title Talk

In 2013-14, South Carolina became the seventh program to win the SEC regular-season title, and the Gamecocks and were predicted by the league's coaches and media to the repeat the feat this season. If Staley's group brings that forecast to fruition, it would be just the fourth team to repeat as the regular-season champion, joining Tennessee (multiple times), Georgia (1996, 1997) and LSU (2005, 2006).

Two Grand

Junior guard Tiffany Mitchell joined senior Aleighsa Welch in the 1,000-point club against Liberty (Dec. 21), making it the first time a Gamecock team has had multiple 1,000-point scorers since 2001-02 when Shaunzinski Gortman and Jocelyn Penn both reached that plateau. In program history, there have been nine seasons that featured multiple 1,000-point scorers, including three seasons that saw three Gamecocks who surpassed the benchmark.

More on Muffin

Senior forward Aleighsa Welch – nicknamed Muffin by her mother at birth – continues to be at the foundation of the Gamecocks' success. The South Carolina high school standout who first took a chance on head coach Dawn Staley's vision has done everything asked to power the Gamecocks to the lofty heights achieved during her career. Always willing to do the "dirty work" that doesn't show up in the box score, Welch's energy is what drives the Gamecocks and what has prompted her teammates to vote her a team captain each of the last three seasons.

Welch's consistent effort has her ranked among the program's career top 10 in six different categories, including three rebounding totals, while also among the top-20 scorers. Her current career .590 field goal percentage (474-of-803) is second in school history behind only Jocelyn Penn's school-record .593 (757-of-1277).

The expansion of the Gamecocks' frontline have brought her rebounding numbers down slightly (5.0 rpg this season vs. 7.2 average previous three seasons), but Welch continues to provide consistency on the offensive end, shooting 62.6 percent from the field and handing out 1.9 assists per game.

Trademark TM

Last season, junior guard Tiffany Mitchell established her presence on a national level based on her offensive versatility. But the All-American frequently kept one weapon in check, taking just 2.2 3-pointers per game to account for just 22.1 percent of her field goal attempts on the season.

This season, the usually attacking guard has shown that opponents better be prepared to play her a little tighter around the arc. Mitchell is second in the nation in 3-point accuracy, hitting

51.5 percent from long range and has made 2.3 3s per game to rank second in the SEC. The outside shot has accounted for nearly half of her field goal attempts (68 3FGA, 139 FGA). In fact, she has taken at least half her shots from outside the arc in eight games this season.

Mitchell's heightened accuracy was on full display against San Diego State (Nov. 23) when her 6-of-6 effort from 3 was the best perfect game in program history. She went on to match her career high with six 3s at Hampton as well, those coming on eight attempts.

Double Trouble

One of sophomore Alaina Coates' goals this season focuses around posting double-doubles, taking to heart her head coach's quip that the 6-foot-4 center is a "walking double-double." Ranking 21st in the nation with an SEC-best seven this season, the Irmo, S.C., native has already passed the halfway mark of her freshman year, during which she posted 10 double-doubles, but just three in non-conference action. With 17 career double-doubles through 49 games, Coates is just three shy of making the Gamecocks' career top 10 in the category.

Welch Watch

Already second in school history in career offensive rebounds, senior forward Aleighsa Welch looks to mount an attack on other parts of the Gamecock charts before closing out her career.

Wilson has earned SEC Freshman of the Week three times and was the USBWA's first ever Freshman of the Week (games Dec. 1-7).

It's Elem-entary

Senior center Elem Ibiam is making a charge at the school record for career blocks this season after setting the single-season mark with 83 in 2013-14. The Fayetteville, Ga., native is currently third with 147 in her career, trailing Michelle Murray (1990-93) in second place at 148. The Gamecocks' career record of 177 of set by Lakesha Tolliver (2004-07) is also well within reach.

Home Grown, Nationally Known

Since her arrival for the 2008-09 season, South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley has been working to protect her new home state's best prospects while fielding a team that competes at a national level. Her efforts have paid huge dividends as eight of the 15 members of this year's team hail from South Carolina. Beginning with Aleighsa Welch, the first South Carolina player to sign a National Letter of Intent for Staley, the Palmetto State has frequently sent its players of the year to Columbia as Welch (2011), Asia Dozier

(2012), Alaina Coates (2013), A'ja Wilson (2014) and Kaydra Duckett (2014) have each earned the title during their high school careers.

Class of 2015 Signee

Head coach Dawn Staley added one future Gamecock during the early signing period. Canada's Shay Colley signed her NLI with South Carolina on Nov. 18 and will have four years of eligibility upon enrollment.

Colley is a three-year standout for Team Canada in junior international play, representing her country in the 2014 FIBA U18 Americas Championship (silver), the 2013 FIBA U19 World Championship (7th) and the 2012 FIBA U17 World Championship (bronze).

DAWN STALEY

**7th Season at South Carolina
Virginia, 1992**

When three-time Olympic gold medalist Dawn Staley took the reins of the University of South Carolina women's basketball program on May 10, 2008, the Gamecocks' stature immediately rose not just in the Southeastern Conference but on the national stage as well. Building on a foundation of hard work, defensive effort and a "team first" mentality, South Carolina began to realize those expectations in 2011-12. Three consecutive 25-win seasons were capped with the 2013-14 squad's 29-win effort that included the program's first SEC regular-season championship and No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament as well as the Gamecocks' second NCAA Sweet 16 appearance in three seasons.

In her 14 seasons as a head coach, Staley has amassed a 308-151 record, including her 136-71 slate in six seasons at South Carolina. She has led her teams to nine 20-win seasons, a total of 11 postseason appearances (two WNIT), highlighted by the Gamecocks' pair of Sweet 16 appearances and 14 weeks in the Associated Press top 10, including four in the top five. The future continues to brighten as the nation's top recruits make Columbia, S.C., a highly coveted destination. Consistently signing the top players in the state, Staley's 2014 group illustrated the seeds her staff had been sowing since its arrival as the No. 1 recruit in the class joined two other top-35 entries among the five-member class that was ranked No. 2 in the nation.

While her coaching career is blossoming, Staley is still recognized for her body of work as a one of the most decorated participants in United States women's basketball history. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame solidified her legacy with her enshrinement into the Hall as part of the Class of 2013. The Phoenix Club of Philadelphia established the Dawn Staley Award recognizing the nation's top guard in women's Division I basketball in 2013 as well. Staley was inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2012 and was one of the final nominees for induction to the U.S. Olympic Hall of Fame the same year. In the summer of 2011, the WNBA recognized her as one of the league's "Top 15," honoring the most influential players in the league's history.

At the helm of the Gamecocks over the last six seasons, Staley has been named National Coach of the Year (2014, Basketball Times), Naismith National Coach of the Year Finalist (2014), SEC Coach of the Year (2014, Coaches and AP) and BCA Female Coach of the Year (2012). She has coached an All-American, 12 All-SEC selections, five SEC All-Freshman team selections, an SEC Player of the Year, an SEC Sixth Player of the Year, an SEC Defensive Player of the Year and two SEC Freshmen of the Year. South Carolina's 29 wins in 2013-14 were one shy of the overall school record, breaking the best mark since joining the SEC of 25 set in 2011-12 and tied in 2012-13. The Gamecocks have won more SEC games than the season before in each of Staley's last five seasons, and her 52 SEC victories are more than any other Gamecock coach and account for 44.8 percent of the program's total 116 league wins. She has helped the Gamecocks to three of the program's four top-four finishes in the SEC, including the first regular-season championship in 2013-14. Her 97 overall wins in the last four seasons marks the most successful four-year stretch in program history.
