Hutchen enters the weekend ranked 10th nationally after finishing sixth at the SEC Championships in the long jump with a season best 25'6" (7.77m). Making his first NCAA Indoor entry, he holds the third-best jump in South Carolina indoor history at 26'1" 3/4.

The women's team, currently ranked No. 15, have five scoring opportunities this weekend. Scheper is coming off the first high jump SEC Championship in program history and is tied for the collegiate lead with a clearance of 6'3" 1/4 (1.91m). After becoming the first Gamecock to qualify for the NCAA Championships in the high jump at the 2012 NCAA Indoor Championships, Scheper finished eighth, to earn the school's first All-America certificate. Beckles is coming off her third-straight top-3 performance at the SEC Indoor Championships in the 60-meter hurdles. She tied for the school record with Olympic silver medalist Lashinda Demus at 8.11. This marks the three-time All-American's third appearance at the NCAA Indoor Championships, finishing 11th in 2010 and 13th in 2012. Rucker is also a Gamecock returner, making her second consecutive appearance. She has finished fourth the last two years at the SEC Indoor Championships and carries the sixth-best time in the nation at 52.22. Olsen is the lone women's individual qualifier for the Gamecocks making her first trip to the championships. Last weekend, Olsen cleared a new personal-best of 13'11" (4.24m) to rank 11th overall this season. She garnered All-American honors in the 2012 outdoor season. The 4x400-meter relay has only run together twice after senior All-American Nadonna Rodriques was injured at the Armory Collegiate Invitational earlier this season. Rucker, Beckles, freshman Tyler Brockington and sophomore Christal Green finished second at the SEC Indoor Championships two weeks ago at a season-best 3:33.68.

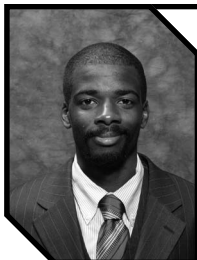

This weekend, the outdoor All-American will look to become the first Gamecock man to earn an indoor All-America certificate in the long jump since Tony Allmond in 2003. His season best ranks him 10th in the country and he finished sixth to score for the Gamecocks at the 2013 SEC Championships with a season-best 25'6" (7.77m). Hutchen's 26'1 3/4 from last season is the third-best jump all-time in South Carolina indoor history.

2012: NCAA Outdoor Participant in the long jump...All-American...Indoors, had a top mark of 24-09.25 (7.55m) in the long jump set at the Tyson Invitational ... placed 11th overall at the SEC Indoor Championships with a best mark of 23-06.00 (7.16m) ... outdoors, placed first or second in every regular season meet ... hit a personal best 26-01.75 (7.97m) wind-aided mark to win the Bob Pollack Invitational ... competed unhealthy at the SEC Outdoor Championships where he took 18th overall at 19-02.50 (5.85m) ... seventh-place finish at the NCAA East Preliminary at 25-00.00 (7.62m) and competed at the NCAA Outdoor Championships but only jumped once due to injury...competed at the US Olympic Trials.

2011: Did not compete indoors ... Outdoors, competed in two meets unattached ... had top marks of 22.97 in the 200m and 24-02.50 (7.38m) in the long jump.

Beckles is making her third NCAA Indoor Championships appearance. She will look to build off of an 11th place finish in 2010 with a time of 8.23 and 13th place finish last year at 8.24. In the finals of last year's SEC Indoor Championships, the senior tied the indoor school record with an 8.11. She shares the top spot with Olympic silver medalist Lashinda Demus. She also holds the Barbados national record with the time. Currently, Beckles, who has finished in the top five of all of her events this season, holds the seventh-best time in the nation this season at 8.17, which she set at the Tyson Invitational.

Making her first NCAA Indoor Championships appearance, this outdoor All-American will look to build on her new personal-best that she set last weekend at the VT Final Qualifier (13'11" // 4.24m). Already holding the outdoor school record, she has the indoor record within her sights. The record is currently held by Vica Shobe (2010) at 13-11 3/4 (4.25m) who set the mark at the 2010 NCAA Indoor Championships for an eighth place finish. Olsen took home the bronze from the 2013 SEC indoor Championships and has finished in the top 3 of all but one event (Armory Collegiate).

Last season's SEC Indoor Freshman Runner of the Year returns to the NCAA Indoor Championships for the second-consecutive year. Rucker currently holds the sixth-best time in the country at 52.22. She set the time in the finals of the SEC Indoor Championships, finishing fourth after Shaunae Miller of Georgia finished at 52.21. Her 52.22 is the sixth-best in South Carolina indoor history. The other nine entries in the Gamecock top 10 are all either NCAA Champions and/or Olympians. The sophomore finished 11th at the 2012 NCAA Indoor Championships.

Rucker, Olivia Ekpone, Kendall Baisden and Ashley Spencer combined to run a new World Junior leader for this year in the event

Scheper sits atop the Division I rankings this season after a clearance of 6'3 1/4 (1.91m) at the Tyson Invitational in Fayetteville. The St. Lucia native is the only women to clear 6' in Gamecock history, doing so five times in Garnet and Black and holding the indoor and outdoor school records. The two-time All American is the first high jumper in South Carolina history to earn an All-American certificate, doing so as a 17-year old sophomore last season. She became the first Gamecock athlete to win an SEC gold medal in the high jump (man or woman, indoor or outdoor).

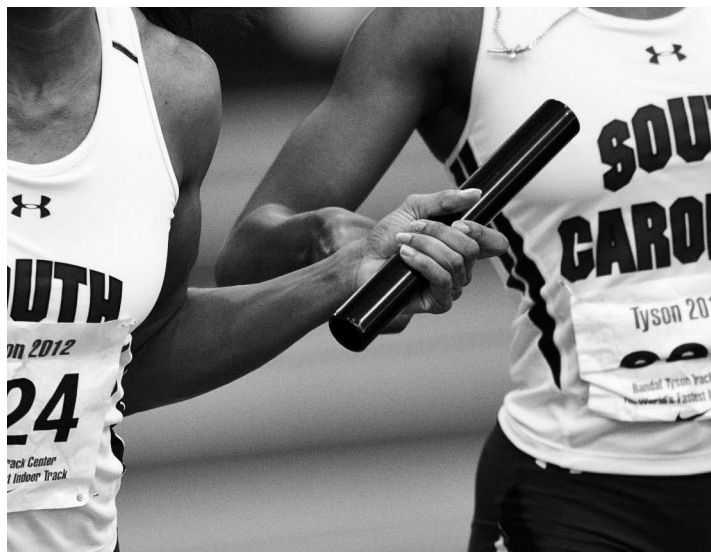

They took home the SEC silver two weeks ago with a season-best time of 3:33.68. Their time is eighth-best in the country this year. In the SEC 4x400m relay, Rucker recorded the fastest leadoff split at 52.37, besting SEC 400-meter champion Regina George's 54.37 leadoff. Their declaration marks the first South Carolina entry in the 4x400m relay at the NCAA Indoor Championships since 2010.
