GAME 4 POSTGAME NOTES

South Carolina 19, Liberty 3

South Carolina Notes

- With the win the Gamecocks improve to 41-18 on the season.
- South Carolina has now won 26-straight home games in postseason play, including a perfect 15-0 mark in Carolina Stadium. The Gamecocks are 57-8 all-time at home in postseason play.
- The 19 runs scored by the Gamecocks are the second most in postseason play in school history, falling short of the 21 scored against Florida International in the 1998 Atlantic Regional.
- The 16-run margin of victory ties the largest margin of victory in South Carolina postseason history, matching the margin from the Gamecocks' 16-0 victory over The Citadel in the 2001 Columbia Regional.
- Sophomore pitcher Jordan Montgomery struck out a career-high 11 batters to earn the win. He allowed just three hits in seven scoreless innings of work.
- Sophomore Connor Bright matched his career high in both RBIs (3) and runs scored (2).
- Sophomore Tanner English tied a season-high with three hits, marking the third time this season he has produced three hits in a game. English also hit the first home run of his career, a two-run blast in the third inning.
- Sophomore Kyle Martin tallied three hits on the night, which matches a career-high, and set a career high with four RBIs.



Liberty Notes

- With the loss Liberty falls to 35-28 on the season.
- The loss snaps the Flames' six-game winning streak, which began with a win in the second game of the Big South Tournament.
- Liberty is now 2-7 all-time in NCAA Regional play.
- The Flames will play Clemson in an elimination game on Sunday at 1 p.m. at Carolina Stadium.
