# **Gamecocks Set for Liz Murphey Collegiate Classic**

South Carolina is set to open play in its third tournament of the spring on Friday as it travels to Athens, Ga. for the 40th Annual Liz Murphey Collegiate Classic. The 54-hole event runs through Sunday at the University of Georgia Golf Course, which features a par-72, 6,335-yard layout.

#### This Week's Lineup

Carolina will be competing with its third different lineup this spring, as senior Katie Burnett, juniors Meredith Swanson and Amanda Strang and sophomores Katie Rose Higgins and Samantha Swinehart will make the trip to Athens. Freshman Justine Dreher will also compete as an individual.

Burnett, who is playing in her 34th straight tournament for the Gamecocks, has moved to first on the career scoring list at South Carolina with a stroke average of 74.37. She led Carolina with a sixthplace finish at the Darius Rucker Intercollegiate earlier this month with a two-round score of 143 (+1). As a team, the Gamecocks finished eighth. Swanson and Strang are each making their second start of the spring. Swanson enters the weekend with the third-best stroke average on the team with an average of 75.71, while Strang isn't far behind with an average of 75.76. Higgins has qualified to start for the first time since the fall, and Swinehart is making her fifth straight start.

# **Breaking Down the Field**

The Liz Murphey Classic is one of the premier events in collegiate golf, and this year's field is among the toughest yet again. Of the 17 teams competing, 13 are ranked in the Golfweek Top 50. Second-ranked Alabama headlines the field, followed by No. 7 Auburn, No. 12 Georgia, No. 16 Florida, No. 23 Michigan State, No. 25 Florida State, No. 26 Oklahoma, the 27th-ranked Gamecocks, No. 28 Virginia, No. 33 Purdue, No. 36 Arkansas, No. 40 Denver and No. 46 Wake Forest, Kent State, Notre Dame and Missouri are also competing.

### **About the Course**

The tournament will be played on the challenging par-72, 6,335-yard University of Georgia Golf Course. Carolina will look to continue its long history of success at the UGA Golf Course this weekend. In 2002, the Gamecocks claimed the program's first and only SEC Championship with a school-record three-day total of 861 at the UGA Golf Course. Kristy McPherson's 209 (-7) led the way and earned her medalist honors for the second straight season. In 2008, Benedicte Toumpsin won medalist honors at the NCAA East Regional. The Gamecocks also played in the 1993 NCAA Championship at the UGA Golf Course and finished 12th, which is the second-best championship finish in school history.

# Gamecocks Finish Eighth at Rain-Shortened Darius Rucker Intercollegiate

South Carolina shot a final-round 301 (+17) to finish in eighth place in the inaugural Darius Rucker Intercollegiate at Long Cove Club. The Gamecocks posted a two-round score of 604 (+36) for the event, which was shortened to 36 holes





after severe storms postponed the second round.

The golfers struggled to put up low numbers during all three days of competition, as only six rounds under par were posted on the weekend. Senior Katie Burnett had a stellar day to lead the Gamecocks as she recorded 14 pars, two birdies and two bogeys to card an even-par 71. Burnett wrapped up the tournament in sixth place with a two-round score of 143 (+1), which is her eighth career top-10 finish. Her weekend total also lowers her career scoring average to 74.37, which ranks first all-time at Carolina.

Dreher earned the first top-20 finish of her career as she carded a 2-over 73 to tie for 20th with a two-round score of 150 (+8). Her round consisted of three birdies, three bogeys, a double bogey and 11 pars. Sophomore Suzie Lee tied for 60th with a two-round total of 158 (+16) after carding a final-round 78 (+7), while junior Meredith Swanson and sophomore Samantha Swinehart tied for 62nd with a score of 159 (+17). Swanson shot 85 (+14) on Sunday, and Swinehart turned in a 79 (+8). Junior Amanda Strang and sophomore Katie Rose Higgins played as individuals for the Gamecocks and finished tied for 49th and tied for 68th, respectively. Strang posted an 81(+10) on Sunday, while Higgins turned in an 80 (+9).

#### Carolina Takes Seventh at UCF Challenge

On what proved to be a tough scoring day, South Carolina shot a final-round 300 (+12) at RedTail Golf Club to wrap up the UCF Challenge in seventh place with a three-round total of 889 (+25).

After several teams posted red numbers the first two days, not a single team was below par, and only four individuals carded rounds under par. Cold temperatures and windy conditions left the field battling for low numbers.

Senior Katie Burnett led the way for the Gamecocks for the second straight day as she posted a final-round 73 (+1) to move seven spots up the leaderboard to finish tied for 14th with a score of 219 (+3).

Junior Meredith Swanson, who played as an individual, carded a 76 (+4) to finish the tournament tied for 32nd with a score of 223 (+7).

Sophomore Samantha Swinehart and junior Amanda Strang finished tied for 38th with a score of 224 (+8). Swinehart carded a final-round 77 (+77), while Strang turned in a 76 (+4).

Freshman Justine Dreher bounced back from Monday's 77 to shoot a 2-over 74. She finished the tournament in a tie for 43rd with a three-round score of 225 (+9). Sophomore Suzie Lee joined Dreher in the group tied for 43rd after shooting 5-over 77.

#### **Gamecocks Wrap Up Fall at Landfall Tradition**

The South Carolina women's golf team wrapped up its fall schedule with a strong performance in the third round at the Landfall Tradition. The Gamecocks shot a 301 (+13) at the Country Club of Landfall's Jack Nicklaus Course to climb four spots to finish the event in fourth place with a score of 922 (+58). South Carolina finished 18 strokes back of tournament champion Purdue (904) and just four strokes behind second-place Auburn (918). The fourth-place showing is the Gamecocks' best this season.

South Carolina senior Katie Burnett added another top five finish to her list of career accomplishments as she shot a final-round 72 (E) to end the tournament tied for fourth with a score of 224 (+8). Burnett now has four top five finishes as a Gamecock.

Junior Amanda Strang was Carolina's next highest finisher as she shot a final-round 79 (+7) to tie for 29th with a threeday total of 233 (+17). Sophomore Samantha Swinehart posted her best round of the tournament with a 2-over 74 to tie for 34th with a score of 235 (+19). Swinehart recorded double bogey on her second hole of the day but she finished strong by playing even par the rest of the way.

Sophomore Katie Rose Higgins and junior Meredith Swanson carded rounds of 76 (+4) and 79 (+7), respectively, to tie for 39th with a score of 236 (+20).

# SEC/Pac-12 Challenge

The South Carolina women's golf team saved its best round for last at the SEC/Pac-12 Challenge as it shot a 293 (+5) in the final round at Holston Hills Country Club.

The Gamecocks improved 17 strokes from their first-round score and 12 from the second round to wrap up the tournament in 17th place with a three-day total of 908 (+44). Carolina's score was the fifth lowest of the day in the 23-team

Sophomore Samantha Swinehart posted a season-low 71 (-1) to lead the Gamecocks on the final day. She recorded three birdies, two bogeys and 13 pars to finish the tournament tied for 44th with a score of 224 (+8).

Senior Katie Burnett also tied for 44th with a score of 224 (+8) after carding a final-round 73 (+1).

Junior Amanda Strang was Carolina's next highest finisher as she shot a 76 (+4) on Sunday to finish tied for 59th with a score of 227 (+11).

Junior Meredith Swanson recorded her best round of the tournament with a 1-over 73, while sophomore Katie Rose Higgins turned in a 77 (+5). Sophomore Suzie Lee, who played as an individual, shot an 82 (+10).

#### **Tar Heel Invitational**

The South Carolina women's golf team posted a final-round 294 (+6) to finish in 11th place at the Tar Heel Invitational at the UNC Finley Golf Course. The Gamecocks concluded the tournament with a three-day score of 882 (+18).

Junior Meredith Swanson bounced back from a 79 on Saturday to lead the way for South Carolina in the final round. Swanson carded an even-par 72 and finished the tournament in a tie for 37th with a score of 222 (+6).

Senior Katie Burnett claimed the highest finished for the Gamecocks despite a final-round 78 (+6) as she tied for 21st with a score of 219 (+3).

Sophomore Suzie Lee shaved four strokes off her second-round score to shoot 1-over 73 on Sunday. Lee's three-day score of 223 (+7) left her in a tie for 44th.

Sophomore Katie Rose Higgins carded her second-consecutive round of 74 (+2) to wrap up the tournament in a tie for 55th with a score of 225 (+9), while junior Amanda Strang recorded a 75 (+3) on Sunday to tie for 73rd with a 227 (+11).

Freshman Justine Dreher played the event as an individual and turned in a final-round 77 (+5). Dreher, whose round of 68 on Saturday was the lowest round ever by a South Carolina freshman, finished the tournament in a tie for 37th with a score of 222 (+6).

# **Cougar Classic**

South Carolina had three golfers post scores under par in the final round of the Cougar Classic on its way to setting the record for the lowest round in school history with a 279 (-9) at Yeamans Hall Club. The Gamecocks finished the tournament with a three-round total of 869 (+5) to claim 10th place in the 22-team field.

South Carolina's score of 279 broke the previous school record by three strokes, which was set in the second round of the 2002 Southeastern Conference Championship. It also tied for the second lowest round in Cougar Classic history. The Gamecocks' tournament total was the fourth best 54-hole total in program history.

Sophomore Katie Rose Higgins posted South Carolina's lowest score of the round with a career-best 67 (-5), tying Burnett and three former Gamecocks for the third lowest round in school history. Higgins' three-round total of 221 (+5) left her in a tie for 44th

After posting a career-low 69 in the second round, South Carolina junior Meredith Swanson was at it again on Tuesday. Swanson fired the ninth-best round in Gamecock history with a 4-under 68. She finished the tournament in a tie for 12th with a three-day score of 214 (-2), which is tied for the 10th best 54-hole total in school history.

Senior Katie Burnett finished in the top 10 for the eighth time in her career as her final-round 74 (+2) moved her into a tie for ninth with a three-day total of 213 (-3). Burnett's 54-hole score is tied for the eighth best in program history.

South Carolina's third round under par came from junior Amanda Strang, who carded a 2-under 70 for her lowest round of the tournament.

Sophomore Samantha Swinehart turned in her best round of the event with a 74 (+2). After making three birdies in the first two rounds combined, Swinehart recorded three in the third round to go along with five bogeys and 10 pars.

# **Burnett Among Gamecock's Best**

Senior Katie Burnett, who has not missed a lineup in her Gamecock career, is in her final season in garnet and black with her name already scattered around the South Carolina record books. Burnett's career stroke average of 74.37 is currently the best all-time, while her 2009-10 stroke average of 73.58 is tied for second in school history.

Burnett's 72-hole total of 286 at the 2010 NCAA Championship ranks first all-time. Her 54-hole total of 210 is the third best score in program history, while her 36-hole score of 142 is tied for first all-time. She is also tied for first in lowest score (66), first round score (67) and second in both second round score (67) and third round score (69).
