### DICK'S Collegiate Challenge Cup Begins Friday

The South Carolina men's golf team opens play in its third tournament of the fall season on Friday at the DICK'S Sporting Goods Collegiate Challenge Cup. The unique event, which features stroke play and match play, runs through Sunday at the par-71, 7,184-yard layout at The Golf Club of Tennessee in Kingston Springs, Tenn.

### The Lineup

- **Junior Will Starke:** Team-best 70.67 stroke average...Tied for fourth at Carpet Capital Collegiate...Finished in top 15 of both tournaments.
- **Senior Will Murphy:** 72.00 stroke average...Tied for eighth at Carpet Capital Collegiate following final-round 66 (-6).
- **Junior Matt NeSmith:** 72.00 stroke average...Tied for 18th at Carpet Capital Collegiate.
- **Sophomore Ben Dietrich:** 72.33 stroke average...Tied for 32nd at Carpet Capital Collegiate.
- **Senior Caleb Sturgeon:** 72.00 stroke average...Tied for 41st at Carpet Capital Collegiate.

### About the DICK'S Collegiate Challenge Cup

The DICK'S Sporting Goods Collegiate Challenge Cup is in its second year and is hosted by the Nashville Sports Council. The field is made up of six teams from the SEC and six from the ACC. A team and individual champion will be crowned following 36 holes of stroke play on Friday and 18 on Saturday. On Sunday the teams will play in the Conference Challenge. Each team from the SEC will face a team from the ACC in match play, and the conference that accumulates the most points wins.

### Breaking Down the Field

For the third straight tournament, the Gamecocks will be competing against one of the strongest fields in the country. Of the 12 teams attending, nine were ranked in the top 50 of the final Golfstat Rankings last season, including five in the top 25. Georgia returns to defend its 2013 Collegiate Cup Challenge. The Bulldogs won last year's stroke play portion with a total of 832 (-20) and helped lead the SEC to the match play title. Missouri, Ole Miss, Texas A&M and Vanderbilt join the Gamecocks and Bulldogs to make up the SEC contingent. Georgia Tech headlines the ACC field as the defending conference champion. Rival Clemson, Duke, Louisville, North Carolina State and Virginia will also represent the ACC. South Carolina has a 2-2 head-to-head record against teams in the field this season.

### Keeping it in the 72s

All five golfers in the South Carolina lineup this weekend have a season stroke average of below 73. Junior Will Starke leads the way with an average of 70.67, followed by senior Will Murphy (72.00), senior Caleb Sturgeon (72.00), junior Matt NeSmith (72.00) and sophomore Ben Dietrich (72.33). Last season four Gamecocks - Starke, NeSmith, Murphy and Sturgeon - wrapped up the year with a stroke average in the 72s,

which is the first time of record that has happened in school history.

### Making it a Habit

The Gamecocks have finished third or better in eight of their last 11 regular-season tournaments dating back to last season, including four tournament wins. Carolina reeled off a school-record seven-straight top-three finishes during the regular season last year.

### Gamecocks in the Golfstat Statistics Rankings

As a team South Carolina ranks 24th in the nation in average score (71.97) and 15th versus par (-0.03). The Gamecocks are 10th in par-4 scoring (4.02), second in eagles (7) and third in birdies (109).

Junior Will Starke is tied for first in the nation in Eagles with three on the season. Starke recorded all three at the Carpet Capital Collegiate, where he finished tied for fourth.

Senior Will Murphy is tied for 17th nationally in birdies with 23.

### 2014-15 Tournament Recaps Carpet Capital Collegiate

The 12th-ranked South Carolina men's golf team captured its first team title of the season after firing a final-round 276 (-12) at the Carpet Capital Collegiate at The Farm Golf Club.

The Gamecocks, who were three strokes off the lead heading into the round, wrapped up the weekend with a 54-hole total of 848 (-16) to win its first Carpet Capital Collegiate title in 24 appearances against one of the strongest fields in collegiate golf. The Gamecocks made their comeback after an incredible back nine as all five golfers in the lineup combined to shoot 10-under.

Senior Will Murphy led the charge up the leaderboard as he fired a 6-under 66, which matches his career low. A native of Columbia, S.C., Murphy finished the weekend tied for eighth with a total of 211 (-5).

Junior Will Starke was the highest Gamecock finisher, tying for fourth place with a total of 209 (-7) after shooting a 69 (-3) on Sunday. Junior Matt NeSmith posted a final-round 68 (-4) to finish in a tie for 18th with a total of 214 (-2).

Sophomore Ben Dietrich tied for 32nd with a total of 218 (+2) after shooting a 73 (+1) on Sunday, while senior Caleb Sturgeon and junior Sean Kelly finished tied for 41st with a total of 219 (+3). Sturgeon shot a 74 (+2) on Sunday, and Kelly carded a 76 (+4).

Georgia Tech finished runner-up with a total of 849 (-15), followed by Auburn (852), Kennesaw State (852) and defending national champion Alabama (853). Georgia Tech's Ollie Schniederjans won medalist honors with a total of 204 (-12).

### The Carmel Cup

The South Carolina men's golf team posted a final-round 365 (+5) to finish in sixth place at The Carmel Cup at the Pebble Beach Golf Links.

The Gamecocks wrapped up the weekend with a 54-hole total of 1,079 (-1), with five scores counting all three days. Georgia won with a total of 1,063 (-17), followed by Vanderbilt (1,068), TCU (1,074), Texas Tech (1,075) and Oklahoma (1,075).

Senior Caleb Sturgeon led the way for Carolina, recording his ninth career top-10 finish as he tied for 10th with a total of 213 (-3) after shooting a 74 (+2) on Sunday.

Junior Will Starke carded the lowest round of the day for the Gamecocks as he turned in a 1-under 71 to finish tied for 13th with a total of 215 (-1). Sophomore Ben Dietrich tied for 15th with a total of 216 (E), following a round of 74 (+2) on Sunday. Junior Matt NeSmith carded a final-round 75 (+3) to finish tied for 26th with a total of 218 (+2), while senior Will Murphy and junior Sean Kelly both finished tied for 29th with a total of 221 (+5). Murphy turned in an even-par 72, and Kelly shot a 74 (+2) on Sunday.

Vanderbilt's Hunter Stewart claimed medalist honors with a total of 205 (-11).

### A Top 25 Program

Under the guidance of head coach Bill McDonald, South Carolina has consistently been ranked in the top 25 of several polls the last two years. The Gamecocks ended last year ranked No. 14 in the final Golfstat Rankings, No. 21 in the final regular-season Golf World/Nike Coaches Poll and No. 20 in the Golfweek Rankings. Carolina

was ranked No. 12 in this year's GCAA Preseason Coaches Poll, No. 7 in Golfweek's countdown of the Top 30 Division I programs and came in at No. 5 in the Golf Channel's Preseason Top 10.

### **Climbing the Record Book**

Senior Caleb Sturgeon and Will Murphy and junior Matt NeSmith continue to climb up South Carolina's career scoring average list. NeSmith currently ranks second all-time with an average of 72.42, while Sturgeon ranks fourth with an average of 73.00 and Murphy is 10th with an average of 73.28.

### **A Look Back at the 2013-14 Season**

The 2013-14 season was a special year for the South Carolina men's golf program. The Gamecocks finished ninth at the NCAA Championship, which is the second-best finish at the national championship in program history. During the regular season, Carolina matched the school record with nine top-five finishes in 12 events, including three tournament wins. At one point during the season, the Gamecocks reeled off a school-record seven straight top-three finishes. Four Gamecocks wrapped up the season with a stroke average below 73, the first time of record that has happened in school history.

### **Among the Best in the World**

South Carolina senior Will Murphy and junior Matt NeSmith are ranked in the top 100 in the latest Golfweek/AmateurGolf.com World Player Rankings. Murphy is No. 8 in the world and No. 2 in the U.S., while NeSmith is No. 195 in the world and No. 86 in the U.S.

In the Scratch Players World Amateur Rankings, Murphy is ranked No. 42, and NeSmith is No. 92.

### **Roster Breakdown**

South Carolina's roster is made up of 10 golfers, including two true freshmen, one sophomore, four juniors and three seniors. Seven of the 10 golfers are from the Palmetto state, with the other three hailing from Georgia, New York and Pennsylvania. A total of six golfers have NCAA Championship experience.

### **Gamecock Accolades in 2013-14**

The Gamecocks received several individual and team accolades last season. Will Murphy earned PING Honorable Mention All-America honors. Matt NeSmith was named to the PING All-Southeast Region Team and was a second-team All-SEC selection. Caleb Sturgeon was named a Cleveland Golf/Srixon All-America Scholar. Ben Dietrich made the SEC Community Service Team. As a team, the Gamecocks earned GCAA All-Academic Team Honors.
