#### Gamecocks Aim For Win No. 4 at Hootie at Bulls Bay

The South Carolina men's golf team will look to win its fourth tournament title of the season as it opens play in the Hootie at Bulls Bay Intercollegiate on Sunday in Awendaw, S.C. The 54-hole event runs through Tuesday at the par-72, 7,282-yard Bulls Bay Golf Club.

#### The Lineup

In the only three tournaments head coach Bill McDonald has used a lineup with juniors Caleb Sturgeon and Will Murphy, sophomores Matt NeSmith and Will Starke and freshman Ben Dietrich, the Gamecocks have come home with a tournament title. After winning with those five golfers last week, Carolina will field the same five in Awendaw, with Starke at No. 1, NeSmith at No. 2, Murphy at No. 3, Sturgeon at No. 4 and Dietrich at No. 5.

#### History at Hootie at Bulls Bay Intercollegiate

South Carolina helped organize the inaugural event in 2005 and is making its 10th-straight appearance at the tournament. The Gamecocks have four top-five appearances their nine previous trips to Awendaw, including runner-up finishes in 2006 and 2008. South Carolina's best individual finisher at the event was George Bryan IV, who claimed second in 2009 with a total of 201 (-12).

#### Last Time at Hootie at Bulls Bay Intercollegiate: March 24-26, 2013

The Gamecocks claimed ninth place at last year's Hootie at Bulls Bay Intercollegiate with a total of 905 (+41). Matt NeSmith led the way with a tie for seventh finish, posting a total of 219 (+3). Will Murphy and Caleb Sturgeon, who are both in the lineup again this year, finished tied for 58th and tied for 67th, respectively.

#### Breaking Down the Field

Of the 15 teams in this week's field, five are ranked in the Golfstat Top 50, including the Gamecocks at No. 24. Virginia is the highest-ranked team at No. 10. The Cavaliers have finished runner-up twice this season and won the Bank of Tennessee Intercollegiate in October. No. 30 Auburn, No. 36 Kentucky and No. 39 Wake Forest are also ranked in the top 50, while USC Aiken is the fifth-ranked team in Division II. Akron, Charleston Southern, College of Charleston, Duke, GRU Augusta, Mississippi, North Carolina, North Carolina State and Wake Forest round out the field. The Gamecocks have a 10-4 head-to-head record this season against teams in this field.

#### What They've Done So Far

- Sophomore Will Starke: Won first collegiate event at the Seahawk Intercollegiate with a total of 137 (-7), the fifth-lowest 36-hole total in school history...Shot a career-low 64 (-8) in the first round, which is tied for the third lowest round in school history...Produced second top-five finish in three events with a tie for fifth showing at the Palmetto Intercollegiate...Tied for 36th at the Bayou City Collegiate Championships...Turned in second top-five finish of the season, tying for fourth at the Wendy's Kiawah Classic...Has three top-five finishes for his career...Tied for 18th at the Badger Invitational...Tied for 37th at the Rees Jones Invitational...Posted a 2-under 214 to finish in a tie for fifth at the season-opening Carpet Capital Collegiate...Ranks second on the team with a stroke average of 72.55.

- Junior Caleb Sturgeon: Tied for 18th at the Seahawk Intercollegiate, his 14th career top-20 finish...Just missed top-20 finish at the Palmetto Intercollegiate, tying for 23rd...Tied for 33rd at the Bayou City Collegiate Championships...Finished tied for 13th at the Wendy's Kiawah Classic...Won second career tournament title, claiming medalist honors at the Badger Invitational with a total of 206 (-10)...Has four career top-five finishes and 13 top-20 showings...Tied for 14th at the Rees Jones Invitational...Tied for 41st at the Carpet Capital Collegiate to open the season...Third on the team with a stroke average of 72.75...Career average of 73.06 is currently fourth best all-time at South Carolina.

- Freshman Ben Dietrich: Recorded first career top-10 finish in a team event, tying for 10th at the Seahawk Intercollegiate...Tied for seventh at the Savannah Quarters Intercollegiate, an individual only event...Recorded first-career top-20 finish, tying for 12th at the Wendy's Kiawah Classic...Tied for 44th at the Badger Invitational...Made collegiate debut at the Rees Jones Invitational as an individual...Finished tied for 33rd...Has a stroke average of 74.62.

### Starke Named SEC Golfer of the Week

South Carolina sophomore Will Starke was named this week's SEC Golfer of the Week after winning medalist honors and leading the Gamecocks to the team title at the Seahawk Intercollegiate last week. His total of 137 (-7) is the fifth-lowest 36-hole total in school history, and it included an opening-round 64, which is tied for the third lowest round in school history. As a team, the Gamecocks score of 560 (-16) is the third best 36-hole total in school history. On the season, Starke ranks second on the team with a stroke average of 72.55 and has four top-five finishes.

### Going for Four and Seven

The Gamecocks will be looking to win their fourth tournament title of the season and earn their seventh-straight finish of third or better this week at the Hootie at Bulls Bay Intercollegiate. A fourth win would tie the school record for wins in a season, matching the 1990-91 and 2008-09 teams. The Gamecocks are just the fourth team to win three tournaments in a season, joining the 1981-82, 2003-04 and 2008-09 squads. A seventh-straight top-three finish would break the school record for the best stretch in school history, surpassing the 1998-99 team's streak of six straight.

### Par-3s Not a Problem

Junior Caleb Sturgeon has been among the best in the nation on par-3 holes this season. Sturgeon currently ranks tied for 10th nationally in par-3 scoring with an average of 3.00.

### Getting Below Par

As a team, South Carolina is tied for 13th nationally in subpar strokes per round with an average of 3.41.

### Race for the Golfstat Cup

Sophomore Matt NeSmith and juniors Will Starke and Caleb Sturgeon are listed in the latest standings for the Golfstat Cup, which will be awarded to the golfer with the lowest adjusted scoring average among all divisions (DI, DII, DIII, NAIA, JUCO) at the end of the season. NeSmith ranks 56th with an adjusted average of 73.66, while Starke is 123rd with an adjusted average of 74.94. Sturgeon ranks 156th with an average of 75.36. Western Carolina's J.T. Poston leads the way with an average of 69.90.

### 2013-14 Tournament Recaps

#### Seahawk Intercollegiate

The South Carolina men's golf team won its third tournament title of the season by 19 strokes after the final round of the Seahawk Intercollegiate was canceled due to inclement weather at the Country Club of Landfall.

The Gamecocks finished the event with a two-round total of 560 (-16), which is the third-best 36-hole total in school history.

Sophomore Will Starke also brought home some hardware as he claimed is first collegiate title with a total of 137 (-7), including a career-low 64 in the opening round on Sunday. Starke's total is the fifth-lowest 36-hole total in school history.

The remainder of the Gamecocks in the lineup recorded top-20 finishes. Sophomore Matt NeSmith earned his sixth career top-five finish, claiming third with a total of 139 (-5). Junior Will Murphy also placed in the top-five, finishing fourth with a total of 140 (-4). Freshman Ben Dietrich tied for 10th with a total of 144 (E), while junior Caleb Sturgeon tied for 18th with a score of 146 (+2).

### Bayou City Collegiate Championships

The 25th-ranked South Carolina men's golf team opened the spring in strong fashion by claiming third place at the Bayou City Collegiate Championships at the Golf Club of Houston.

The Gamecocks fired an 8-under 280 in the final round to wrap up the event with a total of 851 (-13). Tournament host Houston claimed the team title with a total of 833 (-31), while Texas finished runner-up with a score of 841 (-23).

South Carolina has now finished third or better in four straight events, including two wins. It matches last year's stretch of four consecutive top-three finishes as the most by a Gamecock team since finishing third or better in six straight events during the spring schedule of 1999.

Juniors Will Murphy and Caleb Sturgeon and sophomores Matt NeSmith and Will Starke all carded a 2-under 70 for the Gamecocks on Sunday, while junior Blaine Woodruff closed out the weekend with a 74 (+2).

NeSmith, Woodruff and Murphy all just missed out on a top-20 finish as they tied for 21st with totals of 215 (-1). Sturgeon tied for 33rd with a total of 216 (E), and Starke tied for 36th with a score of 217 (+1).

### Badger Invitational

The South Carolina men's golf team closed out its fall schedule in dominant fashion, claiming its second-straight Wendy's Kiawah Classic title by 22 strokes at Turtle Point Golf Club.

The Gamecocks, who won last year's tournament by 20 strokes, posted a final-round 295 (+7) to finish the week with a three-round total of 864 (E) to secure their second-consecutive tournament title of the fall. It marks the first time the program has won consecutive events since winning the Turtle Bay Intercollegiate (11/4/03) and the Mercedes-Benz Collegiate Championship (2/10/04) back-to-back during the 2003-04 season.

Four out of the five golfers in South Carolina's lineup finished the week in the top 15, with sophomore Matt NeSmith leading the way. The North Augusta, S.C., native fired a final-round 68 (-4) to finish runner-up with a total of 212 (-4). Sophomore Will Starke (T-4th), freshman Ben Dietrich (12th) and junior Caleb Sturgeon (T-13th) also finished the week in the top 15. Junior Will Murphy just missed a top-20 finish as he tied for 21st.

Starke recorded his third career top-five showing as he shot a 77 (+5) on Tuesday to finish tied for fourth with a total of 216 (E).

Dietrich carded a final-round 74 (+2) to earn his first career top-20 finish with a total of 220 (+4). A native of Laurens, S.C., Sturgeon posted a 77 (+5) on Tuesday to finish the event with a total of 221 (+5). Murphy turned in a final-round 76 (+4) to conclude the week with a score of 223 (+7), missing out on his seventh career top-20 finish by a stroke. Senior Alan King, who made his Gamecock debut as an individual, finished tied for 76th with a total of 237 (+21) after shooting a final-round 85 (+13).

### Badger Invitational

The South Carolina men's golf team posted a final-round 291 (+3) to cruise to a 24-stroke victory at the Badger Invitational on Tuesday at University Ridge Golf Course.

The Gamecocks led wire-to-wire and wrapped up the week with a 54-hole total of 856 (-8) to pull away from the field for the win. Junior Caleb Sturgeon also captured medalist honors for the second time in his career after firing a 3-under 69 in the final round. He posted a total of 206 (-10) to become the 11th golfer in school history to win

multiple tournament titles.

A native of Laurens, S.C., Sturgeon now has four career top-five finishes, just one shy of breaking into the top-10 in school history. Sturgeon's closest competitor was also wearing Garnet and Black, as NeSmith carded a 73 (+1) to finish runner-up with a total of 212 (-4). NeSmith also has four top-five finishes for his career and has placed in the top 10 in six of the last seven regular-season tournaments dating back to last spring.

Sophomore Will Starke recorded his fourth career top-20 finish as he shot a final-round 72 (E) to tie for 18th with a total of 222 (+6), while junior Will Murphy finished just outside the top 20 in a tie for 25th with a total of 224 (+8) after shooting an 81 (+9) on Tuesday. Rounding out the lineup, freshman Ben Dietrich turned in a 77 (+5) to tie for 44th with a total of 228 (+12).

Kansas finished runner-up with a total of 880 (+16), followed by Illinois State (883), USC Upstate (+22) and Austin Peay (+27).

### Rees Jones Invitational

The South Carolina men's golf team came up short of claiming its third Rees Jones Invitational title as it shot a final-round 299 (+11) to finish in a tie for second at Haig Point Club. The Gamecocks, who have never placed worse than third at the event, finished tied with South Florida with a three-round total of 887 (+23) to fall two shots shy of tournament champion Kennesaw State. The Owls captured their third Rees Jones Invitational trophy with a total of 885 (+21).

The final day proved to be the toughest, as the average score rose to 78.16 with winds gusting as high as 20 miles per hour. South Carolina fought through the conditions to place three golfers in the top 15. Sophomore Matt NeSmith was the highest Gamecock on the leaderboard as he finished in a tie for fourth with a total of 218 (+2) after shooting a 74 (+2) on Tuesday.

Junior Will Murphy carded the lowest round of the day for the Gamecocks, shooting a 1-over 73 to finish in a tie for sixth with a total of 219 (+3). Junior Caleb Sturgeon posted a final-round 77 (+5) to record his second-straight top-15 finish at Haig Point with a total of 222 (+6). Sophomore Will Starke tied for 33rd with a total of 231 (+15) after turning in a 75 (+3) in the final round, while junior Blaine Woodruff shot an 80 (+8) to tie for 48th with a total of 235 (+19). Playing as an individual in his first collegiate event, freshman Ben Dietrich finished in a tie for 33rd with a total of 229 (+13) after carding an 81 (+9).

### Carpet Capital Collegiate

The South Carolina men's golf team shot a final-round 297 (+9) at The Farm Golf Club to finish in 10th place at the Carpet Capital Collegiate. The Gamecocks wrapped up the weekend with a three-round total of 888 (+24).

Continuing his solid play from the first two rounds, sophomore Will Starke recorded his second career top-five finish as he fired a 2-under 70 to conclude the tournament in a tie for fifth with a total of 214 (-2). A native of Chapin, S.C., Starke carded a team-best seven birdies to go with three bogeys and a double bogey. After shooting 1-over 37 on the front side, he bogeyed the 10th hole to start the back nine before playing the final eight holes at 4-under.

Junior Caleb Sturgeon, who posted a 76 (+4) on Sunday, was the next Gamecock on the leaderboard as he concluded the tournament in a tie for 41st with a total of 224 (+8). He recorded a pair of birdies, three bogeys and a triple bogey on the afternoon.

Sophomore Matt NeSmith turned in a 78 (+6) on Sunday to tie for 45th with a total of 225 (+9), while junior Will Murphy tied for 48th with a total of 226 (+10) after shooting a final-round 74 (+2). Rounding out the lineup, junior Blaine Woodruff shot a 77 (+5) to tie for 62nd with a total of 230 (+14).

### Be on the Lookout

Sophomore Matt NeSmith, a PING Honorable Mention All-American last season, was listed among Golf World's top 50 male golfers to watch during the 2013-14 season. NeSmith recorded seven top-10 finishes a year ago.
