### **Gamecocks Travel To Tar Heel Invitational**

The South Carolina women's golf team has played one of the toughest schedules in the country so far this season, and the difficult stretch will continue on Friday at the Tar Heel Invitational in Chapel Hill, N.C. The Gamecocks open play Friday morning at the par-72, 6,285-yard UNC Finley Golf Course and will wrap up the event on Sunday. The 18-team field features 13 squads ranked in the Golfstat Top 50.

### The Lineup

After finishing 18th last week at the NCAA Fall Preview, the Gamecocks will look to bounce back with the same lineup in Chapel Hill. Senior Meredith Swanson, juniors Samantha Swinehart and Suzie Lee, sophomore Justine Dreher and freshman Sarah Schmelzel will be making their third straight appearance this season. South Carolina was also allotted an individual spot for the tournament and will send freshman Chelsey Couch onto the course for her collegiate debut.

### History At The Tar Heel Invitational

The Gamecocks are making their eighth straight appearance at the Tar Heel Invitational and their 25th overall. South Carolina finished 11th at last year's tournament, as Katie Burnett led the way with a tie for 21st finish with rounds of 68-73-78=219 (+3). The program's best finish in Chapel Hill was a third-place showing in 1998.

#### Breaking Down the Field

The 18-team field features 13 ranked in the Golfstat Top 50, including three in the top 10. No. 4 Florida highlights the field, which includes seven teams from the SEC. Arkansas, Auburn, Kentucky, LSU and Mississippi make up the rest of the SEC contingent. Baylor, Colorado, Duke, Louisville, Michigan, Michigan State, host North Carolina, North Carolina State, UCF, Virginia and Wake Forest round out the field.

### **Recapping The 2011 Tar Heel Invitational**

South Carolina posted a final-round 294 (+6) to finish in 11th place at the Tar Heel Invitational at the UNC Finley Golf Course. The Gamecocks concluded the tournament with a three-day score of 882 (+18).

Meredith Swanson bounced back from a 79 in the second round to lead the way for South Carolina in the final round. Swanson carded an even-par 72 and finished the tournament in a tie for 37th with a score of 222 (+6).

Katie Burnett claimed the highest finished for the Gamecocks despite a final-round 78 (+6) as she tied for 21st with a score of 219 (+3)

Suzie Lee shaved four strokes off her second-round score to shoot 1-over 73. Lee's three-day score of 223 (+7) left her in a tie for 44th.

Katie Rose Higgins carded her second-consecutive round of 74 (+2) to wrap up the tournament in a tie for 55th with a score of 225 (+9), while junior Amanda Strang recorded a 75 (+3) on Sunday to the for 73rd with a 227 (+11).

Justine Dreher played the event as an individual and turned in a final-round 77 (+5). Dreher, whose round of 68 on Saturday was the lowest round ever by a South Carolina freshman, finished the tournament in a tie for 37th with a score of 222 (+6).





#### The Tougher The Better

South Carolina enters the weekend with the third toughest schedule in the country according to Golfweek. The Gamecocks have competed against 31 top 50 teams in two tournaments this season and will face 13 more at the Tar Heel Invitational.

#### Unfreshmanlike

Freshman Sarah Schmelzel has been the Gamecocks' most consistent golfer this season. She was South Carolina's top finisher in its first two tournaments, including a tie for 20th showing last week at the NCAA Fall Preview. Schmelzel, who leads the team with a 73.17 stroke average, has climbed to No. 59 in the Golfstat player rankings.

#### NCAA Fall Preview Recap

South Carolina wrapped up play at the NCAA Fall Preview, posting a final-round 309 (+47) at the University of Georgia Golf Course.

Competing against one of the most elite fields in collegiate golf this season with 15 teams in the Golfstat Top 50, the Gamecocks finished 18th with a three-day total of 911 (+47). The tournament served as a preview of the 2013 NCAA Championship, as the top 10 teams from last year's championship and eight more teams with high rankings made the trip to Athens.

The Gamecocks played one golfer short, as junior Suzie Lee withdrew prior to the round with an injury. Freshman Sarah Schmelzel carded the low round for South Carolina for the third straight day with a 2-over 74. A native of Phoenix, Ariz., Schmelzel recorded her first career top-20 finish as she tied for 20th with a total of 220 (+4).

Sophomore Justine Dreher turned in a final-round 76 (+4) to finish the tournament in a tie for 45th with a score of 227 (+11). Junior Samantha Swinehart was the next Gamecock on the leaderboard as she shot a 78 (+6) to tie for 61st with a total of 230 (+14). Senior Meredith Swanson placed 79th with a score of 236 (+20) after shooting an 81 (+9) on Sunday.

### **Cougar Classic Recap**

The South Carolina women's golf team put together its best round of the Cougar Classic, posting a final-round 294 (+6) at Yeamans Hall Club.

The Gamecocks wrapped up the event with a three-round total of 899 (+35) as they moved six spots up the leaderboard to finish in 16th place.

After shooting only one round of par or better the first two days, Carolina finished strong, recording two rounds of even par and narrowly missing on a third 72. Freshman Sarah Schmelzel helped lead the way with her second straight 72. Junior Samantha Swinehart also carded a 72, and sophomore Justine Dreher turned in a 1-over 73.

Schmelzel proved to be the Gamecocks' most steady player at the event, shooting rounds of 75-72-72=219 (+3). She climbed 12 spots up the leaderboard to finish in a tie for 30th. For the third straight day, Schmelzel did not make worse than a bogey as she produced four birdies, four bogeys and 10 pars.

Swinehart bounced back from consecutive rounds of 77 with a 72 on the final day. A native of Lancaster, Ohio, Swinehart tied for 65th with a total of 226 (+10). After recording just one birdie in the first two rounds, she tallied five in the final round to go along with five bogeys and eight pars.

Dreher finished in a tie for 78th with a score of 228 (+12), recording three birdies, four bogeys and 11 pars for her round.

Junior Suzie Lee and senior Meredith Swanson each carded a 5-over 77. Lee tied for 71st with a total of 227 (+11), and Swanson concluded the tournament in a tie for 100th with a score of 232 (+16).

#### Among the Elite

South Carolina head coach Kalen Harris has built a force to be reckoned with in both the SEC and on a national level. Under her guidance, the Gamecocks have won two NCAA East Regional titles and advanced to four NCAA Championships. Last season Carolina finished fifth at the NCAA Championship, which is the best ever by a Gamecock squad at the event.

#### **Busy Summer**

The Gamecocks had yet another successful summer in 2012 with several golfers performing at a high level in events across the country. Senior Meredith Swanson and junior Samantha Swinehart teamed up to take second place at the Pure Silk Collegiate Team Championship. Swinehart and freshman Sarah Schmelzel played at the U.S. Amateur, and Swinehart advanced to the match play portion. Sophomore Justine Dreher advanced to match play at the British Ladies' Amateur Championship.
