Gamecocks Head South to Tallahassee

The eighth-ranked South Carolina men's golf team is set to play for the second time this week as it will tee off in the Seminole Intercollegiate on Friday in Tallahassee, Fla. The 54-hole event runs through Sunday at Southwood Golf Club, which has a par-72, 7,172-yard layout.

History at the Seminole Intercollegiate

The Gamecocks are making their sixth appearance at the Seminole Intercollegiate and their first since 2010. Carolina has finished no worse than sixth in five previous appearances and won the event in 1999. Individually, Kyle Thompson claimed medalist honors at the 1999 Seminole Intercollegiate, and Paul Woodbury won the 2010 event in a four-hole playoff.

Last Time at the Seminole - March 12-14, 2010

The Gamecocks claimed second place, finishing one stroke back of host Florida State with a total of 866 (+14). Paul Woodbury claimed medalist honors in a playoff, winning on the fourth playoff hole. He wrapped up the event with a total of 212 (-1).

Breaking Down the Field

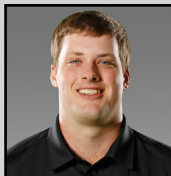
This year's Seminole Intercollegiate features a 17-team field, with nine teams ranked in the top 50 of the latest Golfstat Relative Rankings. Host Florida State enters the tournament ranked No. 2 with three tournament victories on the year. Georgia Tech is ranked No. 7 with two tournament wins, while the Gamecocks are ranked No. 8 with four victories. Ninth-ranked South Florida, No. 23 Virginia, No. 38 Florida, No. 40 Troy, No. 43 Louisville, and No. 50 East Tennessee State round out the teams ranked in the top 50. Cincinnati, George Washington, Illinois State, Jacksonville, James Madison, Mercer, Penn State and Western Kentucky make up the rest of the field. Carolina has a 5-2 head-to-head record this season against teams in this week's field.

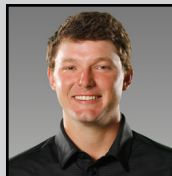

Winning Ways

The Gamecocks captured their fourth tournament title of the season with a one-stroke victory over rival Clemson at the Palmetto Intercollegiate with a total of 825 (-15). The four tournament victories match a school record for most wins in a single season. The 1990-91 and 2008-09 Carolina teams also recorded four tournament wins.

Streaking into the Record Books

The Gamecocks became the first team in Carolina history to win three straight tournaments with their victory at the Palmetto Intercollegiate. Carolina won the Camden Collegiate Invitational to close out the fall and opened the spring with a win at the Bayou City Collegiate Championship before winning in Aiken this week.

Making it a Habit

The Gamecocks have finished in the top five in 14 of their last 17 tournaments dating back to last season, including seven tournament wins. Carolina matched the school record for top-five finishes in a single season last year with nine, including three wins.

Career Year

Junior Will Starke is playing some of the best golf of his career this season as he has finished in the top 15 in all six events, including five top fives and a tournament win, and he won his match against Virginia's Ji Soo Park. His five top-five finishes are tied for the second most in a single season in school history with David Seawell (1993-94), Carl Paulson (1992-93) and Webb Heintzelman (1983-84). Starke has also shot in the 60s in 12 of his last 14 rounds and has only carded three rounds above par this season (73-73-78).

League Leaders

The Gamecocks enter the weekend leading the SEC in team scoring average (281.93) and tournament wins (4). Carolina also has a league best four golfers in the top 10 in the SEC in scoring average, as Will Starke is second (69.61), Matt NeSmith is fourth (70.94), Will Murphy is eighth (71.87) and Caleb Sturgeon is 10th (71.94).

McDonald's 13

Gamecock head coach Bill McDonald is the winningest coach by tournament victories in school history with 13. McDonald broke the previous record of nine held by Puggy Blackmon (1995-2007) with Carolina's win at the Carpet Capital Collegiate this fall. The Gamecocks then gave McDonald his 11th tournament title with a win at the Camden Collegiate Invitational to close out the fall. Carolina opened the spring by winning the Bayou City Collegiate Championship and then won the Palmetto Intercollegiate this week.

A Top 25 Program

Under the guidance of head coach Bill McDonald, South Carolina has consistently been ranked in the top 25 of several polls the last two years. The Gamecocks ended last year ranked No. 14 in the final Golfstat Rankings, No. 21 in the final regular-season Golf World/Nike Coaches Poll and No. 20 in the Golfweek Rankings. Carolina is currently ranked No. 8 in the Golfstat Relative Rankings, No. 14 in the Golf Coaches Association of America Coaches Poll and No. 14 in the Golfweek/Sagarin Rankings.

Keeping it Low

Five Gamecocks currently have stroke averages in the 72s or lower. Junior Will Starke leads the way with an average of 69.61, followed by junior Matt NeSmith (70.94), senior Will Murphy (71.87), senior Caleb Sturgeon (71.94) and junior Sean Kelly (72.67). Last season Starke, NeSmith, Murphy and Sturgeon wrapped up the year with a stroke average in the 72s, which is the first time of record four golfers have done that in school history.

Gamecocks in the Golfstat Statistics Rankings

As a team South Carolina ranks fourth in the nation in average score (71.60) and sixth versus par (+0.41). The Gamecocks are 15th in par-3 scoring (3.14), sixth in par-4 scoring (4.06) and 14th in par-5 scoring (4.76). Carolina is tied for 13th in eagles (13) and 16th in subpar strokes per round (3.34).

Individually, junior Will Starke ranks ninth nationally in scoring average (69.61), 12th versus par (-1.56), eighth in par-5 scoring (4.54) and tied for 13th in subpar strokes per round (4.61).

Rewriting the Record Book

Seniors Caleb Sturgeon and Will Murphy and juniors Will Starke and Matt NeSmith continue to climb up South Carolina's career scoring average list. Starke currently ranks first all-time with an average of 72.03, while NeSmith isn't far behind in second with an average of 72.15. Sturgeon ranks fifth all-time with an average of 72.89, while Murphy is eighth with an average of 73.14.

Starke also has 10 career top-five finishes, which ranks fourth all-time at Carolina. NeSmith is tied for the seventh most career top-five finishes with seven.

A Look Back at the 2013-14 Season

The 2013-14 season was a special year for the South Carolina men's golf program. The Gamecocks finished ninth at the NCAA Championship, which is the second-best finish at the national championship in program history. During the regular season, Carolina matched the school record with nine top-five finishes in 12 events, including three tournament wins. At one point during the season, the Gamecocks reeled off a school-record seven straight top-three finishes. Four Gamecocks wrapped up the season with a stroke average below 73, the first time of record that has happened in school history.

Among the Best in the World

South Carolina senior Will Murphy and junior Matt NeSmith are ranked in the top 100 in the latest Golfweek/Amateurgolf.com World Player Rankings. Murphy is No. 10 in the world and No. 4 in the U.S., while NeSmith is No. 120 in the world and No. 52 in the U.S.

In the Scratch Players World Amateur Rankings, Murphy is ranked No. 48, and NeSmith is No. 78. Junior Will Starke is ranked No. 95.

Roster Breakdown

South Carolina's roster is made up of 10 golfers, including two true freshmen, one sophomore, four juniors and three seniors. Seven of the 10 golfers are from the Palmetto state, with the other three hailing from Georgia, New York and Pennsylvania. A total of six golfers have NCAA Championship experience.

Gamecock Accolades in 2013-14

The Gamecocks received several individual and team accolades last season. Will Murphy earned PING Honorable Mention All-America honors. Matt NeSmith was named to the PING All-Southeast Region Team and was a second-team All-SEC selection. Caleb Sturgeon was named a Cleveland Golf/Srixon All-America Scholar. Ben Dietrich made the SEC Community Service Team. As a team, the Gamecocks earned GCAA All-Academic Team Honors.

2014-15 Tournament Recaps Palmetto Intercollegiate

The eighth-ranked South Carolina men's golf team carded a final-round 279 (-1) to claim a one-stroke victory over rival Clemson at the Palmetto Intercollegiate at the historic Palmetto Golf Club.

The Gamecocks entered the final round with a one-shot lead and went on to win their fourth tournament title of the season with a total of 825 (-15) after Clemson (826) was unable to make up the stroke by shooting an identical 279. The four wins match the school record for most wins in a single season at Carolina. The win is also the Gamecocks' third straight tournament title, which is a school record.

Gamecock junior Will Starke also took home some hardware as he claimed medalist honors by a stroke over Georgia Southern's Scott Wolfes and Clemson's Cody Proveaux with a career-low total of 201 (-9), which is tied for the second-lowest 54-hole total in school history. Starke fired a final-round 67 (-3) for his fifth straight round in the 60s. He has now shot in the 60s in 12 of his last 14 rounds.

The win is the second of Starke's career and is also his fifth top-five finish this season, moving him into a tie for second for most top-five finishes in a single season at Carolina.

Senior Caleb Sturgeon just missed a top-10 finish as he wrapped up the week in a tie for 11th with a season-low total of 206 (-4). Sturgeon carded an even-par 70 on Tuesday to earn his third top-20 finish of the season and 17th of his career.

Junior Matt NeSmith posted a 1-over 71 to head into the clubhouse in a tie for 21st with a total of 210, while senior Will Murphy tied for 29th with a total of 213 (+3) after shooting a final-round 71. Rounding out the lineup, junior Sean Kelly turned in a 71 to finish the tournament tied for 38th with a total of 215 (-1).

Bayou City Collegiate Championship

The ninth-ranked South Carolina men's golf team claimed its third title of the season, shooting a final-round 285 (-3) to hold off Sam Houston State to win the Bayou City Collegiate Championship at the Golf Club of Houston.

The Gamecocks wrapped up the weekend with a 54-hole total of 850 (-14) to finish two strokes ahead of the Bearkats (852), who made a charge by shooting a final-round 277 (-11). Carolina has now won three tournament titles for the second consecutive season. It marks the fifth time in school history a Gamecock squad has won three tournaments in a season.

Five Gamecocks secured top-20 finishes, led by junior Will Starke. After turning in a 66 (-6) in the second round, Starke fired a bogey-free 68 (-4) on Sunday to finish tied for fifth with a total of 212 (-4), his fourth top-five showing this season.

Senior Will Murphy recorded his second top-10 finish this season as he shot a final-round 70 (-2) to tie for 10th with a total of 214 (-2). Junior Matt NeSmith carded an even-par 72 to wrap up the weekend tied for 13th with a total of 215 (-1).

Junior Sean Kelly and freshman Keenan Huskey, who played as an individual, finished tied for 16th with a total of 216 (E). Kelly shot a final-round 75, while Huskey posted a 74. Rounding out the lineup, senior Caleb Sturgeon finished tied for 36th with a total of 221 (+5) after shooting a 75.

Camden Collegiate Invitational

The 10th-ranked South Carolina men's golf team fired a final-round 275 (-5) to win the inaugural Camden Collegiate Invitational by a stroke over Wofford at Camden Country Club.

The Gamecocks, who entered the day seven strokes back of Wofford, wrapped up the weekend with a 54-hole total of 847 (+7) to win their second tournament of the fall. It marks the second straight year Carolina has won two tournaments in the fall. The Terriers finished with a total of 848 (+8) to claim second.

Senior Caleb Sturgeon and juniors Matt NeSmith and Will Starke all carded rounds under par to lead the comeback. NeSmith carded the low round for the Gamecocks, shooting a 3-under 67 to finish tied for seventh with a total of 211 (+1). Sturgeon and Starke tied for fifth with a total of 210 (E) after shooting 68 and 69, respectively.

Senior Blaine Woodruff turned in a final-round 71 (+1) to tie for 26th with a total of 220 (+10), and freshman Keenan Huskey rounded out the lineup, finishing tied for 39th with a total of 223 (+13) after shooting a 73 (+3).

DICK'S Sporting Goods Collegiate Challenge Cup

The South Carolina men's golf team shot a 2-over 286 (+2) at The Golf Club of Tennessee to move one spot up the leaderboard and finish in fourth place in the DICK'S Sporting Goods Collegiate Challenge Cup.

The Gamecocks, whose round was tied for the second lowest of the day, wrapped up the stroke play portion of the tournament with a 54-hole total of 859 (+7). Georgia Tech won the tournament title with a total of 848 (-4).

Junior Will Starke had a stellar tournament, finishing second with a total of 206 (-7) after shooting a 69 (-2) on Saturday. Starke came up one stroke shy of first, as Georgia's Lee McCoy won medalist honors with a total of 205 (-8).

Gamecock junior Matt NeSmith fired a bogey-free 67 (-4) to climb nine spots up the leaderboard to finish tied for fourth with a total of 209 (-4). Senior Will Murphy tied for 23rd with a total of 219 (+6) after carding a 73 (+2) on Saturday. Senior Caleb Sturgeon turned in a final-round 77 (+6) finished 45th with a total of 226 (+13), and sophomore Ben Dietrich tied for 46th with a total of 227 (+14) after shooting a 77 (+6).

Carpet Capital Collegiate

The 12th-ranked South Carolina men's golf team captured its first team title of the season after firing a final-round 276 (-12) at the Carpet Capital Collegiate at The Farm Golf Club.

The Gamecocks, who were three strokes off the lead heading into the round, wrapped up the weekend with a 54-hole total of 848 (-16) to win its first Carpet Capital Collegiate title in 24 appearances against one of the strongest fields in collegiate golf. The Gamecocks made their comeback after an incredible back nine as all five golfers in the lineup combined to shoot 10-under.

Senior Will Murphy led the charge up the leaderboard as he fired a 6-under 66, which matches his career low. A native of Columbia, S.C., Murphy finished the weekend tied for eighth with a total of 211 (-5).

Junior Will Starke was the highest Gamecock finisher, tying for fourth place with a total of 209 (-7) after shooting a 69 (-3) on Sunday. Junior Matt NeSmith posted a final-round 68 (-4) to finish in a tie for 18th with a total of 214 (-2). Sophomore Ben Dietrich tied for 32nd with a total of 218 (+2) after shooting a 73 (+1) on Sunday, while senior Caleb Sturgeon and junior Sean Kelly finished tied for 41st with a total of 219 (+3). Sturgeon shot a 74 (+2) on Sunday, and Kelly carded a 76 (+4).

The Carmel Cup

The South Carolina men's golf team posted a final-round 365 (+5) to finish in sixth place at The Carmel Cup at the Pebble Beach Golf Links.

The Gamecocks wrapped up the weekend with a 54-hole total of 1,079 (-1), with five scores counting all three days. Georgia won with a total of 1,063 (-17).

Senior Caleb Sturgeon led the way for Carolina, recording his ninth career top-10 finish as he tied for 10th with a total of 213 (-3) after shooting a 74 (+2) on Sunday.

Junior Will Starke carded the lowest round of the day for the Gamecocks as he turned in a 1-under 71 to finish tied for 13th with a total of 215 (-1). Sophomore Ben Dietrich tied for 15th with a total of 216 (E), following a round of 74 (+2) on Sunday. Junior Matt NeSmith carded a final-round 75 (+3) to finish tied for 26th with a total of 218 (+2), while senior Will Murphy and junior Sean Kelly both finished tied for 29th with a total of 221 (+5). Murphy turned in an even-par 72, and Kelly shot a 74 (+2) on Sunday.
