ROCKY FACE, Ga. – The South Carolina men's golf team shot a final-round 297 (+9) on Sunday afternoon at The Farm Golf Club to finish in 10th place at the Carpet Capital Collegiate.

The Gamecocks wrapped up the weekend with a three-round total of 888 (+24). Continuing his solid play from the first two rounds, sophomore Will Starke recorded his second career top-five finish as he fired a 2-under 70 to conclude the tournament in a tie for fifth with a total of 214 (-2). A native of Chapin, S.C., Starke carded a team-best seven birdies to go with three bogeys and a double bogey. After shooting 1-over 37 on the front side, he bogeyed the 10th hole to start the back nine before playing the final eight holes at 4-under.

Junior Caleb Sturgeon, who posted a 76 (+4) on Sunday, was the next Gamecock on the leaderboard as he concluded the tournament in a tie for 41st with a total of 224 (+8). He recorded a pair of birdies, three bogeys and a triple bogey on the afternoon.

Sophomore Matt NeSmith turned in a 78 (+6) on Sunday to tie for 45th with a total of 225 (+9), while junior Will Murphy tied for 48th with a total of 226 (+10) after shooting a final-round 74 (+2). Rounding out the lineup, junior Blaine Woodruff shot a 77 (+5) to tie for 62nd with a total of 230 (+14).

Fourth-ranked Georgia Tech won the tournament title with a total of 850 (-14), finishing six shots ahead of second-place Georgia (856).

Georgia Tech's Ollie Schniederjans and North Carolina's Bailey Patrick shared medalist honors after both finishing with a total of 9-under 207.

DAUFUSKIE ISLAND, S.C. – The South Carolina men's golf team came up short of claiming its third Rees Jones Invitational title on Tuesday as it shot a final-round 299 (+11) to finish in a tie for second at Haig Point Club.

The Gamecocks, who have never placed worse than third at the event, finished tied with South Florida with a three-round total of 887 (+23) to fall two shots shy of tournament champion Kennesaw State. The Owls captured their third Rees Jones Invitational trophy with a total of 885 (+21).

The final day proved to be the toughest, as the average score rose to 78.16 with winds gusting as high as 20 miles per hour.

South Carolina fought through the conditions to place three golfers in the top 15. Sophomore Matt NeSmith was the highest Gamecock on the leaderboard as he finished in a tie for fourth with a total of 218 (+2) after shooting a 74 (+2) on Tuesday. It was the third top-five finish of his career.

Junior Will Murphy carded the lowest round of the day for the Gamecocks, shooting a 1-over 73 to finish in a tie for sixth with a total of 219 (+3). Junior Caleb Sturgeon posted a final-round 77 (+5) to record his second-straight top-15 finish at Haig Point with a total of 222 (+6).

Sophomore Will Starke tied for 33rd with a total of 231 (+15) after turning in a 75 (+3) in the final round, while junior Blaine Woodruff shot an 80 (+8) to tie for 48th with a total of 235 (+19).

Playing as an individual in his first collegiate event, freshman Ben Dietrich finished in a tie for 33rd with a total of 229 (+13) after carding an 81 (+9).

South Florida's Chase Koepka claimed medalist honors with a total of 212 (-4).

VERONA, Wis. – The South Carolina men's golf team posted a final-round 291 (+3) to cruise to a 24-stroke victory at the Badger Invitational on Tuesday at University Ridge Golf Course.

The Gamecocks led wire-to-wire and wrapped up the week with a 54-hole total of 856 (-8) to pull away from the field for the win. Junior Caleb Sturgeon also captured medalist honors for the second time in his career after firing a 3-under 69 in the final round. He posted a total of 206 (-10) to become the 11th golfer in school history to win multiple tournament titles.

A native of Laurens, S.C., Sturgeon now has four career top-five finishes, just one shy of breaking into the top-10 in school history.

Sturgeon's closest competitor was also wearing Garnet and Black, as NeSmith carded a 73 (+1) to finish runner-up with a total of 212 (-4). NeSmith also has four top-five finishes for his career and has placed in the top 10 in six of the last seven regular-season tournaments dating back to last spring.

Sophomore Will Starke recorded his fourth career top-20 finish as he shot a final-round 72 (E) to tie for 18th with a total of 222 (+6), while junior Will Murphy finished just outside the top 20 in a tie for 25th with a total of 224 (+8) after shooting an 81 (+9) on Tuesday.

Rounding out the lineup, freshman Ben Dietrich turned in a $77\ (+5)$ to tie for 44th with a total of $228\ (+12)$.

Kansas finished runner-up with a total of 880 (+16), followed by Illinois State (883), USC Upstate (+22) and Austin Peay (+27).

KIAWAH ISLAND, S.C. – The South Carolina men's golf team closed out its fall schedule in dominant fashion on Tuesday, claiming its second-straight Wendy's Kiawah Classic title by 22 strokes at Turtle Point Golf Club.

The Gamecocks, who won last year's tournament by 20 strokes, posted a final-round 295 (+7) to finish the week with a three-round total of 864 (E) to secure their second-consecutive tournament title of the fall. It marks the first time the program has won consecutive events since winning the Turtle Bay Intercollegiate (11/4/03) and the Mercedes-Benz Collegiate Championship (2/10/04) back-to-back during the 2003-04 season.

Four out of the five golfers in South Carolina's lineup finished the week in the top 15, with sophomore Matt NeSmith leading the way. The North Augusta, S.C., native fired a final-round 68 (-4) to finish runner-up with a total of 212 (-4). It's the fifth top-five finish of his career, which moves him into a tie for ninth all-time at South Carolina in career top-five finishes. Sophomore Will Starke (T-4th), freshman Ben Dietrich (12th) and junior Caleb Sturgeon (T-13th) also finished the week in the top 15. Junior Will Murphy just missed a top-20 finish as he tied for 21st.

Senior Alan King, who made his Gamecock debut as an individual, finished tied for 76th with a total of $237 \ (+21)$ after shooting a final-round $85 \ (+13)$.

Marquette finished runner-up with a total of 886 (\pm 22), followed by Winthrop (887), Missouri (888) and Presbyterian (890). Marquette's Nick Nelson claimed medalist honors with a total of 210 (\pm 6).

HUMBLE, Texas – The 25th-ranked South Carolina men's golf team opened the spring in strong fashion by claiming third place at the Bayou City Collegiate Championships on Sunday afternoon at the Golf Club of Houston.

The Gamecocks fired an 8-under 280 in the final round to wrap up the event with a total of 851 (-13). Tournament host Houston claimed the team title with a total of 833 (-31), while Texas finished runner-up with a score of 841 (-23).

South Carolina has now finished third or better in four straight events, including two wins. It matches last year's stretch of four consecutive top-three finishes as the most by a Gamecock team since finishing third or better in six straight events during the spring schedule of 1999.

Juniors Will Murphy and Caleb Sturgeon and sophomores Matt NeSmith and Will Starke all carded a 2-under 70 for the Gamecocks on Sunday, while junior Blaine Woodruff closed out the weekend with a 74 (+2).

NeSmith, Woodruff and Murphy all just missed out on a top-20 finish as they tied for 21st with totals of 215 (-1). Sturgeon tied for 33rd with a total of 216 (E), and Starke tied for 36th with a score of 217 (+1).

A native of North Augusta, S.C., NeSmith turned in his second-straight 70, recording four birdies and a pair of bogeys on the afternoon. Murphy, who tallied five birdies and three bogeys, was 2-over through eight holes but he played outstanding golf to close out the round, going 4-under in his final 10 holes.

Woodruff was even par through 17 holes, but a double bogey on No. 18 dropped him back to 2-over heading into the clubhouse.

After starting his day with back-to-back bogeys, Sturgeon played the rest of the way at 4-under with six birdies and two bogeys.

Starke finished his round with just one blemish on the scorecard, a bogey on the par-4 17th, while recording three birdies.

Arkansas (855) and Baylor (856) finished fourth and fifth, respectively, to round out the top five. Houston's Roman Robledo claimed medalist honors with a total of 204 (-12).

AIKEN, S.C. – The South Carolina men's golf team shot a final-round 288 (+8) to claim third place at the Palmetto Intercollegiate on Tuesday at the Palmetto Golf Club.

The Gamecocks wrapped up the two-day event with a total of 867 (+27) to earn its fifth-consecutive top-three finish, marking the most by a Gamecock team since finishing third or better in six straight events during the spring schedule of 1999. Carolina has never finished worse than third at the event in five all-time appearances.

Sophomore Will Starke led the way for the Gamecocks as he carded a final-round 73 (+3) to finish tied for fifth with a total of 214 (+4), his third top-five finish of the season.

Sophomore Matt NeSmith earned his 13th career top-20 finish, wrapping up the event in a tie for 20th with a total of 217 (+7) after shooting a final-round 71 (+1).

Juniors Will Murphy and Caleb Sturgeon just missed out on top-20 finishes as they tied for 23rd with a total of 220 (+10). Both Murphy and Sturgeon posted a 2-over 72 on Tuesday.

Junior Blaine Woodruff rounded out the Gamecock lineup, finishing in a tie for 47th with a total of 225 (+15). Woodruff turned in a 5-over 75 in the final round.

Clemson won the team title with a total of 854 (+14), followed by Virginia (856), the Gamecocks, Georgia State (874) and Chattanooga (875). Clemson's Austin Langdale won medalist honors with a total of 210 (E).

WILMINGTON, N.C. – The South Carolina men's golf team won its third tournament title of the season by 19 strokes on Monday after the final round of the Seahawk Intercollegiate was canceled due to inclement weather at the Country Club of Landfall.

The Gamecocks finished the event with a two-round total of 560 (-16), which is the third-best 36-hole total in school history. Carolina becomes just the fourth Gamecock team to win three events in a season, joining the 1981-82, 2003-04 and 2008-09 squads. The win is also the Gamecocks' sixth-consecutive finish of third or better, matching the 1998-99 team's streak of six-straight top-three finishes for the best stretch in school history.

Sophomore Will Starke is also bringing home some hardware as he claimed is first collegiate title with a total of 137 (-7), including a career-low 64 in the opening round on Sunday. Starke's total is the fifth-lowest 36-hole total in school history. He finished one shot ahead of Davidson's Sam Echikson, who had a 36-hole total of 138 (-6).

The remainder of the Gamecocks in the lineup recorded top-20 finishes. Sophomore Matt NeSmith earned his sixth career top-five finish, claiming third with a total of 139 (-5). Junior Will Murphy also placed in the top-five, finishing fourth with a total of 140 (-4). Freshman Ben Dietrich tied for 10th with a total of 144 (E), while junior Caleb Sturgeon tied for 18th with a score of 146 (+2).

Playing as an individual, junior Blaine Woodruff finished tied for 45th with a total of 153 (+9).

ETSU finished runner-up with a total of 579 (+3), followed by Ohio State (581), Louisville (581) and Davidson (586).

The Gamecocks concluded the event with a total of 855 (-9), just three strokes back of Auburn for the title. The Tigers claimed the trophy with a total of 852 (-12) after shooting a 273 (-15) on Tuesday. The second-place finish marks the seventh-straight finish of third or better for South Carolina, which is the longest stretch of top-three finishes in school history.

Four of the five Gamecocks wrapped up the event with top-20 finishes, with sophomore Will Starke leading the way. After collecting his first collegiate win a week ago, Starke continued his stellar play in Awendaw on his way to a seventh-place finish, his fifth top-10 finish this season. His final-round 68 kept him firmly in the top 10 with a total of 212 (-4). Starke was 6-under through 14 holes before playing the final four holes a 2-over, including a double bogey on the par-4 16th.

Junior Will Murphy and freshman Ben Dietrich tied for 11th with a total of 214 (-2), which is a season low for Murphy and a career-low for Dietrich. A native of Columbia, S.C., Murphy carded a 1-under 71, including five birdies, two bogeys and a double bogey. Dietrich, who has three top-20 finishes in team events this season, posted a 2-under 70 on Tuesday, tallying five birdies and three bogeys.

Sophomore Matt NeSmith earned his 15th career top-20 finish as he tied for 20th with a total of 217 (+1). He shot a final-round 67 (-5), including a bogey-free 33 (-4) on the front side. Rounding out the lineup, junior Caleb Sturgeon turned in a 75 (+3) on Tuesday to finish the event in a tie for 49th with a total of 226 (+10).

College of Charleston finished third with a total of 857 (-7), followed by Virginia (858) and Wake Forest (865). Kentucky's Ben Stow defeated Auburn's Niclas Carlsson in a playoff for medalist honors after both golfers finished their round with a total of 209 (-7).

AUGUSTA, Ga. – The South Carolina men's golf team carded a final-round 285 (-3) on Sunday at Forest Hills Golf Club to climb three spots up the leaderboard to finish in ninth place at the Augusta Invitational.

The Gamecocks wrapped up the weekend with a 54-hole total of 869 (+5) to move inside the top 10, snapping their streak of seven-straight top-three finishes, which was a school record. South Carolina's score of 285 was the fourth lowest round of the day and just the fifth under par.

Sophomore Matt NeSmith was the highest Gamecock on the leaderboard as he finished 11th with a total of 213 (-3). A native of North Augusta, S.C., NeSmith shot a final-round 71 (-1), which included six birdies and five bogeys.

Junior Will Murphy turned in a 75 (+3) on Sunday to finish tied for 26th with a total of 218 (+2). Murphy tallied one birdie, two bogeys and a double bogey on the afternoon.

Junior Caleb Sturgeon, sophomore Will Starke and freshman Ben Dietrich all finished tied for 45th with a total of 222 (+6).

ST. SIMONS ISLAND, Ga. – The South Carolina men's golf team finished fifth at the SEC Championship after carding a 283 (+3) in the final round on Sunday at Sea Island Golf Club's Seaside Course.

The Gamecocks wrapped up the event with a total of 838 (-2), which is the lowest 54-hole SEC Championship total in school history.

Top-ranked Alabama won its third-straight SEC title with a total of 806 (-34). LSU finished second with a total of 822 (-18), followed by Auburn (829) and Georgia (833).

Junior Will Murphy was the Gamecocks' top finisher as he tied for fifth with a total of 205 (-5), which matches the second lowest 54-hole SEC Championship total in school history. Murphy, whose top-five finish is the third of his career, carded a 71 on Sunday, which included four birdies and five bogeys.

Sophomore Matt NeSmith posted a 1-over 71 on Sunday and just missed a top-20 showing, finishing in a tie for 21st with a total of 210 (E). He made bogey on two of his final three holes on the front side to make the turn at 2-over but responded with a bogey-free 34 (-1) on the back nine to get into the clubhouse at 1-over.

Sophomore Will Starke fired the low round of the day for the Gamecocks as he shot a 3-under 67 to end the weekend in a tie for 26th with a total of 211 (+1). After recording a par, a bogey and a par on his first three holes of the day, Starke reeled off birdies on five of his next six holes to make the turn at 4-under. A birdie on No. 11 moved him to 5-under, but he gave back two strokes with consecutive bogeys on holes 13 and 14. He tallied one more red number with a birdie on 15 but fell back to 3-under for the day with a bogey to close out his round on No. 18.

Freshman Ben Dietrich concluded his first SEC Championship with a round of 74 (+4). He finished the weekend in a tie for 43rd with a total of 217 (+7). On the afternoon, Dietrich recorded one birdie, three bogeys and a double bogey.

Junior Caleb Sturgeon turned in a final-round 72 (+2) to finish in a tie for 51st with a total of 218 (+8). After making a bogey on holes three and five, Sturgeon battled down the stretch and made 13 straight pars to close out his round.

Alabama's Bobby Wyatt took home medalist honors with a total of 192 (-18).

EUGENE, Ore. – The fourth-seeded South Carolina men's golf team punched its ticket to the NCAA Championship for a second-straight year with a fifth-place finish in the NCAA Eugene Regional at Eugene Country Club on Saturday.

The Gamecocks shot a final-round 301 (+21) to wrap up the week with a 54-hole total of 880 (+40), finishing five strokes ahead of North Florida and Chattanooga for the fifth and final spot to the NCAA Championship. South Carolina will be making a second-consecutive trip to the NCAA Championship for the first time since advancing back-to-back in 2006 and 2007.

The course was a tremendous challenge for the entire field on Saturday, as just three golfers turned in rounds under par and only one team was below 10-over par. The average score for the round was more than five strokes over par at 75.52.

Sophomore Will Starke earned his second-straight top-20 finish at a regional as he shot a final-round 77 (+7) to tie for 16th with a total of 217 (+7). Starke came up big down the stretch, sinking a birdie putt on the par-4 17th to help the Gamecocks create some separation coming into the clubhouse.

Freshman Ben Dietrich finished the week in a tie for 22nd with a total of 220 (+10) after shooting a final-round 75 (+5). Dietrich made a huge impact on the final result on the par-4 18th, hitting his approach shot to within five feet and then sinking the putt for birdie.

Junior Caleb Sturgeon saved his best round of the week for Saturday when the Gamecocks needed it the most. A native of Laurens, S.C., Sturgeon posted a solid 2-over 72 to finish the week in a tie for 22nd with a total of 220 (+10). He played the front side at even par with one birdie and one bogey and turned in a 2-over 38 on the back nine with two bogeys and seven pars.

Sophomore Matt NeSmith carded a 77 (+7) on Saturday to finish tied for 36th with a total of 223 (+13). Rounding out the lineup, junior Will Murphy turned in an 82 (+12) to finish 58th with a total of 230 (+20).

Top-seeded Stanford held off host Oregon to win the regional with a total of 853 (+13). The Ducks finished second with a total of 854 (+14), followed by Oklahoma (860) and Houston (875). Stanford's Patrick Rodgers earned medalist honors with a total of 204 (-6).

HUTCHINSON, Kan. – The South Carolina men's golf team made an incredible run at securing a spot in match play in the final round of stroke play at the NCAA Championship on Monday but came up just short after shooting a 282 (+2) at Prairie Dunes Country Club.

The Gamecocks concluded the week with a 54-hole total of 846 (+6) to finish in ninth place, which is the second best finish in program history at the national championship. The total of 846 is also the best 54-hole NCAA Championship total in school history.

After falling down the leaderboard early in the round on Monday, South Carolina battled back to climb as high as tied for fifth on the back nine at 1-over par. However, the Gamecocks gave up five strokes down the stretch to finish one shot back of eighth place.

Junior Will Murphy helped lead the way as he made a run at the individual national title. A native of Columbia, S.C., Murphy posted a final-round 69 (-1) to finish tied for 15th with a total of 208 (-2), the lowest 54-hole NCAA Championship total in program history. With the top-15 finish, Murphy earns his first career All-America honor. He was within one stroke of first place at 5-under late in the round but made bogey and double bogey on his final two holes to fall out of contention and into a tie for 15th, the fourth highest finish by a Gamecock all-time at the national championship.

Junior Caleb Sturgeon was the next highest Gamecock on the leaderboard as he carded a final-round 73 (+3) to finish tied for 29th with a total of 210 (E). Sophomore Will Starke finished tied for 55th with a total of 214 (+4) after shooting a 72 (+2) on Monday.

Freshman Ben Dietrich fired the low round of the day for the Gamecocks, shooting a 2-under 68 to finish tied for 109th with a total of 220 (+10). Rounding out the lineup, sophomore Matt NeSmith posted a 77 (+7) to finish the week tied for 141st with a total of 228 (+18).

Stanford finished first with a total of 827 (-13), while Alabama (836), LSU (836), Oklahoma State (840), Georgia Tech (841), UCLA (844), SMU (845) and Illinois (845) all advanced to match play. Stanford's Cameron Wilson defeated Georgia Tech's Ollie Schniederjans in a playoff to win the individual national title.

2007 NCAA West Regional Champions

South Carolina finishes 44-under-par to set course record en route to program's first regional title

TEMPE, Ariz. – Behind a record-breaking performance, the South Carolina men's golf team claimed a two-stroke victory over UCLA to win the 2007 NCAA West Regional at Karsten Golf Course (Par 72, 7,057 yards) in Tempe, Ariz. The Gamecocks recorded a three-round score of 820 to finish 44 strokes under par and set a course record.

'The guys were focused all week and nothing fazed them," South Carolina associate head coach Bill McDonald said. "I kept talking about winning the tournament, not so much advancing (to the NCAA finals). I wanted them to taste victory. I felt like we were good enough to win earlier in the season. We had some opportunities and didn't get it done. I am proud of the effort they gave."

South Carolina entered the final round one stroke behind regional leader and No. 4 UCLA. The Gamecocks shot 10-under par (278) as a team Saturday to beat the Bruins, who were seven under (281). No. 10 Southern California and No. 18 Arizona State, the regional host, shared third place with a final score of 824 (-40). Fellow Southeastern Conference team Vanderbilt caught fire on Saturday, finishing the third round at 21 under to surge into fifth place.

It was the first regional title for the Gamecocks, who reached the top 10 in three of the previous four NCAA Regionals. In 1999, South Carolina fell just shy of the East Regional title, finishing second in Warren Thomas, Mark Silvers III, coach Bill McDonald, Florian Fritsch, Barrington, R.I., despite Kyle Thompson's individual victory at the Mark Anderson, George Bryan IV, assistant coach Michael Burcin.



The Gamecocks, who entered the tournament as the No. 11 seed, held a slight lead on UCLA for most of the final day, and freshman George Bryan IV's strong finish secured the win. The last player on the course for South Carolina, Bryan eagled No. 17 and sank a 40-foot putt for birdie on No. 18. The Chapin, S.C, product tied for 10th individually with a three-day total of 68-67-69=204 (-12). His tournament total of 204 tied him for fourth place in school history for a three-round individual score and was the best individual performance ever by a Gamecock in regional play. Bryan's 10th-place finish was the best by a Carolina golfer since Thompson won the 2001 NCAA West Regional in Corvalis, Ore.

Sophomore Florian Fritsch and junior Mark Anderson tied for 16th on the individual leader board after posting three-day totals of 206 (-10), which tied for the eighth-best three-round effort in school history. Anderson closed with a 70 (-2) on the final 18 holes, while Fritsch carded a 71 (-1) Saturday.

Sophomore Mark Silvers III fired a final round 69, and junior Warren Thomas posted a 70 on the final 18 holes. Silvers and Thomas both tied for 43rd with a three-day total score of 211 (-5).

"I noticed early on that both teams (South Carolina and UCLA) seemed tight," McDonald said. "It really helped us that Mark Silvers got off to such a good start. He made a couple of birdies early and

made the turn at 32 (four under par). I think when our guys started to see the board and that we had a lead, that really helped. We got a burst of energy on the back nine knowing we had a chance to win.

As a team, South Carolina opened with a

round of 273 on Thursday before shooting 269 on Friday. Those scores are among the five lowest rounds in school history. The team victory was the first for South Carolina since capturing the title at the 2005 Bank of Tennessee Intercollegiate (Oct. 15-16). In 2007, the Gamecocks' previous best performance was fourth place on three occasions.

"I told the team in a meeting a little while ago that this will mean more to them as the years go by," McDonald said of winning the title. "It will really mean a lot. To me, it gives our program validity. Instead of just talking about what we want to do, we went out and did it. It will really help from a recruiting and coaching standpoint. The more they win, the more they will believe and expect to play this way. That will develop tradition and have a long-lasting effect."

Mark Anderson

2005 - Third Team • 2008 - Honorable Mention

Mark Anderson put All-American bookends on his career, earning GCAA PING All-America honorable mention status as a senior after picking up third-team honors from the organization as a freshman. In his final season in the Garnet and Black, Anderson turned in seven top-20 finishes, reaching the status in six of the seven tournaments in the spring, to grab a spot on the All-SEC first team for the second time in his career. As a freshman, he also earned first-team all-conference honors and was named the league's Freshman of the Year. Anderson earned his PGA Tour card for 2012

George Bryan IV

2007, 2009 - Honorable Mention • 2010 - Third Team

George Bryan IV joins David Seawell (1994-96) and Kyle Thompson (1999-2001) as the only three-time All-Americans in South Carolina annals. He earned a selection to the PING All-America Third Team in 2010 after being named an Honorable Mention selection in 2007 and 2009. Bryan wrapped up his career this season as one of the most prolific golfers in South Carolina history. His career scoring average of 72.37 stands atop the record books, as does his average of 71.35 for the 2009-10 season. Ranked 39th in the nation in the final Golfweek/Sagarin release, he tied for medalist honors twice during his senior season - including the SEC Championship - falling in playoffs on both occasions. The native of Chapin, S.C., earned four top-five finishes and eight top-20 showings in 11 events this season. For his career, he posted 17 career top-10 finishes in 46 tournaments, ranking fourth in school history.



Michael Christie

1992 - Honorable Mention

Michael Christie was an all-SEC selection and an honorable mention All-American in 1992. He had seven top-10 finishes in tournament play, including a third-place finish at the 1991 Metro Conference Championship. After a successful collegiate career, Christie completed his degree in retailing and participated in the PGA qualifying school.


Eric Ecker

Webb Heintzelman


1984 - Honorable Mention

Jeff Hull

1989 - Honorable Mention

Jeff Hull earned All-America honors in 1989 as a senior. Hull finished 13th in the 1989 NCAAs. He was also named an All-American Scholar and played in the United States Amateur Championship.


Eirik Johansen

Steve Liebler


1980, 1981 - Honorable Mention

A 1981 graduate, Steve Liebler was a two-time All-American in 1980 and 1981. Liebler claimed four top-10 finishes during his career. He captured the Eastern Amateur in 1981 and won the 1979 Guilford College Intercollegiate Tournament. After five years on the professional golf tour, he returned to his alma mater as head coach. The Virginia native coached South Carolina to six NCAA Championship tournaments in his tenure.

Will Murphy

2014 - Honorable Mention

Will Murphy was named a PING Honorable Mention All-American in 2014. He earned the honor with his tie for 15th showing at the NCAA Championship with a total of 208 (-2), the lowest 54-hole NCAA Championship total in program history. On the season, Murphy played in all 12 tournaments and helped the Gamecocks match the school record with nine top-five finishes, including three wins. He recorded five top-20 finishes and wrapped up the season with a stroke average of 72.63, which is the lowest in a single season by a junior in school history.



Matt NeSmith

2013 - Honorable Mention

Matt NeSmith earned PING Honorable Mention All-America honors in 2013. He turned in one of the most decorated freshman seasons in school history. On top of the All-American honor, he was also named the SEC Co-Freshman of the Year and PING All-Southeast Region. He led Carolina to a runner-up finish at the SEC Championship and a tie for second showing at the NCAA Columbus Regional, which secured the program's first NCAA Championship berth since 2009. He recorded seven top-10 finishes, tying for the second most all-time in a single season at South Carolina. He also led the Gamecocks in scoring with a stroke average of 72.64, which is the second lowest average for a freshman in school history. He was South Carolina's top finisher at the NCAA Championship as he tied for 38th after firing a final-round 66 (-4), matching the lowest NCAA Championship score in school history.

Carl Paulson

1993 - Honorable Mention

Carl Paulson earned All-America honors in 1993. As a Gamecock, Paulson compiled four individual medalist honors, more than anyone ever to wear the garnet and black. He was the Metro Conference Champion in 1991 and was named SEC Player of the Year in 1993. Paulson won the 1995 PGA Tour Qualifying School.







Allen Powers


1968 - Honorable Mention

In 1968, Allen Powers was named to the All-America team and finished in the NCAA top five. A 1968 graduate of USC, Powers won the Carolinas' Four-Ball Tournament four times and captured the S.C. Amateur in 1982. Powers' other collegiate victories included the 1967 South Carolina Intercollegiate and the 1968 Palmetto Intercollegiate.

Brett Quigley

1991 - Honorable Mention

A 1991 graduate, Quigley earned honorable mention All-America honors in his senior season. Quigley also garnered Academic All-America laurels and made first team All-Metro Conference that season. He was second in the 1989 Metro Conference Tournament and posted a 72.9 stroke average his senior year. The Barrington, R.I., native is currently having a successful professional career, including a top-20 finish on the PGA's money list in 2006.





David Seawell

1994 - Second Team • 1995, 1996 - Honorable Mention

David Seawell was named second-team All-America as a sophomore. He won the Carpet Capital Collegiate in 1994 and led the nation in stroke average at one time. Seawell tied for fourth in the NCAA East Regional and qualified as an individual for the NCAA Finals. He qualified for the NCAA Championships in Columbus, Ohio, as a junior, en route to honorable mention All-America honors.


Mark Silvers III

Kyle Thompson


1999 - Second Team • 2000, 2001 - Honorable Mention

Fred Wadsworth


1984 - Second Team






Metro Conference (1984 - 1991)
