Gamecocks Wrap Up Fall At Wendy's Kiawah Classic

The South Carolina men's golf team is set to wrap up its fall schedule as it begins play at the Wendy's Kiawah Classic on Sunday in Kiawah Island, S.C. The 54-hole event runs through Tuesday at the par-71, 7,011-yard layout at Turtle Point Golf Club.

The Lineup

The Gamecocks will be playing with their fourth different lineup of the season at Turtle Point. Senior Dykes Harbin, sophomore Caleb Sturgeon and freshman Matt NeSmith remain in the lineup for the fourth consecutive tournament. Junior Caulder Moore will be making his second appearance of the season, and freshman Will Starke is set to make his collegiate debut.

Harbin continues to play the best golf of his career as he is coming off his first collegiate victory at the AutoTrader.com Collegiate Classic. A native of Augusta, Ga., Harbin posted rounds of 66-72-72=210 (-3) to win the tournament and lead the Gamecocks to a tie for seventh finish. He is currently ranked No. 34 in the Golfstat Player Rankings and leads the team with a stroke average of 71.89.

Through his first three collegiate tournaments, NeSmith boasts a scoring average of 75.00 and has recorded two top-20 finishes, including a tie for seventh showing at the Rees Jones Invitational. Sturgeon enters the event with a scoring average of 75.67, while Moore has a stroke average of 74.67 after playing in the season-opening Carpet Capital Collegiate. Starke, a native of Chapin, S.C., is set to make is first appearance after coming to Columbia as a highly ranked junior golfer by the Junior Golf Scoreboard.

History At Turtle Point

The Gamecocks will be going up against one of the largest fields in collegiate golf this season, as 26 teams will tee off on Sunday. A total of 15 conferences will be represented at the tournament, with South Carolina being the lone SEC program. The Palmetto State will be well represented with seven teams competing, including host Charleston Southern, College of Charleston, Francis Marion, Presbyterian, USC Upstate and Winthrop.

Breaking Down the Field

The Gamecocks will be competing against 15 teams at Berkeley Hills, including SEC foe Georgia. The Bulldogs enter the event ranked No. 7 in the latest Golfstat rankings. Chattanooga, Furman, Georgia Southern, host Georgia State, Jacksonville, Kennesaw State, Mercer, Old Dominion, USC Aiken, Towson, UNC Greensboro, VCU, Winthrop and Wisconsin round out the field.

AutoTrader.com Collegiate Classic Recap

South Carolina senior Dykes Harbin continued to play the best golf of his career as he shot a final-round 72 (+1) to





win the AutoTrader.com Collegiate Classic at Berkeley Hills Country Club. Harbin claimed a two-stroke victory over Chattanooga's Steven Fox, Winthrop's Kamito Hirai and Georgia Southern's Scott Wolfes with a three-round total of 210 (-3), which ties a career low. As a team, the Gamecocks posted the sixth best score of the day with a 10-over 294 on their way to finishing in a tie for seventh place with a total of 889 (+37).

Through three tournaments this season, Harbin has now finished first, sixth and tied for 14th and leads the team with a 71.89 stroke average.

Sophomore Caleb Sturgeon was the next highest finisher for the Gamecocks as he tied for 31st with a total of 225 (+12). Sturgeon carded a final-round 74 (+3), which included two birdies, five bogeys and 11 pars.

Sophomore Will Murphy posted the second lowest score of the day for South Carolina with a 2-over 73. His round consisted of three birdies, five bogeys and 10 pars. Murphy finished the tournament in a tie for 35th with a score of 226 (+13).

Senior Dean Hester tied for 50th with a total of 229 (+16) after shooting a final-round 75 (+4), while freshman Matt NeSmith shot a 78 (+7) to finished tied for 67th with a score of 233 (+20).

Rees Jones Invitational Recap

The South Carolina men's golf team carded a finalround 305 (+17) on Tuesday to finish in third place at the Rees Jones Invitational at Haig Point Club. The Gamecocks wrapped up the event with a three-round total of 896 (+32), finishing two strokes behind second-place East Carolina (894). Liberty won the tournament with a total of 870 (+6), which is one stroke off the tournament record.

The Gamecocks toughed out the conditions and had a strong presence at the top of the leaderboard with five golfers finishing in the top 15. Senior Dykes Harbin led the way for South Carolina as he recorded a final-round 77 (+5) to finish sixth with a total of 221 (+5). The finish is the best of his career and his second career top-10 showing.

Freshman Matt NeSmith bounced back from his second-round 78 to post a solid round of even-par 72 on Tuesday. A native of North Augusta, S.C., NeSmith earned his first career top-10 finish as he tied for seventh place with a total of 223 (+7). Senior Dean Hester, who played as an individual, finished in a tie for 13th with a score of 226 (+10) after shooting a final-round 73 (+1). Sophomores Will Murphy and Caleb Sturgeon tied for 15th with totals of 227 (+11). Murphy closed out the tournament with a 76 (+4), and Sturgeon carded an 80 (+8). Sophomore Sean Kelly shot an 82 (+10) on the afternoon to finish 42nd with a score of 235 (+19).

Carpet Capital Collegiate Recap

The South Carolina men's golf team carded a final-

round 294 (+6) to wrap up the Carpet Capital Collegiate in a tie for 11th place on Sunday at The Farm Golf Club.

The Gamecocks finished the weekend with a three-round total of 886 (+22). Senior Dykes Harbin and freshman Matt NeSmith both finished in the top 20 to lead Carolina, tying for 14th and 19th place, respectively.

Harbin posted the low round of the Gamecocks on Sunday, shooting an even-par 72 to take his three-round total to 216 (E). The top-20 finish is the fifth of his career.

One of three newcomers on the South Carolina roster this season, NeSmith made a stellar debut as he closed out the weekend with a 3-over 75. The North Augusta, S.C., native tallied two birdies, five bogeys and 11 pars to finish with a three-round score of 219 (+3).

Sophomore Sean Kelly produced his best round of the tournament, shooting a 1-over 73 as he finished in a tie for 68th with a score of 230 (+14).

Junior Caulder Moore turned in a 3-over 75 on Sunday to tie for 45th with a total of 224 (+8), while sophomore Caleb Sturgeon posted a 2-over 74 to tie for 66th with a total of 229 (+13).

Leader Of The Pack

Dykes Harbin has taken his leadership role to a whole other level this season. He has been the Gamecocks top finisher in all three tournaments (T-14th, sixth and first) and is leading the team with a 71.89 stroke average. He is currently ranked No. 34 in the Golfstat men's player rankings.

Sophomore Sensations

Caleb Sturgeon, Sean Kelly and Will Murphy were impact performers for the Gamecocks last season and hope to do the same again in 2012-13.

Sturgeon, a selection on the SEC All-Freshman Team, had an average of 72.89, which ties for the second best scoring average in school history for a freshman.

Kelly ranked fifth on the team with a stroke average of 54.13. He posted two top-20 finishes, including one top-five showing.

Murphy played in nine tournaments and tallied one top-20 finish. He ranked fourth on the team with a scoring average of 73.88.

Be on the Lookout

Freshman Matt NeSmith is player to watch in 2012-13, according to Golf Digest. NeSmith is one of 50 golfers on Golf Digest's preseason watch list.

A native of Augusta, Ga., NeSmith was ranked No. 1 in the Polo Golf Rankings. He won three AJGA "majors" last season and was one of four golfers to receive the prestigious Byron Nelson International Junior Golf Award. NeSmith also played at the PGA Wyndham Championship, missing the cut by just two strokes.
