

Women's Swimming - 2008-09 In Review

South Carolina's women's swimmers put together a 2008-09 season that showed the rest of the Southeastern Conference that the Gamecocks are a rising force in the swimming world. Behind seven school-record times, the Gamecock women took home a seventh-place finish from the SEC Swimming & Diving Championships, their best showing since 2005-06.

But it was more than just a strong effort over four days in Auburn. With five dual-meet victories on the year, the Gamecock women put together their best regular-season effort since the 2001-02 campaign. Carolina took down Clemson, Davidson, Duke, Charleston and Vanderbilt on the year to finish 5-5, 1-3 against Southeastern Conference foes.

The team opened at home with top-15 foe North Carolina, dropping a 176-124 decision. But there were several high notes in the meet, most notably freshman Lindsey Olson. She won the 100 butterfly in her first college meet with a time of 56.46, and also helped the 400 MR team to an event victory in her initial swim as a Gamecock.

A week later, defending ACC champion Virginia rolled into town, taking a 163-132 decision back to Charlottesville. But the Gamecocks showed improvement from the first week. Olson continued to impress by winning the 400 IM in 4:24.00, and Shartelle McLean picked up a victory in the 50 free (23.55). In addition, Claire Thompson picked up a third win for Carolina with a 1:50.40 in the 200 freestyle.

Archival Clemson came to Columbia on Halloween night for the annual Palmetto State showdown. The outcome was never in doubt as the Gamecocks dominated the Tigers with a 171-128 victory. Megan Sparks provided the highlight of the night, breaking a 16-year-old school record in the 100 back with a time of 55.86 seconds. Senior Amanda Dunnigan won three of four events on the night, and Olson took two wins in the 100 fly and 200 fly. Christine Thompson got a victory in the 1000 free, and her twin sister, Claire, took first place in the 500 free.

But Carolina didn't have long to celebrate. A trip to No. 5 Florida was looming the following week, and the Gators took a 168.5-126.5 victory in Gainesville. However, the Gamecocks weren't completely shut out. Dunnigan won both the 100 and 200 freestyle, and Olson took first in the 200 fly and 500 free. Claire Thompson tied for first in the 200 free, and Sparks took second in the 200 back.

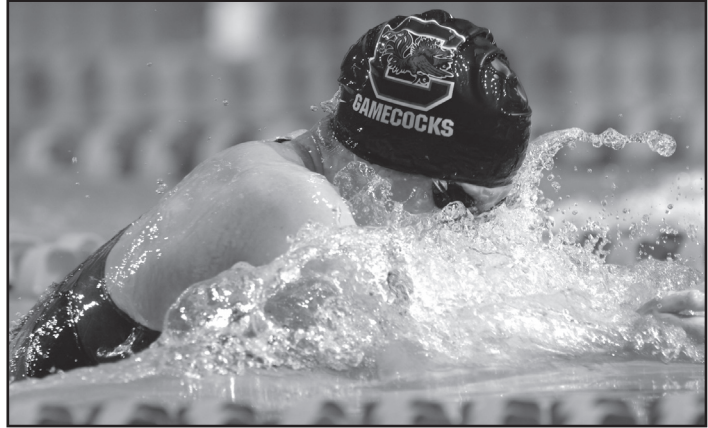
Three weeks later, Carolina played host to the Gamecock Invitational and put on a show for the Gamecock faithful. McLean broke a 20-year-old school record in the 50 free, touching in 22.65 to win the event. Claire Thompson won the 200 freestyle, and a pair of relay teams took first place in their respective events. On the final night, Olson took top honors in the 200 fly and the relays remained strong to help Carolina to a second-place finish against a strong field.

After the holiday break, the Gamecocks went on a four-meet winning streak, their longest 2001-02. They beat Davidson handily, then squeaked out a win over Duke that came down to the last event. Then they took easy home wins over Vanderbilt and College of Charleston, saying goodbye to a pair of seniors - Dunnigan and Kassy Kugler - swimming their final home meets.

The Gamecocks came up short in a tri-meet with Alabama and Georgia, but saved their best performances for the SEC Championships. During the conference meet, Sparks set school records in the 100 and 200 backstroke, Dunnigan took down the Carolina standards in the 200 and 400 IM, and three relay teams set the Gamecock all-time marks; all seven swims were under the NCAA 'B' standard. Between diving and swimming, the Gamecocks had 15 individual scoring efforts and five relays to earn big points as the team turned in a seventh-place overall finish, outpacing Kentucky, LSU and Vanderbilt to earn their best showing in three years.
