Gamecocks Open the Spring in Texas

The ninth-ranked South Carolina men's golf team opens its spring schedule this weekend at the Bayou City Collegiate Championship in Humble, Texas. The 54-hole event runs Friday through Sunday at the par-72, 6,982-yard Golf Club of Houston, the host of the PGA Tour's Shell Houston Open.

Hosts:

History at the Bayou City

BAYOICIT

This year marks the third playing of the Bayou City Collegiate Championship. The Gamecocks played at the event in 2013 and 2014, finishing third each time. Caleb Sturgeon and Will Murphy hold the distinction of having the best individual finish by a Gamecock at the tournament as they finished tied for eighth in 2013 with a total of 214 (-2).

Last Time at the BCCC - Feb. 21-23, 2014

The Gamecocks claimed third place at last year's Bayou City Collegiate Championship after posting a 54-hole total of 851 (-13). Houston claimed first with a total of 833 (-31), while Texas finished second (841). Matt NeSmith, Will Murphy and Blaine Woodruff all tied for 21st for Carolina with a total of 215 (-1).

Breaking Down the Field

A total of 15 teams will be competing for the Bayou City Collegiate Championship title this weekend. Carolina (No. 9) and Baylor (No. 8) are the only two teams ranked in the top 25 in the latest Golfstat Relative Rankings. The Bears have finished in the top three in five of their six events this season, including a pair of wins. Co-host Houston (No. 30) and Arkansas (No. 38) enter the weekend in the top 50. Charlotte, Lamar, Louisiana, McNeese State, New Mexico State, Northern Illinois, co-host Rice, Sam Houston State, Southeastern Louisiana, Troy and UTSA round out the field. The Gamecocks have only competed against one team this season in this week's field, Arkansas. Carolina recorded a head-to-head win over the Razorbacks with a sixth-place finish at The Carmel Cup,

Making it a Habit

The Gamecocks have finished in the top five in 12 of their last 15 tournaments dating back to last season, including five tournament wins. Carolina matched the school record for top-five finishes in a single season last year with nine, including three wins.

McDonald's 11

Gamecock head coach Bill McDonald is the winningest coach by tournament victories in school history with 11. McDonald broke the previous record of nine held by Puggy Blackmon (1995-2007) with Carolina's win at the Carpet Capital Collegiate this fall. The Gamecocks then gave McDonald his 11th tournament title with a win at the Camden Collegiate Invitational to close out the fall.

A Top 25 Program

Under the guidance of head coach Bill McDonald, South Carolina has consistently been ranked in the top 25 of several polls the last two years. The Gamecocks ended last year ranked No. 14 in the final Golfstat Rankings, No. 21 in the final regular-season Golf World/Nike Coaches Poll and No. 20 in the Golfweek Rankings. Carolina is currently ranked No. 9 in the Golfstat Relative Rankings, No. 13 in the Golf Coaches Association of America Coaches Poll and No. 18 in the Golfweek/Sagarin Rankings.

Spring Forward

Carolina's last win to open its spring schedule was a 27-stroke victory at the 2004 Mercedes-Benz Collegiate at Sawgrass Country Club in Ponte Vedra Beach, Fla. The Gamecocks have come close to ending the winless streak to open the spring, finishing third each of the last three years, twice at the Bayou City Collegiate Championship and once at the Seahawk Intercollegiate, and runner-up at the 2010 Seahawk Intercollegiate.

Lowering the Averages

Four Gamecocks wrapped up the fall with a stroke average in the 72s. Junior Will Starke led the way with an average of 70, followed by junior Matt NeSmith (71) and seniors Caleb Sturgeon (72.33) and Will Murphy (72.33). Starke and NeSmith rank second and third, respectively, in the SEC in stroke average. Last season Starke, NeSmith, Murphy and Sturgeon wrapped up the year with a stroke average in the 72s, which is the first time of record that has happened in school history.

Hot Streak

Junior Will Starke played some of the best golf of his career in the fall as he has finished in the top 15 in all four events, including three top fives, and won his match against Virginia's Ji Soo Park. Starke has shot below 70 in seven of his last eight rounds and has only carded two rounds above par this season (73-73).

Gamecocks in the Golfstat Statistics Rankings

As a team South Carolina ranks 10th in the nation in average score (72.00) and 12th versus par (+0.71). The Gamecocks are 11th in par-4 scoring (4.07) and tied for 15th in eagles (10).

Junior Will Starke is tied for 17th nationally in average score (70), ranks 11th in par-4 scoring (4.51) and is tied for 13th in eagles (4).

Climbing the Record Book

Senior Caleb Sturgeon and juniors Will Starke and Matt NeSmith continue to climb up South Carolina's career scoring average list. NeSmith currently ranks first all-time with an average of 72.24, while Starke isn't far behind in second with an average of 72.32. Sturgeon ranks fifth all-time with an average of 72.98.

Starke also has eight career top-five finishes, which is tied for the fifth most all-time at South Carolina with Eric Ecker (1996-2000). NeSmith is tied for the seventh most career top-five finishes with seven.

A Look Back at the 2013-14 Season

The 2013-14 season was a special year for the South Carolina men's golf program. The Gamecocks finished

ninth at the NCAA Championship, which is the second-best finish at the national championship in program history. During the regular season, Carolina matched the school record with nine top-five finishes in 12 events, including three tournament wins. At one point during the season, the Gamecocks reeled off a school-record seven straight top-three finishes. Four Gamecocks wrapped up the season with a stroke average below 73, the first time of record that has happened in school history.

Among the Best in the World

South Carolina senior Will Murphy and junior Matt NeSmith are ranked in the top 100 in the latest Golfweek/Amateurgolf.com World Player Rankings. Murphy is No. 8 in the world and No. 3 in the U.S., while NeSmith is No. 116 in the world and No. 50 in the U.S.

In the Scratch Players World Amateur Rankings, Murphy is ranked No. 43, and NeSmith is No. 72.

Roster Breakdown

South Carolina's roster is made up of 10 golfers, including two true freshmen, one sophomore, four juniors and three seniors. Seven of the 10 golfers are from the Palmetto state, with the other three hailing from Georgia, New York and Pennsylvania. A total of six golfers have NCAA Championship experience.

Gamecock Accolades in 2013-14

The Gamecocks received several individual and team accolades last season. Will Murphy earned PING Honorable Mention All-America honors. Matt NeSmith was named to the PING All-Southeast Region Team and was a second-team All-SEC selection. Caleb Sturgeon was named a Cleveland Golf/Srixon All-America Scholar. Ben Dietrich made the SEC Community Service Team. As a team, the Gamecocks earned GCAA All-Academic Team Honors.

2014-15 Tournament Recaps

Camden Collegiate Invitational

The 10th-ranked South Carolina men's golf team fired a final-round 275 (-5) to win the inaugural Camden Collegiate Invitational by a stroke over Wofford at Camden Country Club.

The Gamecocks, who entered the day seven strokes back of Wofford, wrapped up the weekend with a 54hole total of 847 (+7) to win their second tournament of the fall. It marks the second straight year Carolina has won two tournaments in the fall. The Terriers finished with a total of 848 (+8) to claim second.

Senior Caleb Sturgeon and juniors Matt NeSmith and Will Starke all carded rounds under par to lead the comeback. NeSmith carded the low round for the Gamecocks, shooting a 3-under 67 to finish tied for seventh with a total of 211 (+1). Sturgeon and Starke tied for fifth with a total of 210 (E) after shooting 68 and 69, respectively.

Senior Blaine Woodruff turned in a final-round 71 (+1) to tie for 26th with a total of 220 (+10), and freshman Keenan Huskey rounded out the lineup, finishing tied for 39th with a total of 223 (+13) after shooting a 73 (+3).

DICK'S Sporting Goods Collegiate Challenge Cup

The South Carolina men's golf team shot a 2-over 286 (+2) at The Golf Club of Tennessee to move one spot up the leaderboard and finish in fourth place in the DICK'S Sporting Goods Collegiate Challenge Cup.

The Gamecocks, whose round was tied for the second lowest of the day, wrapped up the stroke play portion of the tournament with a 54-hole total of 859 (+7). Georgia Tech won the tournament title with a total of 848 (-4).

Junior Will Starke had a stellar tournament, finishing second with a total of 206 (-7) after shooting a 69 (-2) on Saturday. Starke came up one stroke shy of first, as Georgia's Lee McCoy won medalist honors with a total of 205 (-8).

Gamecock junior Matt NeSmith fired a bogey-free 67 (-4) to climb nine spots up the leaderboard to finish tied for fourth with a total of 209 (-4). Senior Will Murphy tied for 23rd with a total of 219 (+6) after carding a 73 (+2) on Saturday. Senior Caleb Sturgeon turned in a final-round 77 (+6) finished 45th with a total of 226 (+13), and sophomore Ben Dietrich tied for 46th with a total of 227 (+14) after shooting a 77 (+6).

Carpet Capital Collegiate

The 12th-ranked South Carolina men's golf team captured its first team title of the season after firing a final-round 276 (-12) at the Carpet Capital Collegiate at The Farm Golf Club.

The Gamecocks, who were three strokes off the lead heading into the round, wrapped up the weekend with a 54-hole total of 848 (-16) to win its first Carpet Capital Collegiate title in 24 appearances against one of the strongest fields in collegiate golf. The Gamecocks made their comeback after an incredible back nine as all five golfers in the lineup combined to shoot 10-under.

Senior Will Murphy led the charge up the leaderboard as he fired a 6-under 66, which matches his career low. A native of Columbia, S.C., Murphy finished the weekend tied for eighth with a total of 211 (-5).

Junior Will Starke was the highest Gamecock finisher, tying for fourth place with a total of 209 (-7) after shooting a 69 (-3) on Sunday. Junior Matt NeSmith posted a final-round 68 (-4) to finish in a tie for 18th with a total of 214 (-2). Sophomore Ben Dietrich tied for 32nd with a total of 218 (+2) after shooting a 73 (+1) on Sunday, while senior Caleb Sturgeon and junior Sean Kelly finished tied for 41st with a total of 219 (+3). Sturgeon shot a 74 (+2) on Sunday, and Kelly carded a 76 (+4).

The Carmel Cup

The South Carolina men's golf team posted a final-round 365 (+5) to finish in sixth place at The Carmel Cup at the Pebble Beach Golf Links.

The Gamecocks wrapped up the weekend with a 54-hole total of 1,079 (-1), with five scores counting all three days. Georgia won with a total of 1,063 (-17).

Senior Caleb Sturgeon led the way for Carolina, recording his ninth career top-10 finish as he tied for 10th with a total of 213 (-3) after shooting a 74 (+2) on Sunday.

Junior Will Starke carded the lowest round of the day for the Gamecocks as he turned in a 1-under 71 to finish tied for 13th with a total of 215 (-1). Sophomore Ben Dietrich tied for 15th with a total of 216 (E), following a round of 74 (+2) on Sunday. Junior Matt NeSmith carded a final-round 75 (+3) to finish tied for 26th with a total of 218 (+2), while senior Will Murphy and junior Sean Kelly both finished tied for 29th with a total of 221 (+5). Murphy turned in an even-par 72, and Kelly shot a 74 (+2) on Sunday.
