### Gamecocks Open 2012-13 Season at Carpet Capital

South Carolina will open its season at the Carpet Capital Collegiate for the seventh straight season. The 54-hole event runs Friday through Sunday at The Farm Golf Club in Dalton, Ga. The Gamecocks will be paired with Kennesaw State and Tennessee for the first two rounds.

### The Lineup

The Gamecocks will begin the year with an experience lineup featuring a senior, a junior, two sophomores and a freshman. Senior Dykes Harbin, junior Caulder Moore, sophomores Caleb Sturgeon and Sean Kelly and freshman Matt NeSmith will tee it up for Carolina in Dalton.

Harbin is expected to lead the way for the Gamecocks in his senior campaign after being one of the team's most consistent golfers a year ago. A native of Augusta, Ga., Harbin played in all 12 tournaments in 2011-12, ranking third on the squad with a stroke average of 73.54 and recording four top-20 finishes. Moore finished last season with a scoring average of 75.33 after playing in two tournaments, including the Carpet Capital Collegiate.

Sturgeon and Kelly had stellar freshman campaigns for the Gamecocks. A native of Laurens, S.C., Sturgeon earned SEC All-Freshman Team honors after ranking second on the team and 24th in the conference in scoring with an average of 72.89. He led the team in top-10 finishes with three. Kelly played in eight tournaments a year ago, finishing in the top 20 on two occasions.

NeSmith looks to carry over the momentum of his successful summer to make an immediate impact. He joins the Gamecocks as the top-ranked junior golfer in the Polo Golf Rankings.

### History at The Farm

This year's tournament marks the 24th playing of the Carpet Capital Collegiate, with the Gamecocks having played in 21 of the previous 23 events. South Carolina's best finish at the tournament was a tie for first in 2007. The Gamecocks' next best finish was second in 2008.

Two Gamecocks have claimed medalist honors at the event, as Kyle Thompson (69-69-70=208) and David Seawell (69-68-73=210) won at The Farm in 2000 and 1994, respectively.

### Last time at the Carpet Capital Collegiate - 2011

South Carolina tied for 11th place at the 2011 Carpet Capital Collegiate with a team total of 890 (+26). Dykes Harbin led the way tying for 21st with rounds of 73-73-72=218 (+2).

### Breaking Down the Field

This year's field will be one of the strongest in tournament history with seven teams ranked in the Golf World Top 25, including top-ranked Alabama and defending national champion Texas. Also representing the SEC is No. 6 Auburn, No. 19 Georgia, LSU and Tennessee. Seventh-ranked Georgia Tech, No. 25 Clemson, North Carolina and Wake Forest make up a solid ACC contingent, while No. 15 North Florida, Middle Tennessee State, Kennesaw State and Chattanooga will also compete this weekend.

### Steady Senior

Dykes Harbin looks to be a steady force for the Gamecocks this season. The senior leader was one of Carolina's most consistent golfers a year ago with an average of 73.54. He has four career top-20 finishes and has played in 18 career tournaments, which is the most of any golfer on the roster

### Sophomore Sensations

Caleb Sturgeon, Sean Kelly and Will Murphy were impact performers for the Gamecocks last season and hope to do the same again in 2012-13.

Sturgeon, a selection on the SEC All-Freshman Team, had an average of 72.89, which ties for the second best scoring average in school history for a freshman.

Kelly ranked fifth on the team with a stroke average of 54.13. He posted two top-20 finishes, including one top-five showing.

Murphy played in nine tournaments and tallied one top-20 finish. He ranked fourth on the team with a scoring average of 73.88.

### Be on the Lookout

Freshman Matt NeSmith is player to watch in 2012-13, according to Golf Digest. NeSmith is one of 50 golfers on Golf Digest's preseason watch list.

A native of Augusta, Ga., NeSmith was ranked No. 1 in the Polo Golf Rankings. He won three AJGA "majors" last season and was one of four golfers to receive the prestigious Byron Nelson International Junior Golf Award. NeSmith also played at the PGA Wyndham Championship, missing the cut by just two strokes.

Ranked No. 1 in the Golfweek and Polo junior rankings... Medalist in the 2009, 1010 and 2011 South Carolina Region 4A Championship...Won the South Carolina Lower State in 2011...Finished second at the 4A State Championship in 2010 and fourth in 2011...Won the 2009 Orange Jacket Junior, the 2009 and 2010 George Holliday Junior, the h2010 SCJGA Fall Challenge and the 2011 Junior Heritage... Had second-place finishes at the 2010 Jones Cup Junior Invitational and the 2010 SCJGA South Carolina Junior Championship...Finished third at the 2010 SCJGA South Carolina Players Championship, the 2011 Bobby Chapman Invitational and the AJGA Ping Invitational...Placed fourth at the 2011 Junior Invitational at Sage Valley...Represented the East in the AJGA Wyndham Cup and was the only player to go 4-0-0 for all his matches...Qualified for the 2011 U.S. Junior and finished 10th in the stroke play portion...Was named 2010 Male Athlete of the Year by the Greater Augusta Area Sports Council.
