OUTLOOK – Great stuff, will pitch for the team out of the bullpen ... Got valuable experience last year as a freshman, hopeful he will improve on his solid freshman year ... Very talented, he can be as good as he wants to be.

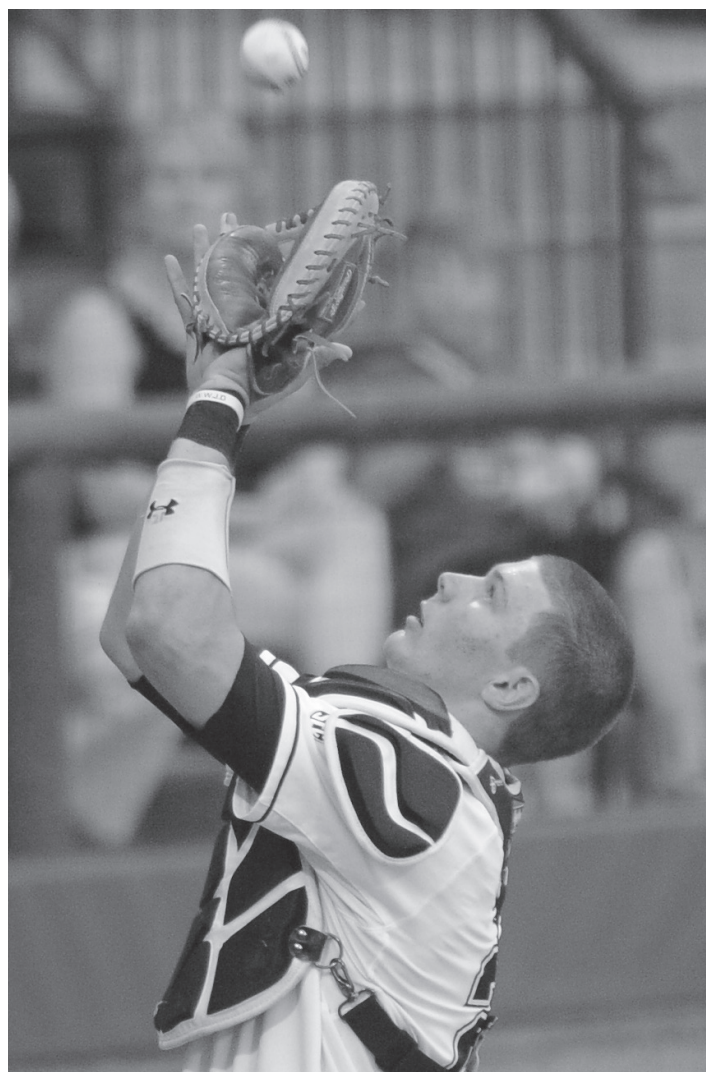

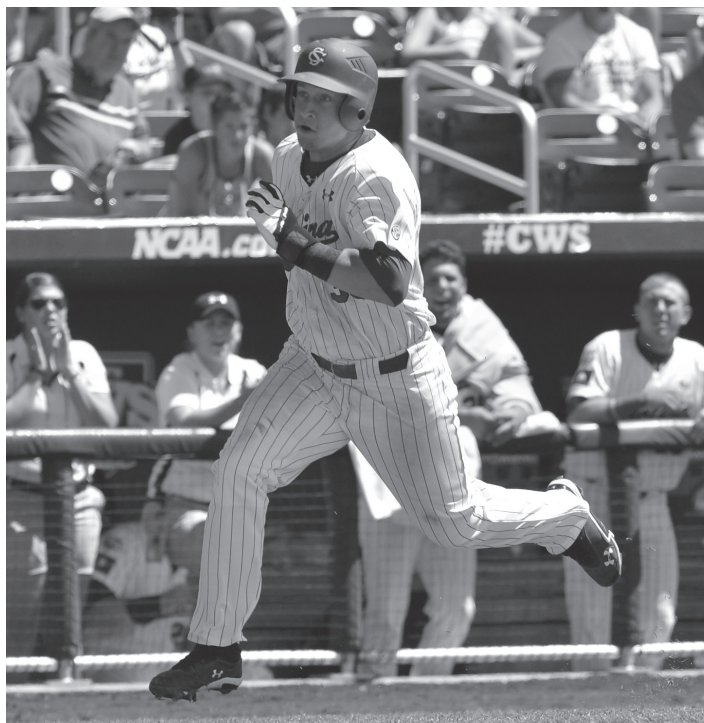

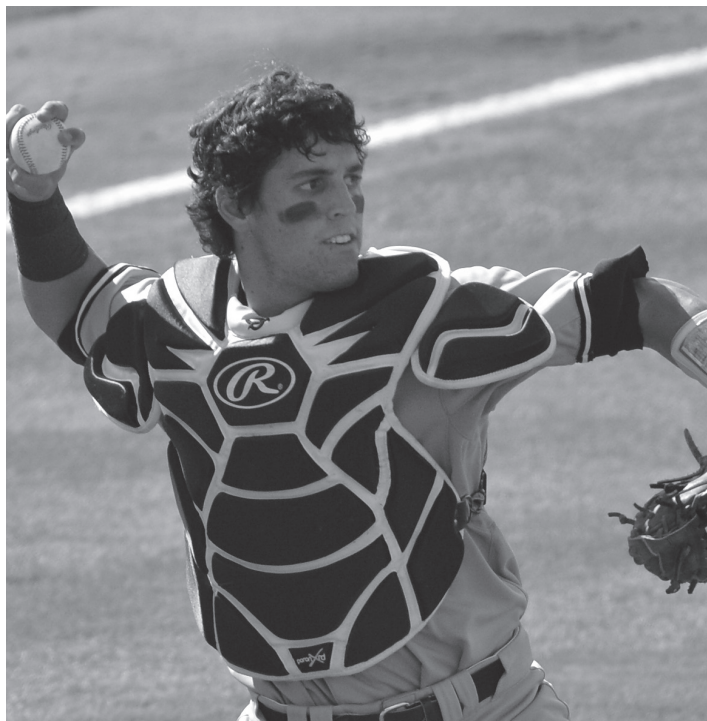
