### Gamecocks Tee off at Mercedes-Benz Collegiate Championship

The South Carolina women's golf team continues fall action this weekend when it opens play on Friday at the Mercedes-Benz Collegiate Championship in Knoxville, Tenn. The 54-hole event runs through Sunday at the par-71, 5,897-yard Cherokee Country Club.

### The Lineup

Junior Justine Dreher will be at the top of this weekend's lineup after competing as an individual at the season-opening Cougar Classic. Seniors Samantha Swinehart and Suzie Lee will fill the two and three spots respectively, freshman Katelyn Dambuaugh will be fourth and sophomore Mary Fran Hillow will round out Gamecocks' lineup. Sophomore Sarah Schemelzel will also make the trip to Knoxville and compete as an individual.

### Breaking Down the Field

The 17-team field consists of two top-25 teams in the GolfWorld/WGCA Preseason Poll, through two tournaments the Gamecocks will have competed against six different top 25 teams.

No. 8 Arkansas highlights the field and is one of six teams representing the SEC along with Missouri, Mississippi, Mississippi State, and host Tennessee. Campbell, Chattanooga, College of Charleston, Louisville, Michigan, Notre Dame, Penn State, Rollins, Tulane, UCF and UTSA round out the field.

### History at the Mercedes-Benz Collegiate Championship

This will mark South Carolina's ninth appearance in the Mercedes-Benz Collegiate Championship since the tournament began in 1997. The last trip the Gamecocks made to the event was in 2011 and they finished 17th. The Gamecocks' best finish at the event came two years prior in 2009 as they took third place.

### Cougar Classic Recap

South Carolina opened fall play with a sixth place finish at the Cougar Classic in Hanahan, S.C., after posting a three-round score of 872 (+8).

The Gamecocks shot their best round on the opening day of the tournament turning in a 3-under 285. Swinehart led the way with a 3-under 69, followed by Hillow's 1-under 71. Dreher, who competed as an individual, also finished with a 1-under 71.

After posting a second round score of 298 (+10) the Gamecocks bounced back in round three carding a 1-over 289.

Dreher recoreded a team-best 13 birdies and finished in a tie for sixth place with rounds of 71-73-70=214 (-2).

Swinehart finished in a tie for 10th place, which is a new career-best for the senior. She posted a three-round total of 216 (E) and had the only ace of the tournament, which came in the first round.

Senior Suzie Lee finished next on the leaderboard for South Carolina posting a third-round 68 (-4), which ties a career-best, for a total of 218 (+2) and landing her in a tie for 19th. Lee tallied six birdies throughout the tournament, five of which came in round three.

Dambaugh and Hillow concluded the tournament in a tie for 37th with totals of 221 (+5). Dambaugh recorded nine birdies in her collegiate debut and Hillow tallied seven.

Schemelzel shot three consecutive rounds of 74 (+2) to finish in a tie for 44th.

### Among the Elite

South Carolina head coach Kalen Harris has built a force to be reckoned with in both the SEC and on a national level. Under her guidance, the Gamecocks have won two NCAA East Regional titles and advanced to five NCAA Championships including a program best fifth place finish in 2012.

### In the Polls

South Carolina earned a preseason ranking of 20th by Golfweek but was left out of the Golfworld/WGCA Coaches Preseason Poll. Five SEC schools made the top 25 including Eastern Division rivals No. 8 Vanderbilt, No. 10 Florida and No. 17 Georgia.

### Busy Summer

The Gamecocks had yet another productive summer in 2013 with several golfers competing in a variety of events. Justine Dreher advanced to the Final 16 at the Ladies' British Amateur, finished tied for third at the Swiss Am and made it to match play as a member of Team France at the European Ladies' Amateur Team Championship. Sarah Schmelzel finished tied for fifth at Trans National Amateur Championship and Katelyn Dambaugh advanced to the round of 32 at the US Amateur Championship.
