South Carolina Notes

- With the win, South Carolina improves to 43-16 on the season.
- South Carolina will face second-seeded Maryland on Saturday at 7 p.m.
- The Gamecocks are now 127-62 all-time in NCAA Tournament games, including a 59-8 mark in home postseason games.
- South Carolina has won 28-straight home NCAA Tournament games and boasts a 17-0 postseason record at Carolina Stadium.
- Prior to giving up a solo home run to Seth LaRue in the top of the fourth inning, South Carolina starting pitcher Jordan Montgomery had not given up a run in 27 2/3-consecutive innings in the NCAA Tournament.
- Montgomery improves to 5-0 in NCAA Tournament games and has a career postseason ERA of 0.93.
- The win was Montgomery's 20th of his career, making him the 22nd pitcher in South Carolina history to reach the mark.
- Connor Bright's single in the sixth inning was his first hit since April 19 at Auburn.
- Marcus Mooney finished the night with two RBIs, both coming on a two-out single in the eighth. Fourteen of his 22 RBIs on the season have come with two outs.



Campbell Notes

- With the loss, Campbell falls to 40-20 on the season.
- The Camels will face No. 3 seed Old Dominion in an elimination game on Saturday at 1 p.m.
- Campbell is now 0-3 all-time in NCAA Tournament games.
- Seth LaRue's solo home run in the top of the fourth inning was the first run South Carolina starting pitcher Jordan Montgomery had given up in 27 2/3 innings in the NCAA Tournament.
