## Redshirt-Freshman Year (2015-16)

- Played in 20 games following hand injury suffered in the preseason, drawing three starts
- Helped pace South Carolina's strong defensive effort against Georgia (Feb. 18) with a career-high three steals
- Scored five of team's first eight points in first career start against \#16/19 Florida (Feb. 11) en route to first double-digit scoring game
- Efficient in relief of Tiffany Mitchell (injury) against \#18/18 Kentucky (Feb. 4), notching seven points (3-of-4 shooting) that included a key bucket in transition during South Carolina's 10-2 run to end the game
- Scored her four points against Ole Miss (Jan. 28) during 13-4 fourth-quarter run to end Rebels' rally
- Made an impact on the boards against Ole Miss (Jan. 28), grabbing a career-best three rebounds in 12 minutes of action
- Showed her court vision at Auburn (Jan. 21) handing out three assists in the second half while capping the third quarter with her first career 3-pointer
- Added five points to win over No. 20/- Missouri (Jan. 10), finding her way in pace of play on both sides of the ball after not seeing game action since high school (2013-14)
- Made her South Carolina debut at Vanderbilt (Jan. 7), tallying two points in five minutes of action
- Had a great preseason before surgery on her right hand in early November ... had cast removed Dec. 17 and was fully cleared for practice in January


## Freshman Year (2014-15)

- Received an initial eligibility waiver from the NCAA, allowing her to enroll in school but not compete
- After focusing on academics in the fall, began practicing with the team in the spring

- Scored over 1,000 points in her career
- Named honorable mention all-state

## Alaina Coates

- Took over after halftime in the first round of the NCAA Tournament against Jacksonville (Mar. 18), tallying 15 second-half points, including nine in the third quarter to help South Carolina build a 24 -point lead heading into the last period
- Averaged a double-double in SECTournament - $10.3 \mathrm{ppg}, 10.0 \mathrm{rpg}$-adding two double-doubles to her season total
- Scored seven of the second half's first 11 points against \#13/13 Kentucky (Mar. 5) in SECTournament semifinal to help stretch lead to 18 and finished with a double-double for the 17th time this season
- Tallied eight points during 12-3 second-quarter run against Auburn (Mar. 4) in SEC Tournament quarterfinal as Gamecocks opened 16-point halftime lead
- Broke school record for career defensive rebounds with 12 of her 14 at Ole Miss (Feb. 25) coming on that end
- Dominated the glass at Alabama (Feb. 22) with 11 of her career-high 18 rebounds coming in 16 first-half minutes
- Scored eight of her 14 points in the second half against \#16/19 Florida (Feb. 11), including six in the fourth quarter to go along with two key assists that helped the Gamecocks preserve their lead down the stretch
- Dominated both ends of the floor against\#18/18 Kentucky (Feb.4), especially down the stretch with 12 of her SEC career-high 27 points coming in the fourth quarter on 4 -of- 4 field goals and 4 -of- 5 free throws
- Quietly stuffed the stat sheet at \#10/10 Texas A\&M (Jan. 31), adding careerhigh six assists to her double-double and helping key a 10-0 fourth-quarter run that turned a deficit into a six-point lead with solid defense at the rim, three defensive rebounds and a drive to the basket
- Grabbed nine of her 14 rebounds against Ole Miss (Jan. 28) in the first half and scored five of last seven points of the half
- Shook off tough scoring night with great rebounding at \#10/10 Mississippi State (Jan. 24), including six in a tight third quarter and her 11th of the night sparking a transition layup for a six-point lead with 3:01 to play
- Established inside game early with six of team's first 12 points at Auburn (Jan. 21) and nearly had double-double by halftime
- Recorded 1,000th career point in first minute against \#20/- Missouri (Jan. 10), finishing with third-straight double-double
- Completed her school-record 12th career double-double in SEC play with key putback in late 11-3 run that sealed win at Vanderbilt (Jan. 7)
- Converted all six of her free throw attempts against Elon (Dec. 22), to finish
in double figures for fifth-straight game
- Posted third-straight double-double against East Carolina (Dec. 20), grabbing 10 of her 15 rebounds in just 11 minutes of second-half action
- Recorded double-double against Hampton (Dec. 16) with 10 of 22 points coming during a $12-4$ second-half run
- Played an historic career game against Winthrop (Dec. 13), recording program's first triple-double since Dec. 20, 2006, and first ever with blocked shots, swatting away a school-record 10 to go with her career high 29 points and 16 rebounds
- Connected on 7-of-9 field goals against \#14/13 Duke (Dec. 6) and tallied six crucial points down the stretch to help South Carolina pull away
- Scored the game-tying putback with 56 seconds left against \#16/18 ASU (Nov. 27)
- Double-double at UCLA (Nov. 22) kept Gamecocks within reach and made key steal during 8-2 run over final 90 seconds to secure the win
- Dominated the glass late against \#6/10 Ohio State (Nov. 13), especially in 10-2 run over final 2:35 that decided the game, and finished the contest with her 24th career double-double ( $17 \mathrm{pts}, 13$ rebs)

- Hit back-to-back buckets to kick off an 18-4 second-half run that turned a one-point game into a 15 -point lead against LSU (Mar. 7) in SEC Tournament semifinals
- Grabbed three of her six rebounds against \#6/6 Tennessee (Feb. 23) in final 2:00 to help seal victory
- Had her best game against a ranked team this season with a double-double against\#12/10 Texas A\&M (Jan. 26), including nine points and six rebounds in second half to help deliver victory
- Hit all six of her free throw attempts in final 2:00 at Missouri (Jan. 15) to seal Gamecocks' win
- Grabbed pair of rebounds during game-changing 5-0 run midway through 2nd half vs. \#10/11 Kentucky (Jan. 11)
- Snared six of her team-high 10 rebounds at \#9/8 Duke (Dec. 7) in the second half, including two defensive in the critical final two minutes of the comeback win


## Freshman Year (2013-14)

- Became first SEC Freshman of the Year in league history to also earn another "of the Year" award with selection as Co-6th Player of the Year from the league's coaches
- Named SEC Newcomer of the Year by the Associated Press and earned Freshman All-America honors from Full Court
- Earned Second-Team All-SEC honors and was named SEC Freshman of the Week a league-record-tying five times
- Played in all 34 games, including one start (LA Tech)
- Was the only freshman to rank among SEC's top-25 scorers (23rd) and top-20 rebounders (sixth)
- Finished third in SEC and 41 st in nation with 2.1 blocks per game, ranking her seventh among the nation's freshmen
- Was fifth-best rebounding freshman in the country (8.4 rpg)
- Set Gamecock freshman record with 73 blocked shots to rank second in the all-time single-season standings
- Also posted program freshman records with .612 (148-242) field goal percentage and 10 double-doubles
- Led team in scoring seven times (Chas. Southern, at San Diego St., SC State, Vandy, Ole Miss, vs. Georgia, vs. UNC)
