FOR STARTERS

South Carolina (12-3) begins a two-game series on Tuesday hosting Penn State (1-8) at Carolina Stadium. Both Tuesday's and Wednesday's games are set for 7 p.m. This is South Carolina's first meeting vs. the Nittany Lions on the baseball diamond since 1912.

RANKINGS

South Carolina is ranked in every publication. The Gamecocks are No. 7 by Baseball America, D1Baseball and Perfect Gane, No. 8 in the USA TODAY coaches poll and No. 10 by Collegiate Baseball.

TO ARMS

South Carolina did not allow an earned run the entire weekend vs. Miami (Ohio) with a pair of shutouts, 2-0, 7-0 and a 5-3 victory on Sunday with the RedHawks scoring all three runs unearned. The Gamecock pitching staff allowed just 11 hits in 27.0 innings pitched with seven walks to 25 strikeouts. Miami hit just .124 for the weekend.

CLOSING IN ON 100

South Carolina head coach Chad Holbrook is one win shy of 100 career wins with a 99-41 (.707) career record in his third season at the helm of the Gamecock program.

JACK OF ALL TRADES

Junior left-hander Jack Wynkoop won his third straight game with eight scoreless innings of work allowing three hits and one walk while striking out five batters in a 7-0 victory over Miami. Wynkoop tied his career longest stint at eight innings, the fourth time he has reached that mark in his career and the second time this season. Wynkoop is 3-1 with a 2.00 ERA on the year with 23 strikeouts to five walks in 27.0 innings pitched. Opponents are hitting .196 against him. Wynkoop's 27.0 innings is tied for second-highest among SEC pitchers.

Wynkoop earned the Tom Price Award as Gamecock MVP of the Clemson series. Wynkoop worked six-plus innings and allowed just one run in the 4-1 victory vs. the Tigers.

Wynkoop is in the weekend rotation for a third straight year. He has made 31 starts in his career, that is second-highest among all returning SEC pitchers.

GORE IN A GROOVE

Sophomore infielder Jordan Gore was South Carolina's top hitter in the Miami series batting .444 (4-for-9) with a pair of runs scored. Gore has a five-game hitting streak, in which he has hit .385 (5-for-13). Gore is among the team's leading hitters with a .313 average (15-for-48) on the year with seven runs scored and 10 RBI.

CONE LEADS IT OFF

Sophomore outfielder Gene Cone had hit safely in the first 11 games this year before his streak was snapped on Wednesday vs. High Point. Cone has reached base safely in all 15 games this year. He is hitting .340 (17-for-50) with 15 runs scored with 11 walks to nine strikeouts and a .484 on-base percentage. Cone's 15 runs scored are tied for seventh-highest in the SEC.

IN THE CROWE'S NEST

Sophomore right-hander Wil Crowe hurled seven scoreless innings with just five hits allowed, three walks and eight strikeouts in the 2-0 victory over Miami on Friday night to earn the win. Crowe is 2-1 with a 3.47 ERA with 31 strikeouts to just seven walks in 23.1 innings of work. Crowe's 31 strikeouts are third-best in the SEC.

Crowe won game one of the doubleheader vs. College of Charleston as he shut down the Cougars going 6.1 innings and allowing just one run on four hits with three walks and a career-high 10 strike-outs. Crowe's 10 strikeouts tied for the most by a SEC pitcher over the weekend. Crowe bested his previous career mark of nine that he set twice, the last time vs. Vanderbilt on May 17, 2014.

Crowe is among the top sophomores in the country. Crowe earned Freshman All-America honors last year as he went 8-3 with a 2.75 ERA in 15 starts with 59 strikeouts to 19 walks in 91.2 innings pitched. Opponents hit just .228 against him. He did not allow a stolen base either.

Crowe is one of 50 players in the nation to be named to USA Baseball's Golden Spikes Award Preseason Watch List.

KEY HITS FROM KOCH

Sophomore catcher Logan Koch hit a game-winning two-run homer in Friday's 2-0 win over Miami and followed that up with a two-run single with the bases loaded in Saturday's 7-0 win. Koch hit .375 (3-for-8) in the Miami series and raised his batting average to .212 for the year in the three wins.

A CLOSER LOOK AT WIDENER

Sophomore right-hander Taylor Widener picked up a pair of saves in the Miami series and retired all four batters he faced over the weekend. Widener got one out in the 2-0 win on Friday and pitched a perfect inning of relief in Saturday's 5-3 win. Widener is 5-for-5 in save opportunities this year. He has a 1.17 ERA with 15 strikeouts in 7.2 innings. Opponents are hitting .080 against him. Widener's five saves is tied for second-most in the SEC.

VINNY

Junior left-hander Vince Fiori allowed just one run, unearned, on one hit in 3.1 innings of relief to earn a win in Sunday's 5-3 victory. Fiori struck out four and walked just one. He also had 1.2 perfect innings in Friday's 2-0 win. Fiori leads the Gamecocks with eight relief appearances and is 2-0 with a 0.69 ERA. He has 12 strikeouts in 13.0 innings with opponents hitting .103 against him. Fiori is tied for fifth in the SEC in appearances for the year.

K-MART

Senior first baseman Kyle Martin hit .400 (6-for-15) in the five victories last week. Martin drove in eight runs in those victories and tied a career-high with four RBI including a two-run homer in the 11-3 win over High Point. For the season, Martin is batting .340 (17-for-50) with two homers, two doubles, 12 runs scored and 15 RBI. Martin's 15 RBI ties him for eight-highest in the SEC.

Martin elected to return for his final season after being selected in the 20th round of the 2014 MLB Draft by the Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim. Martin was Carolina's leading hitter last year batting .336 (82-for-244) with 35 runs scored, 11 doubles, five homers and 38 RBI, a .389 on-base percentage and a .443 slugging percentage. He started all 62 games at first base.

Martin averaged 1.32 hits per game last year, tied for highest among SEC returning leaders. His .336 average is second-highest among returning SEC players as well.

SCHMIDT CONTRIBUTES

Freshman right-hander Clarke Schmidt made his first career start in Sunday's 5-3 win over Miami. Schmidt allowed just two runs, both unearned, on two hits in 4.2 innings with two walks and a careerhigh four strikeouts. Schmidt did not allow a hit until two outs into the fifth inning. Schmidt is 2-0 with a 2.35 ERA on the year. He has 14 strikeouts to only two walks in 15.1 innings.

Schmidt has a pair of wins in relief. Schmidt worked 4.2 scoreless innings with just three hits allowed, no walks and four strikeouts in the 5-2 win over Furman. He followed that up with 2.1 innings of work in a 6-4 win over Northeastern allowing one run on five hits with no walks and three strikeouts.

MAX IT OUT

Junior infielder Max Schrock drove in six runs in the five wins this past week including his first homer of the year, a two-run shot in the 11-3 win over High Point. Schrock owns a .385 on-base percentage with a team-high 16 walks to only two strikeouts. Schrock's 16 walks are tied for the league lead in the SEC.

DYNAMIC DESTINO

Freshman Alex Destino hit a grand slam in Tuesday's 10-4 win over Charleston Southern and followed that up with a 3-for-5 day at the plate with two RBI in the 11-5 victory over High Point. Destino is batting .327 (16-for-49) with three homers and 13 RBI on the year. His .531 slugging percentage leads the team.

CALDWELL A HIT

Senior outfielder Elliott Caldwell continues to lead the Gamecocks in hitting with a .357 average (15-for-42) with eight runs scored and seven RBI. He owns a .471 on-base percentage.

START THEM UP

Gene Cone and Max Schrock have started all 15 games this year for the Gamecocks with all of Cone's 15 starts in center field.

A BRIGHT SPOT

Senior outfielder Connor Bright hit his first career grand slam and the second grand slam of the season for the Gamecocks in the 7-0 win over Miami on Saturday afternoon. Bright is tied for the teamlead in homers with three and has driven in 12 runs as well. He also has nine runs scored. Bright tied a career-high with three runs scored in Saturday's 7-0 win.

DC DELIVERS

Junior infielder DC Arendas reached base in all four plate appearances vs. Charleston Southern with three walks and a hit by pitch. He followed that up going 2-for-2 with two runs in the win over High Point. Arendas is hitting .273 with a .543 on-base percentage.

MOONEY IN THE MIDDLE

Junior infielder Marcus Mooney jumpstarted a six-run seventh inning in the 10-4 win over Charleston Southern and went 2-for-3 with two runs and a RBI in the 11-3 victory over High Point. Mooney is batting .267 for the season.

PRESTON WITH PRECISION

Junior right-hander Preston Johnson retired all 11 batters he faced for 3.2 perfect innings with five strikeouts and earned his first career win in his first career appearance in the 11-3 victory over High Point.

PARKE PROVIDES RELIEF

Sophomore left-hander John Parke earned his first career win with 1.1 scoreless innings of relief in the 10-4 win over Charleston Southern. Parker has six strikeouts in 4.2 innings pitched with a 0.00 ERA in five relief appearances.

GREAT SCOTT

Sophomore right-hander Reed Scott allowed just one run, unearned, on three hits in 2.1 innings with two walks and two strikeouts in the 10-4 win over Charleston Southern. Scott has a 3.12 ERA in five relief appearances.

ON THE MOUND

South Carolina pitchers own a team ERA of 2.35 with 46 runs allowed, 35 earned, on 114 hits with 129 strikeouts to 44 walks in 134.0 innings. The Gamecocks have allowed opponents to hit just .228 on the year. The Gamecocks' ERA ranks sixth-best in the league.

AT THE PLATE & ON THE FIELD

South Carolina is batting .268 (125-for-467) as a team with 88 runs scored and a .374 on-base percentage. The Gamecocks are fielding .968 as well.

SUPERLATIVES

South Carolina is 12-0 on the year when allowing five runs or less. South Carolina is 11-0 on the year with a lead entering the seventh innings. The Gamecocks are 9-0 when allowing less than 10 hits, 6-0 when recording double-digit hits and 8-0 when out-hitting its opponent. South Carolina is 5-1 in games decided by three runs or less.

HOME RUNS

Bright and Destino's three homers ties both of them for fourth highest in the SEC. South Carolina has 11 homers as a team for the season.

AND THEN THERE WAS ONE

South Carolina senior outfielder Patrick Harrington is the last remaining active Gamecock player that was a member of the 2011 national championship team.

Harrington saw action in 26 games last year with 16 starts and compiled a .319 on=base percentage with five runs scored and nine RBI.

GAMECOCK NEWCOMERS

South Carolina baseball's recruiting class was ranked as high No. 5 in the nation as announced by Baseball America. It is the second consecutive year the Gamecocks have brought in a Top 5 class as last year's group was ranked No. 3 in the country by Baseball America.

STUDENT ASSISTANT COACHES

Two former Gamecocks will serve as student assistant coaches this year. Former infielder Scott Wingo (2008-11) and former catcher Justin Dalles (2009) have returned to campus to complete their degree requirements and are serving on the staff this year.

Dalles spent three seasons in the Baltimore Orioles organization, one year with the Philadelphia Phillies and last year in the Independent League. Dalles lettered in 2009 and earned second-team All-SEC honors on the way to being a sixth round MLB draft choice by the Orioles. Dalles hit .324 with 15 homers and 47 RBI to help lead the Gamecocks to a NCAA regional appearance.

Wingo spent the past three seasons in the Los Angeles Dodgers organization. Wingo was a four-year letterwinner at South Carolina from 2008-11 and played on both national championship teams in 2010 and 2011. Wingo served as captain his senior year in 2011, earned first-team All-SEC honors and was the Most Outstanding Player at the College World Series. He was also a two-time SEC All-Defensive team selection. Wingo played in 254 career games with the Garnet & Black, the second highest total in school history.

THIS IS SOUTH CAROLINA BASEBALL

South Carolina earned its 15th straight trip to the NCAA Regional as the 2014 team finished 44-18 and finished ranked as high as No. 22 by the USA Today coaches' poll. South Carolina went 18-12 in the SEC and is one of only two schools in the conference to finish among the top four teams in the league in both 2013 and 2014 and one of four schools in the SEC to win at least 40 games in both 2013 and 2014. South Carolina is also one of only nine schools in the nation to host a NCAA Regional in 2013 and 2014.

South Carolina won the NCAA Division I Baseball Championship in 2010 and 2011 at the College World Series. South Carolina has 11 College World Series appearances, including six in the last 13 years. The Gamecocks own the second-highest win total in the nation in the last 15 years (2000 to the present) with a 713-289 record. South Carolina is one of five schools to appear in the NCAA Regional every season in the last 15 years, including 11 NCAA Super Regional appearances in that span, one of only two schools to accomplish the feat.

Head Coach Chad Holbrook

Chad Holbrook begins his third year as head coach of the South Carolina program after directing the Gamecocks in 2014 to a 15th consecutive appearance in the NCAA Tournament. Holbrook is the only head coach in South Carolina history to have led a team to the NCAA Regionals in his first two years as head coach. His SEC winning percentage of .593 is the highest of any South Carolina coach in the first two seasons of the league and his overall winning percentage of .696 is the second-highest of any South Carolina coach in his first two seasons at the helm of the program.

The 2014 team finished 44-18 and finished ranked as high as No. 22 by the USA Today coaches' poll. South Carolina went 18-12 in the SEC and is one of only two schools in the conference to finish among the top four teams in the league in both 2013 and 2014 and one of four schools in the SEC to win at least 40 games in both 2013 and 2014. South Carolina is also one of only nine schools in the nation to host a NCAA Regional in 2013 and 2014.

Among the highlights in 2014 included a series sweep of instate rival Clemson. Holbrook's team would claim six SEC series including a pair of wins at eventual national champion Vanderbilt as well as a series victory vs. CWS participant Ole Miss. South Carolina hosted a NCAA Regional for the fifth-straight year marking the Gamecocks as one of only two schools in the nation to claim that distinction. Gamecock Nation flocked to Carolina Stadium as South Carolina set a total attendance record at 305,564 in 2014, the first time South Carolina eclipsed the 300,000-plus mark. South Carolina also set a record with 5,957 season tickets sold.

The 2014 Gamecocks led the SEC with a 2.43 earned run average that ranked ninth in the nation. The pitching staff was among the best in the country with 13 shutouts, fifth-highest in the nation, a strikeout-to-walk ratio of 3.03, sixth-best in the country and a 1.12 WHIP that was eighth overall. South Carolina hit .281 as a team with a .361 team on-base percentage and fielded .975 as well.

South Carolina would have seven players selected in the 2014 MLB Draft including five players in the first 11 rounds. Highlighting that group was junior catcher Grayson Greiner, who was a third round pick and the No. 99 overall selection by the Detroit Tigers. Greiner was a second-team All-America honoree by Baseball America and Perfect Game and was named he 2013-14 USC Co-Male Student-Athlete of the Year alongside Gamecock football/basketball standout Bruce Ellington. He would also be a semi-finalist for the Johnny Bench Award for the top catcher in college baseball and a member of the SEC All-Defensive team. Greiner played in 60 games with 58 starts, hit .311 (66-for-212) with 39 runs scored, 50 RBI, 13 doubles and eight homers, also a .389 on-base percentage and a .486 slugging mark. Greiner hit a team-best .327 (37-for-113) in league games with four homers and 24 RBI vs. SEC teams. Junior left-handed pitcher Jordan Montgomery was a 4th round selection by the New York Yankees after leading the pitching staff with an 8-5 record and a 3.42 ERA in a team-high 100 innings with 95 strikeouts. Montgomery became the 22nd pitcher in school history to reach the 20-win total as well. Junior infielder Joey Pankake was

a seventh round pick by the Tigers. He became the 26th player in school history to tally 200 or more hits with a double in the second inning of the Florida game at the SEC Tournament on May 22. He finished his career with 204 hits in the Garnet & Black. He started 58 games and hit .303 (67-for-221) with a team-high 52 runs scored. Junior outfielder Tanner English went in the 11th round to the Minnesota Twins after manning the center field position the entre year with 62 starts and being named to the SEC All-Defensive team. Joel Seddon also was selected in the 11th round after earning second-team All-America honors from the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association with 14 saves. He was also a second-team All-SEC choice. Junior first baseman Kyle Martin was South Carolina's best hitter with a .336 average (82-for-244) and would be picked in the 20th round but chose to return to school for the 2015 season. Right-handed pitcher Evan Beal rounded out the group as a 21st round choice by the Royals. A Gamecock newcomer also found success as freshman righthanded pitcher Wil Crowe earned Freshman All-America honors as announced by Collegiate Baseball on Wednesday morning. In his first season, Crowe went 8-3 in 15 starts with a 2.75 ERA in 91.2 innings pitched. Crowe allowed just 32 runs, 28 earned, on 76 hits with 19 walks and 59 strikeouts. Crowe was strong in his last start with the Garnet and Black as he pitched four-hit complete game shutout in a 9-0 win vs. Campbell in the NCAA Regional that earned him All-Tournament Team honors. Crowe earmed SEC Pitcher of the Week and SEC Freshman of the Week also.

The Gamecocks also shined off the field as Greiner continued a streak of a Gamecock making the Capital One Academic All-America teams to four years, following LB Dantzler's Academic All-America Division I Baseball Player of the Year nod last season and Michael Roth's two selections to the first team in 2011-12.

Holbrook's first season as head coach in 2013 saw the Gamecocks compile a 43-20 record and the school's 11th NCAA Super Regional appearance. Holbrook directed the 2013 squad to a final national ranking of No. 12 in the USA Today Baseball Coaches Poll along with No. 13 by Collegiate Baseball and Perfect Game and No. 14 by Baseball America.

Among the 2013 highlights was a series victory against Clemson, four sweeps of SEC teams and six SEC series victories including a pair of wins at LSU, the only team to go into Baton Rouge in 2013 and claim a three-game set. South Carolina hosted a NCAA Regional for the fourth straight year with the Gamecocks going undefeated in three games and continuing a run of 27 straight postseason wins at home including a 16-0 mark at Carolina Stadium. South Carolina ended the 2013 season with a total attendance of 260,605, third highest in the country.

Chad Holbrook was named head baseball coach for the University of South Carolina on July 16, 2012. Holbrook was promoted to the top spot by athletics director Ray Tanner after four seasons as associate head coach and recruiting coordinator for the Gamecocks. Holbrook came to South Carolina in July 2008 as associate head coach. Along with his recruiting coordinator duties, he served as hitting instructor, overseeing the Gamecock offense, including base running and the short game and was the third base coach. He also worked with the outfielders. Holbrook came to the Gamecock program after serving 15 seasons as a member of the University of North Carolina coaching staff. Holbrook was the 2011 ABCA/Baseball America Assistant Coach of the Year after the Gamecocks won a second consecutive national championship.
