## Sophomore Year (2010-11)

Ranked sixth in the SEC in offensive rebounding (3.0 per game) ... in SEC play, ranked 29th in scoring ... led the team in rebounding 13 times and was the leading scorer three times ... reached double-figure points in seven SEC games ... grabbed three of her five rebounds against Charlotte on the offensive end to go with eight points in the second round of the WNIT ... turned in her second perfect shooting game of the season (6-of-6) against Appalachian State in the first round of the WNIT ... pulled down five rebounds in just nine minutes against Georgia in second round of SEC Tournament ... scored three tough baskets and handed out two assists in SEC Tournament game against Ole Miss ... posted second-straight 14-point game and led the way with seven rebounds at LSU ... paced the team with six boards against Auburn, including five offensive, to finish with 14 points ... netted both her shot attempts, including a layup in the last 20 seconds of the overtime win at Arkansas ... led the team in scoring and rebounding at Auburn ... snagged seven rebounds for the third-straight game and netted 10 points in win over #20/24 Georgia ... added seven points and seven boards while handing out a career-best three assists against Alabama ... narrowly missed her fourth double-double of the season with eight points and nine rebounds, including four offensive, in OT win at Ole Miss, recording six points and six rebounds in the second half to help hold off a late push by the Rebels ... tied the best perfect game in arena history with an 8-of-8 outing against Florida, netting 16 points in a career-high 34 minutes ... swiped the game-changing steal in the final five seconds of comeback against LSU, netting 11 points and pulling in six rebounds, all offensive, as well ... turned in her third double-double of the season with 16 points and 11 rebounds, both game highs, at Georgia ... netted a career-best 18 points against Savannah State, including 15 in the second half, while swatting away four shots for the second-straight game ... swatted away a career-best four shots against Charleston Southern and added eight points ... snagged six offensive rebounds at #3/2 Stanford, leading the team with seven total boards ... recorded her second-consecutive double-double with 11 points and 12 boards against Illinois, the second-straight year a Gamecock has opened the season with consecutive double-double games ... posted her first career double-double in her first career start, collecting 17 points and 15 rebounds against #5/6 Xavier in the season opener.

## Junior Year (2010-11)

Played in every game this season, including two starting assignments ... closed the season with four straight double-figure scoring games and was team's top scorer in postseason play with 12.3 ppg ... was second on team with 11 points in second round of WNIT against Charlotte ... netted 12 points and handed out three assists against Appalachian State in WNIT first round ... led team with 13.0 points and 7.5 rebounds per game in SEC Tournament ... paced team in scoring (13) and rebounding (6), including four offensive boards in second round against Georgia ... delivered eight of her 13 points and four of her game-high nine rebounds in the second half of SEC Tournament game against Ole Miss ... added seven points against Vanderbilt, including five during a second-half run to take the lead ... was second on team with five rebounds against Auburn ... scored five of her nine points in two-minute span to break a tie and give Gamecocks their final lead at Mississippi State ... netted six of her 12 points against #15/18 Kentucky during an 8-0 first-half run that gave Gamecocks a lead they would not relinquish, and tied for team-high honors with eight rebounds ... posted eight points, including a 3-pointer in each half, to go with five rebounds at Arkansas ... drew her first career start against #20/24 Georgia ... provided huge spark off the bench against Alabama, scoring 14 points and snagging six rebounds (four offensive) in just 24 minutes ... ramped up the team's defense against #5/6 Tennessee, swiping a pair of steals, including one that resulted in a layup that cut the lead to five with 5:00 to play ... came off bench to spark comeback against LSU, hitting 3-of-4 3-pointers en route to 12 points and disrupting the Lady Tiger offense with a pair of steals ... swiped three steals and handed out four assists in win over arch-rival Clemson ... helped key crucial second-half run against Illinois with a steal and finished the game with seven points and three assists ... made her Gamecock debut against #5/6 Xavier, adding 12 points and three assists.

## At College of Central Florida

Played two seasons for Coach Cheryl Rice's Patriots ... helped team to combined 40-22 record and two runner-up finishes in Mid-Florida Conference ... earned third-team NJCAA All-America and first-team FCCAA All-State honors as a sophomore, leading team with 17.7 ppg ... ranked among NJCAA's top 20 in assists per game (5.2, 16th) and steals per game (3.5, 16th) that season ... two-time first-team all-conference selection ... twice led FCCAA in 3-point field goal percentage.
