GAMECOCKS TRAVEL TO TAR HEEL INVITATIONAL

Top-ranked South Carolina women's golf travels to Chapel Hill, N.C., this weekend for the Tar Heel Invitational, a 54-hole stroke play event at the UNC Finley Golf Course. The three-day event is set to begin on Friday morning at the par-72, 6,379-yard course.

LAST TIME OUT

The Gamecocks kicked off the season in impressive fashion, besting a field that featured 11 of the top 13 teams in the country by seven strokes at the ANNIKA Intercollegiate in Reunion, Fla. South Carolina fired a 10-under 854 at the event to take home the title. Senior Justine Dreher captured medalist honors with a 9-under 207 to lead the team. On the final day of competition all five golfers finished the day at par or better and recorded nine birdies on the back nine to pull away from the field. The Gamecocks swept Golfweek's weekly honors with the team earning Team of the Week honors and Dreher garnering Player of the Week recognition.

WHO'S NO. 1?

For the first time in program history, the Gamecocks earned a No. 1 ranking after their head-turning win at the ANNIKA. In a record-breaking season in 2013-14, South Carolina reached as high as No. 4 in the Golfweek rankings and No. 5 according to Golfstat.

THE LINEUP

Senior ANNIKA Intercollegiate medalist Justine Dreher, freshman Nanna Madsen, junior Mary Fran Hillow and sophomores Jia Xin Yang and Katelyn Dambaugh are set to make the trip for the Gamecocks. Freshman Ainoah Olarra will make her collegiate debut, competing as an individual.

HISTORY AT THE TAR HEEL INVITATIONAL

This marks South Carolina's 27th trip to the Tar Heel Invitational. Last season, the Gamecocks finished in a tie for fifth place at 14-over par (299-291-288=878). Justine Dreher was the top South Carolina finisher, carding a 2-under 214 with rounds of 70, 71 and 73. Then-No. 4 Duke took the team title and was the only team to finish under par, completing the tournament at 7-under (857). Ashlan Ramsey from Clemson earned medalist honors at 9-under.

RECORDS ARE FALLING

After starting the season a few weeks later than usual because of freshman Nanna Madsen's trip to the Women's World Amateur Team Championship, the Gamecocks matched their 54-hole score at last year's NCAA East Regional with an 854, the second-lowest 54-hole score in program history. Dreher equaled All-American Kristy McPherson's 2001 SEC Championship score of 207 as the lowest individual 54-hole score in school history.

WHO'S BACK

Three of the five golfers from the Gamecocks' core lineup in 2013-14, including Dreher and sophomore All-SEC honoree Katelyn Dambaugh, return. Junior Sarah Schmelzel, an SEC All-Freshman selection in the 2012-13 season, is back as well. Nearly every returning player has been in the Gamecock lineup at some point in her career.

RECORD BREAKING

Climbing as high as No. 4, South Carolina finished last season at No. 6 in the Golfstat rankings. The team finished in the top six at every regular-season tournament and registered nine straight top-five finishes for the first time in program history. A pair of wins at the Florida State Match-Up and PING ASU Invitational as well as runner-up finishes at the SEC Championship and NCAA East Regional also highlighted the season.

AN INTERNATIONAL SUMMER

A pair of Gamecocks represented their home countries in international competition over the summer. Justine Dreher and Team France captured the European Ladies Amateur Team crown in Slovenia, defeating England, Spain and Finland. Dreher went undefeated at the match play event.

Before coming to Columbia, Nanna Madsen won the Danish International Ladies Amateur by four strokes. She then went to the Women's World Amateur Team Championship in Japan and led Denmark to a fourth-place finish. Madsen reached No. 3 in the Women's World Amateur Rankings after the event.

UP NEXT FOR THE GAMECOCKS

South Carolina continues the fall season at the Mercedes-Benz Collegiate Championship in Knoxville, Tenn. The event is set for Fri., Oct. 17 – Sun., Oct. 19, at the Cherokee Golf Club.
