Mark Berson, one of three coaches all-time to post 450 victories while an NCAA Division I head coach, begins his 37th season at the helm of the South Carolina soccer program in 2014. Berson has been at South Carolina from the beginning. He was hired to move the program to varsity status in 1978, and he quickly put Carolina on the map.

Before coming to Carolina in 1978, Berson went 11-5-0 in one season at The Citadel, making his overall record 462-205-68, a .675 winning percentage. In 2006, Berson became one of five active (at that time) Division I coaches and the 10th all-time to reach the 400-victory milestone when his Gamecocks defeated UAB, 2-0, in a televised contest at Stone Stadium. Berson now has a 451-200-68 record at South Carolina.

Berson has taken the Gamecocks to 20 NCAA Tournaments, with those teams advancing to at least the second round 11 times. His squads have four quarterfinal and two NCAA College Cup appearances to their credit as well. In 1993, the Gamecocks advanced to the NCAA Championship Game.

Though Carolina has been independent during the majority of the program's tenure, the Gamecocks have captured four conference titles under Berson's leadership. Carolina won the 1993 Metro Conference Championship in one of its two years competing in the conference. The Gamecocks joined Conference USA in 2005 and promptly claimed the league's tournament championship and automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament, while Carolina also won the C-USA Championship Tournament in 2010 and collected the regular season championship in 2011.

Besides making an impact in collegiate soccer, Berson's presence is also felt within the professional ranks. The Gamecocks are one of only two collegiate programs to have had a player on each of the last four United States World Cup teams. Josh Wolff competed on the United States World Cup team for the second time during the summer of 2006 and was also an Olympic team member in 2000. Clint Mathis, a teammate of Wolff during his time at Carolina, also enjoyed a celebrated professional career that spanned 11 seasons in Major League Soccer. Mathis, who retired from professional soccer in 2010, was a member of the 2002 U.S. World Cup squad and helped his MLS team, Real Salt Lake, capture the MLS Cup in 2009. Mathis also graced the cover of Sports Illustrated in May 2002 prior to the World Cup, marking the third Gamecock athlete, in any sport, to be featured on the cover of the prestigious magazine. Former Gamecock goalkeeper Brad Guzan was honored during the summer of 2010 with a roster spot on the U.S. Men's National Team for the 2010 FIFA World Cup in South Africa. The netminder continued the Gamecocks' streak with a roster spot for the 2014 FIFA World Cup in Brazil.

Berson led Carolina to a 113-39-12 mark (.726) in the 1990s, which rated the Gamecocks as one of the winningest programs in NCAA Division I soccer. In 1998, Berson earned the inaugural Independent Coach of the Year award after leading Carolina to the best record of all Independent schools. Berson has also been honored as the National Soccer Coaches Association of America (NSCAA) Coach of the Year in the South Region on four occasions (1984, 1985, 1988, 1995).

Berson has been involved in soccer development as a coach, teacher and administrator on many levels. He is a U.S. Soccer National Instructional Staff Coach with an "A" coaching license and has served as a US Soccer National Instructional staff coach since 1989. He has served as State Coach for the South Carolina Youth Soccer Association (SCYSA), working in player development and coaching certification. In 1992, he was inducted into the South Carolina Youth Soccer Association Hall of Fame.

Berson also coached the U.S. National U-18 team in the Granatkin/Leningrad Tournament in January 1989, in the Soviet Union. In July 1987, he directed the South team to the gold medal in the U.S. Olympic Festival in Durham, N.C., one year after serving as an assistant coach for the South squad.

A 1971 graduate of Summit (N.J.) High School, Berson attended the University of North Carolina and received his bachelor of arts degree in journalism in 1975. Berson played on the Tar Heel soccer squad for four years, one as a midfielder and the other three in goal. As a senior, Berson received the UNC Educational Foundation Award and was a member of the Academic ACC Honor Roll. Berson earned his master's of education degree in sport administration from Ohio University in 1977.

Born March 16, 1953, in Hartford, Conn., Berson is married to the former Shauna Hopkins, a South Carolina alum, of Columbia. They have two children, Erin Rhea, and Luke William. Erin graduated from South Carolina in 2009, and Luke is currently enrolled at the University of South Carolina in the Moore School of Business.

# 2014 SOUTH CAROLINA GAMECOCK MEN'S SOCCER

## SOUTH CAROLINA TEAM NOTES

- South Carolina returns 18 letter-winners to go with nine newcomers for 2014.
- The Gamecocks return 80 percent of their goals and 76 percent of their assists from last year.
- Included in that returning group is the top-two goal scorers (Jeffrey Torda and Mahamoudou Kaba) and the top-two assist distributors (Kurtis Turner and Ryan Arambula).
- Also back is all but 30 minutes in goal from last year.
- Four Conference USA award winners return, including defenders Mahamoudou "Mo" Kaba and Braeden Troyer as well as 2013 All-Freshman Team members midfielder Kurtis Turner and goalkeeper Marco Velez.
- Both Kaba and Troyer made the C-USA Preseason team, with Kaba garnering the Defensive Player of the Year title.
- The Gamecocks enter 2014 with an all-time record of 451-200-68 (.656).

## GAMECOCKS LOVE OPENERS (AND HOME OPENERS TOO)

- In the 36-year history of Gamecock men's soccer, the program holds a 30-5-1 mark in the first match of the year.
- That mark improves to 31-4-1 in the first home match of the season.
- This will be the 30th time the Gamecocks have started their year at home.
- In those 30 wins to start the year, 17 have come in shutouts, including five in the last seven years.

## GAMECOCKS HAVE A RICH HISTORY IN NCAA TOURNAMENT

- On 20 occasions, the Gamecocks made an NCAA Tournament, the most in Conference USA.
- South Carolina is 16-19-1 in the tourney, making two College Cups in 1988 and 1993.
- Eleven times, the Gamecocks made the NCAA Tournament Round of 16.

## GAMECOCKS CELEBRATING 10 YEARS IN CONFERENCE USA

- The 2014 season is South Carolina's 10th as a men's soccer affiliate member of Conference USA.
- In 2011, the Garnet and Black captured the league's regular-season crown, sharing it with UAB.
- Twice, the Gamecocks have won the league's tournament (2005 and 2010).
- South Carolina's student-athletes have taken 40 all-league nods, with 14 coming on the first team.
- In C-USA outings, South Carolina owns a 35-23-16 (.581) mark. At Stone Stadium, that record is 19-11-6 (.611).

## BERSON RANKS AMONG TOP COACHES IN NCAA HISTORY

- The only head coach in South Carolina men's soccer history, Mark Berson ranks as one of four coaches in NCAA Division I history with 450 wins at one institution.
- With 462 career wins (including 11 in 1977 at The Citadel), he's seventh on the NCAA Division I and 18th on the NCAA All-Divisions wins list, four in back of former SMU coach Schellas Hyndman.
- He's coached 11 players who have captured 13 All-America nods at South Carolina.

## THE FIELD'S NOT THE ONLY PLACE THE GAMECOCKS SHINE

- South Carolina's 18 returners have a total of 30 SEC Academic Honor Roll certificates and 31 Conference USA Academic Honor Roll notations between them.
- Of those, 10 are Conference USA Academic Medal mentions, which is awarded to student-athletes with a 3.75 cumulative GPA or higher.
- Four of the seniors, Robert Beebe, Mahamoudou "Mo" Kaba, Asa Kryst and Braeden Troyer have three certificates each.
- Troyer has three of those Academic Medals, while both Ryan Arambula and Jeffrey Torda have two.

## TROYER'S CHASING SPOTS IN HISTORY

- Senior Braeden Troyer leads all returners with 10 career goals, tied for seventh in Gamecock history during the Conference USA era (since 2005).
- Twice he's been named to the C-USA All-Academic Team, and he has three All-C-USA nods, ('12 second team, '11 & 13 third team).
- He also made the 2011 Conference USA All-Freshman Team.
- On two occasions, CoSIDA has voted him on the Capital One Academic All-District 4 team.

## WE SCHEDULED STRONG FOES

- Of the 17 regular-season matches scheduled this season for the Gamecocks, 12 come against top-100 RPI teams in the final 2013 report from the NCAA.
- Seven of those rank in the top 50, four from Conference USA (Charlotte, UAB, Old Dominion & New Mexico).
- Four foes made the NSCAA/Continental Tire Preseason Top 25, well, 26 when you count Old Dominion tying for the 25th spot with Navy.

### SCOUTING BELMONT

- The Bruins bring back eight starters from last year's 6-10-2 squad while also bringing in nine freshmen.
- Entering the Horizon League for their first year, Belmont also has a new coach in Bryan Green.
- Green spent the last four years as the associate head coach at Drexel, helping them to win two Colonial Athletic Association titles.
- Belmont lost its top goal scorer in Alfred Edmonds as well as Nico Olsak, who ranked second on the team with three assists.
- Leading the returners is goalkeeper Grayson Rector, who had a 1.24 goals against average while playing every minute in goal in 2013.
- Rector had five shutouts on the season.
- AJ Arnold leads the Bruin returners with four goals last year, while Raphael Colmanette tallied 10 points with three goals and a team-best four assists.
- Both Colmanette and Arnold joined Edmonds with two game-winning goals each.

## THE LAST OPENER - AUGUST 30, 2013

### SOUTH CAROLINA VS. EAST TENNESSEE STATE - STONE STADIUM

Midfielder Jeffrey Torda gave South Carolina a 1-0 season-opening victory over East Tennessee State. The Gamecocks edged the Buccaneers 9-6 in shots. South Carolina put five of their strikes on frame, with just one ETSU shot logged on goal. East Tennessee State was awarded three corner kicks to the Gamecocks' two. South Carolina's keeper Robert Beebe kicked off the season with a shutout, posting one save on the night, while Buccaneer netminder Ryan Coulter was saddled with the loss despite saving four Gamecock shots.

Carolina's first scoring threat of the night came just four minutes into the match. Midfielder Kurtis Turner hit a one-time volley from just outside the 18-yard box, which ETSU's Coulter blocked but directly into the path of Torda. He placed an attempt to the left side of frame, but Coulter scrambled to make the diving save.

After an ETSU foul with 22 minutes left in the opening half, midfielder Ryan Arambula sent a high shot towards frame, which Coulter just got a hand on to send the strike into the crossbar. Off the rebound, forward J.P. Rafferty looked for the far post, but Coulter once again held his line.

Torda scored the first tally of the 2013 campaign in the 26th minute on a rocket to the far post. After stealing the ball from an ETSU defender, Torda hit a shot to the far post past Coulter for a 1-0 Carolina advantage.

Just before the half, Gamecock striker Hamilton Carlin hit a shot directly at Coulter, who made his fourth save of the match to hold the score at 1-0 entering the break. Carolina held a 7-1 shot advantage in the opening half, including a 5-0 upperhand in shots on goal.

Beebe collected his first save of the match on a strike from ETSU midfielder Donte Brangman in the 72nd minute. Brangman collected a loose ball within the six-yard box, but the attempt was directly at Beebe.

ETSU attempted a flurry of offense in the final minutes of play, but the Gamecock defense held strong, clearing multiple attempts, to close the 1-0 victory.
