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GAMECOCKS READY FOR CHALLENGE AT 2014 SEC INDOOR CHAMPIONSHIPS

The Gamecocks travel west for the 2014 SEC Indoor Championships at Texas A&M's Gilliam Indoor Stadium in College Station, Texas. As always, a challenging field awaits South Carolina at the conference meet. Fifteen SEC teams, seven men and eight women are featured in this week's USTFCCCA's rankings.

With eight scoring positions up for grabs in each discipline, several South Carolina athletes are in position for a top-eight finish. On the men's side, four individuals – junior Kendall Kee (60m – 8th), sophomores Jermaine Collier (60mH – 4th) and Dondre Echols (60mH – 9th) and freshman Alexandre Asselin (heptathlon- 9th) along with the 4x400-meter relay (8th) – enter the weekend ranked in the conference's top 10.

The women's team features five individual athletes in the SEC top 10 – freshman Precious Holmes (400m – 8th), junior Erika Rucker (400m-10th), senior Jeannelle Scheper (high jump – 1st), sophomore Sarah Graham (high jump – 6th and pentathlon – 10th), and senior Petra Olsen (pole vault – 4th) – and the 4x400-meter relay (6th). Scheper is the defending SEC high jump champion and the current collegiate leader.



Action begins on Thursday, with the heptathlon and the pentathlon. The Gamecocks have an entry in each event in Asselin and Graham. A full slate of events is set for Friday, beginning with the men's 60-meter hurdles featuring sophomores Jermaine Collier and Dondre Echols, junior Andrew Seay in the men's weight throw and senior Petra Olsen in the women's pole vault. On Saturday, the event draws to a close. All three days are scheduled to being at 2 p.m., ET.

The SEC Indoor Championships will air as part of a 90-minute show on ESPNU on Monday, March 10, beginning at 7:30 p.m.

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A LOOK BACK: 2013 SEC INDOOR CHAMPIONSHIP

South Carolina's women's squad posted a sixth-place finish, its best since 2009, at the 2013 SEC Indoor Championships in Fayetteville, Ark., and the Gamecocks return over half of their scoring. Leading the way is defending SEC high jump champion Jeannelle Scheper. The senior, who captured the school's first high jump conference championship last season, will look to repeat the performance. In the pole vault, senior Petra Olsen looks to score for the fourth-straight year. Olsen would be the first Gamecock to achieve the feat. Last season, Olsen won bronze in the event. On the track, junior Erika Rucker will attempt to score for the third-straight season. Rucker. The 2012 SEC Freshman Indoor Runner of the Year has posted a fourth-place finish in the 400-meter dash the last two seasons and has also been a mainstay on the 4x400-meter relay. In 2013, Rucker helped the relay to a silver medal at the conference championships. Sophomore Tyler Brockington gives the Gamecocks a second returner on the relay.

Kayla Lampe, the 2013 SEC Indoor silver medalist in the 5,000-meter run, and Chalese Davis, a two-time scorer in the pentathlon, are redshirting the 2014 indoor season and will not compete.

The men's team will look to new faces to make an impact in College Station. With senior Clayton Gravesande (400 meters) and footballer Damiere Byrd (60 meters) out for the indoor season, South Carolina will not travel a returning individual scorer.

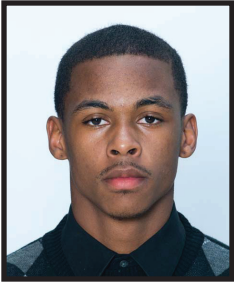

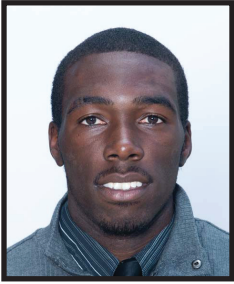
GAMECOCK MEN IN THE SEC TOP 10



KENDALL KEE • 60M • JR • SHELBY, N.C.

60m | 6.67 | VT Challenge (2/21) | SEC 8th | NCAA 22nd

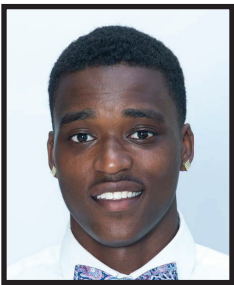
After the first two seasons of his career were riddled with injuries, Kee is finally healthy and is poised to make an impact. Kee began his season by shattering his 60-meter dash PR with a time of 6.68 at the Hokie Invitational (1/24). The time ranked him fifth in school history. After moving through the first five rounds the season as the top qualifier, Kee ultimately finished fourth in a stacked field at the Armory Collegiate Invitational (2/7). Last weekend, he reclaimed the top spot, running a new lifetime best of 6.67 at the VT Challenge for his third win in four 2014 meets. Kee is seeking his first points at an SEC championship event.



JERMAINE COLLIER • 60MH • SO • TRENTON, N.J.

60mH | 7.80 | VT Invite (1/17) | SEC 4th | NCAA 16th

Collier used a strong outdoor season to propel him to his best indoor season in the Garnet & Black. In his first 60-meter hurdle event of the season (1/17), Collier clocked his first sub-eight second time in the prelims (7.97) and followed it up with a PR of 7.80 in the finals. The time broke him into the South Carolina all-time top 10. At the Armory Collegiate (2/7), Collier looked to be on his way to another strong result, but was carded with a false start in the finals. Last weekend, Collier captured his first victory of the season, clocking in at 7.84 at the VT Challenge. While he did not score at last season's SEC Indoor Championships, Collier collected top-five finishes in the 110-meter and 400-meter hurdles at his first SEC Outdoors last season.



DONDRE ECHOLS • 60MH • SO • OXON HILL, MD.

60mH | 7.87 | Hilton Garden (1/31) | SEC 9th | NCAA 34th

As the only school with two athletes in the conference's top nine, the Gamecocks will look to take multiple spots in the 60-meter hurdle finals. Echols has finished in the top three in each of his three 60-meter hurdle finals this season. He posted a win at the Hilton Garden Invite (2/1) where he ran a personal best 7.87. Echols has not run since the Armory Collegiate (2/7) where he earned a ticket to the semis after winning his heat, but pulled out of the competition after slightly tweaking his hamstring. The hurdler is ready to go this weekend, though. Echols did not advance to the finals at last year's indoor championships, but captured a sixth-place finish in the 110-meter hurdles at SEC Outdoors in 2013.



4X400M RELAY

4x4 | 3:11.11 | VT Challenge (2/22) | SEC 8th

The men's relay team will look to lower their season's best time of 3:11.11 from last weekend at this weekend's championships. In their last meet at the VT Challenge, the Gamecocks collected their second win of the season, utilizing a foursome of junior Chris Royster, freshman Ryan Bermudez, sophomore Jermaine Collier and junior Chris Walker. In large part to injury, the Gamecocks have used the same quartet just twice this season. After a disqualification in 2013 at the SEC Championships, South Carolina hopes to return to a scoring position in 2014.



ALEXANDRE ASSELIN • HEPT. • FR • MERIGNIES, FRANCE

Hept. | 4,693 pts | Hilton Garden (1/31) | SEC 9th

A newcomer, Asselin has wasted no time in showing what he can do in the Garnet & Black. In his only heptathlon of the year at the Hilton Garden Invitational (1/31), Asselin posted a collegiate or personal best in five of seven events. He took a lead into day two after winning all four events, but was hindered by the pole vault when he failed to clear a bar. Ultimately, Asselin took third with 4,668 points. The next weekend, Asselin competed in the long jump at the Armory Collegiate (2/7) where he posted the seventh-best leap in school history at 23'9" (7.24m). This weekend is the Gamecock's SEC debut.

PRECIOUS HOLMES • 400M • FR. • NEW HAVEN, CONN.

400m | 53.33 | Armory Collegiate (2/7) | SEC 8th | NCAA 23rd

A 400-meter specialist, Holmes has already made a tremendous impact in her freshman season and is currently the second-fastest freshman in the SEC. A season that has featured two wins and no finish outside of the top five is highlighted by her breakout weekend at the Armory Collegiate (2/7). Holmes ran a collegiate best in the prelims (53.98) and then stormed to a second-place finish in the championship division with a personal best of 53.33. Holmes also gave the team a lead on the 4x4 relay on the leadoff leg that they did not surrender. The freshman contributed to 18 points as the team took third at their first scored meet of the season and was honored by the conference office as the SEC Freshman of the Week. Last weekend, she ran the fastest split of all competitors in the 4x4 to carry the Gamecocks to a win at meet-record pace.



ERIKA RUCKER • 400M • JR • FLOWERY BRANCH, GA.

400m | 54.04 | Armory Collegiate (2/7) | SEC 10th | NCAA 38th

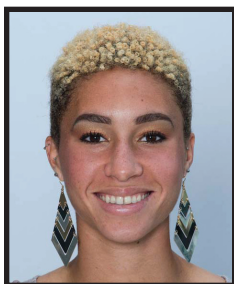
Despite a less than ideal indoor season due to injury and illness, Rucker is still in position to wrap up the indoor portion of her junior year on a high note. The 2012 SEC Freshman Indoor Runner of the Year has competed at just two meets this season, the Virginia Tech Invitational (1/18) and the Armory Collegiate (2/7), and has entered her signature 400 meters only once. In her lone 400-meter event of the season at the Armory, Rucker ran a best time of 54.04 in the finals to finish fifth in the championship division. In her first two seasons, Rucker has posted a fourth-place finish at the SEC Indoor Championships at the distance.



4X400M RELAY

4x4 | 3:34.97 | Armory Collegiate (2/7) | SEC 6th | NCAA 16th

At the 2013 SEC Indoor Championships, the Gamecocks brought home a silver medal. This year's quartet will look to perform at the same level. Already this season, South Carolina has won three events, including the championship division of the prestigious Armory Collegiate (2/7). Last weekend, the quartet of freshmen Precious Holmes, Briana Haith, Marisa Bellamy along with junior Tamera Harris ran their best time of the season at 3:34.97. The time broke a 15-year-old facility record at Virginia Tech's Rector Fieldhouse. Currently four spots out of qualifying position for the NCAA Indoor Championships, the ladies will run to punch their ticket to the event.



JEANNELLE SCHEPER • SR • HIGH JUMP • GROS-ISLET, ST. LUCIA

HJ | 6-02.75 // 1.90m | VT Invite (1/17) & VT Challenge (2/22) | SEC 1st | NCAA 1st

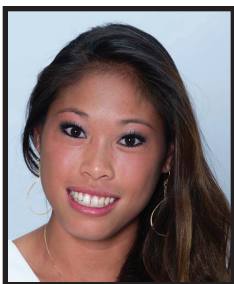
As the reigning SEC indoor high jump champion and current collegiate leader, Scheper enters the weekend as the favorite. Georgia freshman Leontia Kallenou is right on her heels, boasting the NCAA's second-best mark at 6'2" (1.88m). Scheper brings a fierce resume to College Station, though. She is undefeated in 2014, setting a facility record 6'2" $\frac{3}{4}$ (1.90m) at Virginia Tech's Rector Fieldhouse in her first meet of the season (1/18) and matched the effort last weekend. The St. Lucia native also won and set a meet record at the prestigious Armory Collegiate Invitational (6-02.00 // 1.88m), earning the Gamecock the Evelyn Lewis Lawler Award, which recognizes the meet's most outstanding female competitor.



SARAH GRAHAM • R-SO • HIGH JUMP/PENT. • WAKE FOREST, N.C.

HJ | 5-10.50 // 1.79m | Armory Collegiate (2/7) | SEC 6th | NCAA 26th
Pent. | 3,823 pts | PSU National (1/31) | SEC 10th | NCAA 27th

Coming off of a redshirt year in 2013, Graham has shown tremendous improvement in all facets. During the course of the season, she has dramatically improved her lifetime bests in all events of the pentathlon and set a new PR in the multi-event at the PSU National with 3,823 points. Graham has also benefitted from jumping with Scheper on a daily basis, increasing her top high jump mark by over two and a half inches to 5'10" $\frac{1}{2}$ (1.79m) since the beginning of the season. She has completed a 1-2 finish with Scheper in the high jump in her last two events and the pair stands 1-2 in the South Carolina record book.



PETRA OLSEN • SR • POLE VAULT • MALMO, SWEDEN

PV | 13-10.50 // 4.23m | VT Challenge (2/22) | SEC 4th | NCAA 17th

Olsen is trying to become the first Gamecock to score at SEC Indoors in the pole vault for four-straight seasons. Last weekend, the three-time All-American found her form again at the VT Challenge, taking second with a clearance of 13'10" $\frac{1}{2}$ (4.23m). The height is just half an inch away from her indoor PR, which ranks her second in school history. Currently sitting in the 17th spot nationally, Olsen will need a good weekend to move into qualifying position for the NCAA Indoor Championships for the second-straight year.

FRYE ENSHRINED IN USTFCCCA HALL OF FAME

ORLANDO, Fla. - South Carolina track and field head coach Curtis Frye earned one of the highest honors of his career on Dec. 16, 2013, as he was enshrined into the U.S. Track & Field and Cross Country Coaches Association (USTFCCCA) Hall of Fame.

Joining Frye in the Class of 2013 are: Ron Allice, Al Cantello, Dennis Craddock, Jim Hunt and Paul Olsen.

Many of Frye's former athletes and staff members were on hand to celebrate the accomplishment with the coach, including Olympic gold medalists Aleen Bailey, Allen Johnson, along with Olympians Shalonda Solomon and Lisa Misipeka. Jim Bibbs, former Michigan State coach and one of Frye's oldest and most important mentors, was also on hand for the event.



Started in 1995, the USTFCCCA Coaches Hall of Fame exists to recognize coaches who have brought great distinction to themselves, to their institutions and to the sports of cross country and track & field. Each of the honorees exemplifies the qualities of dedication to the sport, leadership and passion for their profession that serve as an inspiration to coaches everywhere in the sport.

Frye joins Weemie "Weems" Baskin as one of two Gamecocks included in the USTFCCCA Hall of Fame. Baskin was the track & field head coach at the University of South Carolina from 1948-69 and the University's outdoor track is named in his honor.
