## South Carolina Notables

- This is the Gamecocks' 39th season as a varsity sport, the fifth with head coach Dawn Staley at the helm.
- The Gamecock defense has held 11 of its 15 opponents to less than 50 points to rank third in the country in scoring defense, allowing just 47.4 points per game. South Carolina has allowed just more than 60 points just once this season.
- South Carolina has found success by limiting its opponents offensive opportunities. While allowing foes to shoot 34.1 percent from the field, the Gamecocks are taking 7.3 more shots per game than their opponents. Last season's defensive effort held opponents to just 51.1 field goal attempts per game with the Gamecocks taking 6.8 more shots per contest over the course of the season.
- Senior guard Sancheon White has thrived since the beginning of SEC play, averaging 9.0 points per game and a teambest 6.5 rebounds per outing. In non-conference action, she posted 5.8 points and 3.7 boards per game.
- Sophomore forward Aleighsa Welch is fourth in the SEC in rebounding ( 8.8 rpg ) and leads the league on the offensive glass (4.5). She is second in the conference with six double-doubles, the first of her career.
- Senior guard Ieasia Walker swiped five steals against Western Carolina (Dec. 29) to become just the 13th Gamecock to amass at least 200 in her career. The three-year starter is also on track to reach the 1,000 -point plateau this season, needing just 37 points to reach the mark.
- Senior forward Ashley Bruner is one of 26 Gamecocks to amass 500 career rebounds and has a chance to become just the 18 th to record at least 600 , needing 61 to achieve that plateau.

## The Vanderbilt Series

The Commodores hold a 21-8 advantage in the all-time series with South Carolina, but the Gamecocks have won three of the last four meetings to hold a 3-2 edge during the Dawn Staley era.

South Carolina swept both games of the series last season for the first time in program history. The Gamecocks followed a 65-55 victory at Colonial Life Arena on Jan. 5, 2012, with a 65-60 overtime decision on Jan. 22 in Nashville.

Five of South Carolina's wins over Vanderbilt have come in Columbia, but the Gamecocks are just 1-5 against the Commodores in Colonial Life Arena.

## Scouting the Commodores

Vanderbilt brings a 12-3 record into tonight's game with those three losses coming back in November. The Commodores have not lost in their last nine outings, winning those games by an average of 24.0 points. The streak includes wins over Ole Miss and Mississippi State to open SEC play.

Head coach Melanie Balcomb's team is a precision combination of offense and defense as the Commodores average 71.9 points on 45.2 percent shooting, including an SEC-best 37.0 percent from 3-point range, while holding opponents to just 56.4 points per game.

Vanderbilt's top three scorers rank among the top 22 in the SEC with two of them among the league's most accurate shooters. Senior forward Tiffany Clarke leads the way at 16.3 points per game ( 4 th in SEC) on 58.2 percent shooting ( 2 nd in SEC). Her 8.2 rebounds per game also rank her seventh in the league, and she adds 1.5 blocked shots per contest as well.

Junior Christina Foggie adds 15.6 points per game, shooting 36.0 percent from 3-point range. Junior Jasmine Lister rounds out the trio of double-digit scorers with 11.8 points per game to go with her 6.1 assists per game, which ranks second in the SEC.

## Gamecocks' Five-Second Count

With a complementary blend of youth and experience, South Carolina opened a season 10-0 for the first time since the 1981-82 team also won its first 10 contests. The Gamecocks, now 13-2, have shown they have both inside and outside offensive options and are dominant on the glass this season while the defense has dropped off very little from last season's NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 effort. Two Gamecocks average double-figure points with three others netting 6.0 or more points per game. South Carolina ranks fifth in the nation with a +12.3 rebounding margin and has three players ranked among the SEC's top 20 rebounders. Defensively, the Gamecocks are third in the nation in scoring defense, yielding just 47.4 points per game. South Carolina has held 11 of its 15 opponents this season under 50 points and limited five of the 15 to under 30 percent field goal shooting, including Hampton which hit just 19.3 percent (11-57) from the field for the second-lowest opponent field goal percentage of the Staley era.

## Home Sweet Home

South Carolina is in its 11th season at Colonial Life Arena and enjoys a 112-57 (.663) record in that time. Overall, the Gamecocks are 356-154 (.698) all-time in home games. Head coach Dawn Staley has amassed a 4624 (.657) home record in her fifth season at the helm.

## Judging January

South Carolina is 178-178 (.500) all-time in the month of January, including a 17-20 (.459) record under fifth-year head coach Dawn Staley. The Gamecocks are 104-75 (.581) in home games during the first month of the calendar year, including a 29-55 (.345) mark at Colonial Life Arena. South Carolina is 61-95 (.391) in January road games and 4-0 at neutral sites during the month.

## Life in the League

South Carolina is 92-193 all-time in its 22nd season of SEC regular-season play. The Gamecocks are 59-84 in SEC games played in Columbia with a 33-109 record on the road. Under head coach Dawn Staley, the Gamecocks victories in Staley's first four seasons are the best four-year mark for the program in more than a decade.

South Carolina is ranked in both national polls for the fifth-straight week. The Gamecocks held at No. 18 in the Associated Press Poll this week after cracking into that poll at No. 24 the week of Dec. 10. It is the program's highest AP rank since the end of the 2002-03 season. The Gamecocks moved down a spot to No. 16 in the USA Today Coaches Poll. With a 13-2 record, including six wins away from home, the Gamecocks are 28th in the first NCAA RPI released this week. South Carolina is one of seven SEC schools rated among the top 35 with four others coming inside the top

The Gamecocks' strength of schedule ranks in the top 50 and will continue to build over the course of the season. The Gamecocks are slated to play five teams currently ranked in the top 25 - then-No. $1 / 1$ Stanford (Dec. 19), then-No. 12/13 Tennessee, at No. 13/12 Georgia (Jan. 13), home and away against No. 6/6 Kentucky (Jan. 24/Feb. 14) and No.

The hallmark of the Gamecocks under head coach Dawn Staley has always been defense, and this season's team is no different. Through games of Jan. 6, South Carolina's defense ranks third in the nation in points allowed per game (47.4), trailing just Connecticut (45.3) and Michigan State (45.6). The Gamecocks have allowed just one opponent to score more than 60 points this season (Tennessee, Jan. 3) and have held 11 under 48 through the first 15 games of

the season.
One of the more interesting facets of the Gamecocks' stifling defense is that it has not necessarily held opponents to a sub-par shooting percentage. Through Staley's tenure, opponents have shot 39.9 percent from the field (3,3057,611). The defensive success has come from limiting opponent shot attempts entirely, especially from the 3-point line. South Carolina has attempted more total shots than its opponents every season except Staley's first (2008-09). Opponents have attempted more 3 s than the Gamecocks just once as well (2009-10).

## Five for Fighting

South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley has used the same starting lineup in every game this season, and the quintet led the way to the program's best non-conference record since 2001-02. Starters - Ieasia Walker, Sancheon White, Tiffany Mitchell, Ashley Bruner and Aleighsa Welch - account for 75.2 percent of the offense and 67.7 percent of rebounds while playing 69.7 percent of the minutes available. Each of the five averages at least 6.2 points per game, more than any Gamecock off the bench. Still, the four reserves available have out-scored their counterparts on the opposite bench nine times this season, during which the Gamecocks are 8-1.

## Good Hands

South Carolina is ranked 13th in the country and second in the SEC in turnovers, committing just 13.7 per game. In conference play, that number is down to 11.5 per game. The Gamecocks have committed 10 or fewer

turnovers four times this season, including a pair of seven-turnover games that rank among the top five in the Dawn Staley era. South Carolina has turned it over more than 15 times in a game just three times, while the defense has forced more than 15 turnovers nine times. The Gamecocks' 13.7 turnovers per game is the lowest average by the program since the 1983-84 team set the school record of 8.2.

## Going Glass

Looking at South Carolina's roster of seven guards and four forwards/centers, the casual observer might think that rebounding would not be the Gamecocks' bailiwick, but South Carolina has out-rebounded all but one of its 15 opponents this season (Stanford), including four by more 20 or more and six other by at least 10 . The team effort has the Gamecocks ranked fifth in the nation in rebound margin at +12.3 .

While rebounding is a team focus, this season has seen a surge in individual performances. In 2011-12, a Gamecock posted double-figure rebounds just seven times over 35 games. Through just 15 games this season, South Carolina has amassed 14 double-digit rebound efforts, including seven from sophomore forward Aleighsa Welch, who is second in the SEC led in the category. Three Gamecocks rank among the SEC's top 20 rebounders - Aleighsa Welch (4th), Ashley Bruner (10th) and Tiffany Mitchell (18th).

## Posts Up - Spurs Up

For the first time in the Dawn Staley era, two of the team's top three scorers are post players. Forwards Aleighsa Welch and Ashley Bruner have been an integral part in the team's 13-2 start this season, averaging 12.1 and 9.3 points, respectively. Welch is shooting a team-best 65.3 percent from the field, although she is nine field goals shy of the minimum required to be ranked in the SEC.

The duo are among the league's top 10 rebounders with Welch ranking fourth at 8.8 per game and Bruner coming in 10th at 7.0. Both are especially proficient on the offensive glass, ranking first and eighth, respectively, in the league. More than half of Welch's 132 total rebounds have come on the offensive end (68), while 46.7 percent of Bruner's 105 have come on a Gamecock miss.

## Twice as Nice

South Carolina's Aleighsa Welch earned a spot on the 2012 SEC All-Freshman Team despite lacking a key resume bullet for forwards - a double-double. The sophomore has made up for last season's missing ingredient by amassing six through the team's first 15 games this season to rank second in the SEC. After narrowly missing the mark in the season opener, Welch picked up her first career double-double two games laster with a 13-point, 12-rebound effort against Savannah State (Nov. 15). She added two more at the Paradise Jam against Hampton (Nov. 22) and Florida Gulf Coast (Nov. 24) and tacked on her fourth against Drexel (Nov. 28). She made it four in five games with a 14-point/10-rebound effort at Seton Hall (Dec. 2). Welch continued her balanced dominance with a 16-point, 14-rebound effort against SC State just before the holiday break.

Welch leads the team and is second in the SEC with seven double-digit rebound games this season and also paces the Gamecocks in double-figure scoring outings with 10 .

## Jane of All Trades

Senior guard Ieasia Walker's ability to adapt her game to the needs of her team has been a key factor in the team's success in her four seasons in the Garnet and Black. After coming off the bench most of her freshman year, the guard's offense exploded in 2010-11 as the team's predicted offensive weapons faltered. Walker more than doubled her scoring output to a team-high 12.2 points per game, including 13.3 points per SEC contest. As a junior, the point guard shifted her focus to conducting the team, both offensively and defensively. While her scoring average dropped to 7.9 points in 2011-12, her overall productivity did not. Walker led the team with 3.2 assists per game, which helped the team generate another 6.9 points per game. In all, her offensive prowess generated 25.4 percent of the team's 61.2 points per game.

This season, Walker has shown her versatility, adding another component to her on-court effort - leadership. With six underclassmen on the roster, Walker showed patience through the non-conference season, stepping out of the spotlight to allow her younger teammates to find their way. Still, the senior has scored in double figures six times, paced the team in assists eight times and ranks 12th in the SEC in steals per game (2.3). Her ability to read the team's needs, has yielded a box score that has two post players and a freshman guard among the team's top three scorers so far this season - a first in the Dawn Staley era.

## Movin' On Up

South Carolina seniors Ashley Bruner and Ieasia Walker have made the most of their time in the Garnet and Black, posting and heading toward significant milestones while moving up the all-time leaderboards in several categories.

Bruner made the first move by becoming just the 26th Gamecock to pull down at least 500 career rebounds, hitting the mark as part of her seven-rebound outing at Seton Hall (Dec. 2). Currently 25 th on the total rebounding list with 539 , she can move into the top 20 with 49 more boards, which would tie her for the 20th spot with Ilona Burgrova (2005-08). With 61 more rebounds this season, Bruner will join just 17 other Gamecocks to reach 600 career boards.

Walker became just the 13th Gamecock to amass at least 200 career steals with her five against Western Carolina (Dec. 29). Currently with 202 steals, she needs just 10 more to join Shaunzinksi Gortman (1999-2002) and Sharon Rivers (1980-83) in the all-time top 10. With 963 career points, Walker is on track to join the Gamecocks' 1,000 -point club as the 28 th member, only 11 of whom have also posted at least 200 steals.
