## JANELLE BRENEMAN, UNCG HEAD COACH:

## **Opening Statement**

"Obviously we're gonna have to go with plan B. Our intent was to come out and win this ballgame and it didn't happen. So we are going to make some adjustments and be ready to play tomorrow morning."

## **BEVERLY SMITH, SOUTH CAROLINA HEAD COACH:**

## **Opening Statement**

"It was an interesting game, I think I saw it was three hours and 55 minutes. I was really excited to get going, I loved seeing the stands filled tonight, unfortunately the rain didn't cooperate with us but I thought the team played really well. Kelsey Oh pitched a fantastic game on the mound, I think any time you can get a shutout on such a good offensive team like UNC Greensboro, it's a feather in our cap. We had great defense behind her and just some gutsy play. I liked Alexis Lindsey's pinch hit for us off the bench to score the run, the game-winner, and I think Jana Johns' hustle play to first base was the difference in the ball game."

## On the atmosphere of the game...

"I was so excited tonight, the first game went a little long and then you just see the people start to pile in and the concourse looks full and the stadium looks beautiful... it was just a fantastic atmosphere and I just kept thinking 'I hope the weather holds off here' because I thought it was going to be a really rowdy crowd.
