POST-MEET INTERVIEWS

Post-game interviews are conducted on the pool deck or in the team meeting room at Blatt P.E. Center. After the athletes warm down, requested athletes will be available. The South Carolina locker room is closed to the media.

At home and on the road, notes and statistics will be provided in the press box and on-line at www.gamecocksonline.com. Complete results will be available shortly after each meet; hard copies can be obtained at home meets and an online version will be available from road meets. A post-meet story following each meet will be faxed and e-mailed to outlets requested. Scores will be reported to area broadcast outlets.

CREDENTIALS

No credentials are required to cover South Carolina home swimming & diving meets. All competitions at the Blatt P.E. Center are free and open to the public. Photographers should contact Justin Holt prior to covering a meet to ensure adequate deck space.

Address: 1400 Wheat St., Columbia, SC 29201

From Greenville/Spartanburg: Follow I-26 East to I-126 toward downtown Columbia, then take the exit for Huger Street. Continue 1.5 miles, then turn left on Blossom Street. At the fourth light, take a right on Sumter St., then take the next left onto Wheat Street. The P.E. Center is on the right.

From Augusta: Follow I-20 East. Take exit 64A onto I-26 East, then follow the directions above.

From Charlotte: Follow I-77 South. Take exit 18 onto Hwy. 277, then continue onto Bull Street into downtown Columbia. Turn left at Gervais Street, then take the next right onto Pickens Street. Continue 0.7 miles, then turn right on Wheat Street. The P.E. Center is on the left.

From Florence: Follow I-20 West. Take exit 73 onto Hwy. 277, then follow the directions above.

From Charleston: Take exit 116 onto I-77 North. Continue to Exit 6 (Shop Road), then follow onto George Rogers Blvd. Turn right at Whaley Street, take the second left onto Sumter Street, then the next right onto Wheat Street. The P.E. Center is on the right.

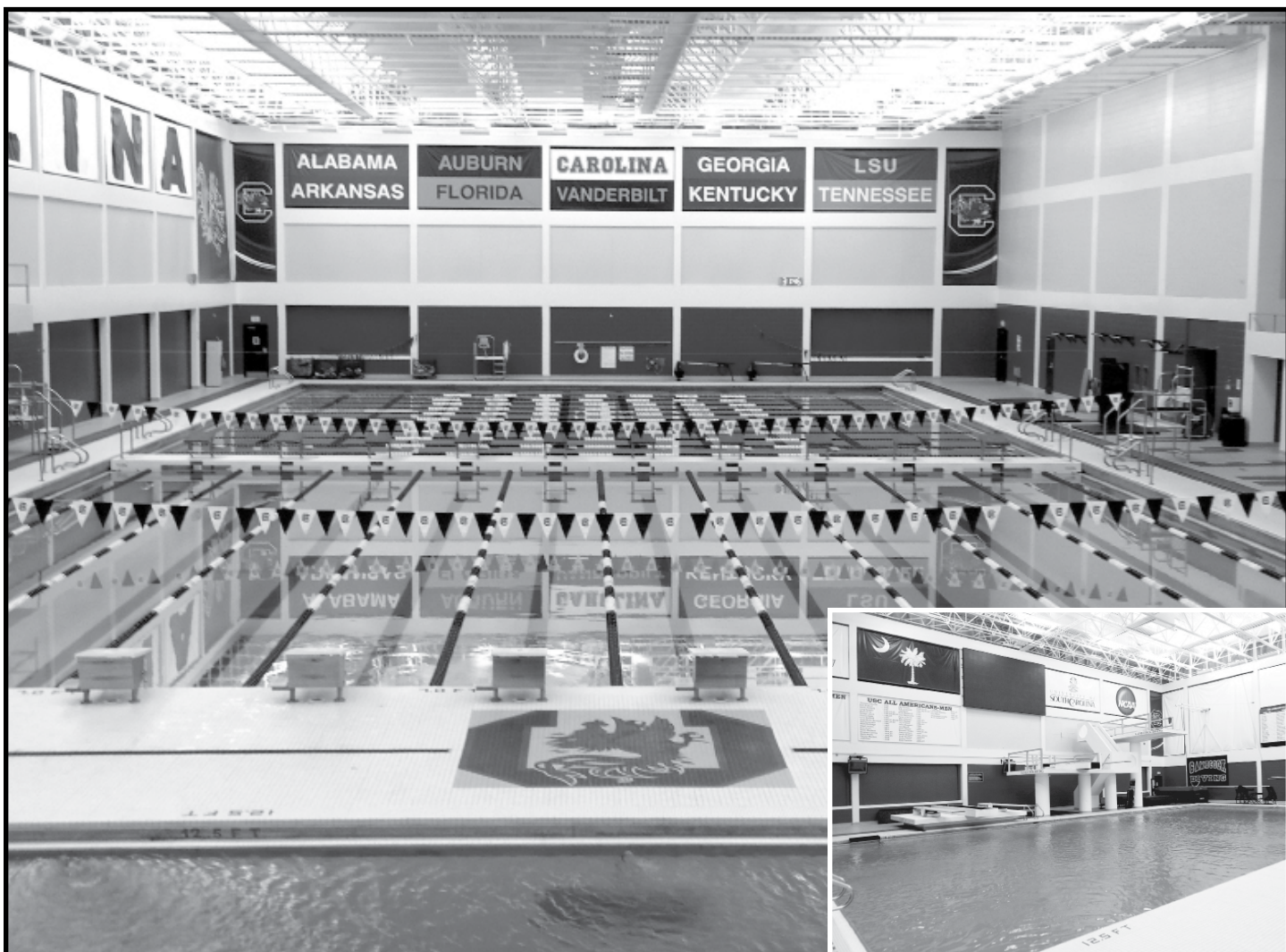
To convert a metric time achieved in a 25-meter racing course to an equivalent time for a 25-yard racing course: (a) transform the achieved metric time into seconds; (b) carrying the calculation out to five decimal places, multiply the transformed time in seconds by the appropriate following conversion factor; (c) drop, without rounding, all units smaller than a hundredth of a second; and (d) finally, transform the resultant value in seconds back into minutes and seconds to obtain the converted time.

Housed in the Sol Blatt P.E. Center, the Carolina Natatorium serves as the home to South Carolina swimming and diving.

Extending 50 meters in length and 25 yards in width, the pool meets all structural requirements for SEC and NCAA competition. One of the more convenient aspects of the pool is its ability to transform from an Olympic size pool to a recreational training facility. A moveable bulkhead - newly installed in 2009 - allows the length of the pool to be set at 25 yards, 25 meters or 50 meters, allowing the Gamecocks to train for various meets.

Having undergone several renovations, the Natatorium can also become a semi-open air facility. Featuring 12 solid electronic moveable doors throughout the natatorium, the doors allow Gamecock swimmers the opportunity to practice under simulated natural conditions. The doors also open to a beautiful sun deck that allows athletes to take full advantage of the warm South Carolina sunshine. The renovation of 2000 included new coaches' offices and meeting rooms, and a fresher look that includes banners of every SEC team, and plaques of every Gamecock All-America swimming and diving selection in school history. This "Wall of Fame" is located in the spectator seating area, which provides a spectacular "birds eye" view of the pool area for fans to view exciting SEC action.

Carolina Natatorium underwent another extensive renovation during the summer of 2010 when a new pool deck and an upgraded new lighting system were installed. In addition, the walls were painted garnet to give the nearly 35-year-old facility a brand new look as it continues to be one of the top swimming and diving facilities in this part of the country.

The Natatorium is also home to a quality diving venue. Featuring two one-meter and three-meter boards and a five-meter diving platform, the natatorium's diving area presents student-athletes with a first-rate training and meet facility. The diving area is 25 yards by 35 feet with depth slopes of 12-14 feet. A state-of-the-art DVR system provides valuable training equipment with both a side view and an underwater camera.

Carolina's swimming facility also features a state-of-the-art Colorado Timing system. It has a 10-lane readout for spectators and swimmers. The seating area features 800 permanent seats with movable seating to accommodate up to 400 more spectators.

The site of the 1995 SEC Championships, the Natatorium served as a training site for the 1996 Russian Olympic Team in June of 1996. The Natatorium was also the site of the mens USA-Russia Dual Meet, nationally televised in April 1995. The New Zealand team also came to USC prior to the Olympics for a meet. The Natatorium also hosts the South Carolina State High School Swimming Championships and the Columbia city championships every year.

A proven leader in the coaching profession, McGee Moody is in his sixth season as the head swimming coach at the University of South Carolina. He and his staff continue to build the South Carolina program and strive toward the elite level of the sport through effective training methods and tireless recruiting efforts.

In his five previous seasons at the helm, Moody has overseen a successful stretch for the Carolina swimming and diving program. Last season the Gamecock women went 7-3, which was one of the best records in program history. The winning season gave Carolina back-to-back winning seasons for the first time since 1994-95. On the men's side, the Gamecocks went 5-4 to achieve back-to-back winning seasons for the first time since 1993-94.

Individually, Carolina had an extremely successful 2011-12 led by diver Courtney Forcucci. Forcucci earned All-America honors on both the one and three-meter springboards at the NCAA Championships. She won gold on the three-meter board at the SEC Championships, setting a SEC and school record. Forcucci also claimed bronze on the one-meter board. Amanda Rutqvist captured silver in the 200 breaststroke at the SEC Championships and earned All-America honors in the event at the NCAA Championships. Michael Flach, who took an Olympic redshirt, made the 200 butterfly finals at the U.S. Olympic Trials and finished eighth overall. Flach was the first Gamecock to make the finals at the U.S. Trials since 1988.

During the 2010-11 season, the Gamecock men equaled the school record for wins in a single season, finishing with a 10-1 dual-meet record. The Carolina women also finished with a winning record for the first time since 2002, posting a 7-6 dual-meet mark.

His first three seasons saw gradual improvements. The 2009-10 season was a bit of a rebuilding year, but highlights included freshman Michael Flach's bronze-medal performance in the 500 freestyle at the SEC Championships. In 2008-09, the Gamecock women finished with a .500 dual meet record for the first time since 2005 and won five meets for the first time since 2002. The women also earned their highest SEC Championships finish in three years. The Carolina men, meanwhile, sent two swimmers - Nick Walkotten and Kyle Cormier - to the NCAA Championships and earned a 29th-place national finish, the best for a Carolina squad since 2005. Combined, the Carolina men and women turned in 23 NCAA provisional qualifying times and broke 14 school records.

It wasn't an easy beginning for the East Carolina

graduate, but Moody made great strides with the South Carolina program in his initial season on the Horse-shoe. Despite arriving on campus only a month before the start of the 2007-08 season, Moody oversaw a successful transition as Carolina sent three swimmers to the NCAA Championships. Walkotten and Dominique Lendjel represented the Gamecock men while Christy Williams swam for the women.

Aside from NCAA competition, Moody saw even more success as nine Gamecock swimmers competed in the Olympic Trials. One swimmer, then-sophomore Shantelle McLean, represented her home country of Trinidad & Tobago in the 2008 Summer Olympics in Beijing. In addition, then-rising senior Nicholas Walkotten competed at the Short Course World Championships.

Moody spent three years at William & Mary, where his teams achieved 559 lifetime best swims, 301 all-time Tribe top-10 performances, 46 school records and 18 gold medals at the Colonial Athletic Association Championships. The Tribe swimming program also excelled academically. The women received Academic All-America honors in each semester under Moody's tutelage.

In 2007, Moody earned the conference's Coach of the Year honor after leading his women's team (8-4, 6-2 CAA) to the first Colonial Athletic Association Championship in the program's 80-year history with a record-tying 12 gold medals. In doing so, the squad swept the conference awards by winning Performer of the Meet, Swimmer of the Year and Rookie of the Year. The men's program finished with a winning record (6-3-1, 5-2-1 CAA) for the first time since 1998-99, and finished fourth at the conference meet behind a pair of runner-up performances and a host of bronze medals.

In 2005-06, the Tribe women's team improved upon its fourth-place conference finish in 2005 by taking second, passing George Mason on the final day of the CAA Championships. During the season, the women were even more impressive, posting a 10-4 ledger (8-1 CAA), to set the school record for conference wins in a season. In the conference, their only blemish was against eventual champion UNC Wilmington. The men also experienced improvement, achieving five dual-meet wins for the first time since 1999 and posting a .500 mark (4-4) in the conference. They also improved on their result at the conference championship, riding a bevy of personal records in the last two days to a fifth-place finish.

Moody spent four seasons as an assistant men's swimming coach at the United States Naval Academy. During his tenure at Navy, Moody coached the Midshipmen's first NCAA automatic qualifier since 1996 in addition to guiding numerous NCAA, Senior National and Olympic Trial qualifiers. His 200 and 400 freestyle relay teams finished the season ranked in the top 25 of the world. Moody also made an impact in the Navy record book, with his athletes setting all of the top-10 fastest times in school history in both the 50 and 100 freestyles. Building his athletes into academic success stories as well, Navy's men's swimming team was awarded Academic All-America honors all three seasons from 2001-2004 under Moody's direction.

Moody got his coaching start at his alma mater, East Carolina University. He was the top assistant swim coach for both men and women for the Pirates from 1996-2000. While working in nearly every facet of the program at East Carolina, Moody coached over 25 varsity record holders.

A 1998 graduate of East Carolina, Moody swam on the Pirates' varsity squad for four seasons, setting several freshman records and captaining the team his junior and senior years. Moody was also an Olympic Trials qualifier in the 200 freestyle in 1992.

Moody, who earned both a bachelor's degree in psychology and master's in sports administration from ECU, is an active professional in the swimming community. He also served in the United States Navy, attaining the rank of Lieutenant. A member of both the American Swimming Coaches Association and the College Swimming Coaches Association of America, he has served as the chair of the latter's Media Relations Committee since 2001. He and his wife, Monica, have four daughters: Sydney (10), Olivia (7), Lily (4) and Whitney (2).

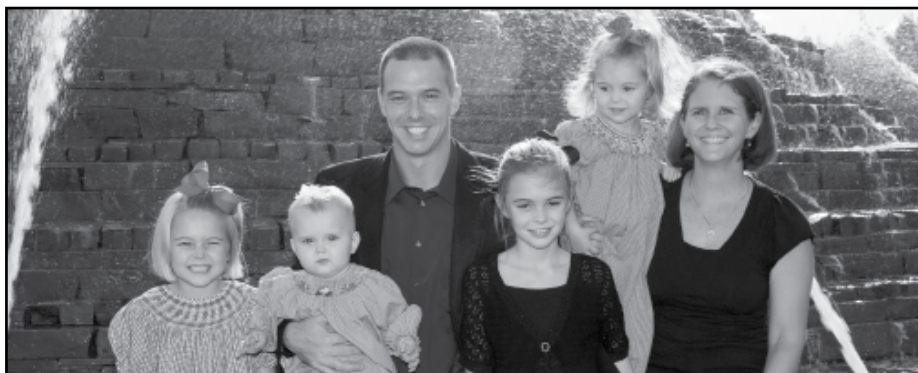

Todd Sherritt

Head Diving Coach

20th Year at South Carolina

Success and Todd Sherritt go hand in hand. Beginning his 20th season as the head diving coach for South Carolina, Sherritt continues to set new standards for Gamecock diving and has established the program as one of the best in the country.

One of the most influential diving coaches in the country, Sherritt has coached 36 NCAA All-Americans, 15 U.S. Diving National Champions, three Olympians, 11 SEC Champions and one NCAA Champion. In 1999, he was named SEC Diving Coach of the Year and, in 1997, he was named USOC Developmental Diving Coach of the Year. Sherritt is also a 10-time World Team Coach for Team USA, including during 2007.

Sherritt has continued to produce greats in the Garnet and Black, most recently Courtney Forcucci, who became the 11th SEC champion for the diving program in 2012. Forcucci set a SEC and school record to win the 3-meter springboard title at the 2012 SEC Championships. She also claimed bronze on the 1-meter board. Forcucci then carried her momentum to the NCAA Championships where she earned two All-America honors, finishing fifth on the 3-meter springboard and 15th on the 1-meter board.

Taryn Zack took the title on the 1-meter board at the 2011 SEC Championships, earning her second gold medal at the league meet. Zack also earned accolades out of the pool as she was named the SEC Scholar-Athlete of the Year for swimming & diving, and she was named a Capital One Academic All-American by the College Sports Information Directors of America, just the second in the history of Carolina swimming & diving.

As a junior, Zack finished seventh at the NCAA Championships in the three-meter event to earn her third All-America honor. She earned her first All-America honor in 2008 as a freshman as she took eighth place on the three-meter board. In addition, an 11th-place finish in the one-meter event that season earned her a nod for Honorable Mention All-American. In her sophomore season, Zack continued her incredible success by winning her first conference title, taking the gold medal in the 1-meter competition at the SEC Championship.

Also in 2009, another pupil of Sherritt's, current Gamecock assistant coach Allison Brennan, captured gold at the USA Diving Grand Prix in the 3-meter event, beating out a pair of 2008 Olympic medalists to take top honors. Recently under Sherritt's guidance, Brennan finished sixth in the world at the World Championships held in Australia in 2007. She also won the 3-meter title at the 2006 U.S. National Championships and placed seventh at the 2006 World Cup in Chengshu, China that same year. Brennan joins Sherritt this year as an assistant coach after a third-place finish at the 2008 Olympic Trials. Brennan was the 2004 NCAA Champion on the one-meter board, the first individual national champion for the South Carolina swimming and diving program. She also was the 2006 SEC Champion on the one-meter and three-meter boards, and set the school record on the three-meter.

The 2003-04 season was a stellar year for Gamecock diving as USC took four divers to the NCAA Championships, and in addition to Brennan, Andy Bradley recorded his second consecutive national runner-up performance on the one-meter board at the NCAA Championships. In 2003, Bradley was the runner-up at the U.S. Championships as well. Internationally, Tracey Richardson found success as she earned a spot at the 2004 Olympics on the Great Britain National Team and competed on the three-meter board. Brennan and Bradley qualified for the U.S. Olympic Trials. Other standouts included All-Americans Lauren King (2003-05) and Holly Hodges (2001-05).

Sherritt's international coaching stints include serving as the head coach for Team USA in the 2000 FINA World Grand Prix in Rodstock, Germany. In 1999, he was selected as the World Cup coach for the United States in Wellington, New Zealand, and he was a World University coach for the U.S. in Mallarco, Spain in July of the same year. Most recently, he served as the team leader for Team USA at the China Open in 2008.

In 1998-99, Sherritt helped lead one of South Carolina's most decorated divers, Michelle Davison, to new heights. Davison won two SEC titles and was named SEC Diver of the Year, en route to finishing fourth and fifth on the one- and three-meter boards respectively at the NCAA Championships. That year, Sherritt was named SEC Women's Diving Coach of the Year.

Sherritt's first Olympic opportunity came in 1996 with Gamecock standout Vivian Alberty. The 1995 one-meter SEC Champion finished her career at USC as a four-time All-American and in 1996 competed for Puerto Rico at the Olympics in Atlanta.

In addition to athletics, Sherritt's divers have excelled outside of the pool as well. Holly Hodges was a recipient of the SEC Community Service Post-Graduate Scholarship in 2004-05. Cheryl Lemon was named USC's Female Student Athlete of the Year in 2000, while Chad Sheldon and Lemon were named to the SEC Honor Roll in 1998. Brandon Hulko was named USC Male Student-Athlete of the Year in 2002, and Taryn Zack was South Carolina's Scholar-Athlete of the Year in 2011.

A native of Cincinnati, Ohio, Sherritt founded South Carolina Divers in 1982, a University of South Carolina based age group diving team. Sherritt received a B.S. degree in physical education from the University of Cincinnati in 1982.

Sherritt has two daughters, Amber and Hannah. His wife's name is Kara.

Jason Memont

Associate Head Coach
Sixth Year at South Carolina

Jason Memont begins his sixth season at South Carolina and first as associate head coach. He joined the Gamecock coaching staff in September of 2007 after spending the previous three seasons in the same capacity at William and Mary alongside head coach McGee Moody.

Memont is primarily in charge of the distance swimmers, which have been a key component of South Carolina's success in his tenure. Most recently he helped Michael Flach reach the finals of the 200-meter butterfly at the 2012 U.S. Olympic Swimming Trials in Omaha, Neb. Flach became the first Gamecock to make the finals at the U.S. Trials since 1988.

In 2011, Memont saw Flach win his second straight bronze medal at the SEC Championships in the 500-yard freestyle and advance to the NCAA Championships, where he earned his first All-America certificate with a 15th-place finish. In addition, he helped sophomores Brooks Ross and Matt Columbus to finals appearances at the SEC Championships. In 2010, he helped Flach win the bronze medal at the SEC Championships in the 500 freestyle, qualifying for his first NCAA Championships.

Memont was directly responsible for many of the top performances during his time at William and Mary. Memont also proved himself as a dedicated coach and recruiter for the Tribe. As head recruiter, he oversaw the two fastest classes in William and Mary history. The '09 and '10 classes accounted for 72% of the teams points at CAA Championships.

Memont joined the Tribe after spending the previous two-and-a-half years as head coach of the YMCA North Shore swim team in Ipswich, Mass. Overseeing all swimmers age five-18, 20 of his swimmers went on to Division I programs under his guidance. He also coached five YMCA qualifiers during his tenure.

An accomplished collegiate swimmer at Rochester Institute of Technology from 1996-2001, Memont won the Empire 8 conference title in the 200 breaststroke his senior season. He also counted two third-place finishes at conferences among his accomplishments, in the 200 IM as a junior and in the 100 breast as a senior. He raced to NCAA provisional marks in the 200 IM and 400 IM and holds five school records (200 IM and all four relays). Named varsity captain in 1999 and 2001, Memont also served as an assistant coach in his final two seasons, helping three national qualifiers. He was also a five-year member and assistant coach of RIT's nationally ranked club water polo team and made the Dean's List four times during his collegiate career.

Memont, who holds a B.S. in information technology from RIT, spent three years as a high school technology teacher at Haverhill High School in Haverhill, Mass. While there, he also served as the men's

Kevin Swander

Assistant Swimming Coach
First Year at South Carolina

Kevin Swander enters his first season as an assistant coach at South Carolina. A 13-time All-American at Indiana, Swander brings an extensive swimming background with him to the Gamecock coaching staff.

A native of Greenwood, Ind., Swander got his start in coaching as a graduate assistant at Indiana from 2008-09. During the stint with his alma mater, Swander did video analysis work and provided detailed analysis and technique suggestions to the coaching staff. He also assisted with on-campus recruiting, managed equipment and helped maintain recruit files.

Following his graduate assistantship at Indiana, Swander spent the 2009-10 season as an assistant coach at Bloomington High School South, where he was in charge of weights and strength training and the breaststroke group.

As a swimmer, Swander has compiled a long list of accolades. A two-time Big Ten Swimmer of the Championships, Swander helped lead Indiana to its first Big Ten title in 21 years in 2006 as he won the 100-yard breaststroke, finished third in the 200-yard breaststroke and fourth in the 200-yard IM. He went on to finish second in the 100 breaststroke at the 2006 NCAA Championships. Along with earning 13 All-America honors during his Hoosier career, he was also a five-time individual Big Ten champion.

Swander was a five-time U.S. National Team member and a three-time Olympic Trials

finalist. At the 2004 ConocoPhillips National Championships, Swander captured the 100-meter breaststroke national title. He won silver medals at the 2005 World University Games in the 100 breaststroke, 50-meter breaststroke and 100-meter medley relay. At the 2009 World University Games, he claimed gold in both the 50 breaststroke and 100 medley relay.

Swander won silver at the 2011 Pan American Games in the 100 medley relay. At the 2011 U.S. National Championships, he captured silver in the 100 breaststroke and gold in the 100 medley relay.
