

FOR STARTERS

SEC play continues as South Carolina (20-2, 3-0 SEC) heads to Oxford for a three-game series vs. Ole Miss (20-2, 2-1 SEC). First pitch on the Thursday opener is set for 7:30 p.m. ET. Friday's game is also at 7:30 p.m. ET. Saturday's series finale is scheduled for 3 p.m. ET.

Friday and Saturday's games will be streamed live on SEC Network Plus. Sunday's game will be televised live on the SEC Network. Thursday and Saturday's games will also be available on the Game-cock IMG Network including flagship station, 107.5 FM, "The Game." Friday's game can be heard on 1320 AM, "The Fan," in Columbia.

RANKINGS

Both teams come into the contest nationally ranked. South Carolina is ranked No. 10 in the USA Today coaches poll, No. 12 by the NCBWA, No. 13 by Collegiate Baseball, No. 14 by D1Baseball, No. 18 by Baseball America and No. 19 by Perfect Game. Ole Miss is ranked No. 6 by Collegiate Baseball, No. 7 by Baseball America, No. 8 by D1Baseball and No. 9 by the NCBWA and in the USA Today coaches poll.

JONES NAMED SEC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

South Carolina sophomore catcher John Jones was named SEC Player of the Week after hitting .500 (7-for-14) in the Arkansas series with a pair of game-winning home runs as well as eight runs batted in. Jones opened the series going 3-for-5 with a pair of run scored and a RBI in the 10-6 win. He followed that up with a two-run homer to break a 2-2 tied in the 6-2 win over Arkansas on Saturday. Jones capped the weekend off going 3-for-5 with a double and a game-winning three-rum homer in the bottom of the eighth inning that lifted Carolina to an 8-6 victory vs. the Razorbacks. Jones' five RBIs in Sunday's contest was a career-high as well.

Jones leads the SEC in batting average (.422) and is tied for the league lead with six home runs and 57 total bases. He ranks third in RBIs (31), third in on-base percentage (.515), fourth in slugging percentage (.687)

This is Jones' second conference award of the year as he was also Co-Player of the Week on February 29 after the Penn State series. It is the fourth time this season a Gamecock has been recognized by the conference. Clarke Schmidt earned SEC Pitcher of the Week on March 7 and Adam Hill was SEC Freshman of the Week on March 14.

Jones earned National Player of the Week honors from Collegiate Baseball and SEC Co-Player of the Week after putting together arguably one of the greatest weekends at the plate in school history in the Penn State series. Jones reached base in all 14 plate appearances vs. Penn State batting 1.000 (8-for-8) with six walks for an OBP of 1.000 as well. Jones went 4-for-4 with a homer and four RBI in a 7-1 series-opening win vs. the Nittany Lions. He followed that up with a grand slam and tying a single-game school record with four walks in Saturday's 16-5 victory vs. Penn State. In the series finale, Jones went 3-for-3 including a two-run single and a walk in the 4-2 win to sweep the series vs. Penn State. Jones' slugging percentage for the weekend was 1.750 also.

In records going back to 1997, Jones is the only Gamecock in school history to start three games in a series and put up a 1.000 OBP, besting the previous mark of .875 set by Christian Walker in 2011 at Mississippi State as well as Walker's .909 batting average (10-for-11). Jones' six walks tied for the most by a Gamecock in a series since Scott Wingo's six walks vs. Brown in 2010. Jones' 10 RBI are the most by a Gamecock in a series since LB Dantzler drove in 10 vs. Albany vs. 2013. Jones' 1.750 slugging percentage is the best in a series since Steven Neff's 2.000 slugging mark vs. Arkansas in 2011.

South Carolina went 5-0 last week with midweek wins at USC Upstate and vs. Davidson and a three-game series sweep vs. Arkansas. The Gamecocks are 20-2 on the year and tied atop the SEC standings with Florida with a 3-0 league mark after one week of conference play.

LOOKING BACK

SCHMIDT WITH SUCCESS

Sophomore right-hander Clarke Schmidt leads the Gamecocks on the mound as he owns a 5-0 record with a 1.27 ERA. Schmidt is one of only three pitchers in the SEC with five wins on the year. Schmidt has allowed just five runs on 22 hits in 35.1 innings of work with six walks and 43 strikeouts. Opponents are hitting .180 against him. He ranks third in innings pitched and strikeouts and fifth in earned run average. Schmidt pitched seven innings and struck out a career-high 11 batters to earn the win in Friday's 10-6 victory over Arkansas.

Schmidt was named SEC Pitcher of the Week on March 7 after he struck out a career-high nine batters in eight scoreless innings in Friday's 8-1 win over Clemson. Schmidt's outing was the longest of his career. Schmidt also earned the Tom Price Award as MVP of the Gamecocks for the Clemson series.

DTW

Junior outfielder Dom Thompson-Williams has reached base in all 22 games this year and is on an 11-game hitting streak. In his current hitting streak, Thompson-Williams has also scored at least one run in each of those games. Thompson-Williams went 7-for-17 (.412) in last week's games including 2-for-3 with three runs in the 15-2 win over Davidson, 2-for-4 with two runs a triple and two RBI in Friday's 10-6 win over Arkansas and a two-run triple in Sunday's 8-6 victory over the Razorbacks.

For the season, Thompson-Williams is hitting .395 (32-for-81) with 28 runs scored, six doubles, two triples, four homers and 20 RBI. He has a team-high 16 walks, has a .505 on-base percentage and is at a .667 slugging mark. Thompson-Williams is tied for second in the SEC in runs scored is tied for fifth with 54 total bases, is fifth in on-base percentage, seventh in slugging percentage, tied for seventh in walks and hits and ninth in batting average. He is also 9-for-10 in stolen base attempts, which is tied for seventh in the league.

WEBB WORKS

Freshman right-hander Braden Webb earned a win his first career SEC start logging a career-high 6.1 innings and tying a career-high with seven strikeouts in the 6-2 win over 13th ranked Arkansas. Webb allowed two runs, one earned, on three hits with four walks to improve to 4-1 on the year.

Webb has allowed 10 runs, five earned, in 26.1 innings of work this year to go along with a 1.71 ERA. He has 28 strikeouts and opponents are batting .147 against him. Webb's .147 opponents batting average is second-best in the league with his ERA ranked ninth in the SEC also.

DYNAMIC DESTINO

Sophomore outfielder/first baseman Alex Destino is on a 14-game hitting streak for the Gamecocks that dates back to the March 1 game at The Citadel. Destino's top performance of the week was a 3-for-4 day at the plate with two runs and two RBI in Friday's 10-6 win over the Razorbacks.

For the season, Destino is batting .364 (32-for-88) with 19 runs scored, three doubles, four homers and 22 RBI. He is slugging .534 as well. Destino's 22 RBI ranks him 12th in the SEC.

REAGAN FROM THE LEFT

Junior left-hander Josh Reagan picked up three saves this past week and leads the SEC with six on the year. Reagan has not allowed a run in eight relief appearances. He has limited opponents to just six hits and two walks while striking out 12 in 13.2 innings of work. Opponents are hitting just .130.

He pitched a perfect inning in Wednesday's 5-4 victory over Furman, 1.1 scoreless innings in Saturday's 5-4 win over Charleston Southern and two scoreless in Sunday's 2-0 victory over the Bucs.

LT

Freshman infielder LT Tolbert hit .455 (5-for-11) in the Arkansas series with a double and five runs scored. He also hit .409 (9-for-22) for the week with a two-run homer on Tuesday at USC Upstate and a 2-for-5 game vs. Davidson. Tolbert tied a career-high in hits in Friday's 10-6 win over Arkansas going 3-for-5 with a run. He capped the weekend off going 2-for-4 with a double and two runs in Sunday's 8-6 victory.

For the season, Tolbert is hitting .295 (23-for-78) with nine RBI and 14 runs scored as well as five doubles. He has a .364 on-base percentage. Tolbert has played in 21 games with 20 starts.

JOHNSON BRINGS THE HEAT

Sophomore right-hander Tyler Johnson picked up his first career save in Saturday's 6-2 win over Arkansas. Johnson pitched 2.2 scoreless with two strikeouts and just one hit allowed. For the season, Johnson has 18 strikeouts in 12.1 innings with opponents batting .209 against him and a 3.65 ERA.

CONE LEADS IT OFF

Junior outfielder Gene Cone hit .333 (4-for-12) in the Arkansas series with a pair of walks. Cone had five runs scored in the Arkansas series. He was 2-for-4 with two runs in Friday's 10-6 win as well as 1-for-4 with a run on Saturday and 1-for-4 with two runs on Sunday. Cone is on an eight-game hitting streak as well. He is hitting .304 (17-for-56) with seven RBI and 13 runs scored.

HILL ON THE MOUND

Freshman right-hander Adam Hill continues to impress as he opened Sunday's game retiring the first eight batters he faced. Hill struck out five and walked one in three-plus innings. He is 4-0 on the year with 37 strikeouts to four walks in 22.1 innings pitched. Hill's 37 strikeouts ranks tied for eighth in the SEC. Hill's average of 14.91 strikeouts per nine innings is second-highest in the nation.

Hill was named SEC Freshman of the Week after winning a pair of games the week of March 7-13 to improve to 4-0 on the year. In a predetermined split on March 8, Hill went three innings and allowed one run on three hits with no walks and five strikeouts in a 7-1 win over Wofford. Senior infielder Marcus Mooney tied a career-high last Tuesday and Wednesday in hits going 4-for-5 in the 12-6 win over USC Upstate and 4-for-4 in Wednesday's 10-6 win over Davidson. Mooney added a key two-run single in Saturday's 6-2 win over the Razorbacks.

He is hitting .313 (21-for-67) with 13 RBI and 15 runs scored. Mooney has a .439 on-base percentage with 11 walks, four hit by pitches and just two strikeouts.

GREAT SCOTT

Junior right-hander Reed Scott is right behind Reagan out of the bullpen with nine relief appearances on the year. Scott pitched one scoreless inning of relief in Friday's 10-6 win over Arkansas and 3.1 scoreless with a season-high three strikeouts in Sunday's 8-6 win. Scott is 1-0 with a 2.65 ERA. He has allowed five runs on 16 hits in 17.0 innings.

CULLEN CATCHING ON

Freshman catcher Chris Cullen caught four of the five games last week. He had a two-run double at USC Upstate and a two-run double in Friday's 10-6 win over the Razorbacks. He is hitting .291 (16-for-55) with four doubles, six runs and 13 RBI.

DC DELIVERS

Senior infielder DC Arendas tallied a two-run double on Tuesday at USC Upstate, was 2-for-2 with two runs scored in Wednesday's win vs. Davidson and went 2-for-4 with a double, a homer and a season-high three RBI in Friday's 10-6 win over Arkansas.

Arendas is hitting .255 with a .381 on-base percentage.

JONAH WITH A JOLT

Sophomore infielder Jonah Bride is hitting .263 (20-for-76) with nine RBI and 22 runs scored and a .408 on-base percentage. Bride leads the SEC in hit by pitch with 10 on the year. Bride tied a school record with a pair of sacrifice flies in the 12-6 win at USC Upstate.

Hopkins tied a single-game school record with two outfield assists on Opening Day. vs. Albany.

TO ARMS

South Carolina's pitching staff is second in the SEC and seventh in the nation with a 2.25 ERA and second in the league with a .208 opponents batting average. The Gamecocks have struck out 217 batters in 196.0 innings, tied for third-best in the league. South Carolina has allowed 60 runs, 49 earned, on 147 hits. South Carolina has allowed five runs or less in 19 of 22 games.

The Gamecocks are seventh in the nation averaging 10.0 strikeouts per nine innings and eighth in WHIP with a 1.09 mark. The team's strikeout-to-walk ratio of 3.29 is 12th best in the nation.

AT THE PLATE & ON THE FIELD

South Carolina is hitting .325 as a team (245-for-755) on the year with a .415 on-base percentage and a .458 slugging mark. The Gamecocks rank second in the SEC and 11th in the nation in hitting as well as second in the SEC in on-base percentage and 13th in the nation. SCOUTING OLE MISS

Ole Miss enters as a consensus top 10 ranked team sporting a 20-2 record with a 2-1 mark after the first weekend of SEC play. The Rebels are hitting .285 (201-for-705) as a team with a .388 on-base percentage and are also fielding .971 as a team. The Rebels own a 2.42 team ERA with 190 strikeouts in 193.2 innings and opponents batting .226 against them.

Sophomore infielder Tate Blackman leads the Rebels at the plate with a .347 average (25-for-72) with 20 runs scored, six doubles, two homers and 21 RBI. Junior outfielder J.B. Woodman is hitting .325 (25-for-77) with 18 runs scored, four homers and 21 RBI. He has a team-high seven stolen bases. Junior infielder Colby Bortles has a .329 average (23-for-70) with three homers, nine doubles and 19 RBI also.

Ole Miss junior right-hander Brady Bramlett is 4-0 with a 2.03 ERA and has struck out 39 batters in 26.1 innings. Opponents are hitting .192 against him. Junior left-hander Wyatt Short has fives saves and a 1-1 record with a 0.87 ERA in seven relief appearances. He has struck out 13 batters in 10.1 innings pitched.

THE OLE MISS SERIES

The Gamecocks lead the series history vs. Ole Miss 32-22 including two of three wins vs. the Rebels the last time the two schools met, March 14-15 in Columbia. After falling 6-4 in the series opener, Carolina swept a double-header with a 5-4 win in 10 innings and a 3-1 victory in the nightcap.

This will be South Carolina's first trip to Oxford since the 2011 regular season. The Rebels were the only team to defeat Carolina in a series that year. The Gamecocks went on to win a second consecutive national title.

MR. MURRAY

Sophomore right-hander Brandon Murray pitched a season-high 3.1 innings and did not allow a run to earn his first career win in the 12-6 win at USC Upstate. Murray has a 3.38 ERA in 10.2 innings with eight strikeouts, opponents batting .220 against him.

SCOLAMIERO

Sophomore Clark Scolamiero has been a key defensive replacement in the late innings with 18 games played in the outfield. Scolamiero has entered late to play center field with Dom Thompson-Williams moving from center to left.

BLAIR

Freshman Danny Blair has six starts and seen action in 11 games. Blair had a career day going 3-for-5 with a double, a run scored and a RBI in a 16-5 win over Penn State. He was 2-for-5 with a RBI double at The Citadel. He is hitting .280 (7-for-25).

DOUBLE TROUBLE

South Carolina tallied a season-high seven doubles in a win vs. Davidson. It tied for the highest single game total under head coach Chad Holbrook and was the most since seven at Tennessee April 7, 2013.

DOUBLE-DIGITS

As a team, South Carolina has reached double-digit in hits in 13 of 22 games this year including tying a season-high 19 vs. Davidson. The Gamecocks' 19 hits tied for third-highest by a Gamecock team in the Chad Holbrook era.

BOWERS BRINGS IT

Junior right-hander Colie Bowers is 1-0 with a 1.23 ERA in 7.1 innings with nine strikeouts on the year. Opponents are batting .043 against him. He has allowed just one hit this year, a solo home run against Penn State.

All six outs recorded by Bowers in a 7-1 win over Penn State were by strikeout.

Bowers won his first career game with the Gamecocks after pitching 1.1 scoreless innings of relief with two strikeouts in the 8-1 win over Albany.

Head Coach Chad Holbrook

Chad Holbrook is in his fourth year as head coach of the South Carolina program and has spent over 20 seasons in college baseball including two national championship staffs with five national championship series appearances, six College World Series trips and 16 NCAA Regionals.

Holbrook was named head baseball coach for the University of South Carolina on July 16, 2012. He was promoted to the top spot by athletics director Ray Tanner after four seasons as associate head coach and recruiting coordinator for the Gamecocks. Holbrook came to South Carolina in July 2008 as associate head coach. Along with his recruiting coordinator duties, he served as hitting instructor, oversaw the Gamecock offense, including base running and the short game and was the third base coach. He also worked with the outfielders. Holbrook came to the Gamecock program after serving 15 seasons as a member of the University of North Carolina coaching staff. Holbrook was the 2011 ABCA/Baseball America Assistant Coach of the Year after the Gamecocks won a second consecutive national championship.

A tremendous evaluator of talent, Holbrook was named the No. 10 best recruiter in all of college sports by ESPNU & ESPN The Magazine in the publication's 2011 January edition. The list was put together in conjunction with three-dozen experts who were asked the question: Who are the top 20 recruiters in college sports? Holbrook was the only baseball coach on the list.

Holbrook's 2015 team was highlighted by first-team All-America first baseman Kyle Martin, who led the Gamecocks in all three Triple Crown categories with a .350 average, 14 homers and 56 RBI. Martin earned first-team All-SEC honors as well and was selected in the fourth round of the 2015 MLB Draft. Junior second baseman Max Schrock also received All-SEC honors and was an 11th round MLB Draft choice by the Washington Nationals. Junior left-handed pitcher Jack Wynkoop would be selected in the sixth round of the MLB Draft as well by the Colorado Rockies after going 8-5 with a 3.27 ERA in 104.1 innings. The 2015 Gamecocks set a school record as well with over 6,000 season tickets sold. Carolina would finish third in the nation in total attendance with 250,057 fans flocking to watch the Gamecocks play at home.

The 2014 team finished 44-18 and finished ranked as high as No. 22 by the USA Today coaches' poll. South Carolina went 18-12 in the SEC and was one of only two schools in the conference to finish among the top four teams in the league in both 2013 and 2014 and one of four schools in the SEC to win at least 40 games in both 2013 and 2014. South Carolina was also one of only nine schools in the nation to host a NCAA Regional in 2013 and 2014.

Among the highlights in 2014 included a series sweep of instate rival Clemson. Holbrook's team would claim six SEC series including a pair of wins at eventual national champion Vanderbilt as well as a series victory vs. CWS participant Ole Miss. South Carolina hosted a NCAA Regional for the fifth-straight year marking the Gamecocks as one of only two schools in the nation to claim that distinction. South Carolina set a total attendance record at 305,564 in 2014, the first time South Carolina eclipsed the 300,000-plus mark.

The 2014 Gamecocks led the SEC with a 2.43 earned run average that ranked ninth in the nation. The pitching staff was among the best in the country with 13 shutouts, fifth-highest in the nation, a strikeout-to-walk ratio of 3.03, sixth-best in the country and a 1.12 WHIP that was eighth overall. South Carolina hit .281 as a team with a .361 team on-base percentage and fielded .975 as well.

South Carolina would have seven players selected in the 2014 MLB Draft including five players in the first 11 rounds. Highlighting that group was junior catcher Grayson Greiner, who was a third round pick and the No. 99 overall selection by the Detroit Tigers. Greiner was a second-team All-America honoree by Baseball America and Perfect Game and was named the 2013-14 USC Co-Male Student-Athlete of the Year alongside Gamecock football/basketball standout Bruce Ellington. He would also be a semi-finalist for the Johnny Bench Award for the top catcher in college baseball and a member of the SEC All-Defensive team. Greiner played in 60 games with 58 starts, hit .311 (66-for-212) with 39 runs scored, 50 RBI, 13 doubles and eight homers, also a .389 on-base percentage and a .486 slugging mark. Greiner hit a team-best .327 (37-for-113) in league games with four homers and 24 RBI vs. SEC teams. Junior left-handed pitcher Jordan Montgomery was a 4th round selection by the New York Yankees after leading the pitching staff with an 8-5 record and a 3.42 ERA in a team-high 100 innings with 95 strikeouts. Montgomery became the 22nd pitcher in school history to reach the 20win total as well. Junior infielder Joey Pankake was a seventh round pick by the Tigers. He became the 26th player in school history to tally 200 or more hits with a double in the second inning of the Florida game at the SEC Tournament on May 22. He finished his career with 204 hits in the Garnet & Black. He started 58 games and hit .303 (67for-221) with a team-high 52 runs scored. Junior outfielder Tanner English went in the 11th round to the Minnesota Twins after manning the center field position the entre year with 62 starts and being named to the SEC All-Defensive team. Joel Seddon also

was selected in the 11th round after earning second-team All-America honors from the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association with 14 saves. He was a second-team All-SEC choice. Junior first baseman Kyle Martin was South Carolina's best hitter with a .336 average (82-for-244) and would be picked in the 20th round but chose to return to school for the 2015 season. Right-handed pitcher Evan Beal rounded out the group as a 21st round choice by the Royals. A Gamecock newcomer also found success as freshman right-handed pitcher Wil Crowe earned Freshman All-America honors as announced by Collegiate Baseball on Wednesday morning. In his first season, Crowe went 8-3 in 15 starts with a 2.75 ERA in 91.2 innings pitched. Crowe allowed just 32 runs, 28 earned, on 76 hits with 19 walks and 59 strikeouts. Crowe was strong in his last start with the Garnet and Black as he pitched four-hit complete game shutout in a 9-0 win vs. Campbell in the NCAA Regional that earned him All-Tournament Team honors. Crowe earned SEC Pitcher of the Week and SEC Freshman of the Week also.

The Gamecocks also shined off the field as Greiner continued a streak of a Gamecock making the Capital One Academic All-America teams to four years, following LB Dantzler's Academic All-America Division I Baseball Player of the Year nod in 2013 and Michael Roth's two selections to the first team in 2011-12.

Holbrook's first season as head coach in 2013 saw the Gamecocks compile a 43-20 record and the school's 11th NCAA Super Regional appearance. Holbrook directed the 2013 squad to a final national ranking of No. 12 in the USA Today Baseball Coaches Poll along with No. 13 by Collegiate Baseball and Perfect Game and No. 14 by Baseball America.

The 2013 highlights was a series victory against Clemson, four sweeps of SEC teams and six SEC series victories including a pair of wins at LSU, making the Gamecocks the only team to go into Baton Rouge in 2013 and claim a three-game set. South Carolina hosted a NCAA Regional for the fourth straight year with the Gamecocks going undefeated in three games and continuing a run of 27 straight postseason wins at home including a 16-0 mark at Carolina Stadium. South Carolina ended the 2013 season with a total attendance of 260,605, third highest in the country.

The 2013 team raised its season batting average 19 batting points to .284 with a .375 on-base percentage and a .419 slugging clip. South Carolina led the SEC and ranked 18th in the nation with 52 homers. The 2013 pitching staff was among the best in the nation with a 3.02 earned run average to go along with a strikeout-to-walk ratio of 3.3 that ranked third best in the nation. South Carolina pitchers averaged 7.8 strikeouts per nine innings while walking just 2.36 batters per contest.

2013 featured third-team All-America designated hitter LB Dantzler. The senior ranked third in the SEC in homers (15) slugging percentage (.617) and walks (42) as well as fifth in total bases (132) sixth in on-base percentage (.444). Dantzler led Carolina in hitting with a .322 average (69-for-214) and was drafted by the Toronto Blue Jays. Senior left-hander Tyler Webb, earned third-team All-America honors from Collegiate Baseball and the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association and second-team All-SEC honors after anchoring a bullpen with 17 saves. That mark is fifth highest in school history and ranked second in the league and seventh in the nation. Webb struck out 60 batters in 43.0 innings and pitched in 32 games on his way to setting a school record for career appearances with 110 on the mound with the Garnet & Black. Webb was selected in the 10th round by the New York Yankees. Greiner was tabbed second-team All-SEC at catcher as a sophomore and made USA Baseball's Collegiate National Team. He hit .298 (61-for-205) with 10 doubles and 38 RBI. Sophomore shortstop Joey Pankake continued his rise with a .311 average (69-for-214) with 11 homers and 42 RBI. Two Gamecock newcomers recruited by Holbrook garnered Freshman All-America honors. Max Schrock started 61 games at second base and hit .282 with six homers and 49 RBI with 36 walks to just 23 strikeouts and was second-team choice by Baseball America, the NCBWA and Perfect Game. Jack Wynkoop went 7-3 with a 3.09 ERA in 64.0 innings pitched on his way to recognition by Collegiate Baseball.

Holbrook's team succeeded off the field logging its highest cumulative GPA in school history with a 3.201 in the Fall 2012 semester. The Gamecocks maintained a high mark in the Spring of 2013 with a 3.050 GPA. The baseball team had 16 players named to the 2013 SEC Spring Academic Honor Roll. Among those were Dantzler, who was named 2013 CoSIDA Baseball Academic All-American of the Year. Dantzler was a finalist for the Senior CLASS Award. Senior right-hander Patrick Sullivan was South Carolina's male nominee for the 2012-13 Brad Davis SEC Community Service Scholarship.

Holbrook is the only head coach in South Carolina history to have led a team to the NCAA Regionals in his first two years as head coach. His overall winning percentage of .696 is the second-highest of any South Carolina coach in his first two seasons at the helm of the program.
