

FOR STARTERS

South Carolina (23-3, 6-0 SEC) is back on the road for conference play with a three-game series at Vanderbilt (21-4, 4-2 SEC) beginning on Thursday night. First pitch for the opener is 8 p.m. ET and will be televised on ESPNU. Game two of the series is set for Friday at 7:30 p.m. ET on SEC Network Plus. The series finale is Saturday at 3 p.m. on the SEC Network. All three games can be heard on the Gamecock IMG Network as well including flagship station, 107.5 FM, "The Game."

LOOKING BACK

South Carolina went 3-0 last week with a three-game series sweep at Ole Miss. The Gamecocks are in first place in the SEC and two games ahead of six teams for the top mark in the league. Carolina had a 13-game winning streak snapped on Tuesday in a 6-5 loss to College of Charleston in 13 innings.

RANKINGS

Both teams are nationally ranked in every poll this week. South Carolina is ranked No. 2 by Collegiate Baseball, No. 5 by D1Baseball, No. 6 by the NCBWA and in the USA Today coaches poll, No. 7 by Baseball America and No. 8 by Perfect Game. Vanderbilt is ranked No. 3 by D1Baseball, No. 4 in the USA Today coaches poll, by Perfect Game and by the NCBWA and No. 6 by Baseball America and Collegiate Baseball.

WEBB NAMED SEC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK & NATIONAL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

South Carolina freshman right-handed pitcher Braden Webb has been named National Player of the Week by Collegiate Baseball and SEC Freshman of the Week after his outing on March 25 at Ole Miss. Webb struck out a career-high 14 batters and retired 17 consecutive batters in a row at one point as he earned the win in Friday's 9-5 victory at Ole Miss.

After allowing three consecutive base runners to reach with one out in the first inning, Webb retired 17 in a row and 23 of 25 at one stretch to help lead the Gamecocks to victory. With the win he is now 5-1 on the year. Webb's 14 strikeouts were the most by a Gamecock since Billy Buckner struck out 16 on March 6, 2004 vs. Clemson and one short of the school's freshman record of 15 set by Brian Williams on May 29, 1988 vs. Georgia Tech. Along with a 5-1 record, Webb owns a 2.10 ERA in six starts with 13 runs allowed, eight earned, on 18 hits in 34.1 innings with 42 strikeouts and 19 walks. Opponents are hitting .148 against Webb. That opposing batting average ranks second best in the SEC. Webb has 24 strikeouts looking, which tops the league mark also.

Webb's recognition is the fifth time this season a Gamecock has earned a weekly honor from the SEC. John Jones was SEC Co-Player of the Week on February 29 and SEC Player of the Week on March 21, Clarke Schmidt earned SEC Pitcher of the Week on March 7 and Adam Hill was SEC Freshman of the Week on March 14.

CONE LEADS IT OFF

Junior outfielder Gene Cone had the top weekend at the plate for the Gamecocks at Ole Miss as he hit .462 (6-for-13) with four runs scored, three doubles, a homer and two RBI. He opened the weekend going 3-for-4 with a double, a homer two runs scored and a RBI in a 5-1 win over Ole Miss and followed that up going 2-for-5 with a RBI and a run scored in Friday's 9-5 win and tallying a hit and a run scored in Saturday's 4-0 victory. Cone is on a 12-game hitting streak.

He is hitting .324 (24-for-74) for the year with nine RBI and 18 runs scored. He has a .416 onbase percentage. Cone has hit .400 (10-for-25) in the league with nine runs scored vs. SEC opponents.

SCHMIDT WITH SUCCESS

Sophomore right-hander Clarke Schmidt is one of only two pitchers in the SEC and one of only three pitchers in the nation with a 6-0 record. Schmidt allowed just one run on nine hits in 6.2 innings of work with no walks and eight strikeouts in Thursday's 5-1 win over Ole Miss. Schmidt owns a 1.29 ERA and has allowed only six runs on 31 hits in 42.0 innings this year with six walks and 51 strikeouts. Opponents are batting .205 against him. Schmidt ranks second in the SEC in strikeouts and ERA as well as third in innings pitched.

Schmidt was named SEC Pitcher of the Week on March 7 after he struck out a career-high nine batters in eight scoreless innings in Friday's 8-1 win over Clemson. Schmidt's outing was the longest of his career. Schmidt also earned the Tom Price Award as MVP of the Gamecocks for the Clemson series.

DTW

Junior outfielder Dom Thompson-Williams has reached base in all 26 games this year. Thompson-Williams is second on the team in hitting with a .367 average (36-for-98) with 30 runs scored, six doubles, two triples, four homers and 24 RBI. He has a .471 on-base percentage and a .592 slugging mark. Thompson-Williams is tied for fourth in the SEC with 30 runs scored. He is 12th in the SEC in slugging, 13th in the league in on-base percentage and 14th in hits and batting average.

He and John Jones are tied with a team-high 12 multi-hit games. Thompson-Williams leads the Gamecocks with 11 stolen bases as well. He drove in at least one run in each game vs. Ole Miss including a pair in Saturday's 4-0 victory.

REAGAN FROM THE LEFT

Junior left-hander Josh Reagan has allowed just one run in 22.0 innings of relief this year. He has a 1-0 record with seven saves in 13 relief appearances. Reagan has yielded just 10 hits and two walks and has 18 strikeouts. Opponents are batting .135 against him. His seven saves is best in the SEC and fifth best in the country.

Reagan made two relief appearances vs. Ole Miss. He worked 1.2 scoreless with a strikeout in Thursday's 5-1 win to earn a save and retired both batters he faced in Friday's 9-5 victory.

MR. JONES

Sophomore catcher John Jones continues to lead the Gamecocks in several offensive categories and is among the league leaders as well. Jones is hitting .384 (38-for-99) with five doubles, six homers, 25 runs scored and 32 RBI. He has a team-high 18 walks and a .492 on-base percentage to go along with a .616 slugging percentage. Jones currently ranks tied for second in the SEC with home runs, fourth in runs batted in, fifth in on-base percentage and total bases, eighth in slugging percentage and tied for eighth in hits. Jones has 12 multi-hit games and a team-high 10 multi-RBI games. He has been on base in 22 straight games. Jones' .417 batting average (10-for-24) in SEC play is also the best on the team.

Jones was named SEC Player of the Week on March 21 after hitting .500 (7-for-14) in the Arkansas series with a pair of game-winning home runs as well as eight runs batted in. Jones opened the series going 3-for-5 with a pair of run scored and a RBI in the 10-6 win. He followed that up with a two-run homer to break a 2-2 tied in the 6-2 win over Arkansas on Saturday. Jones capped the weekend off going 3-for-5 with a double and a game-winning three-rum homer in the bottom of the eighth inning that lifted Carolina to an 8-6 victory vs. the Razorbacks. Jones' five RBIs in Sunday's contest was a careerhigh as well.

That was Jones' second conference award of the year as he was also Co-Player of the Week on February 29 after the Penn State series. Jones earned National Player of the Week honors from Collegiate Baseball and SEC Co-Player of the Week after putting together arguably one of the greatest weekends at the plate in school history in the Penn State series. Jones reached base in all 14 plate appearances vs. Penn State batting 1.000 (8-for-8) with six walks for an OBP of 1.000 as well. Jones went 4-for-4 with a homer and four RBI in a 7-1 series-opening win vs. the Nittany Lions. He followed that up with a grand slam and tying a single-game school record with four walks in Saturday's 16-5 victory vs. Penn State. In the series finale, Jones went 3-for-3 including a two-run single and a walk in the 4-2 win to sweep the series vs. Penn State. Jones' slugging percentage for the weekend was 1.750 also.

In records going back to 1997, Jones is the only Gamecock in school history to start three games in a series and put up a 1.000 OBP, besting the previous mark of .875 set by Christian Walker in 2011 at Mississippi State as well as Walker's .909 batting average (10-for-11). Jones' six walks tied for the most by a Gamecock in a series since Scott Wingo's six walks vs. Brown in 2010. Jones' 10 RBI are the most by a Gamecock in a series since LB Dantzler drove in 10 vs. Albany vs. 2013. Jones' 1.750 slugging percentage is the best in a series since Steven Neff's 2.000 slugging mark vs. Arkansas in 2011.

DYNAMIC DESTINO

Junior outfielder Alex Destino has a team-high 18-game hitting streak. He tied a single-game school record with three doubles in Tuesday's 6-5 loss to College of Charleston. Destino is batting .352 (38-for-108) with 21 runs scored, seven doubles, four homers and 25 RBI.

Destino's top games this year included going 5-for-5 with four RBI in an 8-1 win vs. Clemson and 3-for-6 with a double, two homers, two runs and a career-high seven RBI in a 16-5 win over Penn State.

CULLEN CATCHING ON

Freshman catcher Chris Cullen hit .400 in the Ole Miss series including a 3-for-5 day at the plate with a run scored and two RBI in Friday's 9-5 win. Cullen is hitting .300 (21-for-70) for the year with seven runs scored and 16 RBI. Eight of his 16 runs driven in have come with two outs.

LT

Freshman infielder LT Tolbert scored a pair of runs and tallied a RBI in Thursday's 5-1 win over Ole Miss and followed that up with two more RBI in Friday's 9-5 victory. Tolbert is hitting .260 (25-for-96) with 12 RBI and 17 runs scored. He has five doubles as well.

JOHNSON BRINGS THE HEAT

Sophomore right-hander Tyler Johnson put together a pair of scoreless outings out of the bullpen vs. Ole Miss. Johnson pitched 0.2 scoreless in a 5-1 win and retired all five batters he faced for his second save of the year in the 4-0 victory. He followed that up with 1.2 scoreless with three strikeouts on Tuesday vs. College of Charleston. Johnson has 21 strikeouts in 16.2 innings of relief with opponents batting .182 against him.

HILL ON THE MOUND

Freshman right-hander Adam Hill pitched six scoreless innings to earn the win in Saturday's 4-0 series finale over Ole Miss. Hill is 5-0 on the year with a 1.91 ERA. He has allowed six runs on 20 hits in 28.1 innings with seven walks to 41 strikeouts. Opponents are batting .202 against him. Hill is tied for third in the SEC in wins, eighth in ERA, 12th in opposing batting average and tied for 13th in strikeouts. Hill's 13.02 average for strikeouts per nine innings is seventh best in the nation.

Hill was named SEC Freshman of the Week after winning a pair of games the week of March 7-13 to improve to 4-0 on the year. In a predetermined split on March 8, Hill went three innings and allowed one run on three hits with no walks and five strikeouts in a 7-1 win over Wofford. He followed that up with 5.1 scoreless innings in March 13th's 2-0 win over Charleston Southern. Hill allowed just four hits and one walk while striking out eight in the victory over CSU.

JONAH WITH A JOLT

Sophomore infielder Jonah Bride hit .333 (4-for-12) in the Ole Miss series with a pair of runs scored and three RBI. His top game was on Thursday in the 5-1 win going 2-for-3 with a RBI and a run scored as well as a double. Bride is hitting .264 (24-for-91) with 24 runs scored and 12 RBI. He continues to lead the SEC with 12 hit by pitches and has 13 walks with a 415 on-base percentage.

MOONEY IN THE MIDDLE

Senior infielder Marcus Mooney tied a career-high in hits in the middle of March going 4-for-5 in the 12-6 win over USC Upstate and 4-for-4 in a 10-6 win over Davidson.

He is hitting .313 (26-for-83) with 14 RBI and 18 runs scored. Mooney has a .424 on-base percentage with 11 walks, five hit by pitches and just four strikeouts.

GREAT SCOTT

Junior right-hander Reed Scott is right behind Reagan out of the bullpen with 11 relief appearances on the year. Scott pitched one scoreless inning of relief in a 10-6 win over Arkansas and 3.1 scoreless with a season-high three strikeouts in an 8-6 win over the Razorbacks. Scott is 1-1 with a 4.08 ERA. He has allowed eight runs on 19 hits in 17.2 innings.

DC DELIVERS

Senior infielder DC Arendas has been smooth in the field with just one error and a .988 fielding percentage in 25 games played with 19 starts. Arendas' only error came at shortstop on March 25 at Ole Miss. He has a .329 on-base percentage with 10 runs scored and 10 RBI.

TJ

South Carolina freshman outfielder TJ Hopkins has seen some action with 11 starts in right field. Hopkins is hitting .341 (14-for-41) with seven runs scored, a homer and 10 RBI. Hopkins went 2-fore-4 in the 4-0 win at Ole Miss and made eight putouts in the outfield, one short of single-game school record by an outfielder. He tied a single-game school record with two outfield assists on Opening Day, vs. Albany.

SUPERLATIVES

South Carolina has outscored its opponents this year 189-72 including 50-13 in the first two innings of play. The Gamecocks are 19-0 on the year when scoring first and 12-0 when scoring in the first inning. South Carolina is 19-0 when out-hitting its opponent and 15-0 when hitting at least one home run. The Gamecocks are 22-0 when leading after the seventh inning. South Carolina is 6-2 in games decided by three runs or less. Carolina has reached double-digits in hits in 15 games this year with a 15-0 record with 10 hits or more.

South Carolina pitchers own a team ERA of 2.29 with opponents batting .209 against the Gamecocks. South Carolina has 257 strikeouts to 79 walks. South Carolina has allowed five runs or less in 23 of 26 games. Carolina's ERA is best in the SEC and seventh best in the country. Also, the Gamecocks average 9.8 strikeouts per nine innings, sixth best in the country.

AT THE PLATE & ON THE FIELD

South Carolina is hitting .313 (287-for-917) as a team with a .402 onbase percentage and a .441 slugging percentage. The Gamecocks have hit 20 homers. Carolina is fielding .978 as a team with just 21 errors on the year, the 14th best fielding percentage in the country.

SCOUTING VANDERBILT

Vanderbilt enters the series with a 21-4 record and fresh off a weekend sweep at Missouri.

Sophomore outfielder Jeren Kendall has been the Commodores' top hitter with a .347 average (35-for-101) with four homers, 27 RBI and 29 runs scored as well as a team-high 17 stolen bases. Junior outfielder Bryan Reynolds is the team's top power hitter with six homers and 28 RBI to go along with a .319 average (30-for-94). Vanderbilt is hitting .300 as a team.

On the mound, the Commodores are led by sophomore right-hander Jordan Sheffield, who sports a 3-1 record with a 2.21 ERA and 51 strikeouts in 36.2 innings. Opponents are hitting .204 against him. Sophomore right-hander Kyle Wright is 4-0 with a 1.37 ERA and 35 strikeouts in 26.1 innings. Vanderbilt has a team ERA of 2.66 with 279 strikeouts in 230.0 innings. They are fielding .978 as a team.

THE VANDERBILT SERIES

The Gamecocks lead the series history vs. Vanderbilt 53-28 including a series victory last year.

After falling 12-0 in the series opener, the Gamecocks won game two on the back of left-hander Jack Wynkoop, who hurled a complete game. Carolina then rallied to win the rubber game 3-2 to take the series. Carolina also took the last series the two teams played in Nashville two years ago winning two of three against the Commodores.

MR. MURRAY

Sophomore right-hander Brandon Murray pitched a season-high 3.1 innings and did not allow a run to earn his first career win in the 12-6 win at USC Upstate. Murray has a 2.51 ERA in 14.1 innings with nine strikeouts, opponents batting .196 against him.

SCOLAMIERO

Sophomore Clark Scolamiero has been a key defensive replacement in the late innings with 21 games played in the outfield. Scolamiero has entered late to play center field with Dom Thompson-Williams moving from center to left.

BLAIR

Freshman Danny Blair has six starts and seen action in 13 games. Blair had a career day going 3-for-5 with a double, a run scored and a RBI in a 16-5 win over Penn State. He was 2-for-5 with a RBI double at The Citadel. He is hitting .280 (7-for-25).

DOUBLE TROUBLE

South Carolina tallied a season-high seven doubles in a win vs. Davidson. It tied for the highest single game total under head coach Chad Holbrook and was the most since seven at Tennessee April 7, 2013.

DOUBLE-DIGITS

As a team, South Carolina has reached double-digit in hits in 15 of 26 games this year including tying a season-high 19 vs. Davidson. The Gamecocks' 19 hits tied for third-highest by a Gamecock team in the Chad Holbrook era.

Head Coach Chad Holbrook

Chad Holbrook is in his fourth year as head coach of the South Carolina program and has spent over 20 seasons in college baseball including two national championship staffs with five national championship series appearances, six College World Series trips and 16 NCAA Regionals.

Holbrook was named head baseball coach for the University of South Carolina on July 16, 2012. He was promoted to the top spot by athletics director Ray Tanner after four seasons as associate head coach and recruiting coordinator for the Gamecocks. Holbrook came to South Carolina in July 2008 as associate head coach. Along with his recruiting coordinator duties, he served as hitting instructor, oversaw the Gamecock offense, including base running and the short game and was the third base coach. He also worked with the outfielders. Holbrook came to the Gamecock program after serving 15 seasons as a member of the University of North Carolina coaching staff. Holbrook was the 2011 ABCA/Baseball America Assistant Coach of the Year after the Gamecocks won a second consecutive national championship.

A tremendous evaluator of talent, Holbrook was named the No. 10 best recruiter in all of college sports by ESPNU & ESPN The Magazine in the publication's 2011 January edition. The list was put together in conjunction with three-dozen experts who were asked the question: Who are the top 20 recruiters in college sports? Holbrook was the only baseball coach on the list.

Holbrook's 2015 team was highlighted by first-team All-America first baseman Kyle Martin, who led the Gamecocks in all three Triple Crown categories with a .350 average, 14 homers and 56 RBI. Martin earned first-team All-SEC honors as well and was selected in the fourth round of the 2015 MLB Draft. Junior second baseman Max Schrock also received All-SEC honors and was an 11th round MLB Draft choice by the Washington Nationals. Junior left-handed pitcher Jack Wynkoop would be selected in the sixth round of the MLB Draft as well by the Colorado Rockies after going 8-5 with a 3.27 ERA in 104.1 innings. The 2015 Gamecocks set a school record as well with over 6,000 season tickets sold. Carolina would finish third in the nation in total attendance with 250,057 fans flocking to watch the Gamecocks play at home.

The 2014 team finished 44-18 and finished ranked as high as No. 22 by the USA Today coaches' poll. South Carolina went 18-12 in the SEC and was one of only two schools in the conference to finish among the top four teams in the league in both 2013 and 2014 and one of four schools in the SEC to win at least 40 games in both 2013 and 2014. South Carolina was also one of only nine schools in the nation to host a NCAA Regional in 2013 and 2014.

Among the highlights in 2014 included a series sweep of instate rival Clemson. Holbrook's team would claim six SEC series including a pair of wins at eventual national champion Vanderbilt as well as a series victory vs. CWS participant Ole Miss. South Carolina hosted a NCAA Regional for the fifth-straight year marking the Gamecocks as one of only two schools in the nation to claim that distinction. South Carolina set a total attendance record at 305,564 in 2014, the first time South Carolina eclipsed the 300,000-plus mark.

The 2014 Gamecocks led the SEC with a 2.43 earned run average that ranked ninth in the nation. The pitching staff was among the best in the country with 13 shutouts, fifth-highest in the nation, a strikeout-to-walk ratio of 3.03, sixth-best in the country and a 1.12 WHIP that was eighth overall. South Carolina hit .281 as a team with a .361 team on-base percentage and fielded .975 as well.

South Carolina would have seven players selected in the 2014 MLB Draft including five players in the first 11 rounds. Highlighting that group was junior catcher Grayson Greiner, who was a third round pick and the No. 99 overall selection by the Detroit Tigers. Greiner was a second-team All-America honoree by Baseball America and Perfect Game and was named the 2013-14 USC Co-Male Student-Athlete of the Year alongside Gamecock football/basketball standout Bruce Ellington. He would also be a semi-finalist for the Johnny Bench Award for the top catcher in college baseball and a member of the SEC All-Defensive team. Greiner played in 60 games with 58 starts, hit .311 (66-for-212) with 39 runs scored, 50 RBI, 13 doubles and eight homers, also a .389 on-base percentage and a .486 slugging mark. Greiner hit a team-best .327 (37-for-113) in league games with four homers and 24 RBI vs. SEC teams. Junior left-handed pitcher Jordan Montgomery was a 4th round selection by the New York Yankees after leading the pitching staff with an 8-5 record and a 3.42 ERA in a team-high 100 innings with 95 strikeouts. Montgomery became the 22nd pitcher in school history to reach the 20win total as well. Junior infielder Joey Pankake was a seventh round pick by the Tigers. He became the 26th player in school history to tally 200 or more hits with a double in the second inning of the Florida game at the SEC Tournament on May 22. He finished his career with 204 hits in the Garnet & Black. He started 58 games and hit .303 (67for-221) with a team-high 52 runs scored. Junior outfielder Tanner English went in the 11th round to the Minnesota Twins after manning the center field position the entre year with 62 starts and being named to the SEC All-Defensive team. Joel Seddon also

was selected in the 11th round after earning second-team All-America honors from the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association with 14 saves. He was a second-team All-SEC choice. Junior first baseman Kyle Martin was South Carolina's best hitter with a .336 average (82-for-244) and would be picked in the 20th round but chose to return to school for the 2015 season. Right-handed pitcher Evan Beal rounded out the group as a 21st round choice by the Royals. A Gamecock newcomer also found success as freshman right-handed pitcher Wil Crowe earned Freshman All-America honors as announced by Collegiate Baseball on Wednesday morning. In his first season, Crowe went 8-3 in 15 starts with a 2.75 ERA in 91.2 innings pitched. Crowe allowed just 32 runs, 28 earned, on 76 hits with 19 walks and 59 strikeouts. Crowe was strong in his last start with the Garnet and Black as he pitched four-hit complete game shutout in a 9-0 win vs. Campbell in the NCAA Regional that earned him All-Tournament Team honors. Crowe earned SEC Pitcher of the Week and SEC Freshman of the Week also.

The Gamecocks also shined off the field as Greiner continued a streak of a Gamecock making the Capital One Academic All-America teams to four years, following LB Dantzler's Academic All-America Division I Baseball Player of the Year nod in 2013 and Michael Roth's two selections to the first team in 2011-12.

Holbrook's first season as head coach in 2013 saw the Gamecocks compile a 43-20 record and the school's 11th NCAA Super Regional appearance. Holbrook directed the 2013 squad to a final national ranking of No. 12 in the USA Today Baseball Coaches Poll along with No. 13 by Collegiate Baseball and Perfect Game and No. 14 by Baseball America.

The 2013 highlights was a series victory against Clemson, four sweeps of SEC teams and six SEC series victories including a pair of wins at LSU, making the Gamecocks the only team to go into Baton Rouge in 2013 and claim a three-game set. South Carolina hosted a NCAA Regional for the fourth straight year with the Gamecocks going undefeated in three games and continuing a run of 27 straight postseason wins at home including a 16-0 mark at Carolina Stadium. South Carolina ended the 2013 season with a total attendance of 260,605, third highest in the country.

The 2013 team raised its season batting average 19 batting points to .284 with a .375 on-base percentage and a .419 slugging clip. South Carolina led the SEC and ranked 18th in the nation with 52 homers. The 2013 pitching staff was among the best in the nation with a 3.02 earned run average to go along with a strikeout-to-walk ratio of 3.3 that ranked third best in the nation. South Carolina pitchers averaged 7.8 strikeouts per nine innings while walking just 2.36 batters per contest.

2013 featured third-team All-America designated hitter LB Dantzler. The senior ranked third in the SEC in homers (15) slugging percentage (.617) and walks (42) as well as fifth in total bases (132) sixth in on-base percentage (.444). Dantzler led Carolina in hitting with a .322 average (69-for-214) and was drafted by the Toronto Blue Jays. Senior left-hander Tyler Webb, earned third-team All-America honors from Collegiate Baseball and the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association and second-team All-SEC honors after anchoring a bullpen with 17 saves. That mark is fifth highest in school history and ranked second in the league and seventh in the nation. Webb struck out 60 batters in 43.0 innings and pitched in 32 games on his way to setting a school record for career appearances with 110 on the mound with the Garnet & Black. Webb was selected in the 10th round by the New York Yankees. Greiner was tabbed second-team All-SEC at catcher as a sophomore and made USA Baseball's Collegiate National Team. He hit .298 (61-for-205) with 10 doubles and 38 RBI. Sophomore shortstop Joey Pankake continued his rise with a .311 average (69-for-214) with 11 homers and 42 RBI. Two Gamecock newcomers recruited by Holbrook garnered Freshman All-America honors. Max Schrock started 61 games at second base and hit .282 with six homers and 49 RBI with 36 walks to just 23 strikeouts and was second-team choice by Baseball America, the NCBWA and Perfect Game. Jack Wynkoop went 7-3 with a 3.09 ERA in 64.0 innings pitched on his way to recognition by Collegiate Baseball.

Holbrook's team succeeded off the field logging its highest cumulative GPA in school history with a 3.201 in the Fall 2012 semester. The Gamecocks maintained a high mark in the Spring of 2013 with a 3.050 GPA. The baseball team had 16 players named to the 2013 SEC Spring Academic Honor Roll. Among those were Dantzler, who was named 2013 CoSIDA Baseball Academic All-American of the Year. Dantzler was a finalist for the Senior CLASS Award. Senior right-hander Patrick Sullivan was South Carolina's male nominee for the 2012-13 Brad Davis SEC Community Service Scholarship.

Holbrook is the only head coach in South Carolina history to have led a team to the NCAA Regionals in his first two years as head coach. His overall winning percentage of .696 is the second-highest of any South Carolina coach in his first two seasons at the helm of the program.
