Gamecocks Set to Open Season at Cougar Classic

Coming off one of its most successful seasons in program history, the 17th-ranked South Carolina women's golf team will attempt to keep the momentum going as it opens the 2012-13 season on Sunday at the Cougar Classic in Hanahan, S.C. The 54-hole event runs through Tuesday at Yeamans Hall Club, which features a par-72, 6,219-yard layout.

The Lineup

Carolina has just four golfers returning from a year ago, but three of those golfers were in the lineup at the NCAA Championship. All four returnees will be in this week's lineup, as senior Meredith Swanson, juniors Samantha Swinehart and Suzie Lee and sophomore Justine Dreher will tee off for the Gamecocks on Sunday. Freshman Sarah Schmelzel will be making her collegiate debut after qualifying for one of the five spots.

Swanson will help fill the leadership void left by the departure of All-American Katie Burnett. A native of Roanoke, Va., Swanson played in all 11 tournaments a year ago, compiling the fourth best stroke average on the team (76.03). She played some of her best golf late in the season and recorded her first career top-10 finish with a tie for 10th showing at the Liz Murphey Collegiate Classic.

Swinehart competed in eight events last season and had a scoring average of 77.48. Her season best finish was a tie for 22nd at the Bryan National Collegiate. Lee played a key role in helping the Gamecocks secure the NCAA East Regional title as she fired a career-low 68 (-4) in the final round.

Dreher, who was named to the SEC All-Freshman Team, produced three top-20 finishes in 2011-12. She had a scoring average of 75.50, which ranks third all-time at South Carolina for a freshman.

Schmelzel, a highly ranked golfer on the junior circuit from Phoenix, Ariz., won medalist honors at the 2011 Arizona State High School Championship to lead Xavier Prep to its third team state title in four years.

History at the Cougar Classic

The Gamecocks are making their fifth trip to the Cougar Classic, including their third straight to open the season. Carolina's best finish at the event was a fourth-place showing in 2010.

Breaking Down the Field

This year marks the 10th anniversary of the Cougar Classic, and the field has grown to a tournament-record 24 teams. Of the 13 ranked teams, top-ranked and defending national champion Alabama highlights the field. No. 3 Southern California, No. 5 Duke, No. 6 North Carolina, No. 7 Auburn, No. 8 Vanderbilt, No. 9 Florida, No. 10 LSU, No. 11 Georgia, No. 12 Virginia, No. 13 Tennessee and No. 25 North Carolina State join the 17th-ranked Gamecocks as the remaining ranked teams. The tournament also features the top five teams from last year's NCAA Championship (Alabama, Southern California, LSU, Virginia, South Carolina). Rounding out the field are College of Charleston, Charleston Southern, Furman, Maryland, Miami, Mississippi, Penn State, UCF, UNC Greensboro, Wake Forest and Wisconsin.

Recapping the 2011 Cougar Classic

South Carolina had three golfers post scores under par in the final round of the Cougar Classic on its way to setting the record for the lowest round in school history with a 279 (-9) at Yeamans Hall Club. The Gamecocks finished the tournament with a three-round total of 869 (+5) to claim 10th place in the 22-team field.

South Carolina's score of 279 broke the previous school record by three strokes, which was set in the second round of the 2002 Southeastern Conference Championship. It also tied for the second lowest round in Cougar Classic history. The Gamecocks' tournament total was the fourth best 54-hole total in program history.

Katie Rose Higgins posted South Carolina's lowest score of the round with a career-best 67 (-5), tying Burnett and three former Gamecocks for the third lowest round in school history. Higgins' three-round total of 221 (+5) left her in a tie for 44th. She recorded par on her first three holes of the day and then caught fire with birdies on six of her next seven holes, including four straight on holes 15-18. After five consecutive pars, Higgins carded her seventh birdie of the day at No. 6 but she faltered with bogeys on her final two holes to finish at 5-under.

After posting a career-low 69 in the second round, Meredith Swanson was at it again in the final round. Swanson fired the ninth-best round in Gamecock history with a 4-under 68. She finished the tournament in a tie for 12th with a three-day score of 214 (-2), which is tied for the 10th best 54-hole total in school history.

Swanson, who started her day on hole No. 8, recorded her first of five birdies on the day at the ninth. She fell to 1-over after a double bogey at No. 11, but that turned out to be her only big slip up of the day. The Roanoke, Va., native made a birdie at the 14th to move back to even and then recorded her first eagle of the tournament at No. 15. After a bogey at the first, Swanson tallied birdies on the next three holes and pars on her final three to wrap up the tournament at 2-under.

Katie Burnett finished in the top 10 for the eighth time in her career as her final-round 74 (+2) moved her into a tie for ninth with a three-day total of 213 (-3). Burnett's 54-hole score is tied for the eighth best in program history. After starting the round on hole No. 7, Burnett birdied two of her first four holes, but a double bogey at the 12th and bogeys at the 13th and 16th moved her to 2-over on the day. She fought back to 1-over on three occasions, including with a birdie at No. 5, but she bogeyed her the sixth to finish at 2-over.

South Carolina's third round under par came from Amanda Strang, who carded a 2-under 70 for her lowest round of the tournament. Strang recorded five birdies, 10 pars and three bogeys on the day to wrap up the tournament in a tie for 44th with a three-round score of 221 (+5).

Samantha Swinehart turned in her best round of the event with a 74 (+2). After making three birdies in the first two rounds combined, Swinehart recorded three in the third round to go along with five bogeys and 10 pars.

Among the Elite

South Carolina head coach Kalen Harris has built a force to be reckoned with in both the SEC and on a national level. Under her guidance, the Gamecocks have won two NCAA East Regional titles and advanced to four NCAA Championships. Last season Carolina finished fifth at the NCAA Championship, which is the best ever by a Gamecock squad at the event.

In the Polls

Unlike last season, the Gamecocks were not forgotten in the preseason Golf World/NGCA Coaches' Poll. Carolina enters the year ranked 17th. The Gamecocks are one of 10 SEC teams in the poll, joining top-ranked and defending national champion Alabama, No. 7 Auburn, No. 8 Vanderbilt, No. 9 Florida, No. 10 LSU, No. 11 Georgia, No. 13 Tennessee, No. 15 Texas A&M and No. 23 Arkansas.

Busy Summer

The Gamecocks had yet another successful summer in 2012 with several golfers performing at a high level in events across the country. Senior Meredith Swanson and junior Samantha Swinehart teamed up to take second place at the Pure Silk Collegiate Team Championship. Swinehart and freshman Sarah Schmelzel played at the U.S. Amateur, and Swinehart advanced to the match play portion. Sophomore Justine Dreher advanced to match play at the British Ladies' Amateur Championship.
