

No. 1 South Carolina vs. No. 1 Stanford Postgame Notes December 1, 2017

- Stanford made its eighth trip to the Women's College Cup, and advances to its fourth NCAA Final, all under head coach Paul Ratcliffe.
- South Carolina made the first appearance at the Women's College Cup.
- Stanford midfielder Jordan DiBiasi scored two goals in the first half, her first multi-goal game of the season. The markers were her eighth and ninth of the season.
- DiBiasi now has a team-leading six game-winning goals for Stanford
- Stanford earned its 21st consecutive win this season.
- The result was just the second time all season that South Carolina has been shutout.
- Stanford posted its 19th multi-goal game of the season.
- Stanford head coach Paul Ratcliffe's postseason record improved to 42-11-4.
- Ratcliffe earned his fifth College Cup victory, moving him into third on the all-time list behind Anson Dorrance (45, North Carolina) and Randy Waldrum (8, UCF and Notre Dame).
- Stanford goalkeeper Alison Jahansouz improved to 14-1-0 and recorded her 11th shutout of the season.
