TODAY'S GAME

South Carolina travels to face St. John's on Thursday in the 2012 SEC/BIG EAST Challenge. The contest will be televised on ESPNU and broadcast live on the radio in Columbia on 107.5 The Game and on GamecocksOnline.com. The meeting marks the fourth all-time between the Gamecocks and Red Storm, and the first since the 1975 campaign. The game will be the first between Carolina head coach Frank Martin and SJU's Steve Lavin.



CAROLINA OUICK HITS

South Carolina is in its 105th season of basketball.

The Gamecocks are led by first-year head coach Frank Martin. His associate head coach is Brad Underwood and his assistant coaches are Matt Figger and Lamont Evans. Andy Assaley is the director of basketball operations.

Thursday's contest at St. John's will be the first true away contest for Carolina this season. In his career as a head coach, Frank Martin owns a 26-21 (.553) record in away games.

South Carolina posted a 74-62 victory over Arkansas Little-Rock on Sunday to claim the 2012 Hoops For Hope Classic tournament title in Puerto Vallarta, Mexico. Senior guard Lakeem Jackson was named to the All-Tournament Team and senior guard LaShay Page was named the tournament's Most Outstanding Player.

Jackson collected his second double-double of the season vs. UALR, scoring 10 points and collecting a career-high 15 rebounds. It was the most rebounds in a contest for Jackson since he collected 14 vs. Alabama on March 11, 2010.

Page led the Gamecocks with 19.0 points per game in two contests in Puerto Vallarta, including a team high 22 vs. Missouri State. Page paces Carolina with 15.5 points per game entering Thursday's contest vs. St. John's.

Junior guard Brian Richardson scored 14 points vs. Missouri State, including four 3s, just one shy of matching his career high. Richardson played a career-high 38 minutes in the contest.

Junior guard Eric Smith dished a season-best six assists vs. Missouri State and added five vs. UALR. He leads the Gamecocks with 3.2 assists per game.

Carrera, the Nov. 12 SEC Freshman of the Week, did not play vs. Morgan State, Rider or Elon due to a concussion suffered in practice on Wednesday, Nov. 14. He returned to score 18 points vs. Missouri State, including the game-tying 3-pointer at the end of regulation to send the contest into overtime.

South Carolina's 77.4 percent from the free throw line leads the SEC and ranks 16th in the nation. The Gamecocks hit 22-of-28 attempts vs. Missouri State, including 10-of-12 in overtime.

In two overtime games this season, Carolina has hit an impressive 22-of-24 (91.7%) attempts from the free throw line during OT.

A SOUTH CAROLINA WIN WOULD ...

· Be Carolina's first road win of the season

• Be the Gamecocks' first in the series with St. John's

· Be the most wins for the Gamecocks through the first seven games of the season since the 2010-11 campaign

Senior forward Lakeem Jackson ranks third in the SEC and 13th in the nation in field goal percentage with a mark of 67.4 (31-46).

■ The Gamecocks are a stellar 34-of-47 (78.7%) from the free throw line this season with under five minutes remaining in games (including overtime).

■ Freshman forward Michael Carrera posted the first double-double by a Gamecock freshman since the 2008 campaign vs. Milwaukee with 17 points and a game-best 15 rebounds.

■ South Carolina is 79-32 (.711) all-time in the month of November.

■ Carolina owns a 53-67 all-time record against current schools in the BIG EAST. The last Carolina win vs. a member of the league came in a 69-66 decision vs. South Florida on Nov. 20, 2009, competing at the Charleston Classic, while the last loss to an opponent from the conference came last season in the BIG EAST/SEC Challenge with a 76-67 loss to Providence.

SCOUTING ST. JOHN'S

St. John's enters Thursday contest with a 4-2 overall record, including a perfect 3-0 mark in home contests. The Red Storm has not played since a 79-68 win vs. Florida Gulf Coast on Nov. 24 in Queens. The team is led by sophomore guard D'Angelo Harris with 21.2 points per game, while sophomore guard Phil Greene IV (13.8) and freshman forward JaKarr Sampson (12.3) contribute double-digits as well. Sampson was named the BIG EAST's Rookie of the Week on Monday, while Harrison picked up his second-straight weekly Honor Roll mention following Red Storm wins over Holy Cross and FGCU. Freshman forward Chris Obekpa ranks third in the country with 4.5 blocks per game entering Thursday's contest, while as a team the Red Storm ranks second nationally with 8.3 blocks per game. St. John's is led by Steve Lavin in his third season.

BY THE NUMBERS

33.5 - In two games at the Hoops For Hope Classic in Mexico, the Gamecock bench provided 33.5 points per game. Versus Missouri State, freshman forward Michael Carrera was the high bench scorer with 18 points and junior guard Brian Richardson added 14. Freshman forward Mindaugas Kacinas led the Gamecocks vs. UALR with 13 points. In six games in 2012, four different players have led Carolina in scoring off the bench.

56.2% - The Gamecocks shot a stellar 56.2 percent (50-89) combined vs. Missouri State and UALR, while the Bears and Trojans combined to hit just 39.7 percent (46-116) from the field.

+11.2 - The Gamecocks ranks second in the SEC and 16th in the nation in rebounding margin with a plus-11.2 margin over their opponents.

15 - Lakeem Jackson's 15 rebounds vs. UALR rank him tied with three others - including teammate Michael Carrera - for the most rebounds by an individual player in a single game this season in the SEC. Carrera earned 15 boards in the season opener vs. Milwaukee.

48.6% - South Carolina trails only Kentucky (55.8%) in the SEC in field goal percentage, as Carolina hits 48.6 percent of its attempts thus far in 2012-13.

SEC/BIG EAST CHALLENGE

Carolina's contest vs. St. John's marks the third time that the Gamecocks will compete in the SEC/BIG EAST Challenge. South Carolina earned a 68-67 victory over Providence in Philadelphia during the 2007-08 campaign in its first appearance in the event, while the Friars evened the mark with a 76-67 win last season in Columbia.

STAR WATCH - LAKEEM JACKSON

After averaging 3.2 points and 2.7 rebounds last season, and holding career averages of 6.0 points and 4.4 rebounds, senior forward Lakeem Jackson is performing at an elite level thus far in 2012-13. He is among team leaders with 11.2 points per contest, and leads the team and ranks fourth in the SEC with 8.3 rebounds per game. He has scored in double-figures in four games this season and his 67.4 percent from the field ranks third in the SEC and 13th in the country.

BALANCED ATTACK

The Gamecocks have used a very balanced attack on the offensive end this season, as four different players are currently averaging double-digit points, with an additional three posting at least 7.5 per game. Also, seven different players have scored 14 or more points in a game this season, with LaShay Page (20 vs. Morgan State, 22 vs. Missouri State) and Brenton Williams (22 vs. Rider) posting 20-point games.

UP NEXT FOR THE GAMECOCKS

South Carolina returns home to host Clemson on Sunday in a contest televised on ESPNU at Noon from Colonial Life Arena. The Gamecocks have won two straight in the series vs. the Tigers, including last season's 58-55 victory at Littlejohn Coliseum.

2013 SEC TOURNAMENT

The 2013 SEC Men's Basketball Tournament will be played March 13-17 at Bridgestone Arena in Nashville, Tenn. The men's basketball tournament has expanded to include all 14 teams and will be seeded 1-14. The tournament will begin on Wednesday, March 13 with matchups between the No. 11 and No. 14 seeds and the No. 12 and No. 13 seeds. The winners will advance to meet the sixth and fifth seeds, respectively, on Thursday. Also playing on Thursday with be the No. 8 and No. 9 seeds and the No. 7 and No. 10 seeds. The top four seeds in the tournament will receive byes until Friday's quarterfinal round.

Justin loves to win, and he is coached by Tim Whipple, one of the great coaches in the country, not just in high school basketball or in this state. In my seven months here, Justin has improved as much as any player that I have watched. We really like his toughness, his ability to play defense in a system that is similar to ours and his length and size on the perimeter. He is someone that, as we move forward, we think he is definitely a great part of building a championship program."

Martin on Sindarius Thornwell (G – 6-5 – 180 – Lancaster, S.C. – Oak Hill Academy)

"Sindarius Thornwell is an extremely talented guard, and he is a winner. In todays day and age, you have players that are highly ranked across the country that have a sense of entitlement, and he does not. He remains very humble and very loyal to his state. With his choice to play at South Carolina, it shows the kind of love that he, along with the other guys, have for this University. For he and Justin, representing their state was something very important to them. Sindarius has a chance to be a special player in our program. He is another big guard, who can play the point guard position, as well as the two and three. He is the consummate winner; he defends, he rebounds and he is a great decision maker with the basketball."

COLUMBIA, S.C. -- Brenton Williams scored 12 of his 14 points in overtime as South Carolina (1-0) overcame a 17-point deficit in the second half to defeat Wisconsin-Milwaukee 82-75 Sunday in Frank Martin's debut as Gamecocks coach

They trailed 40-23 early in the second half. But Carolina ended the period on a 26-12 run and tied things on two foul shots by freshman Mindaugas Kacinas to force the extra period.

Freshman forward Michael Carrera was stellar in the contest, posting a double-double with 17 points and 15 rebounds. It marked the first doubledouble by a Gamecock freshman since the 2008 campaign. Kacinas also pulled down double-digit rebounds with 13, while adding eight points.

Senior transfer LaShay Page paced Carolina with 19 points, including 17 in the second half. Williams posted 14 points, including a perfect 8-of-8 performance from the free throw line in overtime.

Jordan Aaron had 28 points to lead the Panthers (1-1).

The teams traded baskets early in the first half before Kacinas assisted Williams on a layup underneath to give Carolina a 14-11 upperhand at the 12:38 mark.

The Panthers responded with an 8-0 run through the under-eight minute media timeout, before a lay-up from Carrera at the 6:21 mark halted the scoring drought for Carolina.

The difference in the first half was eight made 3's from the Panthers, while the Gamecocks were 0-of-8 from beyond the arc. Carrera ended the half with a near double-double, scoring nine points and pulling down nine rebounds. but UWM held a 38-23 upperhand at the break.

Carolina started the second half on a 9-2 run, propelled by a lay-up and two jumpers from Page, which forced an early timeout from Milwaukee.

After the break, stellar play from the Gamecocks brought the score within four at 40-36. Carrera hit a pair of free throws before Kacinas blocked a shot at the opposite end and assisted on Page's fifth made basket of the second half at the 14:32 mark.

Milwaukee extended its lead to 50-36 with 11:53 remaining, but the Gamecocks continued to battle.

The Gamecocks had cut Wisconsin-Milwaukee's lead to 63-58 with 4:32 to go when Theirno Niang hit the team's 13th 3-pointer to give them an eightpoint cushion with under 4 minutes to go.

Kacinas began the final charge in regulation with an inside bucket, Carrera had a putback, and Eric Smith drove in for a layup to make it 66-64 with 1:18 to ao.

After Niang missed a 3-point try, Kacinas found himself with the ball outside the 3-point line and time running down. He got fouled by Kyle Kelm on the long-range attempt and made 2-of-3 free throws to tie the game.

Carrera got things going in overtime with two foul shots as South Carolina moved in front for the first time since early in the opening half. Kacinas followed with two more foul shots before Williams took over.

Williams scored 12 of Carolina's 16 points in overtime. **the Associated Press contributed to this report

#### GAME 2 - SOUTH CAROLINA 87. MORGAN STATE 71 NOV. 16. 2012/COLONIAL LIFE ARENA

COLUMBIA, S.C. - South Carolina (2-0) defeated Morgan State (1-3) 87-71 on Friday night in non-conference action at Colonial Life Arena. Five Gamecocks scored double figures in the match, led by senior guard LaShay Page who scored a game-high 20 points and pulled down five rebounds.

South Carolina junior guards Eric Smith, Brenton Williams and Brian Richardson added 17, 14 and 10 points, respectively, for the Gamecocks. Junior forward R.J. Slawson put up 10 points and brought down seven rebounds and senior forward Lakeem Jackson notched eight points and eight rebounds. Every South Carolina player that registered significant minutes tallied at least two boards in the effort as the Gamecocks out-rebounded the Bears 35-22. South Carolina was without freshman forward Michael Carrera, the reigning SEC Freshman of the Week, due to a concussion.

Two junior guards led the Morgan State effort, Justin Black, who scored 20 points and Anthony Hubbard with 15. Senior forward DeWayne Jackson added 11 on the night. The Bear's leading rebounder was junior center lan Chiles who came down with five.

Morgan State jumped out to an early lead by capitalizing on chances in transition. The Bears built up a seven-point advantage early in the first half, but could not pull away.

After chipping away at the Morgan State lead, South Carolina tied the game at 22-22. Page ignited a run by jumping on a loose ball and calling timeout to give South Carolina possession. Williams drained a 3-pointer coming out of the timeout to spur a 16-5 Gamecock run. Page added another three and a pair of free throws in the spurt to give the home team an 11-point lead.

The Bears responded with a 10-2 run of their own to pull within three, but could not get any closer. The teams went into the locker room with South Carolina holding a 45-41 advantage

Coming out of the break, Morgan State pulled within one at 45-44 on a threepoint play by Hubbard, but the Gamecocks responded with six unanswered points that included back-to-back buckets by Slawson to firmly take the lead. South Carolina built a 12-point lead midway through the second half and went 9-9 from the free throw line down the stretch to maintain their lead and cruise to a 87-71 win.

#### GAME 3 - SOUTH CAROLINA 88. RIDER 76 NOV. 19. 2012/COLONIAL LIFE ARENA

COLUMBIA, S.C. - South Carolina (3-0) defeated Rider (2-2) 88-76 at Co-Ionial Life Arena on Monday night as a part of the Hoops for Hope Classic. Junior guard Brenton Williams led the way for the Gamecocks with the best stat line of his career. In his 38 minutes of play, Williams scored 22 points, hit 5-8 from behind the arc, pulled down four rebounds and dished out four assists. All numbers were career highs.

Every Gamecock who entered the game scored and four reached double figures on the night. In addition to Williams, freshman forward Mindaugas Kacinas scored a career-high 18 and senior forward Lakeem Jackson dropped 14. Senior guard LaShay Page added 12 points despite missing most of the first half with foul trouble. South Carolina also handed out 22 assists on 32 made baskets. Seven of eight South Carolina players brought down at least two rebounds, led by Jackson with seven and Page with six. COLUMBIA, S.C. -- South Carolina (3-1) fell to Elon (4-1) 65-53 on Wednesday night in non-conference action at Colonial Life Arena. Senior forward Lakeem Jackson led the Gamecocks in the effort with 14 points and 10 rebounds

Junior guard Brenton Williams added nine points for the Gamecocks, Junior guard Brian Richardson and junior forward RJ Slawson each added seven points and eight rebounds. The eight rebounds were a career high for Richardson who also dished out four assists. South Carolina turned the ball over 22 times on the night, leading to 18 Elon points. For the third game in a row, the Gamecocks were without freshman forward Michael Carrera.

Three Elon players scored in double figures. Junior forward Lucas Troutman led the team with 15 points and six rebounds. Junior guard Jack Isenbarger and sophomore guard Austin Hamilton netted 13 points apiece as well. Junior guard Sebastian Koch brought down a team-leading seven rebounds. As a team, Elon shot 53.5% from behind the arc, hitting eight in the matchup.

Despite falling behind 11-3 early and tallying seven turnovers in the first ten minutes, South Carolina kept Elon within striking distance. Senior guard LaShay Page sank a shot from behind the arc at the 10:27 mark to bring the Gamecocks to within three at 18-15, but South Carolina was unable to score for the next eight minutes. The Phoenix scored 10 unanswered points during the stretch to give them a 28-15 upper hand. Sophomore guard Damien Leonard ended the Gamecock dry spell with back-to-back 3-pointers to cut into the Elon lead to seven.

Richardson found Jackson in transition for a bucket with 36 seconds remaining in the half, but Elon's Isenbarger responded with a 3-pointer with three seconds to go, giving the Phoenix a 31-23 advantage going into the locker room

After the break, a Richardson 3-pointer and a free throw by freshman forward Mindaugas Kacinas brought the Gamecocks to within four to start the second half, but the Phoenix responded with two 3s of their own to extend the lead back to 10.

Williams, who scored all nine of his points in the second half, cut the lead to four at 39-35 with 15:29 remaining when he poked the ball away and took it the distance for a dunk. The Gamecocks would not get any closer.

Down 53-37 with 10:42 remaining, South Carolina made one last attempt to rally and set off on a 15-4 run to cut the deficit to five. Jackson scored six points in the stretch, with two of them coming on an emphatic dunk in transition. The spurt forced Elon to call timeout to stop the surging Gamecock momentum. After the timeout, the Phoenix responded with three unanswered baskets, all by Troutman, to again give the Phoenix a double-digit lead at 63-52. Each team made an appearance at the free throw line in the final two minutes and Elon held on for the 65-53 win.

PUERTO VALLARTA, Mexico - South Carolina posted a 74-67 victory over Missouri State in the third round of the Hoops For Hope Classic in Puerto Vallarta, Mexico, on Saturday in non-conference action. In his first contest back after missing three games due to a concussion, freshman forward Michael Carrera hit a 3 as time expired in regulation to send the contest into overtime.

Senior guard LaShav Page led the Gamecocks with 22 points and six rebounds, while junior guard Brian Richardson added 14 points, hitting four 3s in the contest, just one shy of matching his career high. Carrera added 18 points in his return and pulled down five rebounds.

South Carolina committed a season high 25 turnovers in the contest, however, after committing 20 of those in the first half, the Gamecocks were solid through the second half and overtime, posting just five turnovers during the stretch. The Gamecocks outrehounded the Bears 33-29

Marcus Marshall led the Bears with 17 points, while Anthony Downing and Christian Kirk both added 16. Keith Pickens' eight rebounds were a game-high.

After Missouri State took an early 2-0 lead after an administrative technical foul called on Carolina during pre-game warmups, the Bears jumped out to a quick 7-0 lead before a 3 from Richardson halted the stretch at the 17:41 mark.

The Gamecocks responded with a 10-4 run over the course of the next three minutes to take a 13-11 lead on another 3 from Richardson. Back and forth play followed, but the Gamecocks were never able to extend a lead due to several turnovers through the middle part of the half.

Missouri State held a 19-18 advantage near the seven-minute mark, but the Gamecocks continued to battle and Richardson's third 3 of the half tied the contest at 23 with 4:31 remaining before halftime.

Carolina committed five turnovers through the last four minutes of play and Missouri State held a 33-28 lead at the half. The Gamecocks finished the half with just 11 shots attempts, connecting on eight to shoot 72.7 percent in the set.

Page scored two 3s and a lay-up through the first three minutes and 30 seconds of the second half to tie the contest at 38. The teams traded baskets before a lay-up and two free throws from Carrera gave the Gamecocks a 42-40 lead with 13:06 on the clock. After a lay-up from Kirk, Richardson's fourth 3 of the contest pushed the Gamecock

lead to 45-42 with 11:24 remaining in regulation. The teams traded baskets and the contest was tied at 47, before Marshall gave the Bears a three-point advantage at the 7:39 mark

Junior guard Eric Smith earned the assist on a lay-up from Page to tie the contest at 51 with just over six minutes remaining. Two free throws from MSU's Marshall gave the Bears a 53-51 advantage, before Carrera tied the contest at 53 with a hard-fought lay-up with 2:42 on the clock.

Kirk gave MSU a 55-53 lead with 1:25 remaining, before the teams traded missed baskets and the Gamecocks were called for an intentional foul with 33 seconds on the clock. The Bears were only able to hit 1-of-2 from the line to hold a 56-53 lead.

Richardson was called for a foul with 29 seconds remaining and MSU's Williams missed the front end of a 1-and-1 opportunity before Page connected on the opposite end on a jumper to pull the Gamecocks within one at 56-55 with 13 seconds remaining. Marshall connected on two free throws for the Bears at the opposite end with 12.2

seconds on the clock to go up three at 58-55. Smith collected the inbounds pass from freshman forward Mindaugas Kacinas and raced down the floor, finding Carrera just beyond the 3-point line with just seconds remaining.

Carrera faced the basket and shot his first attempt from beyond the arc this season hitting at the buzzer to tie the contest at 58 and force overtime.

The Gamecocks dominated the OT session, out-scoring the Bears 16-9 in the set, including four points from Carrera and seven made free throws from Page to secure the Carolina victory




