GAMECOCKS HEAD TO NCAA WOMEN'S CHAMPIONSHIPS
Two swimmers and one diver will represent the South Carolina swimming and diving program this week at the 2012 NCAA Women's Championships, which run Thursday through Saturday at the James E. Martin Aquatics Center in Auburn, Ala.
Senior diver Courtney Forcucci and sophomore swimmers Amanda Rutqvist and Rachael Schaffer are slated to compete for the Gamecocks, marking the second straight year Carolina has sent three individuals to the NCAA Championships.

## CAROLINA'S HISTORY AT THE NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS

The Gamecocks have now sent at least one student-athlete to 11 straight NCAA Championships and 27 overall. Carolina's best finish was a 10th-place showing at the 1989 national championships. The program has produced six top-25 finishes since joining the SEC in 1992, including an 11th-place finish in 2004. Former Gamecock diver Allison Brennan is the only Carolina individual national champion as she won the one-meter title at the 2004 championships.

## RECAPPING THE 2012 SEC CHAMPIONSHIPS

The Gamecocks wrapped up the SEC Championships in eighth place in both the men and women's competition at the Allan Jones Aquatic Center in Knoxville, Tenn. On the week the Gamecocks posted 30 provisional qualifying times, won three medals, broke two school records and set one SEC record. Carolina had a stellar week on the boards led by senior Courtney Forcucci. The Fort Mill, S.C., native won gold on the three-meter springboard with a SEC record 392.4 points. She also claimed bronze in the one-meter competition and scored points with a 10th-place showing on the platform.

Freshman Cole Miller had a solid SEC debut as he finished fifth on the platform and sixth on the threemeter board.

In the swimming events, sophomore Amanda Rutqvist led the way with a silver medal in the 200-yard breaststroke with a NCAA provisional qualifying time of 2:09.48. The Carolina women's 200 -yard medley relay team of Matea Peteh, Rutqvist, Meghan Brockington and Rachel Elliott broke the school record with a time of 1:41.38.

## KEEPING THE TRADITION ALIVE

Under the direction of diving coach Todd Sherritt, the Gamecocks have had great success on the boards at both the SEC and NCAA Championships, and senior diver Courtney Forcucci added to Carolina's Iong list of diving accomplishments in 2012. The Fort Mill, S.C., native won gold on the three-meter springboard at SECs with a SEC and school record of 392.40 . She also claimed bronze on the one-meter board at SECs with a score of 324.20 . Forcucci finished second on the three-meter at the NCAA Zone Championships with a 12-dive school record of 670.75 to earn a berth to the NCAA Championships. She also placed runner-up at the Zone meet in the one-meter competition with a career-best 12-dive score of 590.35 .

## GAMECOCKS END REGULAR SEASON WITH SWEEP OF ECU, VANDERBILT

South Carolina closed out the regular season in dominant fashion with a sweep of East Carolina and Vanderbilt on Senior Day at the Blatt P.E. Center/Carolina Natatorium.

The Gamecock women defeated Vanderbilt, 187-122, and East Carolina, 180.5-140.5, while the South Carolina men topped East Carolina 186-152. South Carolina won nine of the first 11 events before taking exhibition times in the last nine events to conclude the two-day dual meet.

The South Carolina women finish the year at 7-3 overall and 2-2 in the SEC to give them back-to-back winning seasons for the first time since 1994-95. The Gamecock men are now 5-4 on the season and 0-3 in the conference, giving them back-to-back winning seasons for the first time since 1993-94.

The Gamecocks picked up where they left off on Friday as they got off to a strong start, winning both the women and men's 200-yard medley relay.

The South Carolina women's team of Matea Peteh, Amanda Rutqvist, Lauren Raczkowski and Rachel Elliott swam a 1:48.34 to take first, while the Gamecock men's team of Jay Warner, Andrew Seiler, Isaac Badillo and Collin Kaden claimed first with a time of 1:31.99.
The diving corps came up big for the Gamecocks for the second-straight day, winning the women's threemeter and men's one-meter springboards. Senior Courtney Forcucci capped her Gamecock dual-meet career with a first-place score of 351.38 in the three-meter competition. Forcucci has recorded wins in all but two events in dual meets for South Carolina this season. Freshman Patricia Kranz posted an exhibition score of 320.55. In the men's competition, junior Rylan Ridenour followed up Friday's record-breaking three-meter performance with a stellar effort on the one-meter board as he placed first with a score of 382.58. Freshman Cole Miller took second with a score of 341.93 .

South Carolina had a solid day in the distance events, as freshman Brooke Obeck swam a personal best of 17:13.90 to cruise to a win the women's 1,650-yard freestyle. Teammate Sara Columbus took second with a career-best time of 17:35.95. In the men's 1,000-yard freestyle, Gamecocks junior Brooks Ross touched first with a time of 9:29.78, followed by teammates Matt Columbus (9:33.24) and Dan Jackson (9:47.99).

Seiler won his first 50 -yard freestyle race of the season with a time of 20.94, while Warner gave the Gamecock men a first-place finish in the 100-yard backstroke with a time of 51.63. Sophomore Maryn Bieganski swam a personal best of 59.14 to finish second in the women's race.

Sophomore Rachael Schaffer recorded South Carolina's last win of the meet with a time of 2:22.87 in the women's 200-yard breaststroke.

## CAROLINA SWEPT AT GEORGIA

The South Carolina swimming and diving teams dropped a pair of decisions at Georgia in a SEC dual meet at Gabrielsen Natatorium. The Carolina women fell to No. 1 Georgia, 177-112, to drop to 5-3 overall and 1-2 in the SEC. In the men's competition, the Gamecocks lost to the ninth-ranked Bulldogs, 180-112, to fall to 4-4 on the season and 0-3 in the conference.

Senior Diver Courtney Forcucci led the way with wins on both the one and three-meter springboards, while junior Rylan Ridenour finished first on the three-meter board and second in the one-meter competition. Sophomore Rachael Schaffer ( 200 IM ) and sophomore Meghan Brockington (100 butterfly) had the Ione wins for the Gamecock women, while junior Bobby Cave (200 IM) and sophomore Jay Warner (200 backstroke) each had a first-place showing for the Carolina men.

## GAMECOCKS OPENS 2012 WITH SWEEP OF DUKE, QUEENS

After going almost two months without a team competition, the South Carolina swimming and diving teams didn't show any signs of rust on Saturday in their return from winter break. The Gamecocks put together one of their best performances of the season as they swept Duke and Queens University of Charlotte at the Blatt P.E. Center/Carolina Natatorium.

The Carolina women defeated Duke, 170-127, and Queens, 254-39, to improve to 5-2 on the year. On the men's side, the Gamecocks topped the Blue Devils, 170-130, and Queens, 222-66, to move to 4-3 overall.

On the day the Gamecocks recorded 20 first-place finishes in 32 events. Senior diver Courtney Forcucci, junior diver Rylan Ridenour and sophomore swimmers Gerard Rodriguez, Matt Navata and Rachael Schaffer collected two wins apiece to lead the Gamecocks. South Carolina head coach McGee Moody was impressed with his team's strong start to 2012.

## GAMECOCKS HAVE STRONG SHOWING AT NIKE CUP INVITATIONAL

The Gamecock women finish third and the men fourth at the 2011 Nike Cup Invitational on Nov. 17-19 in Chapel Hill, N.C. Carolina achieved eight NCAA provisional qualifying times and posted numerous personal best times during the week.

Sophomore Rachael Schaffer led the way, achieving NCAA provisional qualifying times in the 200 breaststroke, 200 IM and 400 IM . Sophomore Amanda Rutqvist swam B cuts in the 100 and 200 breaststroke, and sophomore Abby Galbreath also recorded a B cut time in the 400 IM . On the boards, senior Courtney Forcucci finished first and second, respectively, on the one and three-meter springboards, while junior Rylan Ridenour finished second in both events in the men's competition.

## CAROLINA FALLS TO TENNESSEE

Despite several strong performances, South Carolina dropped both the men and women's meets against Tennessee. The Gamecock men fell to the Vols, 167-132, while the Carolina women lost to the Lady Vols, 174-124. The Gamecocks tallied 13 wins in 32 events, including two apiece from senior diver Courtney

## GAMECOCKS SWEEP RIVAL CLEMSON IN LAST-EVER MEETING

The South Carolina swimming and diving teams swept rival Clemson last Saturday in the programs' last-ever meeting. The Gamecock men claimed a 162-137 victory to improve to 2-2 on the season, while the Carolina women won 191-108 to move to 3-1 overall.
The Gamecocks won 19 of the 32 events on the day, including two wins apiece from sophomores Rachael Schaffer and Amanda Rutqvist and juniors Matea Peteh and Bobby Cave.

Senior Courtney Forcucci won both the one and three-meter events with scores of 322.13 and 344.55. Reigning SEC Male Diver of the Week Rylan Ridenour swept the men's boards as he won the one-meter event with a score of 350.62 and the three-meter springboard with a score of 366.22 .

Sophomore Abby Galbreath captured the women's 1,000 free with a time of $10: 24.53$, followed by teammates Lindsey OIson (10:26.35), Jordan Gibbs (10:26.35) and Charlotte Ward (10:52.86). Junior Brooks Ross claimed the top spot in the men's 1,000 freestyle in a time of $9: 29.31$, while junior Matt Columbus finished second in $9: 35.61$. Schaffer grabbed first in the 500 free with a time of $5: 04.65$, with teammate Annika Jonsson finishing second in a time of 5:05.91. In the men's 500 freestyle, Columbus picked up the win with a time of 4:39.01, followed by Ross (4:29.02) and sophomore Gerard Rodriguez (4:39.60).

Schaffer earned her second win of the day in the 200 freestyle with a time of $1: 53.26$, while Rodriguez finished first for Carolina in the men's event with a time of 1:40.97

Peteh swept the backstroke events as she won the 100 with a time of 58.05 and the 200 in a time of 2:03.65.

The Gamecocks won all four breaststroke events. Rutqvist finished first in the women's 100 and 200 breaststroke with times of 1:04.98 and 2:20.12, respectively. Cave won the men's events with a time of 57.88 in the 100 and 2:05.57 in the 200.

## CAROLINA SWEEPS GEORGIA TECH IN HOME OPENER

The South Carolina swimming and diving teams turned in a dominating performance en route to a sweep of Georgia Tech in their home opener at the Blatt P.E. Center/Carolina Natatorium.

The Gamecock women (2-1) defeated the Yellow Jackets, 176-122, while the Carolina men (1-2) cruised to a 179.5-116.5 victory. On the day, the Gamecocks recorded an impressive 25 wins out of the 32 events.

The Carolina diving corps gave the Gamecocks plenty of momentum heading into the swimming events by sweeping the boards. Senior Courtney Forcucci won both the one and three-meter springboards with NCAA Zone qualifying scores of 295.35 and 343.20 . On the men's boards, junior Rylan Ridenour posted a Zone qualifying score of 387.75 to win the one-meter springboard. Miller also won the three-meter event with a Zone score of 380.77 .

On the women's side, junior Matea Peteh was a part of three wins. She claimed first in the 100 and 200 backstroke with career best times of 57.22 and 2:02.73, respectively.

Sophomore Matt Navata had a strong showing for the Gamecock men with a win in the 200 butterfly with a time of 1:53.38 and a second-place finish in the 200 backstroke with a time of 1:52.81.

The Gamecocks also had a stellar day in the distance events as they claimed the top two spots in the men and women's 500 freestyle and the men's 1,000 freestyle and the top three spots in the women's 1,000 freestyle.
The Gamecocks took the top three spots in the men's 100 backstroke, as Heinze led the way with a time of 50.75 .

Carolina swept the breaststroke events, as Rutqvist claimed both the women's 100 and 200 breaststroke races with times of 1:05.03 and 2:17.81, respectively. Cave won both events on the men's side with times of 57.73 and 2:05.91. Also collecting wins for the Gamecocks were Badillo in the 100 butterfly (49.56), Schaffer in the women's 200 IM (2:04.85) and Collin Kaden in the men's 200 IM (1:53.39).

## WOMEN SPLIT, MEN FALL IN TRI-MEET WITH FSU, ALABAMA

The South Carolina swimming and diving teams opened the 2011-12 season in a challenging tri-meet at Florida State against the Seminoles and Alabama at the Morcom Aquatics Center last Saturday.

The Gamecock women pulled out a thrilling 151-149 victory over the Crimson Tide but fell to Florida State, 201.50-93.50. The Carolina men lost to the Seminoles, 199-101, and dropped a 171-129 decision to Alabama.

Sophomore Rachael Schaffer helped the Gamecocks clinch the win over Alabama as she claimed first in the 200 IM with a time of 2:04.58.

On the men's side, the Gamecocks had several strong performances despite the losses. Freshman Alex Vance had a memorable start to his Gamecock career, winning the 200 breaststroke and claiming third in the 100 breaststroke with times of 2:04.29 and 58.15, respectively.


# McGee Moody Head Swimming Coach 

 Fifth Year at South CarolinaA proven leader in the coaching profession, McGee Moody is in his fifth season as the head swimming coach at the University of South Carolina. He and his staft continue to build the South Carolina program and strive toward the elite level of the sport through effective training methods and tireless recruiting efforts.

In his five seasons at the helm, Moody has overseen a successful stretch for the Carolina swimming and diving program. This season, the Carolina women went 7-3 overall, giving them back-to-back winning seasons for the first time since 1994-95. The Gamecock men went 5-4 on the season to give them back-toback winning seasons for the first time since 1993-94.

Last season, the Gamecock men equaled the school record for wins in a single season, finishing with a 10-1 dual-meet record. The Carolina women also finished with a winning record for the first time since 2002, posting a 7-6 dual-meet mark.

His first three seasons saw gradual improvements. The 2009-10 season was a bit of a rebuilding year, but highlights included freshman Michael Flach's bronze-medal performance in the 500 freestyle at the SEC Championships. In 2008-09, the Gamecock women finished with a . 500 dual meet record for the first time since 2005 and won five meets for the first time since 2002. The women also earned their highest SEC Championships finish in three years. The Carolina men, meanwhile, sent two swimmers - Nick Walkotten and Kyle Cormier - to the NCAA Championships and earned a 29th-place national finish, the best for a Carolina squad since 2005. Combined, the Carolina men and women turned in 23 NCAA provisional qualifying times and broke 14 school records.

It wasn't an easy beginning for the East Carolina graduate, but Moody made great strides with the South Carolina program in his initial season on the Horseshoe. Despite arriving on campus only a month

home country of Trinidad \& Tobago in the 2008 Summer Olympics in Beijing. In addition, then-rising senior Nicholas Walkotten competed at the Short Course World Championships.

Moody spent three years at William \& Mary, where his teams achieved 559 lifetime best swims, 301 alltime Tribe top-10 performances, 46 school records and 18 gold medals at the Colonial Athletic Association Championships. The Tribe swimming program also excelled academically. The women received Academic All-America honors in each semester under Moody's tutelage.

In 2007, Moody earned the conference's Coach of the Year honor after leading his women's team ( $8-4$, $6-2$ CAA) to the first Colonial Athletic Association Championship in the program's 80 -year history with a record-tying 12 gold medals. In doing so, the squad swept the conference awards by winning Performer of the Meet, Swimmer of the Year and Rookie of the Year. The men's program finished with a winning record ( $6-3-1,5-2-1$ CAA) for the first time since 1998-99, and finished fourth a the conference meet behind a pair of runner-up performances and a host of bronze medals.

In 2005-06, the Tribe women's team improved upon its fourth-place conference finish in 2005 by taking second, passing George Mason on the final day of the CAA Championships. During the season, the women were even more impressive, posting a 10-4 ledger ( $8-1 \mathrm{CAA}$ ), to set the school record for conference wins in a season. In the conference, their only blemish was against eventual champion UNC Wilmington. The men also experienced improvement, achieving five dual-meet wins for the first time since 1999 and posting a. 500 mark (4-4) in the conference. They also improved on their result at the conference championship, riding a bevy of personal records in the last two days to a fifth-place finish.
Moody spent four seasons as an assistant men's swimming coach at the United States Naval Academy. During his tenure at Navy, Moody coached the Midshipmen's first NCAA automatic qualifier since 1996 in addition to guiding numerous NCAA, Senior National and Olympic Trial qualifiers. His 200 and 400 freestyle relay teams finished the season ranked in the top 25 of the world. Moody also made an impact in the Navy record book, with his athletes setting all of the top-10 fastest times in school history in both the 50 and 100 freestyles. Building his athletes into academic success stories as well, Navy's men's swimming team was awarded Academic All-America honors all three seasons from 2001-2004 under Moody's direction.

Moody got his coaching start a t his alma mater, East Carolina University. He was the top assistant swim coach for both men and women for the Pirates from 1996-2000. While working in nearly every facet of the program at East Carolina, Moody coached over 25 varsity record holders.

A 1998 graduate of East Carolina, Moody swam on the Pirates' varsity squad for four seasons, setting several freshman records and captaining the team his junior and senior years. Moody was also an Olympic Trials qualifier in the 200 freestyle in 1992.
Moody, who earned both a bachelor's degree in psychology and master's in sports administration from ECU, is an active professional in the swimming community. He also served in the United States Navy, attaining the rank of Lieutenant. A member of both the American Swimming Coaches Association and the College Swimming Coaches Association of America, he has served as the chair of the latter's Media Relations Committee since 2001. He and his wife, Monica, have four daughters: Sydney (10), Olivia (7), Lily (4) and Whitney (2).

Success and Todd Sherritt go hand in hand. Beginning his 19th season as the head diving coach for South Carolina, Sherritt continues to set new standards for Gamecock diving and has established the program as one of the best in the country.

One of the most influential diving coaches in the country, Sherrith has coached 35 NCAA All-Americans, 15 U.S. Diving National Champions, three Olympians, 10 SEC Champions and one NCAA Champion. In 1999, he was named SEC Diving Coach of the Year and, in 1997, he was named USOC Developmental Diving Coach of the Year. Sherritt is also an 10-time World Team Coach for Team USA, including during 2007.

Sherrith has continued to produce greats in the Garnet and Black, most recently Taryn Zack, who earned the 10th SEC Championship for the Carolina diving program in 2011. Zack took the title on the 1-meter board at the 2011 SEC Championships, earning her second gold medal at the league meet. Zack also earned accolades out of the pool as she was named the SEC Scholar-Athlete of the Year for swimming \& diving, and she was named a Capital One Academic All-American by the College Sports Information Directors of America, just the second in the history of Carolina swimming \& diving.

As a junior, Zack finished seventh at the NCAA Championships in the three-meter event to earn her third All-America honor. She earned her first All-America honor in 2008 as a freshman as she took eighth place on the three-meter board. In addition, an 11th-place finish in the one-meter event that season earned her a nod for Honorable Mention All-American. In her sophomore season, Zack continued her incredible success by winning her first conference title, taking the gold medal in the 1-meter competition at the SEC Championship.

Also in 2009, another pupil of Sherritt's, current Gamecock assistant coach Allison Brennan, captured gold at the USA Diving Grand Prix in the 3-meter event, beating outa pair of 2008 Olympic medalists to take top honors. Recently under Sheritits guidance, Brennan finished sixth in the world at the World Championships held in Australia in 2007. She also won the 3-meter title at the 2006 U.S. National Championships and placed seventh at the 2006 World Cup in Chengshu, China that same year. Brennan joins Sherritt this year as an assistant coach atter a third-place finish at the 2008 Olympic Trials. Brennan was the 2004 NCAA Champion on the one-meter board, the first individual national champion for the South Carolina swimming and diving program. She also was the 2006 SEC Champion on the one-meter and three-meter boards, and set the school record on the three-meter.

The 2003-04 season was a stellar year for Gamecock diving as USC took four divers to the NCAA Championships, and in addition to Brennan, Andy Bradley recorded his second consecutive national runner-up performance on the one-meter board at the NCAA Championships. In 2003, Bradley was the runner-up at the U.S. Championships as well. Internationally, Tracey Richardson found success as she earned a spot at the 2004 Olympics on the Great Britain National Team and competed on the three-meter
board. Brennan and Bradley qualified for the U.S. Olympic Trials. Other standouts included All-Americans Lauren King (2003-05) and Holly Hodges (2001-05).
Sherritt's international coaching stints include serving as the head coach for Team USA in the 2000 FINA World Grand Prix in Rodstock, Germany. In 1999, he was selected as the World Cup coach for the United States in Wellington, New Zealand, and he was a World University coach for the U.S. in Mallarco, Spain in July of the same year. Most recently, he served as the team leader for Team USA at the China Open in 2008.

In 1998-99, Sherritt helped lead one of South Carolina's most decorated divers, Michelle Davison, to new heights. Davison won two SEC titles and was named SEC Diver of the Year, en route to finishing fouth and fifth on the one- and three-meter boards respectively at the NCAA Championships. That year, Sherritt was named SEC Women's Diving Coach of the Year.

Sheritits first Olympic opportunity came in 1996 with Gamecock standout Vivian Alberty. The 1995 one-meter SEC Champion finished her career at USC as a four-time All-American and in 1996 competed for Puerto Rico at the Olympics in Atlanta.

In addition to athletics, Sherritt's divers have excelled outside of the pool as well. Holly Hodges was a recipient of the SEC Community Service Post-Graduate Scholarship in 2004-05. Cheryl Lemon was named USC's Female Student Athlete of the Year in 2000 , while Chad Sheldon and Lemon were named to the SEC Honor Roll in 1998. Brandon Hulko was named USC Male Student-Athlete of the Year in 2002, and Taryn Zack was South Carolina's Scholar-Athlete of the Year in 2011.

A native of Cincinnati, Ohio, Sherritt founded South Carolina Divers in 1982, a University of South Carolina based age group diving team. Sheritit received a B.S. degree in physical education from the University of Cinciinnati in 1982.

Sherritt has two daughters, 21 -year-old Amber and 2-year-old Hannah. His wife's name is Kara.
