NO. 2 GAMECOCKS HOST FOURTH ANNUAL DARIUS RUCKER INTERCOLLEGIATE

South Carolina women's golf is set to host the fourth annual Darius Rucker Intercollegiate in Hilton Head Island, S.C. Known as one of the premiere events in collegiate golf, play is set to begin on Friday. The 54-hole event runs through Sunday on the Pete Dye Course at Long Cove Club, which features a par-71, 6,142-yard layout.

THE LINEUP

Senior Justine Dreher is in the lineup's top spot. Dreher is followed by junior Sarah Schmelzel, sophomore Katelyn Dambaugh, junior Mary Fran Hillow and sophomore Jia Xin Yang. Freshman Ainhoa Olarra will play as an individual after making her debut in the lineup at the spring opener.

HISTORY AT THE DARIUS RUCKER INTERCOLLEGIATE

After finishing eighth in the inaugural Darius Rucker Intercollegiate in 2012 and 11th the following season, the Gamecocks posted their best finish at Long Cove last season, taking fifth. Justine Dreher was the top finisher for South Carolina in 2014, tying for 12th with a 54-hole total of 219 (76-71-72, +6)

BREAKING DOWN THE FIELD

On a run of 12-straight regular-season top-5 finishes, the Gamecocks face a stiff test at their home event. The field of 17 accounts for 11 of the last 14 NCAA champions and features 12 of the top 20 teams in this week's Golfstat Relative Rankings. Ten of the nation's top 15 individuals will also be on display at Long Cove. After falling to just three opponents all of last fall, South Carolina finished fourth at the Florida State Match-Up to open the spring. This weekend, the Gamecocks will face all three teams – Furman, Virginia and Mississippi State – that bested them three weeks ago in Tallahassee. All six teams that have finished ahead of South Carolina during the 2014-15 season will be at the event.

LAST TIME OUT

The Gamecocks opened their spring schedule with a fourth-place finish at the Florida State Match-Up to extend their streak of regular-season top-five finishes to 12, dating back to September of 2013. In Tallahassee, Dreher posted her third top-five individual result of the season, carding rounds of 72-72-73=217 (+1) to finish tied for fifth and recorded the first eagle of South Carolina's spring. Schmelzel returned from an injury that kept her out for the entirety of the fall season to post a top-10 finish at the event, finishing just one stroke behind Dreher at 2-over.

FALL RECAP

During the best fall in program history, South Carolina reached the No. 1 spot on both the Golfweek/Sagarin and Golfstat Relative Rankings for the first time ever before finishing the year ranked No. 2 in both rankings behind Washington. The Gamecocks started the season with a head-turning win at the ANNIKA Intercollegiate, which boasted the toughest field of the regular season, before posting a runner-up finish at the Tar Heel Invitational. South Carolina returned to the top at the Mercedes-Benz Collegiate before wrapping up the fall with a third-place result at the Landfall Tradition. In four fall starts, the Gamecocks posted two wins and did not fall out of the top three. Golfweek named South Carolina its team of the week twice during the first half of the season. The 54-hole scores from the Gamecocks four fall events all rank in top 10 in program history.

GOING LOW

Nearly half (26 of 58) of the Gamecocks' individual rounds in the fall season were at par or better. The total includes Hillow's program record 65 at the Mercedes-Benz Collegiate Championships (Oct. 19, 2014) and three rounds of 68 – two from Dreher at the ANNIKA Intercollegiate and one from Dambaugh at the Tar Heel Invitational.

STROKE STORY

Dreher posted a 71.92 stroke average last fall to lead the Gamecocks into the spring. The senior All-American is tied with junior teammate Sarah Schmelzel for third in the program's career scoring average (min. 55 rounds) at 74.30.

NEW GROUND

The Gamecocks returned to the No. 1 spot in the Golfweek/Sagarin and assumed the top spot in the Golfstat Relative Rankings for the first time ever after their win at the Mercedes-Benz Championship. After finishing the season behind top-ranked Washington, the Gamecocks retook the No. 1 spot in the Golfstat Relative Rankings in February after the Huskies posted a sixth-place finish in their first spring tournament. The pair have exchanged spots once again, with Washington back at the No. 1 spot in this week's rankings.

WHO'S BACK

Three of the five golfers from the Gamecocks' core lineup in 2013-14, including Dreher and sophomore All-SEC honoree Katelyn Dambaugh, return. Junior Sarah Schmelzel, an SEC All-Freshman selection in the 2012-13 season, is back as well after missing the fall with an injury. Nearly every returning player has been in the Gamecock lineup at some point in her career.

AMONG THE ELITE

Climbing as high as No. 4, South Carolina finished last season at No. 6 in the Golfstat rankings. The team finished in the top six at every regular-season tournament and registered nine straight top-five finishes for the first time in program history. A pair of wins at the Florida State Match-Up and PING ASU Invitational as well as runner-up finishes at the SEC Championship and NCAA East Regional also highlighted the season.

INTERNATIONAL SUMMER

Justine Dreher and Team France captured the European Ladies Amateur Team crown in Slovenia, defeating England, Spain and Finland. Dreher went undefeated at the match play event.

UP NEXT FOR THE GAMECOCKS

South Carolina travels to Athens, Ga., for the Liz Murphey Intercollegiate Mar. 27-29.
