## Last Time Out

South Carolina's bench was more than prepared on Sunday afternoon as its 42 points, including all 30 of the second half, helped down Presbyterian 52-24 at Colonial Life Arena. Freshman Tina Roy enjoyed her coming out party as she paced the offense with 15 points on five 3-pointers. Junior Ashley Bruner turned in her first double-double of the season with 10 points and 11 rebounds. Defensively, the Gamecocks were just as good, tying a school record by holding the Blue Hose to just 24 points. The 11 points by Presbyterian in the second half is the new South Carolina record as well.

## Xavier Series Notes

The Musketeers lead the series 2-0 after last season's 84-65 outcome in the last season's opener at Colonial Life Arena. South Carolina's Ashley Bruner turned in her first career double-double in that game, adding 17 points to her 15 rebounds against then-No. 5/6 Xavier. The only other meeting between the two teams was a 70-65 Xavier overtime victory in the WNIT on March 17, 2006.

South Carolina head coach has a much longer history with the Musketeers thanks to her eight seasons at Temple, an Atlantic 10 Conference rival of Xavier. Routinely among the league's top two teams, Staley held a 7-4 edge over the Musketeers.

## Road Warriors

South Carolina has a 181-230 (.440) alltime record on the road. The Gamecocks' best season on the road was 1979-80 when they went 11-4. Under head coach Dawn Staley, South Carolina is 12-21 in road games. In her 11th season as a head coach, Staley has a 74-67 road record.

NCAA released its statistical rankings for the first time this season. The Gamecocks are fifth in the nation (first in the SEC) in scoring defense, yielding just 45.3 points per game this season. In fact, no team has scored more than 55 points on Carolina so far. Much of that low scoring may be attributed to the Gamecocks' ability to defend the 3-point shot, a category in which they rank 11th in the nation (first in the SEC) with opponents hitting just 19.0 percent from beyond the arc. And, finally, South Carolina is 20th in the country (third in the SEC) in turnover margin at +7.8 . The Gamecocks have forced at least 20 turnovers in four of their six games this season while only committing 20 or more turnovers once.

## For Starters

South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley has started the same five Gamecocks in each game this season and has always liked the idea of bringing an offensive weapon off the bench. That strategy seems to be working to full effect this season as 52.1 percent of the Gamecocks' scoring has come from someone not in the starting five. It is the highest percentage of bench scoring in Staley's tenure at South Carolina - in 2010-11, the bench netted 36.7 percent of the team's points, in 2009-10, it was 27.5 percent, and in her inaugural season of 2008-09 it was 29.0 percent. The delay tactic has not slowed the Gamecocks' production in the early going as they have been in the lead in all every game in the opening five minutes.

## Exploring Diversity

Throughout the preseason, head coach Dawn Staley talked about the versatility of her team as a key to the season's success. So far, the Gamecocks' ability to get points from various locations has delivered the program's best opening record since 2003-04. In six games, five different players have led the team in scoring - Ashley Bruner (2), Markeshia Grant (1), Tina Roy (1), Charenee Stephens (1) and Ieasia Walker (1).

## Helping Hand

With arguably the best point guard in international women's basketball history at the helm, South Carolina has been at its best when its assist numbers are highest. In the Dawn Staley era (2008-09 through present), the Gamecocks are $36-15$ when handing out 10 or more assists, including a $4-0$ mark this season. When missing the 10 -assist plateau, South Carolina is just 12-35 overall with Staley, including a 4-20 mark in SEC action. That overall record includes this season's 1-1 ledger.

## Triple Play

Coming into the season, may observers felt the fate of the Gamecocks' season rested largely in the hands of its experienced backcourt - seniors Markeshia Grant and La'Keisha Sutton and junior Ieasia Walker. Through the first six games, that has certainly been the case as between their points and assists, the trio has contributed to 61.3 percent of the team's 59.5 points per game.

The trio's camaraderie on and off the floor has bred friendly competition specifically between the two seniors, designed to ultimately guide the team to its goals. After Sutton led the team with 3.6 assists per game last season, Grant has set her sights on unseating her classmate in the assist department.

Sutton is currently leading the friendly competition with 22 assists -3.7 per game to rank 12th in the SEC. Grant has the edge in efficiency, however, with a 2.1 assist-to-turnover ratio. Meanwhile, Walker leads the scoring battle as her 7.7 points per game are second-best on the team.

## Not So Fast

While the backcourt got all the attention leading into the season, a member of the Gamecock frontcourt leads the team in scoring as junior Ashley Bruner's 11.2 points per game includes four double-digit outings and ranks among the top 30 averages in the SEC. Additionally, she ranks 12th in the league in field goal percentage (.527).

Particularly when it comes to the assist battle in the backcourt, South Carolina's forwards will be counted on to deliver the basket at the end of those passes. That ability was especially on display in the second half against Alabama A\&M when Bruner and freshman Aleighsa Welch netted 15 of the team's 30 points. The duo finished the night with 27 of the Gamecocks' 60 points and handed out three assists of their own. Bruner also matched her career high with four steals in the outing.

The six forwards on the South Carolina roster have accounted for 45.0 percent of the team's 59.5 points per game - Bruner 11.2 ppg , Charenee Stephens 5.3 ppg, Aleighsa Welch 6.0 ppg, Elem Ibiam 3.0 ppg, Courtney Newton 1.3 and Pamela Decheva 0.0.

## Noting November

The Gamecocks are 74-39 (.655) all-time in the month of November, including a 37-10 (.787) record at home. Under head coach Dawn Staley, South Carolina is 12-10 in the first month of basketball season. The Gamecocks went 3-2 in Staley's first year at the helm (2008-09), were 3-3 in 2009-10 and posted a 2-4 mark last season. The team is currently 5-1 this month.

## On the Horizon

Head coach Dawn Staley inked four players in the early signing period. Below is a brief look at each of the future Gamecocks.

- Tiffany Davis (Houston, Texas/Westbury Christian) is a 5 -foot-8 point guard rated the 29th in the 2012 class at that position. Before transferring to Westbury Christian, she helped Westside High to the 2011 District 20-5A championship game. Davis earned all-region and first-team all-district honors as a junior, netting 16.0 points per game.
- Asia Dozier (Columbia, S.C./Spring Valley) is a 5 -foot-11 guard who helped Spring Valley to state championships in 2009 and 2011. Rated the 34th-best guard in the 2012 class and a four-star player by ESPN Hoop/Gurlz, Dozier averaged 17.1 ppg and 3.8 apg as a junior as the Lady Vikings went 29-0. As a freshman, her 18.3 ppg and 3.8 apg earned her Class 4A Area Player of the Year honors from The State newspaper. Her father, Perry, and uncle Terry Dozier also played basketball for the Gamecocks.
- Tina Mitchell (Charlotte, N.C./Providence Day) is a 5 -foot-10 guard who is rated among the top 50 players in the 2012 class by ESPN Hoop/Gurlz. She earned South Charlotte player of the year honors and was an Associated Press All-State selection after averaging 18.4 points, 6.9 rebounds, 4.2 steals and 3.9 assists as a junior. She guided the Chargers to 21 straight wins in 201011, including the program's second-straight NCISAA state title.
- Khadijah Sessions (Myrtle Beach, S.C./ Myrtle Beach) is a 5 -foot-6 point guard rated the seventh-best in the class at her position by ESPN Hoop/Gurlz. The 40thranked player overall, she averaged 17.9 points and 5.7 assists as a junior while leading the Seahawks to their secondstraight AAA state championship. A member of the all-state team, Sessions also captured all-region honors last season.


## Preseason Props

SEC Coaches voted two Gamecocks to the Preseason All-SEC team last week as senior La’Keisha Sutton and junior Ieasia Walker earned spots on the second team. The pair of guards accounted for 38.2 percent of the team's scoring last season and handed out 54.0 percent of the assists.

## Strength of Schedule

After finishing the 2010-11 campaign with the nation's 19th-toughest schedule, the Gamecocks are facing another challenging slate in 2011-12. With both the Associated Press and USA Today/ESPN Coaches preseason polls released this week, South Carolina will play seven games against nationally ranked teams. Another five games will be against teams that also received votes in one or both polls.

Seventeen of the Gamecocks' 29 games this season will be against teams that participated in the 2011 postseason, including nine who were in the NCAA Tournament. Of the 24 opponents on the schedule, eight finished the 2010-11 season with an RPI in the top 50 . Six others closed with an RPI between 51 and 100 .
